Introduction

After the Revolution of Dignity a year passed. During these 365 days, Ukraine has experienced more than during the previous period of its independence. But Ukraine has managed to survive, it did not fell apart after annexation of Crimea and forced conversion of Donbass in an open wound. Rather complicated situation in the country requires more power, real actions and reforms from the authorities.

Ukraine began diplomatic game by agreeing to the introduction of UN peacekeepers in the Donbas and as a result forced Russia to find itself in rather bad position as RF representatives publicly oppose the peacekeeping mission to Ukraine.

Ukraine fully felt the breath of terrorism. During a peaceful march in Kharkov dedicated to the anniversary of the Revolution of on February 22 explosion took place and took lives of 5 march participants.

Ukrainian troops started the removal of heavy weapons, according to the Minsk agreement. In the same time it looks like separatist are not for fair game.

All these events are taking place on the background of severe economic decline and impoverishment of the population.

Prognosis and polls

Survey: Number of Russians who think open war with Ukraine possible rises sharply, 02.02.2015

More than half of Russian believe eastern Ukraine is in state of civil war that broke out "after the seizure of power by a junta," according to a survey of the All-Russian Center for the Study of Public Opinion.

In addition, 17% of the respondents believe that Ukraine is seeing genocide and terrorism, Ukrainian newspaper Zekalo Nedeli reported, citing Russian newspaper Vedomosti. Some 3% of Russians blame the West for the conflict in eastern Ukraine. Another 10% say that war is already underway in Ukraine and they support the supply of financial assistance and weapons to the militants.

According to Valeriy Fiodorov of the Center for the Study of Public Opinion, Russian citizens base their judgment on what is happening in eastern Ukraine on information provided by the major Russian media. Almost 86% of TV viewers, 68% of readers of publications and 53% of online media readers completely trust their national media.

Survey: Number of Russians admitting to open war with Ukraine dramatically increases, 02.02.2015

According to survey results, hostility of Russians towards Ukrainians has significantly grown. According to Russian Public Opinion Research Center's (VCIOM) survey, more than half of Russians believe the conflict in eastern Ukraine is a civil war that occurred "because "junta" seized power."

Also, 17% of respondents believe that genocide and terror is taking place in Ukraine. 3% of Russians accuse the West in the conflict in eastern Ukraine. 10% say that the war in Ukraine is already underway and support financial and military assistance to the Donbas militants. http://mw.ua/WORLD/number-of-russians-admitting-to-open-war-with-ukraine-dramatically-increases-1075_.html

Poll: 82% of Crimeans support annexation, 04.02.2015

A total of 82% of the population of the Crimea fully support Russia's annexation of the peninsula, according to a poll carried out by the GfK Group research institute in Ukraine, Ukrainian online newspaper Ukrainska Pravda reported on Wednesday.

Another 11% of respondents said that they rather support the annexation of Crimea, while 4% were against it.

In addition, only 14% of Crimeans believe there will be a full-scale war between Ukraine and Russia, and another 74% do not believe in any such possibility. http://www.unian.info/politics/1040281-poll-82-of-crimeans-support-annexation.html

Poll: Russian hostility to US and EU breaks records, 10.02.2015

The number of Russian citizens who have a negative attitude towards the United States has risen to 81%, while a year ago it was 44%, according to the results of a survey carried out by the Levada Center, an independent Russian polling and sociological research organization. The number of Russians who describe relations between Russia and the United States as hostile has increased by more than 10 times over the year, from 4% to 42%, the center reported.

At the same time, Russians are less hostile to Europe. Only 71% of Russian citizens have a negative attitude towards the EU. However, 40% of the survey respondents still believe that Russia needs to strengthen its relations with the European Union, while 36% of respondents support complete isolation from Europe, according to Ukrainian newspaper Zerkalo Nedeli. The number of those who continue to consider Russia as one of the most influential countries in the world almost halved. A year ago, 45% of Russians believed in this, while this year this number is only 27%.

The previous survey carried out by the Levada Center showed that 79% of Russians had already been affected by Western sanctions, while 47% of Russian citizens had experienced serious financial difficulties.

The Triumph of Fear, 18.02.2015

Analyst: Ukraine and the West need a strategy for turning time to their advantage. The most challenging goal must be slowing down the figting.

Wednesday's Minsk summit, the latest meeting in the 'Normandy format', was the product of fear rather than strategic calculation. It would be difficult to find any other explanation for the frenzied movements of Angela Merkel and François Hollande last week. How else to explain the surprise of Washington, 'informed' but in no way consulted, the bypassing of the EU troika and the extraordinary secrecy of the proceedings? For the past year, Angela Merkel has been the embodiment of Western solidarity and firmness. Her approach has been forthright, methodical and consistent. 75% of Poles think Ukraine conflict threatens their security, 18.02.2015

What is more, 67% of those polled consider that the events in the east of Ukraine pose a threat to the entire Europe, and 55% to the entire world.

Fifty-six per cent of the pollees believe that Poland, jointly with other EU member states, should support Ukraine, while 6% said that Poland is obliged to provide special support for its eastern neighbors.

However, 33% of those polled would prefer that Warsaw in no way participated in the Ukrainian events. Sixty-two per cent are against Polish financial assistance to Ukraine, while half that percentage is in favor of such assistance.

The Poles are critical of Polish Prime Minister Ewa Kopacz's decision to lend Kyiv EUR 100 million: 41% of the pollees believe that it is the excessive burden on the Polish economy. Only 23% consider it to be a good initiative, and a mere 5% believe it to be a very modest proposal on behalf of Poland.

The survey revealed a mixed assessment by the Poles of the sanctions the EU has already introduced against Russia over Ukraine: 51% consider this measure as insufficient, 20% as adequate, 8% as excessive.

Poll: 86% of Russians support Putin's policies, 26.02.2015

The number of Russian citizens who support Russian President Vladimir Putin has risen to 86%, while a month ago it was 85%, according to the results of a survey carried out by the Levada Center, an independent Russian polling and sociological research organization. The poll was conducted in February. A total of 1,600 people were questioned in 46 regions of Russia. In particular, 86% of respondents said that they approved the president's policies. A total of 13% of respondents had a negative attitude towards Putin's policies.

Putin's rating, though very high, isn't the highest for a world leader however. According to a survey of the popularity of world leaders carried out late last year, Chinese President Xi Jinping, the leader of the world's largest one-party state, has a whopping 94.8% approval rating among his people.

Obama considers annexation of Crimea as 'improvisation' by Putin, 02.02.2015

Russian President Vladimir Putin had no strategy prepared concerning Ukraine and the annexation of the Crimea was "an improvisation" by the Kremlin in response to the unexpected ouster of Ukraine's president, U.S. President Barack Obama said in an interview with the U.S. television's CNN channel on Sunday, according to Ukrainian news service Podrobnosti. "Mr. Putin made this decision around Crimea and Ukraine - not because of some grand strategy, but essentially because he was caught off-balance by the protests in the Maidan and [former Ukrainian President Viktor] Yanukovych then fleeing after we had brokered a deal to transition power in Ukraine." Obama said.

European Investment Bank to provide Ukraine with one billion euros for projects this year, 03.02.2015

The European Investment Bank will allocate Ukraine EUR 1 billion for projects in the country this year, the press service of the Ministry of Economic Development and Trade has reported. The press service quoted a statement by the head of the representative office of the EIB in Ukraine, Lilia Cherniavska, that she made at a meeting with representatives of the Ministry of Economic Development.

"We have fulfilled the task related to the assistance that the European Union planned to provide [to Ukraine] through the EIB mechanism," Cherniavska said.

"But this year we have just as ambitious plans – the projects to be signed this year are worth about EUR 1 billion."

US 'not to supply weapons to Ukraine in near future, 03.02.2015

The U.S. government will not supply weapons to Ukraine "in the near future," Deputy National Security Advisor for Strategic Communication for U.S. the President, Benjamin J. Rhodes has said in an interview with CNN, German broadcaster Deutsche Welle has reported.

According to Rhodes, up until now sanctions have been the most effective way to exert pressure on Russia in connection with the Ukrainian conflict. Increasing the number of weapons to "fight back" is not a proper response to the conflict, Rhodes said.

At the same time, a report by the New York Times that the United States is considering the possibility of supplying Ukraine with defensive weapons was not explicitly refuted by Rhodes. He said that U.S. President Barack Obama has instructed all his advisors to consider "every opportunity." Rhodes said that Washington prefers to support a de-escalation of the conflict by peaceful means.

Russia's State Duma 'to demand EUR 4 trln from Germany' in reparations for attack on Soviet Union, 03.02.2015

MPs in Russia's State Duma have proposed to demand that Germany pay reparations for Nazi Germany's attack on the Soviet Union, Russian online news service Lenta.ru reported on Tuesday, quoting Russian newspaper Izvestia.

According to the report, a specially created working group will assess the amount of compensation that is planned to be presented to Berlin as a liability for reparations. "In fact, Germany didn't pay the Soviet Union any reparations for the destruction and atrocities during World War II. After the war, the Soviet Union government signed an agreement with the GDR on not levying reparations," State Duma MP from the Liberal Democratic Party Mikhail Degtiarev said.

"No such agreements were concluded with the Federal Republic of Germany or the united Germany, so that's why it's an open question," he said.

Steinmeier: We cannot allow situation in Ukraine to get out of control, 04.02.2015

Everything should be done to prevent the conflict in Donbas getting completely out of control, German Foreign Minister Frank-Walter Steinmeier has said in an interview with the German publication Nuernberger Nachrichten, Ukrainian newspaper YevroPravda has reported. "With the conflict in eastern Ukraine the question of war and peace has returned to the European continent. People are afraid, and that fear is in the images that we daily receive from eastern Ukraine," Steinmeier said.

"That is why we must act wisely. I see it as our duty to do everything in our power to ensure that this conflict does not go completely out of control," he said.

According to Steinmeier, there is no reason to abandon the commitments the parties signed up to in Minsk.

US intelligence: Russia creating long-term conflict in eastern Ukraine, 04.02.2015

Russia is trying to create a "permanent conflict" in eastern Ukraine and "will continue this year putting pressure on Kyiv through military and non-military methods", according to the statement of US Defense Intelligence Agency Director Lieutenant General Vincent Stewart released at a congressional hearing devoted to global threats, Russian news agency TASS has reported. Moscow's actions with regard to Ukraine "correspond to Russia's new military doctrine and strategy, which will cause further anxiety among neighboring states," Lieutenant General Stewart said.

The Pentagon's intelligence office believes that Russia has updated the doctrine to allow for the use of "new warfare methods," and "has made significant progress in modernizing its nuclear and conventional weapons."

"We expect that in 2015 the Russian military activity will remain at a high level," Lieutenant General Stewart said.

US adds four Russian defense industry enterprises to sanctions list, 05.02.2015

The U.S. State Department has added four Russian companies to its sanctions list under the "Iran, North Korea, and Syria Nonproliferation Act," Russian newspaper Izvestiya has reported, with reference to the U.S. State Department.

In addition to four Russian legal entities, the list also includes 18 organizations from Belarus, China, Iran, North Korea, Sudan, Syria and Venezuela.

"Sanctions against legal persons were introduced after obtaining reliable information on the transfer or acquisition of goods and technologies, provision of certain services included on the list of U.S. export controls, to Iran, Syria or North Korea," the State Department noted.

Saakashvili: Putin wants corridor to Transnistria, 05.02.2015

Russian President Vladimir Putin wants to create a land corridor to Transnistria and he will try to achieve a military coup in Ukraine or riots in Kyiv to achieve this goal, Former Georgian President Mikheil Saakashvili said.

"Now he has a plan – to create new bridgeheads in Debaltseve, and then to make a corridor through Volnovakha to Crimea. Steinmeier to discuss Ukrainian crisis in Warsaw on February 5, 05.02.2015

German Foreign Minister Frank-Walter Steinmeier will review the situation in Ukraine and the EU in Warsaw on February 5, the press secretary of Polish Ministry of Foreign Affairs Marcin Wojciechowski wrote on his Twitter account on Wednesday.

"German Foreign Minister Steinmeier will visit Poland tomorrow. The main topic of conversation with Polish Foreign Minister Grzegorz Schetyna will be a crisis in Ukraine and the EU affairs," he said.

Earlier, Steinmeier said everything must be done to stop the situation in Ukraine getting out of control, as U.S. officials raised the issue of supplying arms to Ukraine in response to Russia's escalation of the conflict in eastern Ukraine.

German Chancellor Angela Merkel has said that Germany will not provide weapons to Ukraine, and that there can only be a peaceful solution to the Ukraine conflict.

Lithuania calls for Ukraine to be given weapons, 05.02.2015

Linkevičius also called for military assistance to be provided to Ukraine.

US claims Russian troops operating in Ukraine since April 2014, 05.02.2015

Russian troops have been present in the east of Ukraine since the beginning of the armed conflict in April 2014, U.S. Ambassador to NATO Douglas Lute said, Radio Liberty reported. Russian military experts are exercising command and control functions in the conflict, and also operating sophisticated equipment that untrained separatists are not able to use, Lute stated before a meeting of NATO defense ministers in Brussels held on Thursday.

Russia's armed forces present on the territory of Ukraine include military forces, intelligence. and operational staff. Some of them are operating in uniforms of Russian troops, while others do not. Lute said.

Italy's Foreign Minister Paolo Gentiloni rules out any planned deliveries of lethal arms to the Ukrainian military, 05.02.2015.

US to Fork Over \$16 Million in Humanitarian Aid to Ukraine, 05.02.2015

US Secretary of State John Kerry arrived in Kiev to discuss reforms and de-escalation in Ukraine's war-torn east.

During his brief visit to Kiev Secretary Kerry pledged an additional \$16.4 million in humanitarian assistance to Ukraine.

Yatseniuk outlines conditions for growth of Ukrainian economy in 2016, 12.02.2015

The government expects Ukraine's economy to resume growth in 2016, provided reforms envisaged under the new lending program with the IMF are implemented and Russia ends its aggression, Ukrainian Prime Minister Arseniy Yatseniuk said on Thursday.

As reported earlier, international financial institutions expect that the fall of Ukraine's economy will slow in 2015, although based on IMF forecasts, it may grow by 1% in 2015.

According to Ukrainian government forecasts, the Ukrainian economy will shrink by 4.5% in 2015 and grow slightly in 2016.

Official estimaties of the State Statistics Service regarding Ukraine's GDP fall in 2014 have not been published yet, but according to IMF estimates the decrease was 7-7.5%.

On February 11, the Ukrainian government and the IMF agreed on a new lending program for a period of four years in an amount of \$17.5 billion, with the possibility of increasing macro financial support to \$25 billion. A final decision on such program by the IMF Executive Board is expected in about a month.

Merkel: EU not to cancel new sanctions against Russia, 13.02.2015

The European Union will not cancel new sanctions against Russia that are due to come into force on Monday, February 16, German Chancellor Angela Merkel said after an EU summit in Brussels on Thursday, according to German broadcaster Deutsche Welle.

The adopted package of measures provides for the prohibition of entry to the EU of some of the Russian-backed militants and the freezing of the accounts of 19 individuals and nine companies. The names of these 19 people and the list of nine companies have not yet been made public.

The Minsk peace deal negotiated by the leaders of Ukraine, Russia, France and Germany will have no effect on France's decision to suspend the sale of French-built Mistral helicopter carrier assault ships to Russia, French Foreign Minister Laurent Fabius said in an interview.

"How can we fulfill under present circumstances the terms of a transaction negotiated few years ago? At the moment it is suspended," Fabius said.

The EUR 1.2 billion contract for the two Mistral helicopter carriers was signed between the French company DCNS and Russia's Rosoboronexport in 2011. The first ship, the Vladivostok, was expected to go into service in the Russian Navy in 2014, while the second, named the Sevastopol, was to be commissioned in 2015.

"Ukraine's accession to NATO would be a fateful error," Gentiloni said when asked whether Russian President Vladimir Putin can be allowed to influence Ukraine's foreign policy choices, particularly, its choice regarding NATO membership.

EU puts new sanctions into force against Russia, 16.02.2015

The EU has included on its travel blacklist three senior officials of the Ministry of Defense of Russia, singer and State Duma MP Iosif Kobzon, and a number of militants from the Donetsk and Luhansk People's Republics, who are also subjected to the freezing of their bank accounts. The corresponding list was published in the Official Journal of the European Union on Monday, according to an UNIAN correspondent in Brussels.

In particular, the list included Deputy Defense Minister Anatoliy Antonov, the First Deputy Defense Minister Arkadiy Bakhin, head of the Main Operations Directorate and Deputy Chief of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation Andrey Kartapolov.

The list also includes MPs of the State Duma losif Kobzon and Valeriy Rashkin.

The rest of the list is made up of militants and members of the self-proclaimed Donetsk and Luhansk People's Republics. In particular, the list includes: the commander of the first Cossack regiment Pavel Dremov, commander of the Russian association Aleksei Milchakov, commander of the Sparta battalion Arseniy Pavlov, known as Motorola, and the commander of the Somali battalion, Mikhail Tolstoy.

"They said that the Ukrainian armed forces from 'the Debaltseve pocket' should hand over their weapons. Everyone was left speechless. The four [leaders] almost got up and left," Kuchma said.

US accuses militants, Russia of violating ceasefire in Donbas, calls for immediate end to hostilities, 17.02.2015

The United States has urged Russia and the Russian-backed militants in eastern Ukraine to immediately stop their attacks on Ukrainian forces and start a dialogue with the OSCE on the implementation of the Minsk agreements.

"The United States is gravely concerned by the deteriorating situation in and around Debaltseve in eastern Ukraine," the U.S. State Department said in a press release issued on Monday. "The OSCE Special Monitoring Mission confirms that attacks continue in this area as well as other locations, including Sievierodonetsk, Luhansk, and Donetsk city. The government of Ukraine reports that its forces have been fired on 129 times in the last 24 hours by Russia-backed separatists, killing five and wounding 25, including attacks on a convoy evacuating the wounded from Debaltseve.

"The separatists have publicly declared that they refuse to observe the ceasefire in Debaltseve, and OSCE monitors have not been provided security guarantees for access. These aggressive actions and statements by the Russia-backed separatists threaten the most recent ceasefire and jeopardize the planned withdrawal of heavy weapons, as called for in the February 12 Minsk packet of implementing measures.

He has already initiated several criminal cases, arrested some high-profile corrupt officials, and by this way I think he has got a significant credibility," Poroshenko said. In response, the head of the Bundestag said that Ukraine may rely on a high level of trust and support in Europe.

"I do not need to say that Germany is on your side, without any objections. We share the understanding of what is happening now - this is not merely an Ukrainian issue, but an issue of the future of the whole Europe," Lammert said.

"At first we received a very strange proposal regarding the ceasefire being introduced after 20 days. Cameron calls for crackdown on Russian spies, 23.02.2015

"We hope that the member states of the United Nations and, first of all, the UN Security Council, will support this request for help," he said.

"This initiative does not contradict the Minsk agreements, but rather can help to fulfill these agreements and to restore peace," Klimkin said.

The minister also said that the agreements on a ceasefire reached by the "Normandy Four" leaders in Minsk had not been implemented.

Cameron: UK to send military experts to Ukraine, 25.02.2015

Britain will send 75 servicemen to Ukraine in March to act as advisers and instructors in infantry tactics and logistic support, but they will be "far from the line of contact of the warring parties," UK Prime Minister David Cameron told the Liaison Committee of the British Parliament. "If Russia is not stopped now in Ukraine, tomorrow we will see the destabilization of Moldova

and the Baltic countries," Cameron said.

The prime minister also said that the continuation of Russian interference in Ukraine may lead to new sanctions against Russia, including a third package of sanctions against key sectors of the Russian economy.

When asked about the possibility of weapons supplies to Ukraine, the British prime minister said that it was now the time to think about this. "By extension, I am also disturbed by Russia's apparent unwillingness to publicly insist that the rebels immediately allow the monitors access, stop all ceasefire violations and withdraw all heavy weapons. EU President Tusk: more sanctions against Russia over Ukraine "remain on the table", 25.02.2015

Tusk announced this in European parliament on Wednesday when reporting the results of an informal meeting of the EU Heads of State or Government held on February 12.

Tusk said that at the February 12 meeting, the EU leaders exchanged views with Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko on the situation in Ukraine, and thanked German Chancellor Angela Merkel and French President Francois Hollande for their "indispensable efforts for peace as the initiators of the Normandy Four talks."

"We gave the fragile agreement our cautious support. The European Union still hopes for peace so that the independence, sovereignty and territorial integrity of Ukraine can be restored as soon as possible," he said.

Putin hasn't accomplished his objective inside Ukraine, new advances possible – Commander of U.S. European Command, 25.02.2015

Gen. Philip Breedlove, the Commander of the Supreme Allied Command Europe and U.S. European Combatant Command, announced this during a U.S. House Armed Services Committee hearing in Washington on February 25, 2015.

"I don't think any of us are sure he [Putin] has accomplished his objective inside Ukraine," he said, suggesting that the Russian president may continue to move forces further into Ukraine, according to Ukrainian online newspaper Ukrainska Pravda.

"I don't believe Ukrainian forces can stop a Russian advance in eastern Ukraine," he added. He said that Russia had seriously increased financial injections in its defense sector, including in nuclear weapons.

According to Breedlove, Putin's "disinformation campaign is quite impressive" on Ukraine. Kuchma: Putin delivers ultimatum to Ukraine, 26.02.2015

"We were actually given an ultimatum: If we don't accept its terms and stop any resistance, we'll cease to exist as an independent state," Kuchma said.

"[Putin] made it clear that he would not stop before any losses and costs in achieving his goal," he said.

Kuchma also said he believed that such an ultimatum had been delivered not only to Ukraine, but to the whole of the Western world.

Breedlove concerned about militarization of Crimea, 26.02.2015

NATO Supreme Allied Commander Europe General Philip Breedlove has expressed concerns about Russia building up its military capabilities in Crimea, particularly, the deployment of long-range anti-aircraft and attack missile systems on the peninsula, Russian newspaper Lenta.ru. has reported with reference to a report from the U.S. Naval Institute.

"What we have seen is that Crimea has been transformed in some fairly significant ways, as far as weapon systems in the Crimea," Breedlove said.

"These weapon systems — from air defense systems that reach nearly half of the Black Sea to surface attack systems that reach almost all of the Black Sea area — have made the platform of Crimea a great platform for power projection into this area."

U.S. experts say such placement of weapons directly threatens U.S. and NATO ships in the Black Sea and could change the equation of power in the region.

When asked about Russian aircraft flying over U.S. ships that enter the Black Sea, Breedlove said their behavior could not be classified as aggressive on the whole.

US Congress considers bill on allocation of \$1 bln in military aid to Ukraine, 27.02.2015

Thornberry is Chairman of the House Committee on Armed Services, and Smith is its Senior Democrat.

In addition to their signatures, the document was signed by 28 parliamentarians.

According to the text of the bill, U.S. Secretary of Defense has the right together with the Secretary of State to provide assistance, including training, equipment, weapons of a defensive purpose, logistic support, supplies, maintenance, and technical support for the Ukrainian army and the Ukrainian armed forces.

Pentagon chief will have this right before September 30, 2017.

Prosecutor says Azarov suspected of illegally terminating Antonov audit, 20.02.2015

"Based on the results of official investigations initiated by the military prosecutor's office and conducted by the Commission of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine, it was established that M. Azarov, while serving as prime minister of Ukraine, illegally suspended in autumn 2012 the audit of the government interagency group that revealed significant violations of budget legislation in the activities of state design bureau Antonov," the press service of the Prosecutor's General Office reported.

"Funds received from commercial use of Ruslan cargo aircraft remained in the accounts of two foreign companies and a representative of the mentioned enterprise, and were used by them at their own discretion."

The press service said that as a result of these illegal actions by the suspect, as well as the state's failure to claim corporate rights to dividends, the country incurred losses of UAH 37 million, as confirmed by evidence obtained during the investigation.

"At the moment, we have recorded that the militants again started to use the tactics of ambush and 'wandering tanks' supported by mortars. We have recorded at least two such groups, which are periodically launching attacks on the forward positions of the Ukrainian armed forces," he said.

OSCE: Kramatorsk fired on from south-southeast, 11.02.2015

The Smerch rockets that hit Kramatorsk on Tuesday, killing 16 people and wounding another 64, were fired from the south-southeast, from the direction of militant-held territory, the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe has reported.

The results of an OSCE investigation at the scene of the attack were given in a brief report by its special monitoring mission in Kramatorsk, Ukrainian online newspaper Lb.ua reported. "According to the special monitoring mission, three shells were 300mm ammunition fired from BM-30 Smerch [rockets]," the OSCE said.

"Based on observations on the ground, photographs and a map analysis, the mission has determined that the [rocket were launched] from the south-southeast direction. The special monitoring mission has not yet carried out an analysis of the [impact] craters for safety reasons," the report reads.

Ukrainian government has said the Smerch rockets were fired from the militant-held town of Horlivka, about 90 kilometers to the south-southeast. Smerch rockets have a maximum range of 90 kilometers.

"In the first day after the beginning of the ceasefire, the illegal armed groups failed to comply with the agreements they signed in Minsk. Thus, yesterday the occupants twice shelled ATO positions in the settlement of Shyrokino with tanks," the statement reads.

It also said that at 0100 on Monday militants launched attacks with small arms on Ukrainian positions in the same village.

The situation in other positions of the "M" or Mariupol sector of the frontline is calm. The Ukrainian military are in their positions, and do not open fire, fully complying with the Minsk agreement, the report said.

"Analyzing the first day since the beginning of the ceasefire, we can say that the illegal armed groups are not adhering to the agreements they signed," the report says.

Media: Militants want to occupy Debaltseve to supply front line by rail, 16.02.2015

Debaltseve is an important military objective of the Russian-backed militants as taking the town would enable them to increase the amount of military supplies getting to the front line, Ukrainian news service TSN.Tyzhden said on Sunday.

Debaltseve stands at the crossroads of rail communications between Luhansk and Donetsk, as well as Russia's Rostov-on-Don - the main Russian city from which Russian military equipment and troops have been sent into Ukraine since the beginning of the war, TSN said.

If the town is occupied, the militants will be able to move supplies freely from the Russian border to the front line, TSN said.

The volumes of what Russia claims is humanitarian aid that could be sent by rail will be much more than the current volumes it is sending in trucks. One rail freight car alone can hold the same volume as three of the biggest Kamaz trucks that Russia has been sending into Ukraine since August.

The Russian Emergency Situations Ministry says more than 20,000 tonnes of cargo have been already sent to Ukraine, in more than a thousand Kamaz trucks over six months. By rail, similar amounts could be sent in one, two, or three trains per day.

UN: Number of killed in Donbas conflict exceeds 5,600

A total of 5,617 people, including 63 children, have been killed in the Donbas conflict zone in eastern Ukraine since fighting broke out there in mid-April, the UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) reported on Monday, according to Russian news agency TASS. In addition, 13,400 people, including 159 children, were injured during this period.

According to the UN's review of the situation in Ukraine from January 7 to February 13, as of February 9, a total of 1.7 million people have been registered as internally displaced persons. The deterioration of the humanitarian situation due to the conflict in the Donbas has affected 5.2 million people.

Also, according to Stelmakh, the Artemovsk-Debaltseve highway is completely controlled by Ukrainian military, with Ukrainian checkpoints being set up there.

"The road is completely controlled by us, ammunition and food are transported there, and a scheduled rotation of personnel is being carried out," he added.

"The fuel in these areas comes from Russia in two ways – convoys (10 to 15 fuelling vehicles in each column, escorted by armed guards) and through previously arranged contraband routes," Tymchuk wrote.

He said that as a result of shelling the local police department building had been practically destroyed. He ordered the police officers to relocate to a more fortified place, as it was too dangerous to stay in the old building.

"The negotiations regarding the prisoners of war are underway. I think this [release] will happen soon if the Minsk agreements are fulfilled. The Ukrainian side has already submitted its [POW] lists," he said.

Leader of the militants of the so-called Donetsk People's Republic Oleksandr Zakharchenko has approved documents for the withdrawal of heavy weapons.

Petro Kanonik, the head of the Ukrainian military group at the Joint Centre for Ceasefire Control and Coordination, told this to Ukrainian online newspaper Ukrainska Pravda.

"Just an hour ago, Russia's representative to the Joint Center Alexander Lentsov signed heavy weapons withdrawal documents with Zakharchenko, and before that they were signed with [Luhansk People's Republic leader Igor] Plotnitsky," Kanonik said.

"Zero hour is to begin tomorrow, February 22," he said.

OSCE reports humanitarian disaster in Debaltseve, 22.02.2015

OSCE monitors have registered numerous cases of destruction and signs of a humanitarian disaster in Debaltseve in Donbas during their visit to that town.

This was announced by spokesperson for the OSCE Special Monitoring Mission to Ukraine Iryna Hudyma in an interview with a TASS correspondent.

"We spent there about half an hour yesterday. We saw not a single facility not damaged by shells, not a single intact building. There is neither water, nor food, or heat, or electricity, or medicines in the town," she said.

The OSCE also said that its monitors did not plan to visit Debaltseve on Sunday, as they were going to other towns.

New types of weapons used to shell Ukrainian troops near Mariupol, 22.02.2015

New shells with microshrapnel burst 40 meters above the surface.

A case when a new type of weapons was used against the Ukrainian troops was registered in the village of Shyrokyne outside the city of Mariupol in eastern Ukraine. The Armed Forces of Ukraine haven't experienced the effect of such weaponry before, announced by Deputy Commander of the 'M' (Mariupol) sector of the frontline Viktor Shydliuk.

According to him, the enemy allegedly used tube-launched projectiles with a special feature: they burst at a height of 40 meters above the surface.

After the surface burst, the affected area is covered by a large number of microshrapnel whose size is several millimeters. They cause multiple shrapnel wounds; surgery of a person with such small injuries becomes complicated and lasts much longer than usual.

"As for the deaths, it is hard to tell the exact number, but, according to our estimates, it is already more than 65 children," Kuleba said.

General Staff: Ukraine begins withdrawal of heavy weapons, 26.02.2015

The victims of the regimes, 28.02.2015

The murder of Russian opposition politician Boris Nemtsov in Russia and the suicide of a former member of the Party of Regions Mikhail Chechetov in Ukraine indicate that the regimes built in the two neighboring countries devour not only their opponents, but also those of their supporters who happen to know too much.

The death of a Ukrainian politician, former member of a Party of Regions Mikhail Chechetov seems less significant on a global scale. He was just released on bail of nearly UAH 5 million on Monday, February, 23. However, in an internal Ukrainian context, his death caused no less resonance. "As early as in 2005, Mikhail Chechetov said that he would cooperate with law enforcement authorities and would give testimony. Given that Chechetov had been at the forefront of privatization and had witnessed many deals, which involved a lot of money, incitement to suicide is possible," says political scientist Taras Zagorodnii.

Angry over being denied voting rights, Russia says PACE mission can't visit Savchenko, 03.02.2015

Chairman of the International Affairs Committee of the Russian State Duma Alexey Pushkov has said Moscow will maintain contact only with countries that voted against maintaining sanctions on the Russian delegation in the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE).

Relations between Russia and the PACE have been suspended unilaterally by Russia until the end of the year in the wake of the PACE's decision to deprive Russia of its voting rights in the assembly due to its aggression in Ukraine.

In a move seemingly reflecting Moscow's anger with the assembly, PACE delegates were refused access to Ukrainian pilot Nadezhda Savchenko in the Russian prison in which she is held, and members of the assembly have not been permitted to visit Crimea to verify the observance of human rights in the Russian-annexed Ukrainian territory.

MEP goes on hunger strike in support of Savchenko, 05.02.2015

As UNIAN reported earlier, Savchenko was abducted by Russian-backed militants in the Donbas in the summer of 2014, and then taken to Russia, where she was charged with being involved in the death of Russian journalists.

Russian court extends Savchenko's arrest until May 13, 10.02.2015

Moscow's Basmanny Court extended the arrest of Ukrainian pilot Nadezhda Savchenko until May 13 at a hearing on Tuesday, as the prisoner entered the fifty-seventh day of a hunger strike in protest at the conditions of her detention.

According to UNIAN correspondent in Russia, the decision was announced by the Judge Artur Karpov in the courtroom.

In addition, lawyer Ilya Novikov has said that the defense is ready to agree to any bail. He also said that Savchenko can be released under the personal guarantee of the Ukrainian Parliament Commissioner for Human Rights Valeria Lutkovska, he added.

He appealed to the court to choose any preventive measure except detention, as "this will kill Savchenko."

Russian State Duma says no automatic release for Savchenko, 12.02.2015

There is no mechanism for the automatic release of citizen of Ukraine Nadia Savchenko, and her innocence must be proved in court, the chairman of the State Duma's Foreign Affairs Committee Aleksey Pushkov said on Thursday, according to Russian news agency TASS. "As far as I understand, if [Ukrainian President Petro] Poroshenko made this statement in

Minsk, it was probably very important for him to send a signal to Kyiv that he had achieved something [with regard to] the fate of Savchenko," he said.

"However, very serious charges were made againsst Savchenko. In order to withdraw them, either the investigating authorities must recognize that these charges are not sufficiently substantiated, or a court hearing must be held that will decide on her innocence," Pushkov said. "There is no mechanism for the automatic release of a person who is accused of complicity in murder, in this case, of a Russian journalist," he said.

Savchenko to Dzhemilev: I won't stop hunger strike, 27.02.2015

Ukrainian pilot, MP and member of the Ukrainian delegation to PACE Nadia Savchenko has rejected a call from the leader of the Crimean Tatars and representative of the President of Ukraine on the Crimean Tatars Mustafa Dzhemilev to stop her hunger strike.

A letter from a prisoner in Moscow was handed over via her lawyers, and published by a correspondent of the AFP information agency, Maria Antonova, on her Twitter account on Thursday.

Savchenko thanked Dzhemilev for his support but said that she would continue to starve herself. She reminded the leader of the Crimean Tatars that he was also on hunger strike for 303 days in a Soviet prison.

"At one time you accomplished a feat for your people, going hungry for 303 days in jail! If you hadn't done this, maybe your people would never be able to return to their land... I have a good example - it's you! "Territorial issues are not the subject of negotiations between Poroshenko, Hollande and Merkel," a representative of the German government said.

At the same time, according to Le Figaro, the fact that Merkel has agreed to negotiate, "gives reason for optimism," since the Astana meeting in Normandy format, which was scheduled on January 15 and then cancelled, was initiated by the German chancellor, according to media reports.

Putin offers Merkel and Hollande to 'create new Transnistria in Ukraine, 06.02.2015
