

Monitoring of Xenophobia and Extremism in Ukraine April 2016

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Introduction

The country has received a new government, which should solve a number of strategic objectives for the exit of Ukraine's economic and political crises. Defense Minister Stepan Poltorak and Foreign Minister Pavlo Klimkin were not changed. Protracted debates about the coalition and the division of ministerial portfolios influenced economic situation in the country. Against the backdrop of political instability negotiations on financial assistance were almost stopped, while international donors started to revise their forecasts for Ukraine's economy. Odessa Governor Mikhail Saakashvili urged President Petro Poroshenko to deploy in Odessa National Guard because of the night attack on the "Antimayor Maidan".

Famous journalist Savik Shuster's permission to work in Ukraine was canceled. The reason of cancellation of the work permit for Schuster was the letter of the criminal proceedings against the broadcaster. Few days late the permission was renewed. However, it is still not clear who and why needed that.

Crimea Supreme Court recognized Mejlis of the Crimean Tatars an extremist organization and banned its activities on the peninsula and in Russia.

Politically, the issue of releasing Ukrainian officer Nadia Savchenko resolved. Russian commandos Eugene Yerofeyev and Alexander Alexandrov were sentenced to 14 years with confiscation of property.

OSCE Mission announces record number of attacks since September 2015 in the Donetsk area. According to the Chairman of the Special OSCE monitoring mission in Ukraine Ertugrul Apakan, the mission is particularly concerned about the use of heavy weapons and artillery. In addition, because of the constant shelling cities can not restore the infrastructure.

Prognosis

Russia Drops Out of EU'S Top Three Trading Partners, 01.04.2016

Russia's share in trade with the European Union dramatically reduced last year, pushing the country out of the top three main trading partners of the EU, the European statistics agency Eurostat reported. According to data from Eurostat, the Russian share in the total volume of EU trade dropped to 6 percent or 210 billion euros (\$238 billion). It has been decreasing since 2013, Eurostat said. Meanwhile the share of the United States — the EU's biggest partner — accounted for 18 percent or 619 billion euros (\$702 billion). The U.S. is followed by China, whose share totaled 15 percent or 521 billion euros (\$591 billion) and Switzerland with 7 percent — 253 billion euro (\$287 billion). Dutch referendum says No with 61.1%, turnout 32.2%: preliminary count over, 07.04.2016

Reliminary results of the voting say it's 38.1% of Yes votes against 61.1% of votes opposing the Association Agreement, with another 0.8% of the ballots recognized as void. The final results of the referendum will be announced on April 12. The Dutch government is yet to decide on ratification of the Ukraine-EU Association Agreement given the non-binding nature of the referendum, which is advisory to the authorities.

Dutch Prime Minister Mark Rutte said the government would analyze step by step what its response should be to the outcome of the referendum, adding that he will consult with the EU partners and the Dutch parliament. Number of crimes in Kyiv rose by 45% – National Police, 13.04.2016

"Analyzing the situation, I can say that there are a number of problems requiring special attention. We are concerned about the increase in the number of certain types of crime: robberies, thefts from vehicles and GTA. Therefore, we must develop an integrated approach to stabilize the crime situation," Dekanoidze said at the meeting of the General Directorate of the National Police of Ukraine. In turn, Chief of Kyiv Police Andriy Krysnchenko spoke about the growth trends of certain crimes. "During the last three years, we have actually recorded growth in numbers of certain offenses. We have repeatedly talked about the reasons: the Anti-Terrorist Operation, socio-economic situation in the country, increase in the number of population in the capital, and system reformatting.

US General: NATO To Switch 'Assurance To Deterrence' in E. Europe, 01.04.2016

NATO and the United States are switching their defense doctrine from assurance to deterrence in Eastern Europe in response to a "resurgent and aggressive Russia," the top US general in Europe said Thursday. The comments by Gen. Philip Breedlove in the Latvian capital Riga come a day after the Pentagon said it would begin continuous rotations of an additional armored brigade of about 4,200 troops in Eastern Europe beginning in early 2017. "We are prepared to fight and win if we have to ... our focus will expand from assurance to deterrence, including measures that vastly improve our overall readiness," Breedlove said following talks with Baltic region NATO commanders.

Biden to Poroshenko: Formation of new government opens possibility of additional financial support, 01.04.2016

"According to Joseph Biden, the formation of a new government, oriented on reforms and cooperation with the IMF, opens possibilities for providing the third loan guarantee of \$1 billion, as well as for assistance of other international financial institutions," Poroshenko's press service said. U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry was present at the Poroshenko-Biden meeting. The parties discussed recent developments in Donbas in the context of Russian aggression. The parties agreed that Russia needs to meet security-related conditions to implement the political provisions of the Minsk agreements. Biden also announced a U.S. decision to provide additional \$335 million for reforms of the security sector of Ukraine, in particular of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, the National Guard of Ukraine and the State Border Guard Service of Ukraine. Poroshenko and Biden also talked about possibilities of deploying an international security mission in Donbas.

Poroshenko says Ukraine hopes OSCE will send armed police mission to Donbas, 02.04.2016

"One of the most likely and acceptable options to resolve this problem is an international security component in the form of an armed OSCE mission. For this we definitely need an OSCE decision, extension of the mandate, and we are now effectively conducting negotiations with our partners to ensure this security component," the president said at a press conference in Washington. Poroshenko stressed that Ukraine insists on the full implementation of the Minsk agreements. "This is Ukraine's firm position that for the implementation of the Minsk agreements in full it is necessary to ensure a security component. This component includes the fact that we must ensure ceasefire, an effective regime of monitoring weapons withdrawal and effective control over the uncontrolled section of the Ukrainian-Russian border," Poroshenko stressed.

Statement on "Russia's ongoing aggression against Ukraine and violations of OSCE principles and commitments", 05.04.2016

In the last two meetings of the OSCE Forum for security co-operation the Delegation of Ukraine drew attention to the Budapest Memorandum of 1994 in which the signatories provided security assurances to Ukraine in connection with its renouncement of the world's third largest nuclear arsenal and accession to the Non-Proliferation Treaty as a non-nuclear state. Last week the Ukrainian Foreign Minister renewed Ukraine's proposal to hold consultations of all parties to the Memorandum. We look forward to the reaction of Moscow which until now ignored such earlier formal proposals, based on a specific para 6 of the Budapest Memorandum and thus constituting an integral part of the undertaken commitments. Intensified international efforts are required as the developments in Donbas remain far from our expectations for de-escalation and stabilization. The initial provisions of the Minsk Agreements remain unimplemented. Moreover, we register significant increase of the number of ceasefire violations by the militants, including with the use of heavy weapons that must have been withdrawn in line with the Minsk Agreements.

Poroshenko rules out use of force for de-occupation of Crimea, 06.04.2016

"In any case, when there is a certain international conflict, it is impossible to solve it by military forces, because this could lead to more threatening consequences. We should use the language of diplomacy in order to resolve new or old problems," he said at the Japan National Press Club. "We have never said that we will use the language of force and violence in order to liberate Crimea, but an effective mechanism for the global coordination of efforts can help us find a solution to this complex problem," Poroshenko said.

Poroshenko promised to make it impossible to use offshore companies in Ukraine, 06.04.2016

President of Ukraine Petro Poroshenko, who after the publication of "the Panama document" is suspected of creating multiple companies overseas to evade paying taxes in their own country, promised to make impossible the use of offshore companies at home. Meanwhile, the faction of "Batkivshchyna" demanded from the Verkhovna Rada to adopt a "global law" on de-offshorisation. The statement about offshore Poroshenko said while on an official visit in Japan. "I plan to carry out significant reforms, which will make impossible the use of offshore accounts in Ukraine", – said the President of Ukraine. "We transformed my assets, and they (the Rothschild Bank. – Approx. NEWSru.com) has agreed to manage on a blind arrangement of my assets, to be separated from my work on the presidency", – says Poroshenko. He stressed that "did not do it for tax avoidance, and that it was transparent activity".

Poroshenko: Even unpopular measures to be used to bring peace to Donbas, 06.04.2016

"We will ensure peace in Donbas, even if we have to use some steps that are unpopular with Ukrainian society," Poroshenko said at the Japan National Press Club on Wednesday. Ukraine has been waging war for the second year in a row, facing "barbaric Russian aggression." About 10,000 people have been killed and 21,000 Ukrainian citizens have been injured in the war. Over 1.7 million people have become internally displaced persons. Dzhemilev: 22 people reported missing in Crimea, primarily Crimean Tatars, 06.04.2016

"According to our data, the number of missing people in Crimea is 22 at the moment, most of them are Crimean Tatars. These are the cases we are aware of, but there can be more..." wrote Dzhemilev. Dzhemilev said there were cases when the fact of the disappearance of individuals was used a threat during interrogations by security forces. "The disappearance of people is often used by security officials as a threat during interrogations. If the people questioned by the FSB retain their dignity, they can be asked whether they are afraid that they or their children may disappear as well," he said.

Dutch Foreign Minister: Whatever referendum's outcome, we need to remain friends with Ukraine, 06.04.2016

"It remains important to keep very friendly relations between our countries we have, I've seen that in the last couple of days. Gryzlov warns of possible escalation in Donbas if OSCE police mission deployed, 06.04.2016

"Unfortunately, in the case of an offer for a so-called "international police mission" none of the basic principles of the Ukrainian settlement are observed. A set of measures for the implementation of the Minsk agreements contains no mention of the creation of such a structure," Gryzlov has told. "In addition, we know the position of the second side of Ukraine's internal conflict, which sees in such actions an attempt to foreign occupation of their territory. This means that these calls will not only fail to help in the search for a peaceful solution, but on the contrary, they will only provoke escalation. I am convinced, that neither Ukraine, nor the EU, nor Russia are interested in this," he said. Gryzlov said that all parties should be careful in promoting any initiatives in the issues of security. "We should follow the principle of "do no harm," in order not to destroy what has been achieved," he said.

He added that Japan will continue fulfilling its obligation to provide assistance to Ukraine with the implementation of reforms in the amount of \$1.85 billion.

Ukraine says it will push towards EU despite rejection by Dutch voters, 07.04.2016

Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko said on Thursday his country will continue moving towards the European Union despite a resounding rejection by Dutch voters of a treaty on closer ties between the European body and Ukraine. The broad political, trade and defense treaty is already provisionally in place but has to be ratified by all 28 EU member states for every part of it to have full legal force. The Netherlands was the only country that had not done so. Many Ukrainian politicians feel their country deserves the treaty and are keen to show they have made progress in aligning their country with EU standards since the 2014 uprising that toppled pro-Russian president Viktor Yanukovich.

Cameron: I hope Dutch rejection of Ukraine deal will not affect EU referendum, 07.04.2016

David Cameron has said he hopes the rejection by Dutch voters of a trade deal between Brussels and Ukraine will not affect the outcome of Britain's referendum on EU membership. Strong opposition to an agreement has been seen as a reflection of wider anti-EU sentiment in the Netherlands and was seized on by Brexit campaigners as a signal to wavering Britons that it is "moderate and normal" to oppose Brussels. Merkel wants Ukraine on path towards EU despite Dutch 'no' vote, 07.04.2016

German Chancellor Angela Merkel said on Thursday the Netherlands would work out with Europe's institutions how to proceed with a Ukraine-EU treaty on closer political and economic ties that Dutch voters rejected in a non-binding referendum. "We of course have every interest that Ukraine's way towards the EU, and above all towards certain standards that are agreed on in the treaty of association, is a continuous way," Merkel told reporters after a joint Franco-German cabinet meeting.

Rothschild says Ukraine president's trust up to international standards, 07.04.2016

The wealth management arm of Rothschild Group set up a trust it handles for Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko in line with international standards for the treatment of assets of politicians in office, the company said. Poroshenko has had to defend himself repeatedly against accusations he tried to evade tax after the "Panama Papers" data leak on Sunday showed he had placed his Roshen confectionary business assets in an offshore account. Rothschild said Poroshenko had appointed it as a trustee of a blind trust to hold his shares in Roshen. Russia may transfer to Ukraine Sentsov, another 3 political prisoners, 08.04.2016

At the same time, the Ministry of Justice noted that the final decision will be made by Russian federal courts. According to the press service, on April 7, at the Ministry of Justice received a request for the transfer to Ukraine of A.A. Kolchenko, G.S. Afanasyev, O.G. Sentsov, Yu.D. Soloshenko for serving the rest of their prison terms in Ukraine. "Based on the applications received from the Ukrainian side March 10, 2016, the Russian Ministry of Justice with its letters dated March 25 sent to the Federal Penitentiary Service the instructions to draft necessary documents for resolving the issue of the transfer of these convicts, as well as to check if there are any grounds preventing this transfer. Dutch referendum outcome won't prevent Ukraine from receiving visa-free travel with EU, 09.04.2016

The outcome of the recent referendum in the Netherlands on the ratification of the European Union-Ukraine association agreement, should not be an obstacle for Ukraine to be granted visa-free travel with the EU countries, says Ukrainian Foreign Minister Pavlo Klimkin. "There are clear assurances [by European politicians] that visa-free travel is an absolutely separate way. And, if the European Commission gives the go-ahead - and the European Commission has already drawn up a relevant decision that Ukraine has fully complied with all of the requirements on its way toward visa-free travel - we are moving ahead toward visa-free travel," Klimkin said on Ukrainian television.

International conflicts cannot be settled without Russia's participation — Germany's FM, 10.04.2016

"I would not like the G7 format to be a long-term one; we need to create conditions for return to the G8 format," the minister said. "However, such conditions have not yet formed this year," he added. Speaking about conditions for Russia's return to the Group of Eight, Steinmeier stressed the need for Russia's contribution into reaching a "political solution" for the crisis in Ukraine and the "constructive role in establishing piece in Syria." "Not a single major international conflict can obviously be settled without involvement of Russia," Steinmeier said. Remaining months of this year should demonstrate whether Russian intends to continue playing a constructive role in eliminating the conflict in Syria, the minister said. "Certainly, a discussion will be held within the G7 framework when and on what conditions the return [of Russia to G8] is possible, he added.

Statement by the Spokesperson on the latest developments in eastern Ukraine, 10.04.2016

The significant increase of ceasefire violations in the Donetsk region represents an unprecedented level of violence since the sides recommitted to the ceasefire in 2015. We back the call by Special Representative of the Federal Government of Germany for the OSCE Chairmanship, Gernot Erler, and urge all sides to take steps to de-escalate the situation and to fully honour their commitments. A sustainable ceasefire is urgently needed, not least to ensure progress at last in implementing the political obligations from the Minsk agreements. The recent incidents of targeting the OSCE SMM monitors are unacceptable. We call on all sides to refrain from such actions.

G7 calls on Moscow to comply with Minsk accords, influence militants, 11.04.2016

At a meeting in Hiroshima, the leaders urged Moscow to put influence on the militants in eastern Ukraine and re-emphasized direct link between the lifting of Western economic sanctions against the Russian Federation with the compliance of the Minsk agreements. According to the communique, the annexation of the Ukrainian peninsula of Crimea by the Russian Federation is regarded by G7 countries as a violation of international law. "We expect that Russia will respect its obligations," the report says.

All interested parties should fully implement the Minsk agreements to solve the problem through peaceful and diplomatic means, G7 foreign ministries said. At the same time, diplomats have expressed interest in a dialogue with Moscow.

Russia has asked Ukraine to extradite convicted six Russians, 13.04.2016

CHUBAROV CALLS FOR EXTRAORDINARY UN SECURITY COUNCIL MEETING AS MEJLIS BANNED, 14.04.2016

"I presume that the President shall immediately apply to the UN Secretary-General, as well as the leaders of the European Parliament and the Council of Europe demanding urgent meeting of the UN Security Council, as well as of the executive bodies of the European Union and the Council of Europe aimed at forestalling the threat of direct reprisals coming from Russia, which has occupied the peninsula, against the indigenous people of Crimea," Chubarov wrote. "We condemn this kind of behavior. It is reckless. It is provocative. It is dangerous. And under the rules of engagement that could have been a shoot-down," Kerry said in an interview: "People need to understand that this is serious business and the United States is not going to be intimidated on the high seas. ... We are communicating to the Russians how dangerous this is and our hope is that this will never be repeated." The repeated flights by the Sukhoi SU-24 bombers on Tuesday, which also flew near the ship, the USS Donald Cook, a day earlier, were so close they created wake in the water, a U.S. official said. A U.S. Air Force reconnaissance plane was barrel-rolled by a Russian jet over the Baltic Sea during a routine flight in international airspace, U.S. European Command said Saturday, but Russia disputed that account. The incident Thursday occurred when a Russian jet "performed erratic and aggressive maneuvers" as it flew within 50 feet of the U.S. aircraft's wing tip, Danny Hernandez, a spokesman for U.S. European Command, said. The Russian Su-27 began the barrel roll from the left side of the U.S. RC-135 and went over the top of it to end on the right side of the aircraft, European Command said.

The RC-135 aircraft was "intercepted by a Russian SU-27 in an unsafe and unprofessional manner," Hernandez said, adding that the U.S. plane never entered Russian territory. "The unsafe and unprofessional actions of a single pilot have the potential to unnecessarily escalate tensions between countries," said Hernandez, who added the United States is protesting with the Russian government.

The SMM monitored the implementation of the "Package of measures for the implementation of the Minsk agreements". Its monitoring was restricted by third parties and security considerations*. The fighting at and around Donetsk airport continued with increased intensity compared to previous days. The security situation within Shyrokyne deteriorated during the day. The fighting at and around Donetsk airport continued with increased intensity compared to the previous days. Between 9:03 and 13:00hrs, at the Joint Centre for Control and Coordination (JCCC) observation point at Donetsk central railway station ("Donetsk People's Republic" ("DPR")-controlled, 8km north-west of Donetsk city centre), the SMM heard and saw 168 explosions consistent with mainly mortar and tanks rounds. Of those, 109 explosions occurred north and north-west of Spartak and of Donetsk airport (both "DPR"-controlled), in the area between government-controlled and Opytne, Butrovska mine and Muraveynyk (both government-controlled) at a distance of 3-7km from the SMM position. Another 39 explosions occurred 10-15km north-east of the SMM position.

Avdivivka still epicenter of militant attacks, 01.04.2016

"By focusing mortar and artillery fire on the Ukrainian defenders, the enemy struck 30 powerful blows, using banned heavy weapons from 82mm to 152mm calibers," the report says. In the Donetsk sector, the militants repeatedly attacked ATO forces near the villages of Zaitseve, Mayorsk, and Butivka coal mine. The town of Avdiyivka remains the epicenter of hostilities. "The enemy fired cannon artillery, mortars, rocket-propelled grenades and small arms 16 times on our positions there. The illegal armed groups also used heavy weapons against the local people in the so-called industrial zone. The militants are aimed to weaken the positions of our troops and spread panic among the people, accusing the Ukrainian side of neglecting the peace agreements," the press center said.

while an SMM patrol, comprised of four SMM members in two armoured vehicles, was 3.5km north-east of Snizhne ("DPR"-controlled, 72km east of Donetsk) near the administrative boundary between Donetsk and Luhansk regions, the driver of the front SMM vehicle heard the trunk window crackling. After stopping to inspect the vehicle, the SMM noted on the lower right part of the trunk window a hole, 5mm in diameter, assessed to be caused by a bullet. This window was not bullet-proof, whereas a bullet-proof glass divides the trunk and the passenger cabin of the car. On the latter the SMM noted a small chip, 3mm in diameter, possibly caused by the same bullet. The SMM further observed a bullet exit point on the left side of the trunk window, a hole 15mm in diameter. No bullet or projectile was recovered from inside the vehicle. No SMM members were hurt and the patrol returned safely to its base in Luhansk city at 12:30hrs. The SMM recorded a higher level of violence in Donetsk and Luhansk regions compared with both 16 and 17 April. The Mission followed up on allegations of shelling in areas near the contact line. It noted weapons in violation of withdrawal lines and others absent from storage sites. The SMM facilitated and monitored adherence to the ceasefire to enable repairs to essential infrastructure. It observed long queues at checkpoints along the contact line. The Mission monitored one border area outside government control and was denied access to another. The SMM's freedom of movement was restricted further in areas not controlled by the Government, including access to a site known as a heavy weapons holding area.* The SMM was threatened by armed men in areas outside of Government control.*

At the same time, at a military-type compound in Leninskyi district of DPR-controlled Donetsk city, the SMM observed five surface-to-air missile systems (9K35 Strela-10, 120mm). The SMM also observed one surface-to-air missile system (9K33 Osa, 120mm) in an area east of Avdiyivka.

Sajdik: Around 4,700 ceasefire violations in Ukraine a day, 20.04.2016

"The coordinator of the working group on security expressed concern over a sharp increase in the ceasefire violations. Around 4,700 such violations are registered every day," Ambassador Martin Sajdik said. The OSCE representative noted with regret that the parties to the conflict have started using heavy weapons, including artillery and mortars. Contrary to the existing agreement, the weapons have been taken out from storage sites. "All parties violate their commitments," he noted.
