Introduction

The death of Pavlo Sheremet could trigger a social and political crisis. A terrorist attack is different from a "regular" homicide with the former having an apparent political purpose. It's too early for law enforcement agencies to know for sure who wanted eminent journalist Pavlo Sheremet dead. However, the targeted car blast in the center of Ukraine's capital Kyiv on July 20 can lead to a new period of social and political turmoil in the country.

Meanwhile, a so-called cross procession across Ukraine heading towards Kyiv, organized by the Moscow Patriarchate of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church, is being seen by many as deliberate provocation.

Nadia Savchenko is dancing to someone else's tune. Nadia's intention to become president with dictatorial powers has come as no surprise: she seems to be too preoccupied with catching up with all that she's missed following her release from a Russian prison and, unfortunately, hasn't noticed that she's become a tool in someone else's dirty hands. The anniversary of Volodymyr Groysman's first 100 days in office was a rather routine affair. The premier says the Ukrainian economy is sending positive signals, these can only be felt by the experts. Millions of Ukrainians hear much more distinctly the populist outcries of some politicians, who forecast a terrible winter following an increase in the gas tariffs. Rada Speaker Andriy Parubiy appears overly optimistic about Parliament's performance. According to him, the lawmakers were able to overcome the crisis at work and are now willing to work effectively for the sake of Ukraine.

Over 40% of Ukrainians say NATO membership fundamental guarantee of national security, 06.07.2016

A total of 43% of Ukrainians consider NATO membership Ukraine's main national security guarantee, according to a study by Ilko Kucheriv Democratic Initiatives Foundation and the Razumkov Center, a political analyst of the Democratic Initiatives Foundation Maria Zolkina said at a press conference on Wednesday.

Less than 25% of liberated Donbas residents back economic, political alliance with Russia – poll, 14.07.2016

Only 22% of respondents in the liberated territory of Donetsk region supported an economic and political alliance with Russia, while almost half of the residents of the uncontrolled territories, some 48%, back this idea. At the same time, the option of joining the European Union was supported by 23% of respondents in the liberated territories, whereas only 9% of respondents in the occupied areas favor this option. Further, at least one-third of the respondents in both parts of the Donetsk region would prefer that Ukraine not join any political or economic associations, voicing these positions by 38% and 30%, respectively. Head of Think Tank Donbas Dmytro Tkachenko has said that after two years into the conflict, the region remains unique, in terms of socio-cultural features. "If we are talking about the portrait of residents in controlled and uncontrolled territories, we say, straight away, that we witness a very strong phenomenon in both parts of the region that we call paternalism: the desire for a strong state and a strong leader, underdeveloped civic engagement and civic positions, low level responsibility and unwillingness to take responsibility," said Tkachenko. He added that the Donbas residents declared that their rights and freedoms remain important.

NATO's Warsaw summit will stabilize eastern flank: Polish minister, 01.07.2016

Polish Defence Minister Antoni Macierewicz said: "We are confident that this summit will stabilize the situation both in the east and south. NATO is a defensive alliance. It responds to threats. "The response which will be given on 8 and 9 July will be a sufficient response, an effective response, a response which is an effective deterrent and providing security for our countries and nations." Macierewicz added that 8-9 July gathering in Warsaw would be "the largest NATO summit so far, both in terms of numbers and decisions [and] the breakthrough nature of these decisions. The forces of our allies will finally be in place permanently on the eastern flank." Asked about NATO's relations with Russia, Macierewicz said talks with Moscow should take place "from a position where decisions have been taken" to beef up the alliance's presence on its eastern borders. "Prior to this decision, there was no reason to talk. He also expressed gratitude to USA and other countries for synchronous continuation of sanctions.

Kwasniewski: Ukraine should abandon the dream of being a NATO member and full partner of the EU, 04.07.2016

In his words, «has nothing against the goals of Kiev ever to become a full member of the Alliance». Kwasniewski, speaking at the event of the Fund named Cerberus in Warsaw, expressed concern about the security of their country, the Baltic States and Moldova. Kwasniewski said that the situation in this region is the least secure for 17 years, since Poland joined NATO. This situation, according to Kwasniewski, was formed due to the high activity of the Russian military in the region, especially near the borders of Estonia and Latvia, in addition, in the vicinity of Moldova. He also noted that because of the teachings of Russia on the Eastern borders of the Alliance rely on the fact that during the summit of countries-members of NATO on 8 and 9 July in Warsaw will be taken the decision to strengthen its military presence in Poland and the Baltic States.

Russian aggression in Ukraine raises questions over security of neighboring states: UK Parliament, 05.07.2016

"Russian actions in Ukraine have created a deep instability within Europe of a type not witnessed since the end of the Cold War," the report reads. British parliamentarians admit that this "is a problem for Europe in general and for the NATO alliance in particular." While Ukraine is not a member of NATO and therefore not subject to Article 5 guarantees, it was guaranteed by the Budapest Agreement. Russian military action there thus raises questions over the security of neighboring countries which fall within Russia's military reach and which Russia would like to bring into its sphere of influence. Noting that Russia has harnessed a wide range of capabilities which can rapidly be deployed for use in conjunction with classic military power, the MPs say NATO needs to respond in kind if it is to counter unconventional as well as conventional warfare. The report strongly recommends that NATO, as part of its response to Russia, "addresses its shortcomings in terms of the full range of unconventional warfare."

OSCE Parliamentary Assembly passes declaration condemning Russian aggression in Crimea, 05.07.2016

The Parliamentary Assembly of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe has adopted at its meeting held in Georgia a so-called "Tbilisi Declaration" which condemns the aggression of the Russian Federation in Crimea, according to a Ukrainian MP Anton Gerashchenko. "Right now, the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly at its meeting in Tbilisi adopted a `Tbilisi Declaration,` part of which is a tough resolution on Crimea, proposed by the Ukrainian delegation. Representatives of more than 50 parliaments of OSCE member states have voted for [the declaration], which once again showed strong rejection by the European community of Russia's aggression. 122 votes were `For`," the official wrote. Only 6 votes of the Russian and Armenian delegates were cast against the document.

Ukraine seeks to set up joint production of lethal weapons with U.S. – Ambassador, 05.07.2016

According to the diplomat, in such a way Kyiv can compensate for Western unwillingness to openly provide lethal aid to Ukraine. Ukraine may also gain a strategic advantage in the long run. "We're talking about how we can deepen cooperation with the United States in the overall production of weapons, general action in this sector. It is much more important, it is the strategic direction," Chaly said. According to the Ambassador, Kyiv has changed its position on receiving lethal aid, taking into account the reaction of the U.S. allies. "The official position of the White House now is that they are not talking about lethal weapons. Meanwhile, frankly speaking, we have also changed our approach. That's because we can produce lethal weapons in Ukraine," the diplomat said.

Savchenko insists on direct contact with "DPR", "LPR": "We need to talk beyond Minsk process", 06.07.2016

Batkivshchyna MP Nadiia Savchenko calls for direct talks with the leaders of the so-called "LPR" and "DPR", bypassing the Minsk agreements. In phone conversation with Nadiia Savchenko, who is currently visiting Ukraine's east, she stressed that the Minsk agreements can not stop the war but they stopped the barrage. When asked how to resolve the situation in the Donbas, she suggested three steps. In particular, she called for seeking mutual understanding and noted the importance of mutual forgiveness. She added that both Chechen and Dagestani scenarios are unsuitable for the Donbas as Ukraine needs to refrain from carnage. "There are three steps. First, the sanctions against Russia should be extended. as it has not yet realized it has to withdraw. Second, we should launch direct, internal talks beyond the Minsk agreements with the "DPR" and "LPR", excluding any third or fourth party," the deputy stressed.

Norwegian FM: Donbas elections impossible until Russia withdraws troops, 06.07.2016 "We shouldn't think that the Minsk agreements only mean elections and decentralization. Minsk also means the withdrawal of Russian armed forces, Russian military vehicles from Donbas, the stoppage of their financial support for their mercenaries," Brende said at a joint press conference with Ukrainian Foreign Minister Pavlo Klimkin in Kyiv on Wednesday. According to Brende, there are still Russian troops and weapons in Donbas, and the Russian Federation continues to finance mercenaries. "Do the OSCE observers have full access to Donbas? Does Ukraine have full control over its borders? I think we know the answers to these questions. I agree with Minister Klimkin that elections are important, but they must be held only after other Minsk conditions are fulfilled," he said. During the presentation of the first systematic report "Ukraine and Association Agreement: monitoring the implementation of the 2014-2016 years", prepared by the Public Association "Ukrainian center of European policy", Head of EU Delegation to Ukraine Ian Tombinski expressed concern over blocking of Verkhovna Rada. In the context of Ukrainian prospects of gaining membership in the European Union for 10 years, the Ambassador stressed that Ukraine needs to set such tasks, but also "needs to move from declaratory policy to a policy of real action". "We are very concerned that the Ukrainian parliament is almost paralyzed in the last week", Tombinski said. "It need to continue working", the ambassador said, adding that it is necessary first of all to implement and launch the necessary reforms.

U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry says that there is the ability in short order to begin the process of the full implementation of the Minsk peace agreements on Donbas. "Without excessive optimism, with a pure note of reality, I am convinced that in the time left there's the ability in short order, frankly, to begin the process of the full implementation," he said at a joint press conference with Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko in Kyiv on Thursday. "Now, I think that it is necessary to find a path forward that unites the interests of the parties in a way that is fair and sensible, and provides assurance to both sides – to all sides, because there's more than one, or two – that the requirements of Minsk are in fact being met and being met in a way that gives everybody an assurance that their needs are going to be satisfied," he said while commenting prospects for the completion of the implementation of the Minsk security component until the end of Barack Obama's presidency. Kerry also pointed to Ukraine's significant progress in the implementation of the Minsk agreements, particularly, their political aspects.

According to Obama, "in Warsaw, we must reaffirm our determination — our duty under Article 5 of the North Atlantic Treaty — to defend every NATO ally." "We need to bolster the defense of our allies in central and eastern Europe, strengthen deterrence and boost our resilience against new threats, including cyberattacks," he said.

Dzhemilev sees no military solution to regaining Crimea, 11.07.2016

Dzhemilev made this statement during an interview with the Voice of America's Russian Service. In discussing how Ukraine might counter Russia's aggression, Dzhemilev noted that Ukraine's most realistic option remains assistance from the North Atlantic Treaty Organization. However, according to Dzhemilev, NATO has not shown sufficient determination in assisting Ukraine. He further said NATO could have displayed the same determination as they demonstrated during the NATO campaign, in response to the genocide in Kosovo. At the same time, Dzhemilev said there is no military solution to allow Ukraine to regain Crimea, since that would result in a tragedy.

Quasi-Russian protectorate in Donbas to never be integrated into Ukraine – Klimkin, 11.07.2016

Ukrainian Foreign Minister Pavlo Klimkin stressed that the Minsk agreements were "not in a dead end". "Firstly, it's not the Minsk agreements which are in a dead end. We have a problem with Russia's reluctance to fulfill any agreements on security issues," said Klimkin. "Russia does this absolutely deliberately, in order to create, as a result, a quasi-Russian protectorate in Donbas and try to integrate this quasi-Russian protectorate back into Ukraine, in line with [Russia's] logic, as we understand it, so as to destroy [Ukraine]," said Klimkin. "It's clear that this will never happen," the minister said.

According to Ukraine's top diplomat, it is possible to say that Russia is blocking the implementation of the Minsk agreements.

Russia exploits new methods of hybrid war against Ukraine, 12.07.2016

Kyiv is expecting mass provocations during the upcoming celebrations of Kyivan Rus' Christianization. According to official sources, Russian secret services have organized bands of provocateurs and extremists. Disguised as orthodox believers, the recruited bandits are anticipated to destabilize the situation in Ukraine with mass uprisings. A couple of days ago a big group of Moscow Patriarchate parishioners set from the city of Kharkiv in eastern Ukraine heading for Kyiv. Russia plotting offensive operations in Donbas – Turchynov, 13.07.2016

Turchynov visited the frontline of the Ukrainian defenses in connection with the escalation in the east of Ukraine, according to the press service of the NSDC. As noted in the report, the secretary held a working meeting with the ATO military commanders and inspected the combat readiness of the Ukrainian military units in the area of the Ukrainian strategic stronghold at the Azov Sea Mariupol, visited the outposts in Shyrokine and other areas on the southern defensive lines. According to Turchynov, the Russian occupation troops of the "1st and 2nd Army Corps" have significantly increased the number of attacks, which "defiantly disregard the agreements on the withdrawal of heavy weapons from the contact line." Russia's permanent representative to NATO: There is no Russian military activity in Ukraine, 13.07.2016

Grushko said the sides talked about how to "deal with the crisis in Ukraine", Grushko said: "There is no Russian military activity in Ukraine". Speaking about the recent decision of NATO to strengthen its presence in the East of the Alliance, the Russian diplomat said that Russia considers these measures as those that "have no basis, excessive and counterproductive". "They are confrontational, they weaken the common European regional security and bring us back to the safety circuits of the Cold War. Russia is not a threat to Alliance members", Grushko said. The Russian diplomat also expressed the point that NATO's open door policy "is not a contribution to the security of Europe". "The territory of the Eastern European members of the Alliance is transformed into a base for military deployment and implementation of military and political pressure on Russia. It does not increase, but reduces the security of the region", he said.

Sajdik supports creation of Minsk subgroup on Ukraine's regaining border with Russia, 14.07.2016

"This issue has long been discussed....it was raised last year and is part of the Minsk Agreements. And I believe this issue needs to be discussed. Unfortunately, it's not clear now how we'll be implementing it. But, in the end, one should finally start discussing and addressing this problem," Sajdik said, after a Trilateral Contact Group meeting in Minsk on Wednesday. The creation of the subgroup is an initiative of Ukraine. Ukraine's Border Service reported in October 2015 that Ukraine did not control a length of the Ukrainian-Russian border exceeding 409 km. Readout of Secretary Kerry's Meeting With Russian President Putin, 14.07.2016

The following is attributable to Spokesperson John Kirby: Secretary Kerry met this evening in Moscow with Russian President Putin to advance efforts to restore the nationwide cessation of hostilities in Syria and to establish conditions that can enable political transition talks to resume between the opposition and the Assad regime. The Secretary expressed concern about repeated violations of the cessation of hostilities by the Syrian regime. The two also discussed the need to increase pressure on terrorist groups like Daesh and the al Qaeda affiliate in Syria, Jabhat al Nusra. Secretary Kerry emphasized that absent concrete, near-term steps, diplomatic efforts could not continue indefinitely. Discussions in the morning between Secretary Kerry and Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov were expected to explore initiatives in more detail. On Ukraine, the Secretary urged an acceleration of negotiations on implementation of the Minsk agreements, especially on the security elements.

Transparency International Ukraine head says he was attacked in Kyiv, 16.07.2016

Marusov believes these incidents were connected with his work. The laptop had a data about the current activity of Transparency International and the organization's archive, he said. "I consider this as a pressure at Ukraine's department of Transparency International related to its anti-corruption activity," Marusov wrote. Transparency International condemned the return of a military prosecutor Kostiantyn Kulyk to his post. The National Anti-Corruption Bureau suspects Kulyk of corruption and illegal enrichment. Marusov said that Kulyk and Chief Executive Prosecutor Anatoly Matios recently publicly accused Vitaly Kasko, a member of Transparency International board of directors, of meddling the investigation of corruption activity of oligarch Sergiy Kurchenko. Earlier, the same accusations also voiced lawmaker Serhiy Pashynsky, head of the parliament committee on security and defence.

OSCE SMM says no evidence its interpreter was SBU agent, 18.07.2016

"The Mission takes such allegations seriously; however, at this moment we have no evidence to support these claims. As such, the SMM will not comment on these allegations at the moment, but is reviewing the situation," the OSCE SMM said in a statement on Monday. Presently, the OSCE Special Monitoring Mission to Ukraine includes international monitors originating from more than 45 countries, as well as 305 national staff, it said. According to the OSCE SMM, any serious violation of the Code of Conduct, to which all mission members agree when they join the organization, leads to an immediate dismissal of the member of the mission. "On rare occasions we have already taken such decisions, and if required in future we will do so again," the statement said. The OSCE says that its SMM is a civilian monitoring mission, with a mandate that does not include any intelligence gathering activity and operates on the principals of transparency and impartiality.

According to Herashchenko, the militants refuse to provide information about the numbers of the prisoners. The envoy also claims, the hostages are outright being tortured by their kidnappers. "The situation is only getting worse. During our last meeting, the militants admitted to putting a critically ill patient without limbs and eyes in jail. Alexander Hug: "We note a sustained supply of ammunition in areas not controlled by Gov't", 19.07.2016

Mr. Hug, the Political Committee of the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly recently adopted a resolution calling for setting up a peacekeeping operation in Ukraine. In particular, the document stipulates the strengthening of control over the borders as well as providing access of the international mission to all locations in the temporarily occupied areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions, Crimea and Sevastopol. I'd like to make a comment that the Parliamentary Assembly is not a decision making body upon which field operations are established. Such decisions are to be taken by the Permanent Council of the OSCE in Vienna, the delegations of 57 participating states that represent their governments. So the decision reached in the Parliamentary Council does not create a mission on the ground. It is indeed true that the OSCE SMM has great difficulties in freely accessing the conflict area. What is worse, the lack of access translates into the lack of being able to monitor, which also equals the lack of being able to verify whether the sides comply with Minsk agreements. And that in return does not build trust, and that does not allow the situation to normalize. So the access is key for us to provide assistance to the process.

Ukraine to consider martial law option amid further escalation in Donbas, 19.07.2016 Oleksandr Turchynov says that the NSDC may consider the introduction of martial law should escalation continue in Donbas. Should these dangerous trends go on, Ukraine will take all necessary measures to protect its integrity and the safety of its citizens, up to consideration by the NSDC of the introduction of martial law," Turchynov said. "Continuous barrages when Russian aggressors use heavy weapons, which are banned by the Minsk agreements, along with modern means of weapon guidance and fire adjustment cause heavy losses among our soldiers," he said. "In the past 24 hours, our casualties were 21 soldiers – seven of them were killed and 14 were wounded," he added. In his words, the Ukrainian armed forces strictly abide by the Minsk agreements and use weapons only in response to "bloodshed acts of provocation by the Russian invaders."

Worldwide attention to the circumstances in eastern Ukraine and Russian-annexed Crimea must not decrease as, unfortunately, nothing has changed, Estonian member of the European Parliament Urmas Paet stressed at a meeting with Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko in Kyiv. "As new crises emerge, the danger exists that earlier conflicts move out of the focus of attention, which further adjourns finding a solution to them. Therefore, the situation of Ukraine requires constant visible action (until) Ukraine has full control over its territory again," Paet said. Poroshenko noted at the meeting with members of the group of Liberals in the European Parliament that the ceasefire in eastern Ukraine is ineffective and Ukrainian soldiers are killed every day. Additionally, Russia is making regular use of heavy weapons and is not abiding by the Minsk agreements, he said. It's vital to ensure access for OSCE observers to all parts of eastern Ukraine, as well as the Russia-Ukraine border. "Ukraine wishes an OSCE police mission both on the front line as well as on the Russia-Ukraine border, and this must be supported," the MEP stated.

"I categorically do not accept palliative descriptions such as an 'abstract armed conflict' or 'armed confrontation.' These are definitions given by others, not Ukrainians. What is happening in eastern Ukraine now should be called an invasion by intruders," he said on Thursday, during an official event at St. Volodymyr's Hill in Kyiv on the occasion of the Day of Introducing Christianity into Kyivan Rus-Ukraine. "Two and a half years ago, Moscow unleashed war against the golden-domed Kyiv. Things should be called by their proper names. The Savior teaches that there is a clear boundary between the truth and lies," Poroshenko stated. "I am convinced that religious peace and mutual respect of the state-and-church partnership are significant accomplishments by Ukraine, and we should staunchly protect these achievements, especially now, during times of great trial," he added. In addition, Poroshenko expressed gratitude to the churches and religious leaders, organizations, and communities who have firmly defended Ukraine as a God-given duty. "Thanks to those of you who continue to support our armed forces and all the defenders of Ukraine with the word of God, prayers, and humanitarian aid. I express my gratitude to everyone who is helping alleviate the suffering of civilians caused by Russian aggression and Moscow-backed formations," he said.

The minister also stressed that Germany and France were together negotiating with Ukraine and Russia to execute the Minsk agreements. "By maximum September, we will know whether something works," the official added. Putin steps up drive to kill sanctions amid signs of EU disunity, 29.07.2016

Vladimir Putin will step up Russia's campaign to end European Union sanctions with a visit to Slovenia on Saturday, encouraged by signs his tactic of lobbying what he views as more pliant southern and eastern European states is starting to pay off. The sanctions, imposed over the Ukraine crisis, are designed to block access to Western credit and technology for people and businesses linked to President Putin. Combined with American and Group of Seven sanctions, they have made it harder for Russia to weather an economic crisis fueled by low oil prices. The EU earlier this month extended economic sanctions on Russia until the start of 2017, despite misgivings from some countries such as Slovakia who are keen to debate their effectiveness. Several Moscow-based EU diplomats say Russia's tactic of methodically lobbying southern and eastern EU member states is starting to seriously erode the bloc's unity on the issue, making it potentially harder to renew them next time. "Russia is constantly trying to find a way around the sanctions, targeting countries it thinks are softer. They are trying to kill the sanctions with a softly softly approach," one of the diplomats, from a country which favors their continuation. The law provides for an amnesty and is to extend its action primarily on the combatants, those who defended the independence, sovereignty, and territorial integrity of Ukraine, took part in the ATO, on the juveniles and women, as well as men who have children under 16 years or disabled children, on disabled persons of the first, second and third groups, patients with tuberculosis, cancer, and those who have reached retirement age. The Verkhovna Rada also defined categories of convicts in respect of which an amnesty could not be applied. Above all, these are the persons who have committed grave and especially grave crimes, as well as persons who have committed corruption offenses. The amnesty does not apply to persons convicted of crimes against Ukraine's national security.

"Ex-head of the Regions Party faction Yefremov has been detained on suspicion of infringement of the territorial integrity and inviolability of Ukraine," Lutsenko wrote on his Facebook page on Saturday. "He has been detained at the airport with a ticket to Vienna this morning," the press secretary of the Prosecutor General, Larysa Sarhan, told. On November 21, 2015, the Prosecutor General's Office of Ukraine (PGO) sent materials regarding the indictment of former Party of Regions MPs Oleksandr Yefremov and Oleksandr Stoyan, and Serhiy Hordiyenko of the Communist Party, to a court over their voting for the "dictatorship laws" on January 16, 2014. The former MPs are suspected under Part 2 of Article 364 (abuse of power or office), and Part 2 of Article 366 (forgery by an official) of Criminal Code of Ukraine. On November 30, 2015, the Pechersky District Court returned to the prosecutor's office the indictment against Yefremov, Stoyan and Hordiyenko in the case of voting for the "dictatorial laws" on January 16, 2014. The relevant decision was made by a panel of three judges, who said that the indictment did not meet the requirements of the Criminal Procedure Code of Ukraine.

Attempts by Kremlin-backed militants in Horlivka, a city in the so-called 'Donetsk people's republic' [DNR] to milk small business owners has prompted the first mass demonstration in the city since 2014. Over a thousand people, mainly traders from the local market, are reported to have gathered outside the city administration protesting against the militants' methods for extracting money and demanding a system like what they had under Ukrainian government control. Ironically, it seems that the last major demonstration in Horlivka in 2014 was in favour of the May 11 pseudo-referendum, with the residents wanting to join Russia. Since Russia has changed its position many times, with the militants forced to follow suit, it is worth recalling that the militants who first seized control were assuming – and promising - that Donbas would join Russia, and they did have support from a part of the population. Two years later the situation – and the attitude to Ukraine - is dramatically different. Over a thousand small business owners gathered on July 16 outside the city administration. They were protesting against a new 'law' on small businesses which increases tax and 'customs' tariffs, and brings in a system where absolutely everything, including goods obtained before the militants seized control, must be included in an inventory of goods liable to taxation.

On Russia's Ongoing Violations in Ukraine | Statement to the PC, 21.07.2016

The United States remains deeply concerned about the sharp uptick of attacks launched by combined Russian-separatist forces in eastern Ukraine. On July 19 alone, seven Ukrainian soldiers lost their lives and 14 others were injured, the highest number of casualties in a single day this year. Combined Russian-separatist forces are taking provocative actions even in what had been relatively quiet areas along the line of contact. Luhansk had been quiet over the past six months, partly because a river served as a natural barrier dividing the sides. However, combined Russian-separatist forces have initiated a dangerous escalation in Stanitsya Luhanska, where they crossed the river and set up a new position in government-controlled territory. This transformed Stanitsya Luhansksa into a new hotspot, further endangering the local population. As a result of this provocative action, ceasefire violations surged more than sevenfold in Luhansk over the past week, according to reports from the Special Monitoring Mission (SMM). Colleagues — a real ceasefire, followed by the disengagement of forces, would create the circumstances necessary for progress on the political aspects of Minsk. Yet for the third week in a row, the SMM was denied access to proposed sites for disengagement, yet another setback in making this vital stabilization measure a reality. The SMM has also encountered problems with the Joint Center for Control and Coordination (JCCC). Ukraine troops warn of threat of full-scale war, 22.07.2016

According to Ukraine's military intelligence, the leaders of the so-called Donetsk and Luhansk People's Republic, which Ukraine considers terrorist organizations, urgently called all the militants out from holidays and vacations, and banned them from leaving their bases, TSN news service reported. In the last two days, the enemy has been much more active, said the Ukrainian soldiers defending their positions near Krasnohorivka as the enemy is just 700 meters away. The roar of armored vehicles is heard from the other side more often. "The smoke and dust are all over the place. "Maybe they've brought some new equipment... They will regroup now preparing for the night," say the soldiers.

ATO report: militants attack Ukraine forces 54 times overnight, 23.07.2016

Over the past day, Russian occupation forces opened fire 54 times on positions of the Ukrainian military in Donbas, of which 26 times – in the Mariupol sector, 24 – in the Donetsk sector, and four – in the Luhansk sector, the press center of the Anti-Terrorist Operation (ATO) headquarters reported on Saturday morning.

Revenge on Commanders: Russian soldiers in Ukraine's Donbas burn down their own rocket launcher, 23.07.2016

Russian soldiers stationed in the occupied city of Horlivka deliberately destroyed their artillery system to protest a theft of their phones and rough treatment from commanders. The incident was reported by the Main Intelligence Directorate of the Ukrainian Defense Ministry. In a Facebook posting the representatives of Ukrainian intelligence said Russian soldiers, dispirited by long stay on combat positions, lack of financial support and ill-treatment, intentionally burned down their BM-21 Grad - a truck-mounted 122 mm multiple rocket launcher.

ATO HQ reports 77 attacks in last day: Mariupol direction hottest, 24.07.2016

Forty attacks were recorded in the Mariupol sector, another 19 – in the Donetsk sector, and 18 - in the Luhansk sector, according to data released by the press center of the ATO Headquarters as of 06:00 July 24. The situation was tense in Maryinka, Mariupol direction, the HQ reported. "Here the enemy subversive groups tried twice to seize our strong points but the Ukrainian troops gave a fitting rebuff to the saboteurs. In addition, the Russian occupiers fired from 120mm mortars on Chermalyk, Hnutove, Novohryhorivka, Shyrokine, Vodiane and Starohnativka. 82mm mortars, grenade launchers, weapons installed on infantry combat vehicles, large-caliber machine guns and small arms were fired at the positions of ATO forces in Pryazovia. Russia creating three divisions for deployment at Ukraine border – Intel, 26.07.2016

The Russian Federation is actively regrouping its two armies near the border with Ukraine and new divisions are being formed, according to the representative of Ukraine's military intelligence agency. "The 1st Tank Army, which is stationed in Moscow region, is being built up, as well as the 20th Army with Headquarters in Voronezh. Three new divisions are being created. The plans of the Russian leadership are changing," told the representative of the Main Directorate of Intelligence of the Ministry of Defence of Ukraine Vadym Skibitskiy. "A few years ago they said that near the border with Ukraine, three brigades were deployed. Now, these brigades have turned into three divisions," said Skibitskiy.

2 OSCE SMM's UAVs come under fire in Donbas, another one downed, 26.07.2016 "At 23:51 on July 25, while flying over government-controlled Avdiivka, approximately 600m north-west of the contact line and 12.5 km north of Donetsk, an SMM long-range unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) experienced a loss of signals with the Ground Control Station and the SMM lost all communication with the UAV," the mission's spot report says. After 30 minutes from the loss of communication with the UAV, a Ukrainian Armed Forces liaison officer in the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) informed the SMM that the Ukrainian Armed Forces had identified a crash site. At 08:00 on July 26, the Ukrainian Armed Forces Major General, Head of the Ukrainian side to the JCCC, informed the SMM that Ukrainian Armed Forces soldiers had retrieved the UAV. The Ukrainian Armed Forces later handed over to the SMM the UAV's tail rotor and the anti-jamming equipment that had been located in the tail. Read also Alexander Hug: "We note a sustained supply of ammunition in areas not controlled by Gov't" In addition, it has been reported that at 12:48 on July 25, "the SMM conducted a flight of its mini UAV on the southern edge of "LPR"-controlled Kalynove (58 km west of Luhansk). The SMM heard four shots which it assessed as being fired from an assault rifle targeting the UAV. At the time of the incident, the UAV was flying 800 metres south-west of the launch site."

Russian proxies use 122mm artillery to attack Ukraine troops in Avdivivka, 27.07.2016

"The town of Avdiyivka remains a hot spot. The enemy fired 122mm artillery systems, 120mm and 82mm mortars, rocket-propelled grenades, heavy machine-guns and small arms on our fortified positions there," the press center said. Most of the attacks – 22 incidents – were recorded in the Mariupol sector. The Russian-backed mercenaries continue armed provocations in the Donetsk sector where 17 cases of violation of the ceasefire were recorded in the past day.

Luhansk militant leader is to create task group on talks with Savchenko, 27.07.2016

The leader of the so-called LPR Ihor Plotnitsky ordered to create a workgroup which would conduct talks with Ukrainian MP Nadiya Savchenko, militant websites report. Plotnitsky said that Savchenko voiced readiness to meet with some fighters, so she could talk to those LPR "deputies" who took part in the battle, where the Ukrainian MP was taken prisoner. "I think we can create a kind of a deputy group, of three persons. Basically, we can talk as a deputy to a deputy, if one wants to find a compromise and resolve the situation peacefully,"- he said. He gave instructions to get in touch with Savchenko, and pledged to guarantee her security if she comes to Luhansk.

Spot Report by OSCE Special Monitoring Mission to Ukraine, 29.07.2016

The SMM saw fresh tracks, assessed as caused by an infantry fighting vehicle leading south from "DPR"-controlled Lukove (72km south of Donetsk). At 13:47, while following the tracks, it was stopped by two armed "DPR" members who blocked the road with a camouflaged-style jeep (vehicle #1) and pointed their guns at the SMM. They ordered the SMM to leave the area, which they did. At 13:49, when leaving the area, a second camouflaged-style jeep (vehicle #2), approached from a side road at high speed, almost hit the lead SMM vehicle and came to an abrupt stop in front of the patrol, blocking its way. At the same time, the two armed "DPR" members in vehicle #1 blocked the SMM from behind. Three armed "DPR" members jumped out of vehicle #2 and pointed their guns at the first SMM vehicle in a very aggressive manner and screamed at the driver to open the vehicle door. One "DPR" member made a "cut throat" sign to the SMM and took photographs of both SMM vehicles and the drivers. The SMM was ordered to follow the "DPR" members to a checkpoint in Prymorske (76km south of Donetsk, 5km south of Lukove). One of the "DPR" members in vehicle #2 kept his gun pointed at the SMM for the duration. At this point the patrol called the SMM Regional Security Officer, who in turn informed the JCCC.

Ukrainian court of appeal acquits journalist sentenced for high treason, 14.07.2016 Kotsaba's lawyer in his final speech has stressed that the charges claiming the defendant allegedly impeding the activities of the armed forces of Ukraine are unfounded, according to Halka news outlet. He also said that none of the witnesses who spoke in court said anything about the actual effect of Kotsaba's calls on mobilization. In turn, the prosecutor noted that the court had failed to examine the evidence in full, which made it impossible to find Kotsaba guilty of high treason. The accused journalist, who also spoke in court before the ruling was handed down, reiterated his beliefs that it's a fratricidal war that is ongoing in Donbas, although he pleaded not guilty of high treason and impeding the activities of the armed forces.

Ukrainian-Belarusian journalist Pavel Sheremet killed in Kyiv, 20.07.2016

Journalist Pavel Sheremet was killed in a car explosion in Kyiv on the morning of July 20. Sheremet worked in Ukrainska Pravda, a popular online news outlet. The car exploded when Sheremet was driving it at 7.45 a.m. in the central part of Kyiv, on the corner of Ivan Franko and Bohdan Khmelnytskiy Streets. The car belonged to Olena Prytula, a founding editor of Ukrainska Pravda. Sheremet hosted a morning show on Radio Vesti. According to the radio's website, the journalist was heading to the radio's office to host his show when the car exploded. Lyubov Pereyenko, a witness of the explosion, was selling fruits in her kiosk nearby. According to her words, the ambulance came very quickly, some 7-8 minutes, and police came after that. "Law enforcement came just after ambulance, and took (everyone) to the safe distance," Pereyenko said. "The explosion was so strong that the parts (of the car) were lying near my kiosk." Aleksandr Rotan, a waiter at Device Club, located meters from where the explosion took place, helped drag Sheremet out of his car immediately after the explosion. "It sounded like a shell," Rotan said, adding that Sheremet was still alive, though unconscious immediately after the blast.

PROSECUTOR: MH17 INVESTIGATION GOING WELL, 01.07.2015

The criminal investigation into the cause of the disaster with flight MH17 in eastern Ukraine is going well, according to chief prosecutor Fred Westerbeke.

The chief prosecutor of the Public Prosecutor's national office said that though the investigators haven't reached the point of "formally" identifying suspects, they have a group of potential suspects in view, NU reports. "We are getting closer to legal and convincing evidence." he said. According to the Public Prosecutor, the most likely scenario is that the Malaysian Airlines airplane was shot down by a BUK-missile. But that is not the only scenario that the Prosecutor is looking at. Experts are busy investigating alternative scenarios in order to substantiate or exclude them.

Russia: EU prolongs economic sanctions by six months, 01.07.2016

These measures were introduced on 31 July 2014 initially for one year in response to Russia's actions destabilising the situation in Ukraine. They were reinforced in September 2014. They target the financial, energy and defence sectors, and the area of dual-use goods. On 19 March 2015, the European Council agreed to link the duration of the sanctions to the complete implementation of the Minsk agreements, which was foreseen to take place by 31 December 2015. Since the Minsk agreements were not fully implemented by 31 December 2015, the Council extended the sanctions until 31 July 2016. Having assessed the implementation of the Minsk agreements, the Council decided to renew the sanctions for a further six months, until 31 January 2017.

Kremlin dubs Crimean journalists, activists as 'terrorists', 13.07.2016

Authorities in Moscow have listed 22 people who were born on Ukraine's Crimea Peninsula as "terrorists and extremists". The list, published on July 12 by Russia's Federal Financial Monitoring Service (Rosfinmonitoring), includes journalists, civil activists, and political prisoners who have criticized Moscow's occupation and illegal annexation of Ukraine's Crimea region, RFE/RL reported Tuesday. Mykola Semena, a contributor to a news site about Crimea that is run by Radio Free Europe/Radio Liberty, is also on the list. Jitters in Ukraine As Politically Charged Religious Processions Approach Kyiv, 24.07.2016

The All-Ukrainian Procession of the Cross for Peace, Love and Prayer for Ukraine includes thousands of believers from the Ukrainian Orthodox Church of the Moscow Patriarchate -- an affiliate of the Russian Orthodox Church and a rival of a major Kyiv-based church. Marching in two groups -- one from the west of the country and another from the east -- they plan to converge on Kyiv's Volodymyrska Hill and then at the Kyiv-Pechersk Monastery on July 27, the eve of the celebration of the 10th-century Baptism of Kievan Rus. Moscow Patriarchate leaders say they will pray for peace and prosperity in Ukraine. The church's Bishop Clement that there

will be no provocations, at least from their side. Ukrainian authorities say they suspect the marches are merely a front for a Moscow-orchestrated plot to stir unrest and prove what Russia has claimed since Euromaidan protests drove a Moscow-aligned president from power in 2014: that the rights of Russians, Russian speakers, and members of the Moscow-based church's flock are at risk here.
