

Monitoring of Xenophobia and Extremism in Ukraine August 2015

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Introduction

Based on the current information vibe in Moscow, the Kremlin is not going to return the occupied Donbas, at least in the near future. Recent months events also prove this point. In Moscow, they like to talk of Ukraine abusing Minsk agreements, but they forget about the issue of restoring control over parts of Russian-Ukrainian border. Meanwhile, there is an ongoing integration of the occupied areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions in the Russian political space. The clones of Yedinaya Rossiya, the country's prime political party, have been established. Russian generals are in control of the Russian officers deployed in Donbas, who, in turn, are commanders over Russian citizens with Russian weapons and Russian tanks. Meanwhile, the Russian propaganda keeps branding this as "civil war" in Ukraine. As a new political season starts, we can expect on new horror stories about slaves and crucified boys. The latest developments push to the disappointing conclusion - Donetsk and Luhansk regions will embrace a gray zone status for a long period time. When the attacks on the positions of the Ukrainian military and relevant counteractions cease, people will gradually start returning to the region, but not for long. Unemployment, lack of political rights, destroyed infrastructure will force people to make a choice: to move to Russia, which is closing the "iron curtain," for good, or choose another destination – the free Ukraine.

Ceasefire has been constantly violated. Ukraine was receiving new refugees and new losses. On August 31 the draft bill on decentralization amendments to the Constitution had been passed. Clashes outside the Ukrainian Verkhovna Rada in Kyiv started shortly after the parliament had voted on decentralization-related amendments to the Constitution on Monday. Protesters (lead by Svoboda & Radical Parties) disagreeing with the amendments started throwing bottles, smoke bombs and paving stones at law enforcement officers. Also, a grenade was thrown at them. 122 people have been wounded in clashes, 10 of them seriously. Three policemen died due to wounds.

Slowdown in industrial contraction gives hope for Ukraine recovery: Reuters poll, 05.08.2015

Ukraine's economy may start recovering in the coming months as a contraction in output battered by a separaist conflict in the industrial east - slows, as shown by a Reuters poll on Wednesday. Analysts at 13 Ukrainian banks and brokerages expect industrial output to have shrunk 17% in July year-on-year versus 18.1% in June, 20.7 percent in May and 21.7% in April. "Ukraine has been suffering from the loss of the industrial Donbass region since last year. But it looks like the country has managed to adjust to it. Soon the double-digit fall in production output will be left behind," Dmytro Boyarchuk of the economic research organization CASE Ukraine, said. Ukrainian industry was already shrinking before the conflict. In June 2012 output fell by 1.4% due to poor external demand for steel, one of Ukraine's key exports. The military conflict with Russian-backed separatists in Donetsk and Luhansk regions – the location of the majority of coal mines and metals plants - worsened the situation last summer. In July 2014 industry shrank by 12.1% year-on-year and in August the contraction deepened to 21.4%. Kiev says it has lost about 20% of its industrial capacity due to regular shelling in the east. Russia, Putin Held in Low Regard around the World, 06.08.2015

Opinions of Russia are more unfavorable than favorable in 26 nations. The strongest negative sentiment is in Poland and Jordan (both 80%). The former is a legacy of a long history of bilateral tensions. Public opinion in Jordan may be influenced by Moscow's current support for the regime of President Bashar al-Assad in Syria, Jordan's neighbor and the source of hundreds of thousands of refugees in Jordan. Anti-Russian sentiment is also particularly strong in Israel (74%), Japan (73%), Germany (70%) and France (70%). These are among the main findings of a Pew Research Center survey, conducted in 40 nations among 45,435 respondents from March 25 to May 27, 2015. Russia's greatest support is in Vietnam (75%). But in only two other nations do about half or more of the public have a positive view of Russia: Ghana (56%) and China (51%). In a number of countries, large segments of the public express no opinion about Russia.

Over 60% of Ukrainians support Ukraine's NATO bid, 14.08.2015

35.7% of respondents in 2015 cited joining NATO as the best security option for Ukraine. 28.8% said they supported the country's non-aligned status. 22.9% of the respondents sould not make up their mind on the issue. Besides, 7.8% back the military alliance with Russia, while 3.2% - with the United States. Other alliances are considered by another 1.6%. It

should be emphasized that for a long time, the majority of Ukrainians believed that neutral status is Ukraine's security guarantee (42% in April 2012). A substantial part of the population saw the military alliance with Russia as the security solution (in 2012 - 26%). It is reported that had a referendum on joining NATO been scheduled for this year, the idea would gain support of 64% of Ukrainians. In turn, 28.5% would vote against the move, and 7.5% would remain undecided.

Over 40% of Russians support embargoed food destruction, 38% against, 21.08.2015

Russians have mixed feelings about the Russian authorities' decision to destroy embargoed food smuggled into Russia from the European Union, the United States, Australia, Canada and Norway: 42% believe the embargoed food needs to be destroyed, while 38% disagree, according to business daily Vedomosti, which cites the findings of the Public Opinion Foundation's poll. The poll confirms that most of Russians, or 83%, know about such a decision. Those WHO support the Destruction of foods embargoed Claim That such foods fail to meet biosecurity Requirements, They are of power quality, out-of-date and Harmful (17%), and that domestic production should be developed and domestic producers should get support (8%). Their opponents propose the distribution of the food among the needy (18%), orphanages or homes for elderly people (5%). All in all, 70% of the polled agree with the Russian authorities' decision to ban imports of certain products from the European Union, the United States, Australia, Canada, and Norway. At the same time, those who call this decision erroneous account for 11%, while 19% are undecided.

Poll: Ukrainians dissatisfied with ATO pace in Donbas, 28.08.2015

Most Ukrainians believe the situation in the east of Ukraine is volatile and express their dissatisfaction with the pace of the anti-terrorist operation in Donbas, according to the results of a survey carried out by TNS market research company. According to the survey, the percentage of those who consider the situation in Donbas extremely tense and volatile decreased in July, but the number of such Ukrainians is still very high, keeping at 76%. The number of Ukrainians, who believe that the situation in Donbas tense, but stable, and not volatile, has also increased. Among other things, the survey showed that the evaluation index of the Anti-Terrorist Operation (ATO) had gradually decreased towards absolutely negative since March, which indicated that the society was dissatisfied with the course of the ATO. http://ukrainianwall.com/english-news/poll-ukrainians-dissatisfied-with-ato-pace-in-donbas/

Over 50% of Ukrainians see Donbas conflict as Russia's aggressive war – poll, 28.08.2015

Over 50% of respondents believe the conflict in eastern Ukraine covering parts of Luhansk and Donetsk regions is in fact Russia's aggressive war. 25.6% of respondents call it a fight between the U.S. and Russia over influence on Ukraine. 13.6% think it is a civil conflict. In turn, 8.7% of respondents believe Russia not involved in the Donbas hostilities and is not a party to the conflict. 64.9% of respondents named the "DPR" and "LPR" terrorist organizations that have no right to represent the local population of the named regions. 16.3% believe that they actually can represent the occupied territories.

At the same time 34.5% of Ukrainians say that Ukraine should continue the Anti-Terrorist Operation until full restoration of control over the occupied territories.

28.5% think that these territories should be granted special status, while 19.9% advocate the idea of separating the occupied areas of Donbas from Ukraine. 36.5% of respondents supported Constitutional amendments on the special status of Donbas, while 39.2% are against such option. 44% of Ukrainians negatively assess current results of the Minsk agreements, 12% praise them, while almost 23% remain neutral.

UKRAINE'S FOREIGN MINISTRY: RUSSIA VIOLATES MOST OF OSCE PRINCIPLES, 01.08.2015

The ministry said that the leaders of 35 countries in Europe and North America signed the Final Act of the Conference on Security and Co-operation in Europe in Helsinki, Finland, on August 1, 1975. Despite ideological differences, the states participating in the conference agreed on ten fundamental principles of cooperation to ensure peace and security in Europe. In furtherance of these commitments the leaders of the member states agreed at the OSCE summit in Astana in 2010 to work towards building a common Euro-Atlantic and Eurasian security community.

"Unfortunately, Russian aggression against Ukraine thwarted these ambitious plans and marred the celebration of the 40th anniversary of the Helsinki Final Act. Having illegally occupied and annexed Crimea with the city of Sevastopol, having invaded Donbas and kidnapped citizens, Russia has violated most of the principles and obligations that lay the OSCE's grounds. Among them are sovereign equality, respect for the rights inherent in sovereignty, territorial integrity, inviolability of frontiers, refraining from the threat or use of force, as well as fulfillment in good faith of obligations under international law," the statement said. http://x-news.com.ua/ukraines-foreign-ministry-russia-violates-most-of-osce-principles-53578/

Dzhemilev doesn't rule out Crimean Tatar military formation in Kherson, 01.08.2015

"We plan to be based in Kherson, together with a representation of other [ethnic] minorities. It's possible we may participate in a military formation to be created for the struggle. After the peninsula has been liberated from the occupiers, such formations are most likely to be used to maintain security on the peninsula, Dzhemilev said at the second World Congress of Crimean Tatars in Ankara on August 1. In his words, the Crimean Tatars who were forced to leave Crimea as internally displaced people due to the pressure of the Russian occupying authorities will be settled in Kherson region.

"I'd like to assure you that Ukraine will never, under any circumstances, put up with the violation of the rights of its citizens, human rights, the rights of the Crimean Tatar people to live freely on their land. Ukraine, together with its international partners, will do its best to restore the rule of law on the peninsula and the return of Crimea under Ukrainian jurisdiction. We have established government institutions that are engaged in the pursuit of the state policy in relation to Crimea. Representatives of the Crimean Tatars, including national leaders, Members of Parliament Mustafa Dzhemilev and Refat Chubarov, enjoy a worthy place among the Ukrainian authorities," Poroshenko said in a statement addressing the second World Congress of the Crimean Tatars, which is being held in Ankara July 31 through August 2. "I sincerely welcome representatives of the courageous and freedom-loving Crimean Tatar people, who came to participate in the second World Congress of the Crimean Tatars. The whole world is with you now. A considerable number of participants in the forum from different countries is proof of this," the president said in the statement.

Ukraine calls on Russia to negotiate end to war in east, 02.08.2015

Ukraine's foreign minister is calling on Russia to come to "real negotiations" about a ceasefire and stabilization in Ukraine's war-torn east which will require fair elections that are internationally monitored. Pavlo Klimkin said in an interview with The Associated Press that Russian military and special forces are "in full command" in the rebel-controlled eastern regions of Donetsk and Luhansk. He cited Ukraine's capture a few days ago of a large Russian truck filled with weapons that was driven by a Russian special forces officer as one of many examples of Russia's presence.

DZHEMILEV: 10,000 CRIMEAN TATARS FLEE CRIMEA SINCE RUSSIAN ANNEXATION, 02.08.2015

"Tough discrimination and lawlessness against the Crimean Tatars, especially the kidnapping and murder of young people; forced recruitment of young people into the army with a view to sending them to war with their brothers, the Ukrainians; the complete absence of democratic freedoms and the lack of any prospects for young people in occupied Crimea are forcing many to leave their homeland again and move to the Ukrainian mainland," Dzhemilev said at the second World Congress of Crimean Tatars in Ankara. He noted that after the so-called "Crimean Spring" 76 families attempted to return to the peninsula from places of deportation, but none of them were allowed to settle in Crimea, as "the annual quota" had been reached, so they all had had to go back. "One gets a clear and rightly impression that the iniquity against Crimean Tatars takes place, including with the purpose to drive them beyond Crimea", said Dzhemilev.

"Our Prime Minister Stephen Harper and Canadian Defense Minister Jason Kenney have repeatedly said that we take into account all variants, and all of them are available in case of escalation of the conflict, including the supply of lethal weapons," he said.

"Today, there are those in Russian prisons, whom we consider to be political prisoners. They are eleven of them," said the foreign minister. "To some of them we still have no consular access, despite all international legal norms... to Karpyuk, to Klikh," Klimkin said. He noted that the Foreign Ministry is making efforts to provide for the release not only of a well-known Nadia Savchenko and Oleh Sentsov, but also of other Ukrainian citizens, who are prisoners in Russia.

Klimkin: Crimea to return earlier than expected, 04.08.2015

"The annexation of Crimea violated international principles, so the "sanctions against Russia for the annexation of Crimea will never be lifted," he said. "No one will ever invest in Crimea, and no one will come to Crimea... Therefore, Crimea will return to Ukraine. And I'm sure that it will happen much sooner than many expect," Klimkin said. The minister believes that the lack of any investment, along with corruption, banditry and economic difficulties will deprive Russia of supporters among the Ukrainians. "Sooner or later, Russia will be forced to sit at the negotiating table. And it's not just about sanctions, which will never be lifted. It is the economic situation, when any development is impossible. That is what is happening there. Even against the background of the whole situation in Russia, the wave of corruption and crimes in Crimea will have a sobering effect on those who are influenced with Russian propaganda," he said.

Lukashenko: No intervention in Ukraine from Belarusian territory, 04.08.2015

"When I met with [Secretary of NSDC of Ukraine Oleksandr] Turchynov, I assured him that this would never ever happen. Nobody will attack Ukraine from our territory unless our interests have been infringed or Ukraine has been first to attack. But this will never happen," Lukashenko told non-governmental Belarusian media. "There will be no intervention in Ukraine from Belarus," he promised.

In his words, there are "two absolutely peaceful" Russian military bases in territory of Belarus. "[There is] a base in Baranovichi – probably three-quarters of our people serve there. [There is] a base in Gantsevichi – one can describe it as a high-tech engineering station that monitors rocket launches. Can they attack Ukraine? No, they can't. We've got a small group of customs officers and several Russian border guards, as there is no actual border between Russia and Belarus. I have given permission for their observers to monitor when we know this. There are ten of them," he said.

POROSHENKO: PSEUDO-ELECTIONS IN DONBAS CAN DISRUPT MINSK ACCORDS, 04.08.2015

The presidential press service reports that the participants are discussing the situation in Donbas and coordination of further action at the War Cabinet. According to Poroshenko, taking into account the growing number of militant attacks on the Ukrainian army positions in the Anti-Terrorist Operation area, it is necessary to define a strategy, to agree and coordinate further actions. "We need to clearly define a plan to strengthen defense in case of escalation of the conflict," the president said. Poroshenko also drew attention to the need to strengthen interaction with the OSCE Special Monitoring Mission (SMM) to Ukraine and the effective operation of the Joint Center for Control and Coordination (JCCC) in order to create the conditions for uninterrupted monitoring of the ceasefire and prevent cases of non-admission of the OSCE monitors to the areas where heavy weaponry and artillery are located after withdrawal from the contact line. According to Stratfor, there are two indicators we are watching that could provoke responses by both sides: newly trained pro-Russian separatists rotating in, and NATO finally installing Force Integration Units into Eastern European countries along Russia's periphery. February's agreement to halt hostilities between Ukraine and the Russian proxies has proved to be a cease-fire in name only. Meanwhile, the political dimension of the conflict has so far barred any definite resolution, and as long as a deep gulf separates Kyiv and its Western backers from Moscow and the militants over the future of Ukraine, the potential for further escalation on the battlefield remains. To basic issues divide the two sides. The first is the political status of the separatist regions. Ukraine wants to see separatists implement the Minsk agreements and lay down their arms before officials amend the Ukrainian Constitution to grant the eastern territories more autonomy. The separatists want constitutional changes first, and they want a role in determining those changes.

"I hate the idea of talking about the future of my country with representatives of another country who are not my countrymen," Poroshenko said. In his words, these are "Russian puppets" who have taken control of occupied territories. However, the president stressed that making a lasting peace requires the withdrawal of Russia's weapons from Donbas. What is more, the border between Ukraine and Russia needs to be sealed in order to prevent further arms supplies from Russia. "Once weapons, ammunition and soldiers stop flowing into the country, peace will be restored immediately," Poroshenko added.

Russia's FSB Federal Security Service uses smuggling in the Donbas conflict zone as bait to recruit Ukrainian soldiers, employing the same methods as during the Chechen wars, which may turn into mass treason, Chairman of Luhansk Regional Military and Civil Administration Heorhiy Tuka said.

"Highly professional FSB officers are working there. They have experienced the same tricks during the two Chechen wars. Chechens used these methods against them, when the poor officers were bribed, and ended up blatantly betraying troops, when the commanders deliberately sent whole battalions under artillery fire," Tuka told Ukrainska Pravda.

Tuka described the model in the following way: at first, a person is allowed to earn some money, after that he is squeezed for handing over secret information, after that he is under control. "It comes to such ridiculous things that our boneheaded officers do not even realize what risk they are at when they get some money for their services in cash and the rest is transferred onto their bank cards with their names on them," he said.

Four judges of the Constitutional Court of Ukraine – Serhiy Sas, Mykola Melnyk, Mykhailo Hultai and Ihor Slidenko – issued separate opinions to the CC conclusion on the amendments to the Constitution regarding decentralization, including regulations on special order of the local government in certain areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions. Judge Melnyk notes that the bill proposes to supplement the Article 18 of the Transitional Provisions of the Constitution as follows: "Features of the local self-government in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions shall be determined by a separate law". Read alsoPutting Ukraine in an untenable position According to Melnyk, this creates constitutional preconditions for the existence of "permanent characteristics of the local self-government in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions". He notes that, therefore, the wording of the proposed amendment may form a constitutional basis for conservation, or foresight, of these and other provisions in an ordinary law, which go beyond the implementation of local self-government in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions.

"Unfortunately, there is no good contact who would provide information about all our guys who are held captive," he added.

Gen. Ray Odierno, the outgoing Army chief of staff, said Wednesday that Russia is the top military threat to the U.S. "I believe Russia is the most dangerous," he said at a Pentagon briefing. "First, they are more mature than some of our other potential adversaries, and I think they have stated some intents that concern me, in terms of how the Cold War ended. "And they have shown some significant ability in Ukraine to do operations that are fairly sophisticated, and so for me, I think we should pay a lot of attention to that," he added. Odierno's comments come as defense officials suspect that Russia is behind last month's cyber attack of the Joint Chief of Staff's unclassified email server. They also come as the U.S. is continuing to support Ukrainian forces as they battle Russian-backed separatists and Russian forces in Eastern Ukraine. The four-star general said he is also "greatly" concerned by the prospect of Russia violating the sovereignty of Baltic states that are members of NATO, which would require the U.S. military to come to their defense under Article V of the organization's founding treaty.

Russia will avoid engaging in a large military operation in Donbas, while localized escalations are possible, as the Russian proxies will attempt to achieve limited objectives in an effort to force the other side into a more accommodating position at the negotiating table, Stratfor, private geopolitical intelligence firm, reports.

Despite communications between Kyiv, its Western backers, separatists and Russia, hostility remains, according to Stratfor. The political status of the separatist regions and Moscow's broader regional imperatives continue to prevent true tactical de-escalation on the battlefield. Although both sides now appear to be increasing their ability to conduct armed operations again, Stratfor still does not foresee Russia engaging in a major offensive. However, the current instability and higher concentration of forces on the demarcation line may rekindle fighting with limited offensive operations in the coming weeks. In case the offensive operations will resume, they have narrowly defined objectives. Localized escalations similar to the Debaltseve standoff, which lasted beyond the cease-fire, could emerge at various points on the front line.

"As the Minsk ceasefire agreement stalls and fighting continues in eastern Ukraine, we are back to where we started a decade ago. The leaders of Russia, China and the U.S. will listen to the leaders of the largest EU states, but are not at all inclined to act on what they hear. And if they want to call "Europe" it is still not clear which number they should ring," he wrote. The White House's message to Kiev was advice, not an order, U.S. and Ukrainian officials have recently told us, and was based on a variety of factors. Hollande, Merkel, Putin back ceasefire plan for eastern Ukraine-France, 29.08.2015

France, Germany and Russia back plans for a complete ceasefire in eastern Ukraine from Sept. 1, the French presidency said after their respective leaders spoke by telephone on Saturday. Ukraine and pro-Russian separatists, in a gesture to shore up a tenuous ceasefire, agreed on Aug. 26 to strive for an end to all truce violations from next Tuesday, the OSCE and rebel representatives have said. In a statement, French President Francois Hollande's office said he also agreed with German Chancellor Angela Merkel and Russian President Vladimir Putin that it would be useful to hold a summit with Ukraine's Petro Poroshenko in the coming weeks. "They strongly backed the call for a complete ceasefire from Sept. 1," Hollande's office said. "They underlined that the respect of a lasting ceasefire was a necessity given the situation of civilians in eastern Ukraine."

Klimkin: MH17 tribunal may be set up by agreement among five states, 31.08.2015

Five countries investigating the MH17 crash will try again to get UN Security Council's approval for the international tribunal to prosecute the alleged perpetrators, the report says. AZAROV JR.'S PROPERTY ARRESTED IN SARDINIA, 03.08.2015

Pre-trial investigation has been initiated against the son of Ukraine's fugitive ex-prime minister Mykola Azarov on suspicion of illicit enrichment. It was found out that in 2012-2014 Oleksiy Azarov, serving as an MP, received EUR 7.7 million, CHF 600,000 and \$500,000 from unidentified sources. Later, those funds were transferred to banks in Switzerland, Italy and the Principality of Liechtenstein. Within a criminal proceeding Kyiv- Sviatoshynskyi district Prosecutor's Office and the SBU detained three men while trading a massive party of weapons. As reported by Kyiv region Prosecutor's Office press service, three AKM's with eight magazines, 11 grenades "F-1", three grenades "RKG-3E", a variety of ammunition exceeding one thousand items. The cost of the weapons is nearly 100,000 UAH (about \$4,655). A criminal proceeding has been started under Part 1 of Article 263 of the Criminal Code of Ukraine (illegal handling of weapons). The offenders may be sentenced to a 7-year imprisonment. A remand in custody is currently being considered.

Ukraine's law on local elections comes into force, 07.08.2015

The law on local elections has been published in the Holos Ukrayiny (Voice of Ukraine) parliamentary newspaper, and the election campaign in the country is due to begin on September 5. Under the new law, a first-past-the-post system will be used to elect members of village and township legislatures in single-seat electoral districts, which make up the territory of the appropriate administrative entities. Meanwhile, members of regional, city and district legislatures will be elected based on the 'one person, one vote' rule with open election tickets. The electoral threshold for parties has been increased to 5%, as compared with the 3%-threshold used at the 2010 elections. Political parties registered before the publication of the new law will be able to run in local elections. The transitional points of the document also say that elections to the local legislatures of Crimea and certain districts of the Donetsk and Luhansk regions will not be held.

It is necessary to "stop the judicial farce" and "immediately release Sentsov and Kolchenko, as well as all other political hostages," the ministry said.

The Donetsk BCP continued to experience more traffic than the Gukovo BCP. The cross-border movements registered at both BCPs accounted for just under thirty-three per cent of all entries/exits in the Rostov region. The majority of the vehicles crossing the border have number plates issued in the Luhansk region, including a number of articulated trucks and long-distance coaches commuting between the Luhansk region and cities in the Russian Federation.

U.S. suspects Russia in hack of Pentagon computer network, 07.08.2015

U.S. military officials said Thursday that they suspect Russian hackers infiltrated an unclassified Pentagon e-mail system used by employees of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, the latest in a series of state-sponsored attacks on sensitive U.S. government computer networks. The electronic intrusion was detected about July 25, officials said. The Pentagon immediately disabled the e-mail system, which is used by about 4,000 military and civilian personnel, in an attempt to contain the damage. The network remains offline, although officials said they hoped to restart it in the coming days. U.S. military officials said Thursday that they suspect Russian hackers infiltrated an unclassified Pentagon e-mail system used by employees of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, the latest in a series of state-sponsored attacks on sensitive U.S. government computer networks. The electronic intrusion was detected about July 25, officials said. The Pentagon immediately disabled the e-mail system, which is used by about 4,000 military and civilian personnel, in an attempt to contain the damage. The network remains offline, although officials said they hoped to restart it in the coming days. The Defense Department disclosed the attack shortly after it occurred, but only in recent days have investigators traced it to Russia. Officials said the complexity and advanced nature of the hack strongly suggested that a foreign government was responsible.

"This attack was fairly sophisticated and has the indications . . . of having come from a state actor such as Russia," said a U.S. official who spoke on the condition of anonymity to discuss details of the investigation.

- five operators of Crimean ports and one Crimean ferry operator;

- 35 companies controlled by the persons that were previously included into the sanctions list, as well as those companies with more than 50% of capital being controlled by Russian Vnesheconombank and Rosneft.

Investigation into possible Buk-missile-parts, 11.08.2015

In cooperation with the Dutch Safety Board (DSB) the Joint Investigation Team (JIT) investigates several parts, possibly originating from a Buk surface-air-missilesystem. These parts have been secured during a previous recovery-mission in Eastern-Ukraine and are in possession of the criminal investigation team MH17 and the Dutch Safety Board.

The parts are of particular interest to the criminal investigation as they can possibly provide more information about who was involved in the crash of MH17. For that reason the JIT further investigates the origin of these parts. The JIT will internationally enlist the help of experts, among others forensic specialists and weapon-experts.

At present the conclusion cannot be drawn that there is a causal connection between the discovered parts and the crash of flight MH17.

The JIT conducts the criminal investigation and the DSB the investigation into the cause of the crash. Both investigations are conducted separately but JIT and DSB occasionally share material. Putin visits annexed Crimea, warns Tatars on status, 17.08.2015

Russian President Vladimir Putin warned Crimea's minority ethnic Tatars on Monday they should not strive for special status on the Black Sea peninsula Moscow annexed from Ukraine in 2014, stoking Cold War-like tensions between Moscow and the West. Muslim Tatars comprise more than 10 percent of Crimea's population and largely opposed falling under Russian rule last year, remembering the mass deportations ordered by Moscow during the Soviet era. They have come under pressure to align themselves with the new authorities since the annexation. Putin began a three-day visit to Crimea much to Kiev's anger, with the aim -- according to the Kremlin's website -- to hold meetings on ways to develop the Black Sea peninsula and promote tourism there.

He praised bringing Crimea into Russia as a matter of historic justice. However, sanctions slapped on by the West over the annexation, which followed the fall of a pro-Moscow president in Kiev, have cost the ailing Russian economy dearly.

NATO launches largest airborne drills in Europe since end of Cold War, 18.08.2015

Nearly 5,000 soldiers from 11 Nato allies are taking part in four weeks of "simultaneous multinational airborne operations" across Germany, Italy, Bulgaria and Romania that began on Saturday, the US army said in a statement. "Swift Response 15 is the largest Allied airborne training event on the continent since the end of the Cold War," according to the statement from the US army in Grafenwohr in southern Germany.

The Guardian view on the latest Ukraine ceasefire call: why this could be the one that works, 30.08.2015

The prospects are not good that the new international call for a ceasefire in eastern Ukraine will be heeded any more rigorously than its predecessors were. Yet in the continuing 16-month war on Europe's fringes, some of the dynamics may perhaps be shifting in some important ways. On Saturday the leaders of Germany, France and Russia held a three-way phone conversation in which they backed a joint announcement made by Ukraine and pro-Russian separatists last week, that a ceasefire would be reinstated on 1 September. The weekend initiative is the latest attempt to put some life back into February's Minsk agreement, which has all but fallen apart as the fighting has continued. The agreement remains a fragile plant; both sides came out on Saturday with separate statements with very different emphases. Vladimir Putin laid all the blame on the Ukrainian government, while Kiev has been warning that Russia is readying for new offensives.
