

Monitoring of Xenophobia and Extremism in Ukraine August 2016

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Introduction

The presidential campaign in the United States continues to haunt the minds of Ukrainians. German Foreign Minister, the Presidency of the OSCE, does not bother to disguise the pro-Russian position.

Putin arrived in the thumb track occupied Crimea, where he said the members of the Russian Security Council that Ukraine was preparing attacks in the peninsula, because they do not want or can not fulfill Minsk agreements. The provocation of the Russian Federal Security Service proved to be unsustainable in the occupied Crimea.

It is hard to imagine a more telling example of shifting the blame on others, even more so - in the context of the deterioration of the situation in the Donbass.

Putin declared in the Crimea the appointment of Dmitry Livanov as a Special Representative for social and economic cooperation with Ukraine. This designation must demonstrate to the world community that the Kremlin is not completely configured to destroy the relations with our country. However, there is a nuance: the last few years, so the special representative was the Russian ambassador in Ukraine, but the failure of adventure with pushing to work in Kiev, Mikhail Babich has forced the Kremlin to look for ways to save face. Hence Putin's statement that Russia is not interested in folding contacts with Ukraine. Ukrainian officials continue to shy away from Putin's "fraternal embrace." Poroshenko did not rule out the Russian invasion, stressing that the Ukrainian military are willing to give it back. Klimkin said that the Russian-Ukrainian diplomatic relations retain their shape, but not the content, so Kiev will initiate burst. Consistent attention to the situation in Ukraine on the part of Joe Biden, once again became a permanent interlocutor Poroshenko, Ukrainian President informed the leaders of Germany and France on the Kremlin's effort to thwart settlement in Donbass formed the agenda of the last month.

Prognosis

Expert assessment "President Poroshenko's First Year in Power", DIF, 05.06.2015

General score for the first year in Office was 5.3 points out of 10 possible. The most successful, in the view of experts, is – foreign policy achievements (7.3 points). Also, mostly positive assessment the President received for cooperation with the Parliament (6.4 points) and government (5.8 points). Furthermore, the experts gave Poroshenko (5.5 points) for his actions in defence policy, the functions guarantor of the Constitution and the rights and freedoms of citizens (5.4 points) and interaction with society (4.6 points). As for progress in reforms most experts assessed this are in negative term with only 4 points and this bring fulfilment of his election promises, in the eyes of the experts to only 3.7 points.

Analysing the achievements of the President, the experts pointed first of all to his role in the formation of an international coalition of countries and organizations that supported Ukraine in its conflict with Russia. He also was praised for signing the Association Agreement with the EU. As for domestic policy, Poroshenko's main achievements are: successful early parliamentary elections, freazing the acute phase of hostilities in the Donbas, preventing the spread of separatism in other regions of Ukraine, as well as enhancing the combat readiness of the Ukrainian armed forces. Some experts also mentioned Poroshenko efforts in preserving political stability in the country and some individual reform efforts. As for main failures during the first year, experts agreed on poor human resources policy (in particular in the context of the appointment of the Prosecutor General Vitaliy Yarema, Defense Minister Valery Geletey and head of the National Bank of Valerie Gontareva) and a very weak progress in implementing reforms expected by society. The inability of the President to perform one of the most high-profile campaign promises – to sell his business – has been the subject of criticism among the surveyed experts. In addition, some experts said Poroshenko failed to successfully complete the anti-terrorist operation despite his promises before the elections.

Putin accuses Ukraine of trying to provoke a new conflict over Crimea, 10.08.2016 Russia's FSB security service said two people were killed in clashes and its forces had dismantled a Ukrainian spy network inside Crimea. Kiev denied the assertions, calling them an attempt by Moscow to create an excuse to escalate towards a war. The Russian president accused Kiev of playing a dangerous game and said he saw no point in holding a new round of talks about the troubled peace process in eastern Ukraine on the sidelines of a G20 summit in China next month. "The people who seized power in Kiev ... have switched to terror tactics instead of searching for ways for a peaceful settlement," Putin told a news conference, saying Russia would not let such actions pass without a response. "The attempt to provoke an outbreak of violence, to provoke a conflict is nothing other than a desire to distract (Ukrainian) society from its problems," he added, calling Ukraine's actions "criminal."

U.S. not to comment on Russia's reports about incident in Crimea, 11.08.2016

"We've seen the reports. We're going to refer you to the government of Ukraine for further information. I would note that we're also directly in touch with Ukrainians ourselves," Director of the Press Office of the U.S. Department of State Elizabeth Trudeau said at a daily press briefing in Washington, DC, on August 10. She reiterated that the U.S. position on Crimea remained unchanged. "Crimea is and will always be part of Ukraine. We condemn and call for an immediate end to the Russian occupation of Crimea, and our Crimea-related sanctions will remain in place until Russia returns the peninsula to Ukraine," she said. Trudeau also said that the U.S. sees dialogue as an instrument of the Minsk talks on Donbas.

Pyatt said U.S. sanctions in relation to Russia's annexation of Crimea would remain in place until the territory was returned to Ukraine. Russian President Vladimir Putin accused Kiev on Wednesday of using terrorist tactics to try to provoke a new conflict and destabilize Crimea, a region Moscow annexed from Ukraine in 2014. Russia said it had thwarted armed Ukrainian attempts to get saboteurs into the peninsula. "Russia has a record of frequently levying false

accusations at Ukraine to deflect attention from its own illegal actions," Pyatt wrote. "US government has seen nothing so far that corroborates Russian allegations of a "Crimea incursion" & Ukraine has strongly refuted them."

Gerashchenko: Russia accusing Ukraine of all mortal sins to end sanctions, 11.08.2016 Russia is trying to get rid of international sanctions by claiming alleged Ukrainian provocations in the occupied territory of Crimea, Iryna Gerashchenko, first deputy chairperson of the Verkhovna Rada and Ukraine's representative in the humanitarian subgroup of the Trilateral contact group on Donbas settlement, posted. Statement by the High Representative/Vice-President Federica Mogherini on the situation in Ukraine, 12.08.2016

I spoke this afternoon with the Ukrainian Minister of Foreign Affairs, Pavlo Klimkin, about the escalation in tensions between Ukraine and the Russian Federation.

The European Union condemns and does not recognise the illegal annexation of Crimea and Sevastopol by the Russian Federation. We continue to be unwavering in our support for the territorial integrity and sovereignty of Ukraine. Any actions that could lead to a further escalation of the conflict must be avoided by all sides; a peaceful resolution of the conflict is the only possible solution. This includes eastern Ukraine, where we urge all parties to fully engage in the complete implementation of the Minsk agreements. The European Union and its Member States will continuously assess the situation, including at the level of the Political and Security Committee next Wednesday.

U.S. general calls on Russia to allow observers at military drills, 12.08.2016

Russia should allow observers, including Western journalists, to attend upcoming military drills that could again put Ukraine on edge just as Russian President Vladimir Putin has sharpened his rhetoric, the commander of the U.S. Army in Europe. The comments by Lieutenant General Ben Hodges came as Ukraine accuses Russia of amassing more than 40,000 troops in Crimea, a Ukrainian peninsula seized by Moscow in 2014, and on the Ukrainian border. Ukraine's U.N. ambassador, Volodymyr Yelchenko, warned this week that the Russian forces could reflect "some very bad intentions." Hodges declined to offer estimates of Russian forces or speculate about Putin's intentions ahead of pre-announced, large-scale exercises in Russia's south that are expected to include Crimea. But he said Russia could help address concerns by following the example of military drills led by the United States and its allies in Europe, to which Russia was allowed to send observers.

Crimean saboteurs not members of Ukrainian intelligence - Ukraine Defence Ministry, 13.08.2016

Ukraine's Defence Ministry has stated that those individuals who, according to the Russian security services, were part of so-called Crimean "subversive groups," had never been members of the Main Directorate of Intelligence. "Regarding some allegations by the Russian special services, the Ministry of Defense reports that the 37th battalion of the 56th brigade had never been part of the Main Directorate of Intelligence. Those persons who appeared in the reports are not employees of the Main Directorate of Intelligence of the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine," according to the report issued by the Ministry of Defence.

We also underscore, as have our partners and allies, the need for full implementation of the Minsk agreements, in order to end the violence and bring about a peaceful and durable solution in eastern Ukraine."

With those moves, he said, the world "is completely changed." "Russian aggression completely destroyed the post-war global security system," he said. Steinmeier Calls For New Arms Deal With Russia To Avoid Accidental War, 26.08.2010 Germany's foreign minister is calling for a new arms control deal with Moscow as intensified military exercises by Russia and NATO have raised concerns that a war could inadvertently be triggered. Frank-Walter Steinmeier said that while Russia has since 2014 violated the bonds of trust built up over decades as well as basic principles of peace, "we must all be united in the desire to avoid a further twist in the escalating spiral." In 2014, Russia illegally seized Crimea from Ukraine and began backing separatists fighting Kyiv's forces in eastern Ukraine. A new arms control process would offer a "proven means for transparency, risk avoidance, and trust building," he said. "We want a structured dialogue with all partners who carry responsibility for the security of our continent," perhaps working through the OSCE, he said.

U.S. concerned about sudden combat readiness check of Russian armed forces, 26.08.2016 The Pentagon is deeply concerned about the escalation of violence in Donbas and the proximity of Russian military units to Ukraine, Baldanza said. Slovakian leader renews call for ending EU sanctions on Russia, 27.08.2016

Slovak Prime Minister Robert Fico renewed his call for the European Union to end sanctions against Russia after a meeting this week with President Vladimir Putin in Moscow. Slovakia holds the rotating EU presidency and will host a meeting of the bloc's foreign ministers next week. He is one of several central European leaders opposed to continuing sanctions on Russia. Slovakia imports almost all its gas and oil from Russia, as well as nuclear fuel to generate two power plants. It exports cars to Russia.

The decision to arrest Medentsev, who is suspected of taking a UAH 570,000 bribe for a decision in favor of a certain company, was supported by 265 out of 324 MPs registered in the session hall. Medentsev is now on the wanted list.

The decision on Chernushenko's arrest was backed by 273 out of 340 MPs registered in the session hall. As reported earlier, on June 24, the Prosecutor General's Office reported Chernushenko was suspected of committing serious criminal offenses.

Prosecutor General Viktor Shokin initiated that he should be removed by the High Qualification Commission of Judges of Ukraine from performing his duties and appealed to the parliament with a request for authorizing the arrest of Chernushenko.

SBU prevents blast at railway in Lviv region, one law enforcement officer injured, 10.08.2016

In a special operation, officers found and detained five members of the terrorist group that planned to simultaneously blow up the railway tracks going in three different directions from the regional center. One terrorist was detained while laying explosives on a bridge near the village of Dubliany in Lviv region. He opened fire while trying to resist arrest, as a result of which one officer was injured. The terrorist was wounded when law enforcement officers fired in retaliation. The lives of the officer and the terrorist are not under threat. While searching the detainees, secret service officers seized a large number of firearms, explosives and components for their production, in particular: RPG-7 and RPG-26 grenade launchers, RGO, F-1 and RGD-5 grenades, as well as five kilograms of explosives IX 25, 600 grams of TNT, three electric detonators, three pistols and a large quantity of ammunition of various calibers. Searches and other urgent investigative actions are underway.

Ukraine buys Russian buses worth UAH 78 million, 10.08.2016

The report says the buses are produced in Russia and imported from the aggressor country. They are later re-equipped in Ukraine into school buses. Ukrainian Interior Minister Arsen Avakov has submitted for approval a draft proposing a reduction in the posts of generals. "The proposed cuts: the State Border Guard Service (with about 42,000 people), including 74 generals, will have 14 people remaining; the National Guard (46,000 people), including 38 generals, will have 18 people remaining; the Emergency Service (73,000 people), including 27 generals, will keep 21 people; the National Police and the Ministry of Internal Affairs (175,000 people), including 57 generals, will have 42 people left," he wrote. Telephone conversation with Angela Merkel and Francois Hollande, 23.08.2016

The three leaders discussed the internal Ukrainian crisis and the possibility of implementing the Minsk agreements by coordinating political and security measures. They focused on the importance of formalising the special status for Donbass, implementing a constitutional reform and amnesty, as well as holding local elections. All these issues should be coordinated within the Contact Group, where Kiev can talk directly with Donetsk and Lugansk. The leaders also expressed concern over persisting instability at the contact line and numerous ceasefire violations and pointed to the need for strict compliance with the ceasefire agreement, the withdrawal of heavy weapons under the OSCE Special Monitoring Mission's control and the adoption of measures to further de-escalate tensions, including by disengaging the armed groups and creating demilitarised zones. President of Russia Vladimir Putin updated his colleagues on the crude provocation by Ukraine, which sent a group of subversives in early August to stage terrorist attacks in Russia. Kiev's use of such forceful measures is directly harming the Minsk process and cooperation within the Normandy format.

President of Ukraine discussed the escalation of the situation in Donbas with NATO Secretary General, 25.08.2016

The Head of State informed about the escalation of the situation in Donetsk and Luhansk regions, and the growing number of Russian provocations in the occupied Donbas and Crimea. Petro Poroshenko also called for keeping the issue of the Russian aggression against Ukraine on the agenda of the North Atlantic Alliance. Jens Stoltenberg underscored the importance of full implementation of the Minsk agreements. The Parties discussed the status of implementation of the 'Integrated package of NATO assistance to Ukraine' approved at the Alliance Summit in Warsaw. "Russia's Bastions [mobile coastal defense missile systems] are being relocated to the Starokrymsky training range," a witness comments in the second video clip. The K-300P Bastion-P (NATO reporting name SS-C-5 Stooge) is a Russian mobile coastal defense missile system. The main role of the Bastion-P is to engage surface ships, including carrier battle groups, convoys, and landing craft. A typical battery is composed of one or two command and control vehicles based on the Kamaz 43101 6×6 truck, one support vehicle, four launcher vehicles based on the MZKT-7930 8×8 chassis, each operated by a three-man crew and holding two missiles, and four loader vehicles. Launcher vehicles can be located up to 25 km (16 mi) away from the C2 vehicles.

Close to midnight, the occupiers fired 152mm artillery systems and launched about six dozen artillery shells at the village of Semyhirria.

In the Mariupol sector, Russia's hybrid military force fired 122mm self-propelled units, launching more than 100 shells at the village of Shyrokyne. Spot Report by OSCE Special Monitoring Mission to Ukraine, 31.08.2016

Between 20:55 and 21:00 on 30 August, whilst at the SMM forward patrol base in government-controlled Shchastia (20km north of Luhansk), an SMM patrol comprising five SMM staff members and a paramedic heard four shots of under-barrel-grenade-launcher (GP-25) fire approximately 1km south of their position. At approximately 22:05 the SMM heard four explosions assessed as mortar rounds outgoing from an undetermined distance south of its location. Within a few seconds, the patrol heard and felt four impacts assessed as caused by mortar rounds landing within 200m or less of the forward patrol base. The explosions shook the building and electricity immediately went out. After five minutes, the SMM heard and felt five-six more impacts of what it assessed as mortar rounds over approximately 20 minutes. The rounds were assessed as impacting within 300m of the forward patrol base. The SMM did not register any damage to its base.

We call on the Russian authorities to respect international human rights standards; to release Umerov without delay; and to allow him access to the medical care that he needs. It is clear that human rights standards are not being met in Crimea and we continue to call on the Russian Federation to allow immediate, unfettered access to all international human rights monitoring bodies. We do not, and will not, recognise Russia's illegal annexation of Crimea. Russia must return Crimea to Ukraine.

Ilchenko first spent 11 months in prison and was then placed under house arrest, which is when he decided to flee. Russia had accused him of inciting ethnic hatred and instigating terrorist acts, and one of the counts was a reposting of the then leader of the Right Sector Dmytro Yarosh's article with a suggestion to cut off gas supplies to Russia's Rostov region, TSN.ua wrote. Ilchenko claims that the prison in Crimea where he was held in custody was so crowded that there was no place to sleep. For example, 15 people had to sleep in bunks designed for six people. "Everyone had to sleep for a few hours by turn. It was like a minibus during the rush hour. The food they gave us stank so much even from afar that we did not take it. When someone fell ill and we knocked to call a doctor, we were told it was not a hospital and nobody was a patient here; only there should be either dead or alive. They said they could be called when someone was dead. Bodies were given to the relatives in black bags, just like garbage. The conditions there were terrible and not everyone could stand them. I saw people hang themselves or cut their veins," he recalled. He realized that "something must be done" when he was placed under house arrest.

Russian Economy at Risk of Delayed Recovery After Crimea Flareup, 29.08.2016

After President Vladimir Putin accused Ukraine of plotting terrorist attacks on the Black Sea peninsula this month, the chance that Western countries will scrap economic sanctions against Russia has declined, according to a Bloomberg survey of economists. Of the 21 asked, 52 percent see the European Union beginning to lift its penalties in the next 12 months. That's down from 69 percent in the previous survey. Only 10 percent expect the U.S. to start removing its sanctions, down from 19 percent a month ago.

"Increasing Ukraine tensions will undermine investor confidence, keep EU and U.S. sanctions in place and further put off foreign capital flows, as Putin will not be focused on economic reforms," said Christopher Shiells, a senior analyst at Informa Global Markets. "This will weaken the ruble and force the central bank to adopt a more cautious, hawkish tone."
