Introduction

The intensity of the Russian - Ukrainian war in Donbas began to grow again, civilian and military casualties continued to grow.

Russia's army is massing troops and hundreds of pieces of weaponry including mobile rocket launchers, tanks and artillery at a makeshift base near the border with Ukraine, as per Reuters reporter. Many of the vehicles have number plates and identifying marks removed while many of the servicemen had taken insignia off their fatigues. As such, they match the appearance of some of the forces spotted in eastern Ukraine, which Kiev and its Western allies allege are covert Russian detachments. The scene at the base on the Kuzminsky firing range, around 50 km from the border, offers some of the clearest evidence to date of what appeared to be a concerted Russian military build-up in the area.

Earlier this month, NATO military commander General Philip Breedlove said he believed the separatists were taking advantage of a ceasefire that came into force in February to re-arm and prepare for a new offensive. However, he gave no specifics.

Russia denies that its military is involved in the conflict in Ukraine's east, where Moscow-backed separatists have been fighting forces loyal to the pro-Western government in Kiev. Visa free regime was not obtained by Ukraine in Riga though it was quite predictable. On May 30 Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko has introduced former Georgian President

Mikheil Saakashviliбцрщ had become a Ukrainian citizen, as head of Odesa Regional Administration. This appointment provoked vivid discussion within the society and as a result quite a lot of xenophobic statements appeared in social networks.

Prognosis and polls

Aliyah numbers up 41 percent so far in 2015, 07.05.2015

Immigration to Israel under its Law of Return increased in the first quarter of 2015 by 41 percent over the corresponding period last year.

Approximately a third of the 6,499 newcomers were from Ukraine, and more than half were from the former Soviet Union, according to an interim report released recently by the Jewish Agency for Israel. Jewish immigration, or aliyah, to Israel from Ukraine consisted of 1,971 individuals in the first quarter of 2015 compared with 625 in the first three months of 2014 — a 215 percent leap. Ukraine's economy has suffered huge losses and monetary depreciation as a result of a revolution that swept its former president, Viktor Yanukovych, from power and triggered an armed conflict with Russian-backed insurgents, with devastating effects to the country's industrial heart in the east. Aliyah from Russia also increased significantly, from 1,016 to 1,515. Plummeting oil prices have triggered a financial crisis exacerbated by Western sanctions over the government's annexation of Ukraine's Crimean Peninsula last year.

Poll: Third of Russians believe Russia would win war against NATO, 12.05.2015

According to the survey, another fear that has been actualized among the Russian population in recent years is the possibility of U.S. military intervention.

Despite the rise of xenophobia against the Western countries, half of the respondents don't want there to be war between Russia and NATO, as "no one will win in such a war." However, one in three Russian believes that Russia would be able to defeat NATO. The majority of Russians believe that the "militarization" of Russian society is forced and defensive in nature, and 42% believe that Russia's political leadership is unlikely to use nuclear weapons. http://www.unian.info/war/1077002-poll-third-of-russians-believe-russia-would-win-war-against-nato.html

Ukrainians getting more dissatisfied with performance of government – poll, 25.05.2015

In particular, 31% of Ukrainians consider the actions of Ukrainian authorities to stabilize the situation in the country as completely dissatisfactory, while 28% of respondents believe that the government, in general, is not fulfilling its duties and responsibilities, and 37% of respondents agree that the government is not working at its full potential.

Only 1% fully support the activities of the government. Also the findings indicate that in the period from November 2014 to April 2015 the government performance index dropped by half. In April, only 8% of Ukrainians expressed satisfaction with the activities of the government, against 68% being unsatisfied with it. According to experts, such results result from the unpopular laws that are related to the tariff policy in the country.

At the same time, 51% of Ukrainians do not support or are rather dissatisfied with the activities of the president, with 17% of respondents giving a positive evaluation of his activities, while from July 2014 to April 2015 the president's performance index dropped by 12 points, remaining below its average level.

Putin's Approval Rating Remains at 86% Unfazed by Economic Crisis, Ukraine Conflict, 28.05.2015

President Vladimir Putin continues to enjoy the approval of a staggering 86% of the Russian public, a poll revealed Thursday, indicating levels of support that many Western leaders could only dream of. Putin's approval rating, announced by independent Moscow-based pollster the Levada Center, sat at the same level last month, when a similarly worded poll was conducted. By comparison, the most recent Gallup Poll data shows that U.S. President Barack Obama enjoys the approval of a mere 46% of Americans. German Chancellor Angela Merkel currently has the approval of 70% of her compatriots, Reuters reported in early May. Meanwhile, 63% of the public voiced approval of the actions of Prime Minister Dmitry Medvedev, a decrease of three percentage points from a similar Levada poll conducted in April.

Russia may be readying for new Ukraine offensive - NATO commander, 01.05.2015

Russia's military may be taking advantage of a recent lull in fighting in eastern Ukraine to lay the groundwork for a new military offensive, NATO's top commander told the U.S. Congress. U.S. Air Force General Philip Breedlove, the NATO supreme allied commander, said Russian forces had been seeking to "reset and reposition" while protecting battlefield gains, despite a fragile ceasefire agreed in February. "Many of their actions are consistent with preparations for another offensive," Breedlove said. Pressed during the hearing, Breedlove acknowledged he could not predict Moscow's next move but characterized its ongoing actions as "preparing, training and equipping to have the capacity to again take an offensive."

"In the past they have not wasted their effort," Breedlove told the Senate Armed Services Committee. Breedlove said Russia was seeking to tighten its grip over separatist fighters, bolstering its command and control "because there was disunity in some of the earlier attacks." "We do see a very distinct Russian set of command and control in the eastern part of Ukraine," he said on Thursday.

Kremlin denies Putin consented to peacekeepers in Donbas, 01.05.2015

The President of Russia Vladimir Putin during a conversation with leaders «channel four» disagreed with the possibility of placing peacekeepers in the Donbass. About it the President's press Secretary Dmitry Peskov told journalists.

According to him, the theme of the peacekeeping force «really rose», and «the idea of a peacekeeping contingent of the Russian side never challenged». However, while Russia is opposed to this decision for two reasons. First, this question cannot be «subject to discuss <...> without the point of view of the parties to the conflict,» secondly, it is necessary first of all to implement the Minsk agreements.

«Before I made the Minsk agreements, to raise issues of particular property is absolutely impossible. Russians training 50,000-strong militant army in Donbas - Ukraine's presidential spokesman, 01.05.2015

"According to information we have, on the uncontrolled territories there is a contingent of almost 50,000 armed men, which is being formed into military units and trained by Russian specialists," Taranov said.

Asked whether Ukraine has the resources to defend itself against such an army, Taranov said that the Armed Forces of Ukraine, quantitatively, and technically, were able to "meet all the challenges." "All four waves of mobilization, and the fifth is going on now, ensure the country's defense. A large percentage of those who have served in the war for a year on a voluntary basis are still ready to serve. First of all these are the troops of the 25th and the 95th airborne brigades. They are specialists who have combat experience."

Russia continues to undermine the Minsk agreement implementation plan - U.S. State Department, 01.05.2015

Russia continues to undermine the implementation plan of the Minsk agreements through ongoing support of the militants, Spokesperson for the U.S. State Department Marie Harf said. She stressed that Russia and militants cannot choose which items of the Minsk agreement they will perform and which not- they signed these agreements and they need to respect them. The press-secretary of the U.S. State Department stressed that Ukraine continued to demonstrate progress in the implementation of the Minsk agreements unlike Russia and the militants it supports. In addition, she noted that the presence of U.S. military instructors in Ukraine does not violate the agreements that were reached in Minsk. The U.S.- Ukrainian exercises are held in the western part of the country, not in the east, and these exercises have been carried out for the past 20 years.

"One can't draw the line on history," Merkel said.

"We Germans do have a special responsibility to deal in an aware, sensitive and knowledgeable way with what we perpetrated under Nazism," she said.

While there are "deep differences of opinion" with Russia, she said "it's important" for her to visit Moscow on May 10 to join the honoring of soldiers who died in World War II.

Like many western leaders, Merkel will not be attending Russian Victory Day celebrationsbeing held one day earlier. However, Merkel said she intends to lay a wreath at a memorial to victims of World War II, along with Russian President Vladimir Putin.

Press secretary of the U.S. Department of State Marie Harf commented on recent statements of former President Jimmy Carter after his meeting with Russian President Vladimir Putin, who called the Russian annexation of Crimea inevitable, citing the Soviet-Russian roots in the region and, in his opinion, what the people of Crimea wanted.

"I'm not going to get into the mind of President Putin about why he made decisions about what to do in terms of Crimea, annexing part of Ukraine, part of another country," Harf said.

"We have remained consistent that Crimea is a part of Ukraine, that's why we've put sanctions on, that's why we continue to put pressure on. Obviously, there are enormous challenges here," Harf stressed.

OSCE Chairperson-in-Office concerned about ceasefire violations in Donbas, 04.05.2015

OSCE Chairperson-in-Office and Serbia's Foreign Minister Ivica Dacic has condemned violations of the ceasefire along the contact line in eastern Ukraine that occurred during the last few days. Dacic is particularly concerned about the use of the proscribed heavy weapons as well as the increased fighting in the area of Donetsk and Shyrokyne, the report reads. He once again called on the parties to the conflict to fully and unconditionally respect the ceasefire, to cease hostilities and comply with all provisions of the Minsk Agreements, including the withdrawal of heavy weapons.

"At this moment, it is essential for the political process to gain momentum, and I call all sides to invest all possible efforts towards that end," Dacic said.

ITALY FROZE ASSETS OF PUTIN'S FRIEND AND AZAROV'S SON. 05.05.2015

Italian financial police seized the accounts and real estate of Putin's ally Arkadiy Rotenberg and property of Oleksiy Azarov, purchased through the front company. This was announced in an interview with the "European truth" by Ukraine's Ambassador to Italy Yevhen Perelygin. He stressed on the ambiguity of the Italian policy towards Ukraine and Russia. Despite the obvious pro-Russian mood, Italy was the only European country that seized and froze assets and other real estate of Putin's friend Rotenberg, the ambassador said. He also noted that in the autumn of 2014 the land plots and real estate of Oleksiy Azarov were arrested, although this fact has not received significant publicity. As it is known, his property is under the EU sanctions since March last year. Oleksiy Azarov is accused of embezzling public funds and bringing them abroad. However, in the Rotenberg case, Ukraine is involved in litigation as a third party.

Russia: EU Does Not Want Ukraine Truce To Hold, 05.05.2015

Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov has accused "someone in the European Union" of trying to ensure that a cease-fire in eastern Ukraine fails and of turning a blind eye to attacks which have killed civilians in rebel-held areas. He also described what he called increased military activity by Ukrainian forces in recent weeks as an attempt to tear up the cease-fire accord. "Judging by certain signs, someone in the European Union wants the EU to allow the Ukrainian government not to implement the Minsk agreements," he said after talks with Austrian Foreign Minister Sebastian Kurz.

The EU did not immediately respond to Lavrov's remarks.

The Head of State has emphasized that the new stage of the Trilateral Working Group's functioning had begun. The President has informed on his decision to delegate experienced Ukrainian politicians to the work of the subgroups. "We must begin topical practical consultations on specific directions of the Minsk agreements' implementation," the President noted. Coordination in all subgroups is carried out by the representatives of the OSCE and other international organizations, as stated by Petro Poroshenko.

"Any rotation, format transformation or retreat from the Minsk agreements is inadmissible," the President said. Petro Poroshenko has noted that the structure of the working subgroups should meet the structure of the TCG. "Neither Ukraine, nor our international partners accept the revision of the Minsk agreements. We persistently demand signatories to the Minsk agreements, first of all Russia, to make every effort for the agreements to be fully implemented," the Head of State emphasized.

Some 1,460 people missing in Donbas, about 400 held captive – Kuchma, 06.05.2015

Ukraine's representative in the Contact Group on Ukraine, Leonid Kuchma, has said that 1,460 people have gone missing during the military conflict in Donbas and nearly 400 are held captive. "You probably know, and today this figure was announced: 1,460 missing persons. And that is against the backdrop of thousands of those killed. Three hundred ninety-nine are held captive," Kuchma told reporters in Minsk on Wednesday after a meeting of the Contact Group.

NATO not obliged to guarantee Ukraine's security — Latvia's NATO envoy, 06.05.2015 "I must draw the line between NATO member-countries and any other country which is not a NATO member. For example, Ukraine. There's no doubt that what is happening in Ukraine is a tragedy, since soldiers and civilians are dying. People often don't understand why NATO doesn't provide military assistance to Ukraine. It's worth recalling that NATO's basic task is to protect the security of residents on the territory of the Alliance members. Ukraine is a close partner of NATO, but, no matter how cynical this may sound, guaranteeing Ukraine's security is not NATO's duty. NATO is not a global policeman, and it has no intention of acting outside the territories of its member-countries," - said Maris Riekstins, Latvia's Ambassador to the Alliance who is mentioned as one of the republic's potential presidential candidates.

Moscow names its representatives in Ukraine settlement subgroups, 06.05.2015

Members of the Russian Armed Forces' General Staff, the Emergencies Ministry and the Ministry of Economic Development will represent Russia in the working subgroups of the Contact Group on Ukraine, Russia's representative in the Group Azamat Kulmukhametov said on Wednesday.

"Representative of the Russian General Staff Yaroslav Moskalev will be a delegate from the country in the working subgroup for security, while Deputy Emergencies Minister Vladimir Stepanov will represent Russia in the subgroup for humanitarian issues," Kulmukhametov said. "Maksim Polyakov will become a member of the working subgroup for political issues, while Deputy Economic Development Minister Sergey Nazarov - of the working subgroup for economic affairs." he said.

EU's top diplomat says destabilized Russia in nobody's interest, 06.05.2015

A destabilized and isolated Russia is in nobody's interests, and sanctions are only being kept in place because a truce agreement in the conflict in Ukraine is not being fully implemented, the European Union's foreign policy chief said on Wednesday.

Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov accused "someone in the European Union" on Tuesday of trying to ensure a ceasefire in eastern Ukraine does not hold.

Pro-Russian separatists and the Ukrainian government agreed the truce in the Belarussian capital Minsk on Feb. 12, but it has failed to end all fighting and the Lithuanian president told Reuters it was now all but dead.

Speaking to students during a visit to Beijing, the EU's top diplomat Federica Mogherini said that while she did not see Russia as an "actor" of instability or insecurity, violations of Ukraine's territorial integrity and sovereignty were a matter of universal concern.

President: There will be no more monopolism in the supply of energy in Ukraine, 06.05.2015 President of Ukraine Petro Poroshenko has noted that in the interests of energy security, the

share of any energy supplier should not exceed 30%.

"Our strategy provides for the exclusion of the situation when the share of an energy supplier exceeds 30%," the President said at the NSDC meeting.

According to the Head of State, Ukraine has achieved significant progress in securing gas supply. "Winter has passed without potbelly stoves and nightlights. We have won the winter battle against Gazprom. However, it is too early to speak of the complete victory in this war. We have finally put an end to the monopoly of this political-energy structure in supplying gas to Ukraine. In the first quarter of 2015, the share of Gazprom in the import of gas to Ukraine equals 37%. The rest is related to the supplies from our European partners. By the way, they are deeply diversified: more than 10 companies are involved in the reverse gas supply," Petro Poroshenko noted.

Poroshenko Warns Of Worsening Conflict, 06.05.2015

Poroshenko told a security and defense council meeting in Kyiv that "the threat of large-scale military action from Russian terrorist groups not only remains but is growing."

Poroshenko said there were more than 40,000 pro-Moscow fighters in the rebel-controlled territories and a further 50,000 Russian troops across the border.

Separatists poised for offensive in Ukraine: US, 06.05.2015

The Pentagon chief also said that sanctions imposed by European countries and a decline in oil prices were the most effective way to exert pressure on Russia over its role in the conflict. "It does appear that clearly, Russian-backed separatists in eastern Ukraine are preparing for another round of military action that would be inconsistent with the Minsk agreement," Carter told the Senate Appropriations defense subcommittee.

A shaky truce agreed in Minsk in February has dampened the violence overall but clashes continue to erupt in pivotal flashpoints.

Ukrainian government forces and analysts have warned that pro-Moscow rebels are readying for a push to extend their control to the key seaport of Mariupol, the largest remaining Ukrainian-controlled city in the conflict zone.

Tymoshenko asks to eliminate shock policy, 06.05.2015

Leader of Ukrainian Batkivshchyna [Fatherland] party Yulia Tymoshenko thinks "shock" social and economic policy in Ukraine is faulty and calls for its eliminating.

"We should immediately eliminate it, moreover, it should be changed into a radically opposite direction," Tymoshenko said on air of Ukrainian Pershe Natsionalne Radio, the website of the party reported. According to her, maintaining shock therapy "will lead to the complete downfall of the economy, as the best investor in Ukraine's economy is not a foreign investor, not Ukrainian entrepreneurs, but Ukrainian citizens who invest their money by buying clothes, food, paying for services. Here is the investor!" she said.

Yulia Tymoshenko is confident that, if all the money of this investor is taken away, the economy "will fall in a matter of months." She cited the findings of Vienna Institute for International Economic Studies, according to which, it is recommended "to stop the shock therapy, impose fair market values and not inflated prices, index pensions and salaries."

"We should talk not about populism, but about extremely unprofessional work in the economic and social fields, which is carried out today," Tymoshenko added. http://www.ukrinform.ua/eng/news/tymoshenko asks to eliminate shock policy 331167

Poland to send its policemen to Ukraine, 06.05.2015

In turn, OSCE special representative Heidi Tagliavini states that the subgroup on economy may hold its next meeting on May 16.

In Minsk, representatives of the Trilateral Contact Group agreed to send observers from each subgroup to the contact line in Donbas. According to the Ukrainian representative, the main things in the current situation are a ceasefire, withdrawal of heavy weapons and their verification by the OSCE.

"The relevant documents have been prepared, now it is time to work for groups and military experts," he added.

Switzerland to double grant aid to Ukraine to about \$100 mln in 2015-2018 – ambassador, 07.05.2015

Such data were voiced by Ambassador of Switzerland to Ukraine Christian Schoenenberger in Kyiv, when signing a memorandum of understanding on technical and financial assistance for energy efficiency projects in Zhytomyr between the State Secretariat for Economic Affairs of the Swiss Confederation, Ukraine's Ministry of Regional Development, Construction, Housing and Utilities Services, Zhytomyr City Council, and municipal enterprise Zhytomyrteplokomunenergo. "Switzerland decided to double its technical aid in 2015-2018, the budget will be about \$100 million," he said.

EU trade chief says Ukraine deal to start in 2016, 07.05.2015

European Trade Commissioner Cecilia Malmstrom said on Thursday that a planned EU-Ukraine trade deal would be implemented from the start of 2016 despite Russian calls for further delay and threats of retaliation.

Russian President Vladimir Putin has warned that Moscow will curtail Ukraine's access to vital Russian markets if Kiev implements any part of a trade deal with the European Union. "It is not for Russia to decide," Malmstrom told reporters on arrival for a meeting with EU trade ministers. "There has been a very clear statement by the European Union, by member states, by the Ukrainians ... that the first of January 2016 is the date."

The start of 2016 is already a year later than planned as Russia seeks to oppose European efforts to integrate Ukraine and move it out of Moscow's sphere of influence. Russia had been pushing for the deal to be postponed by at least one more year.

"We don't have the opportunity [of increasing budget social payments] if we have it I'm ready [to do this]," she said on the sidelines of the roundtable organized by the U.S.-Ukraine Business Council (USUBC) in Kyiv on Thursday.

Commenting on the surplus of the national budget in the first quarter of 2015, Jaresko said that this is a temporary phenomenon caused by devaluation, and not by economic growth. On the contrary, the economy fell by 15% over the period, and one cannot make conclusions on the basis of figures for only one quarter. She said that the level of revenues that would allow securing social expenses next year should be reached.

Scores of Russian soldiers killed in east Ukraine: opposition report, 12.05.2015

At least 220 Russian soldiers have been killed in east Ukraine, opposition activists said on Tuesday in a report offering what they called "ample evidence" to rebut President Vladimir Putin's denial his troops are fighting there.

The report, the last project of murdered Kremlin critic Boris Nemtsov, also said Russia had spent more than 53 billion rubles (\$1.04 billion) in 10 months to fund the conflict and deprived people of 2.75 trillion rubles of money lost to inflation.

"The war with Ukraine is an undeclared war, a vile cynical war which amounts to a crime against all of the Russian nation. Putin will go down in history as the president who made Russians and Ukrainians foes." said Ilva Yashin, an aide to Nemtsov.

"The main conclusion of our report is that we have collected and systematized (information) which we think provides ample evidence of the presence of Russian soldiers in Ukraine," he told a news conference to unveil the report called "Putin. War".

Justice Task Force Presents Its First Proposed Constitutional Amendments, 15.05.2015
Presidential Administration Deputy Head Oleksiy Filatov, who chairs the Working Group on
Justice within the Constitutional Commission, reported on the Group's first proposed
amendments to the Constitution of Ukraine after the Commission meeting on Friday.
According to Filatov, the task force worked on the contents and structure of the Constitution's
"Justice" section, qualifying requirements for judges (such as age, educational background,
professional experience, etc.), and appointment, transfer and dismissal of judges as well as
quarantees of their activities.

It was suggested that the legal guarantees of observing the principle of independence of judges would include their appointment with no fixed term of office, functional immunity, appointment exclusively based on a competition, and calling them to account exclusively by a body in which judges account for majority and which is elected by judges.

The Working Group recommends that the appointment and dismissal of judges would be struck off the powers of the Verkhovna Rada, Filatov said and mentioned that the Venice Commission emphasized the necessity of this change more than once. As for the powers of the President, he or she would appoint judges, with no fixed term of office, based on a decision by relevant authority (the High Council of Justice).

Today, with the government, I had chance to meet with Deputy Foreign Minister Ryabkov, who is responsible for relations in our bilateral channels, and with Deputy Foreign Minister Karasin, who is Russia's point person on Ukraine.

Today's consultations were very detailed, they were very pragmatic. In both meetings, we were talking about how we build on the conversation in Sochi, on all of the issues that were discussed between President Putin and Secretary Kerry. But we particularly dug in on how the United States might be able to support the process of Minsk implementation, support the parties Ukraine, the OSCE and Russia – as they try to take forward the work of the Trilateral Contact Group and as the four working groups – on security, on political issues, on economics and on humanitarian aspects of the Minsk Agreement – get going.

We had very detailed discussions on all of the issues that I spoke about in Kyiy, from securing a true cease-fire on the line, starting with getting the OSCE into Shyrokyne, to the political working group and setting the conditions for free and fair elections under the Ukrainian Constitution in correspondence with OSCE standards, to improving humanitarian conditions on the ground for the people of Donbas, allowing humanitarian assistance in not only from the Russian side but also from the Ukrainian side, to ensuring that the OSCE can be present all along the border as Minsk requires, to the inspection of convoys coming from the Russian side. The United States' goal here, as I said in Kyiv, is to support the full implementation of Minsk. We are doing this in lockstep with the Normandy powers, with our colleagues in the EU, with Germany and France. I will be debriefing them and Ukraine on the consultations that I had here. NATO says not clear if Russia serious about Ukraine peace deal, 18.05.2015

Following the Supreme Rada's adoption on 9 April of the law "On condemnation of the Communist and Nazi totalitarian regimes in Ukraine and banning of propaganda of their symbols," OSCE Representative on Freedom of the Media Dunja Mijatović on 15 April wrote to the President of Ukraine. Petro Poroshenko, asking for his careful consideration of the law before approving it. The law was signed by the President on 15 May.

"It is discouraging for freedom of expression and media freedom advocates that the law has gone into effect, despite various calls to safeguard these basic rights," Mijatović said. The law criminalizes public denial of the activities of these regimes and bans all related symbols, except for restricted educational or scientific purposes. Violation of the law carries a penalty of potential termination of activities of media and prison sentences for five to ten years. "While I fully respect the often sensitive and painful nature of historical debate and its effect on society, broadly and vaguely defined language that restricts individuals from expressing views on past events and people, could easily lead to suppression of political, provocative and critical speech, especially in the media," Mijatović wrote.

The group, whose exact membership had until now not been disclosed, said it consisted of funds managed or advised by BTG Pactual Europe, Franklin Advisers., TCW Investment Management Company and T. Rowe Price Associates, who hold approximately \$8.9 billion of Ukrainian debt.

Over 10,000 Crimean Tatars flee Crimean after occupation – Chubarov, 19.05.2015

The actual number of Crimean Tatars that have left Crimea since its occupation by Russia exceeds the official figure of 10,000 people, head of the Mejlis of the Crimean Tatar People Refat Chubarov has said.

"I won't say the exact number, as the numbers stated by the official executive agencies are already outdated. It's believed that 20,000 people have left the Crimean peninsula, about half of them are Crimean Tatars. But our research says that this number is higher," he said at a briefing in Kyiv on Monday.

During the briefing, Chief of the Security Service of Ukraine Valentyn Nalyvaichenko officially presented the materials of archive cases on the torture of Crimean Tatars by the NKVD to Mejlis representatives. According to Chubarov, work to create a detailed account of the people who have left Crimea, including Crimean Tatars, is underway.

Georgia's Leader Warns of Russian Expansion, 19.05.2015

Georgia's president said Tuesday that Russia is poised to use its armed forces to expand further into former Soviet states and called on the West never to accept any Russian aggression.

"They are the fastest and the first to bring in their tanks," he said, speaking near-fluent English.

"So that's why we can say that half of the Eurasian continent is living under constant threat. If they have some kind of unstable environment in their country, their sovereign country, the neighbor will be quick to solve the problem through Kalashnikov[s]."

Margvelashvili said Georgia still feels the military threat from Russia after losing 20 percent of its territory to Russian-supported separatists after the 2008 war. Russia has border guards and troops stationed in the breakaway territories of South Ossetia and Abkhazia.

Just like Russia did in Georgia in 2008, Margvelashvili said Russia exploited instability in Ukraine following the ouster of a Russia-friendly president to seize Crimea in March 2014 and foment an armed rebellion in Ukraine's Russian-speaking east. The president warned if there were not a stronger condemnation from the West, the pattern could be repeated in other countries along Russia's border.

"What we are hoping to see is a more stronger, principled message that this is unaccepted — and this will stay unaccepted even after the cease-fire [in east Ukraine]," Margvelashvili said. Georgia also sees a threat across Europe from the vast Kremlin propaganda machine as Russia conducts what the EU sees as a disinformation campaign to change perceptions of Russia's involvement in Ukraine.

Donetsk, Luhansk self-proclaimed republics should remain part of Ukraine, 19.05.2015

The self-proclaimed Donetsk and Luhansk People's republics (DPR and LPR) should remain part of Ukraine, Russian Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov said in an interview.

"At all levels - by means of statements on the part of the Russian president, in other formats - we have been saying that we are for them to become part of Ukraine," Lavrov said.

"They have now submitted their draft of the constitution. In it, they are talking about the status envisioned by the Minsk agreements: the republics will be part of Ukraine, and then there will be a constitutional reform to secure that status on a permanent basis," he said.

Lavrov said the commitment was paraphed by German Chancellor Angela Merkel and French President François Hollande.

Russia deploys nuclear fleet in Crimea - Turchynov, 20.05.2015

Russia continues to deploy additional offensive weapon systems in the occupied Crimea and to prepare the infrastructure to station nuclear weapons and means for their delivery on the peninsula.

Secretary of the National Security and Defense Council of Ukraine Oleksandr Turchynov has said this in an interview with Ukrinform.

"Russia is taking specific steps to provide the full-fledged operation of the units of the 12th Main Directorate of the Defense Ministry of the Russian Federation on the peninsula. This directorate is tasked to prepare the operation and supplies of nuclear munitions to the combat units of the Black Sea Fleet of the Russian Federation," Turchynov said.

According to him, Russia plans to deploy in Crimea a regiment of Tu-22M3 attack aircraft, equipped to carry nuclear warhead missiles. In addition, the unit will include three divisions of Iskander-K and Iskander-M Tactical Ballistic Missile System, including some equipped with nuclear warhead missiles.

Turchynov added that Russia also intended to complete the deployment of a powerful submarine fleet base in Crimea.

Poroshenko: Russia is preparing summer offensive, 20.05.2015

Ukraine's president Petro Poroshenko says the country is now in a "real war" with Russia, and Ukrainians should prepare for a Russian offensive.

President Poroshenko told the BBC's Fergal Keane he did not trust his Russian counterpart Vladimir Putin. He said, however, that he had no option but to negotiate with Mr. Putin. Russia denies Western accusations that it has sent regular troops and armor to help the rebels in eastern Ukraine. The United Nations says at least 6,000 people have been killed since fighting started in eastern Ukraine in April 2014.

Pro-Russian rebels made significant gains in the region, including, most recently, the rail hub of Debaltseve. They, and Russia, have denied they are receiving Moscow's support.

But Russia's role has again come into question, after the capture on Saturday of two men Ukraine said were elite Russian soldiers working in eastern Ukraine.

In an interview with Latvian TV Lithuanian President Dalia Grybauskaite said that modern Russia is behaving worse than under the regime of former Soviet dictator Josef Stalin. "In fact, Russia is worse than in the days of Stalin, and is waging the first non-convention war using cyber-attacks, as well as information and propaganda attacks," the Lithuanian president said. In addition, according to her, the aim of the Russian president is to destabilize the situation in Ukraine, but he would not likely do more.

"Europe is not such a weak point that he could put pressure on it," Grybauskaite said. Number of Russia troops deployed in Ukraine sometimes reaches 14,000 – Poroshenko, 20.05.2015

President of Ukraine Petro Poroshenko has said that presence of the Russian troops in Ukraine has been proven, and at different times the number of Russian troops varies from between 4,000 to 14,000.

"The fact of the presence of Russian soldiers in our territory was proven many times, and in various times there are from 4,000 to up to 14,000 Russia regular troops in the territory of Ukraine," he said at a joint conference with Slovak President Andrej Kiska in Kyiv on Wednesday. "This is not just Ukrainian information, this is the data of NATO intelligence and other sources, we have the facts of [Russian soldiers] crossing of our border, which was registered by satellite," Poroshenko said. He said this concerns not just the number of Russian troops, but also a significant number of modern weapons, "including missiles and anti-aircraft complexes."

Novorossiva's Parliament is dead, 20.05.2015

Oleg Tsarev, who heads the so-called Parliament of Novorossiya, says the group has ceased all activities, "insofar as it was not written into the peace plan signed by the Normandy Four" in Minsk earlier last February. A spokesman for the Donetsk People's Republic has also said efforts to develop a union between Donetsk and Luhansk have been suspended indefinitely, blaming Kiev for suppressing pro-Russian sentiment in the areas around and between Ukraine's two separatist enclaves. Tsarev has said Novorossiya includes several areas: both the rebelheld areas of Donetsk and Luhansk, as well as regions still under Ukrainian control, like Kharkov and Dnipropetrovsk. Russians, meanwhile, lack a strong common understanding of Novorossiya. According to a recent poll by the Levada Center, fewer than half of Russians say it is a "historically developed" region in southern Russia. Another 25 percent say Novorossiya is merely a "historical term that lacks any meaning today," and 8 percent say it is a "new myth invented by Moscow."

Poroshenko: Ukraine not to go into default, 20.05.2015

Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko has said that there will be no default in Ukraine. He said this at a joint press conference with Slovak President Andrej Kiska, an Ukrinform correspondent reported.

"When you talk about the threat or the possibility of bankruptcy - you won't see it," Poroshenko said. Thus, according to the President, Ukraine will effectively implement its cooperation with the IMF and with the EU. In particular, tomorrow Ukraine will be provided with macro-financial assistance worth EUR 1.8 billion during the summit of Eastern Partnership.

"And I am sure that the restructuring of the Ukrainian debts will be held by the Ukrainian government with the support of our partners," he said.

Poroshenko assured that economic growth will start in Ukraine in 2016, but peace is the main thing needed for this. "I am confident that we will reach the economic growth in 2016. Russia says Ukraine debt repayment law amounts to default, 20.05.2015

Russia on Wednesday demanded the timely repayment of all debts owed to it by Ukraine and accused Kiev of effectively preparing the way for default with a new law.

It threatened to take the issue to international courts if necessary.

The law, approved by Ukraine's parliament on Tuesday, gives the government the right to miss payments to its international creditors as it wrangles over the terms for restructuring \$23 billion worth of foreign debt.

Russia holds a \$3 billion Ukrainian Eurobond whose full repayment is due by the end of the year. Moscow, whose relations with Kiev have been wrecked by a year-long conflict in eastern Ukraine, has declined to join the debt restructuring talks.

President Vladimir Putin, speaking at a meeting with government ministers, said he found the new law "strange". "To effectively announce an impending default shows a poor level of professional responsibility, all things considered," said Putin, noting that the International Monetary Fund does not lend to countries in default.

They are the right avenue for bringing the economies of Georgia, the Republic of Moldova and Ukraine closer to the EU and to our internal market. The €2 billion are an investment to make these economies more competitive and an investment into local companies that will create more jobs for the population. They are a sign of the EU's strong commitment to further deepen our cooperation with our Eastern partners", said the President of the European Commission, Jean-Claude Juncker.

Juncker stated this on the sidelines of the Eastern Partnership summit in Riga on May 21, an Ukrinform correspondent reports. "It is not the meeting to consider the issues of the EU membership. We should clearly point out that there is a European prospect for any of these countries [Eastern Partnership countries]. They are not ready, we are not ready, but the process is ongoing" the President of the European Commission said.

President of the European Commission noted that the Riga summit did not deal with the issue of the EU membership of the eastern partners.

Russia might deploy nuclear weapons delivery systems - Breedlove, 22.05.2015

Russia has deployed systems which may be used to deliver nuclear weapons in eastern Ukraine. "Majority of nuclear weapons delivery systems, used by Russia, is dual-use equipment: for conventional and nuclear weapons. Some of them have already been placed," NATO Supreme Allied Commander Europe General Philip Breedlove said.

The General said that NATO called irresponsible signals from Russia about the deployment of nuclear weapons on the territory of the annexed Crimea.

"We believe the media reports on deployment in Crimea and possibility of use of nuclear weapons to be irresponsible on part of Russia being the nuclear state. At the same time, we actually have not seen any direct changes, but that does not mean they can not happen," Breedlove emphasized. He also said that NATO did not know anything about the plans for deployment of missile defense systems in Ukraine.

Cabinet staff reshuffle expected in autumn, some ministers could be replaced earlier – Lutsenko, 23.05.2015

Significant personnel changes in the Cabinet of Ministers will take place in autumn, while some ministers could be replaced at the current session of the Verkhovna Rada, Head of the Bloc of Petro Poroshenko parliamentary faction Yuriy Lutsenko forecasts.

"Talking about the government reshuffle has a reason. I emphasize: not the change of the government but changes in the government," he said in an exclusive interview with Interfax-Ukraine. According to the politician, MPs have claims to some of the ministers in connection with the insufficient level of reform implementation.

"I think we'll have this kind of reformatting. There will be major staff reshuffle in autumn, I feel this. But I do not rule out that there could be individual personnel decisions by the end of this session, several ministers could be replaced," Lutsenko said.

Russia vows 'tough' action if Ukraine defaults on debt, 23.05.2015

Russian Prime Minister Dmitry Medvedev said Saturday that his government will adopt a "tough stance" if Ukraine defaults on its debt, which includes a \$3 billion loan from Moscow. Speaking in an interview with state channel Rossiya, Medvedev said Ukraine's failure to repay its debt or a decision to freeze payments could prompt Russia to oppose new IMF loans to the country. The conflict with pro-Russia separatists in Ukraine's industrial east -- which Kiev blames on Moscow -- has greatly exacerbated economic difficulties in the former Soviet republic. Medvedev said recent steps by Kiev toward freezing debt payments are "looking like the denial by Bolsheviks to pay the debt of the tsarist government."

"If indeed it will be done this way, that is undoubtedly a default by Ukraine," Medvedev said of the potential debt freeze.

Granting visa-free regime with the EU agreed in Riga – Presidential Administration, 24.05.2015

It is about the annexation of the territory of Ukraine and control over a specific database, which could have been captured, particularly, in Donetsk and Luhansk. There is a new situation when the European Union said that it cannot now monitor if these moments are not used to enter the European Union illegally," Chalyi said. According to him, the problem was that the European partners have changed the conditions. "Our position was the following: sorry, but the repeating introduction of new conditions and the war as an explanation of the impossibility of Ukrainians to travel do not suit us. We defended our position and now we have a very clear knowledge that review of the implementation of Ukrainian obligations should take place until the end of 2015. Immediately after that the decision on visa-free regime for Ukrainians should be granted," he stressed.

With this new funding, total U.S. humanitarian assistance since the start of the crisis will reach more than \$61 million.

The United States remains concerned by the growing humanitarian crisis in eastern Ukraine, particularly in areas occupied by combined Russian-separatist forces, and the limits on assistance agencies' response due to the underfunding of humanitarian appeals. More than five million people in Ukraine are in need of aid, according to the UN, including 1.2 million internally displaced persons. Single-headed households, the disabled, and the elderly are particularly vulnerable.

Putin Classifies Information on Deaths of Russian Troops on Special Missions, 28.05.2015

President Vladimir Putin on Thursday declared all deaths of Russian soldiers during special operations to be classified as a state secret, a move that comes as Moscow stands accused of sending soldiers to fight in eastern Ukraine.

Putin, who has repeatedly denied any involvement of Russian troops in a pro-Russian rebellion there, amended a decree that had previously classified only deaths of servicemen during war time as secret. Asked to explain the rationale behind Putin's move, his spokesman Dmitry Peskov had no immediate comment.

Russian opposition activists released a report saying at least 220 serving Russian soldiers were killed in fighting in two hot spots in east Ukraine last summer and earlier this year.

Ukraine general budget reaches record surplus in 1Q15, 05.05.2015

Ukraine reported its 1Q15 general budget at a UAH 14.0 bln surplus, compared to a UAH 0.5 bln surplus in 1Q14. At the same time, the 1Q15 central budget (net of local budgets) surplus reached UAH 4.2 bln, compared to UAH 4.1 bln deficit in 1Q14. General budget revenue surged 25.0% yoy in 1Q15 on the back of a 55.4% yoy VAT increase, 58.5% yoy excise duty upsurge, 26.7% yoy growth in personal income tax collections and 2.6x jump in import tariff revenue. Also during the reported period, Ukraine received UAH 6.2 bln in a first wire from the sale of 3G licenses. At the same time, the central bank's support for the budget in 1Q15 shrunk by a third to UAH 5.5 bln from UAH 15.8 bln a year ago.

General budget spending increased only 17.2% yoy in 1Q15 compared to 26.9% yoy general spending growth targeted for the whole year.

Alexander Paraschiy: The general budget surplus is positive, though it's too early to celebrate. The main source of the budget collections upsurge was rapid hryvnia devaluation in February. We see it as a one-off effect that will fade out in line with falling consumption. Another point of concern is the modest spending activity of local budgets. Starting the year, local authorities received more own financial resources (like 5 percent of local excise duties) to boost their coffers. At the same time, the procedures for spending those funds have not been fine-tuned yet. As a result, local authorities are just sitting on money and are waiting for clear instructions on what to do with those funds.

News of the defeat of Nazi Germany reached Moscow on May 9, so the Soviet Union, and latterly the former Soviet Union republics, have traditionally celebrated the victory a day after the countries of western Europe.

The new date was set by a decree of Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko "On the celebration in 2015 of the 70th anniversary of the victory over Nazism in Europe and the 70th anniversary of the end of World War II."

The new date is not the only symbolic change marking Ukraine's break with its Soviet past. The symbol of the memory of war victims in Ukraine has now become the red poppy, as in many European countries. The St. George's Ribbon, which was the traditional symbol in the FSU, is now shunned in most of Ukraine, as it was appropriated as the symbol of the Russian-backed militants now fighting Ukrainian government forces in the east of the country.

Russia celebrated the 70th anniversary of the surrender of Nazi Germany during World War II in epic style on Saturday, with a massive military parade in Moscow's Red Square.

The national parade during the largest secular holiday in Russia is a chance for the country to display its military might; military vehicles and hoards of soldiers were the centerpiece of the Victory Day celebrations, which are held annually. But the 70th anniversary doesn't come along every year.

In both countries, it was a sight to be seen.

In Kiev, Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko led a small procession of officials and diplomats to the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier to honor those who died during WWII. During an address to the group, Poroshenko made a clear distinction between Ukraine marking the day and Russia's commemoration.

"May 9 will always be a red date in the Ukrainian calendar, just as these red poppies that symbolize the remembrance of the fallen," said Poroshenko. "We will never celebrate this day under the Russian scenario again, because it provides for the cold-blooded use of the Victory Day for an apology to the expansionist policy regarding neighbors aimed at keeping them in the sphere of one's influence and restoration of empire."

Ukrainian parliament approves mobilization of demobilized military in special period, 14.05.2015

The explanatory note to the bill states that the provisions of the third paragraph of Article 23 of the Law of Ukraine "On mobilisation preparation and mobilisation", which supplement this Law according to the Law dated March 18, 2015 (the changes took effect on April 15, 2015), provides for deferment for military service during the mobilisation of reservists from among citizens who have already passed the military service, and were transferred to the reserve. Ukrainian parliament allows use of video and audio records in official bribery cases, 22.05.2015

The law authorizes the use of video and audio records in courts to prove cases of bribery and extortion by officials. Also, the law as a whole is designed to strengthen the role of civil society in combatting corruption by introducing the institution of public prosecution in criminal proceedings.

It is stipulated that a natural or legal person can be appointed a public prosecutor if they are directly affected by a criminal offense or if they have knowledge of crimes involving official corruption in relation to other persons, as stipulated in Article 368 (acceptance of an offer, promise or receiving illegal benefits by an official), Article 370 (provocation of bribery) of the Criminal Code of Ukraine. At the same time the public prosecutor has the same rights as the investigator and the prosecutor, and becomes a full participant in criminal proceedings. The chairman of the Verkhovna Rada Committee for legislative support to law enforcement, Andriy Kozhemiakin, said that according to the law the public prosecutor shall be "provided with a legal weapon in the fight against corruption, which allows the initiation of a special procedure for criminal proceedings; use technical means to record the crime; apply for the application of security measures in criminal proceedings; appeal against the inaction and other illegal actions of the investigator and the prosecutor."

Militants fire 'banned' weapons at Ukrainian army positions overnight, 01.05.2015 In the attacks, which were recorded from 1800 to midnight on Thursday, the militants used weapons of types that they should have been withdrawn far from the front line, according to the Minsk peace agreements, the press center said.

It said the militants shelled the positions of Ukrainian troops with 120mm mortars and 122mm caliber artillery. According to the Minsk agreement, all weapons of caliber over 100mm were to be withdrawn to create a 50 kilometer wide security zone along the length of the front line between the two side. In Donetsk region the militants fired 122mm artillery at Ukrainian army positions at the town of Avdiivka. Chief Monitor of OSCE Special Monitoring Mission calls for respect of monitors' safety and freedom of movement, 02.05.2015

The most serious incident occurred early Saturday afternoon when a patrol in Shyrokyne was hit by small arms fire. There were no injuries.

Also on Saturday in Pisky (near Donetsk airport), four mortar shells landed nearby an SMM patrol while it was approaching an observation point. There was no fighting in the area at the time and the situation was quiet. Less than two hours later, the same patrol, while stationary in Adviivka, came under cross fire including by 152mm artillery that is proscribed under the Minsk agreements. In both cases there were no injuries.

Militants use heavy artillery systems to shell ATO forces in Pisky, Shyrokyne, Avdiyivka, 02.05.2015

The ATO forces in the town of Avdiyivka, the villages of Opytne, Pisky [near the destroyed Donetsk airport], Triokhizbenka, and the village of Shyrokyne [located at the coast of the Sea of Azov, not far from the Ukrainian-held city of Mariupol in Donetsk region] were under fire from heavy artillery systems. Militants also used 82mm-caliber mortars eight times.

"In Donetsk region, militants shelled our positions near Avdiyivka from a 120mm-caliber mortar, 122mm-caliber artillery systems, and a tank. A skirmish occurred near the village of Pisky from 2214 to 2240 Kyiv time on Friday. Dense fire from small arms by Ukrainian troops forced the enemy to retreat," the press center said. The hottest spot in Luhansk region was the village of Triokhizbenka where the ATO forces were shelled by militants from 120mm-caliber mortars, automatic grenade launchers and machine guns. "Over the period under review, the Ukrainian forces spotted eight enemy drones flying in the sky in Donetsk region," the ATO press center said

On 2 May, at 11:55hrs, en route to Shyrokyne, approximately 1km west of the entrance of the village, the SMM heard a burst of small-arms fire originating from north-west of its position. The SMM armoured vehicle sustained a direct hit to its rear right corner from a single 5.45mm bullet fired in the burst. The SMM patrol did not sustain casualties as a result of the attack. On 2 May, at 14:45hrs, while monitoring at a Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) observation post in Pisky (government-controlled, 13km north-west of Donetsk), four 82mm mortar shells impacted 100m from the SMM's location. The SMM patrol did not sustain casualties. The SMM took shelter and retreated from the area as soon as it was possible. On 2 May, at 16:05hrs, the same SMM patrol visited the JCCC patrol base in Avdiivka (government-controlled, 15km north-west of Donetsk). Whilst there, the SMM observed what it assessed to be shelling by 152mm artillery. The SMM took cover in a nearby underground shelter and was only able to depart from the location following the implementation of a five-minute local ceasefire. The SMM patrol did not sustain casualties.

Massive rise in number of militant attacks on Ukrainian forces, fears of Russian-militant offensive grow, 04.05.2015

"The number of ceasefire violations over the past day was 95, which is almost at the level seen before the conclusion of the [peace] agreements in Minsk [on February 12.] The enemy is no longer hesitating to fire on our positions several times a day with heavy artillery and rockets, trying to provoke Anti-Terrorist Operation forces into giving the appropriate response." The huge increase in attacks came just days after Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko warned that the combined Russian-militant forces might launch a fresh offensive in mid-May. "We keep getting more evidence and information proving that the aggressor will commence a military offensive in the second half of May," Poroshenko said on April 30. "[But] I don't want to frighten anyone, and you should know that the country is capable of protecting its citizens," the Ukrainian president said.

"According to the Minsk agreement, all the heavy weapons prescribed by the protocols have been withdrawn by Ukrainian side to the distance provided by the Agreement... There are no our MRLS' there, all of them are at the designated storage areas," – he said.

The Ukrainian APC was on a reconnaissance patrol mission on a dirt road when it went over the mine, Moskal said. He said two soldiers killed, aged 30 and 40, died at the place of the explosion. Three others have been hospitalized.

Latest from OSCE Special Monitoring Mission to Ukraine, 05.05.2015

The SMM continued to observe ceasefire violations[1] in and around Donetsk airport ("Donetsk People's Republic" ("DPR")-controlled, 11km north-west of Donetsk), and near Shyrokyne (20km east of Mariupol). From the observation point on the eastern outskirts of government-controlled Berdianske (1.5km west of Shyrokyne, 20km east of Mariupol), between 14:20 and 18:00hrs, the SMM heard 47 mostly outgoing explosions and observed 26 airbursts of small arms fire. The explosions came from south-east, east, north and north-west direction from a distance between 0,3km and 2.5km. The weapons used included 82mm mortars, anti-tank guns and small arms. This represents a decrease compared to the number of ceasefire violations recorded on 4 May at this location.

Militants attack Ukrainian army positions 27 times overnight, 05.05.2015

On Monday evening the situation in ATO zone remained tense, the press center said. In Donetsk region, the ATO positions were shelled with 120mm mortars near the villages of Shyrokyne, Pisky, Gnutovo, Opytne, and with 82mm mortars near the village of Pisky, Mayorsk, Leninske, and Kirovo.

Moreover, the militants attacked Ukrainian positions near Shyrokino and near the settlements of Opytne, Pisky, and Hranitne with 122mm caliber artillery and tank shells, while at Avdiivka attacks were carried out with automatic weapons, hand grenades and small arms.

In Luhansk region the militants also opened fire using 82mm caliber mortars, attacking the positions of the Ukrainian army near the village Syze.

Only 20% of ATO soldiers receive status of combatants, 05.05.2015

According to Shcherbatiuk, the status of combatant has been granted to 39,000 soldiers. "Even this figure is quite significant, because there are many military men drafted recently and they will soon be eligible for this status. In addition, the law allows the status to be given to people who were only in the ATO zone for a few hours. That means that the number of people could be quite extensive," the lawyer said.

At the same time, he pointed to the range of challenges faced by the participants of ATO and their relatives when applying for the status of combatant. He said there was the lack of a clear approach to participants in volunteer battalions - a law has been adopted but has yet to be signed by the President first."

Ukrainian Army Suffers Deadliest Day in 3 Weeks in Blow to Truce, 06.05.2015

Five servicemen were killed in the past 24 hours, four by a land mine and one in an ambush, Defense Ministry spokesman Andriy Lysenko said Wednesday. Twelve were injured, while the separatists target the town of Shyrokyne, near the Mariupol port, he said. The rebels accused Ukraine of breaking the cease-fire 55 times in the past day, including with artillery. "Ukraine has numerous pieces of evidence that insurgents are systematically violating" the cease-fire, Lysenko said in Kiev. "The enemy is delivering dense fire from heavy weapons --large-caliber cannons, mortars. Snipers are also at work."

Kremlin-backed forces have also reinforced their formations in the Svitlodarsk-Artemivsk area of the region by moving two convoys of infantry and armor consisting of 18 armored personnel carriers, seven tanks and several trucks closer to the front line, he said on Facebook on May 6. Latest from OSCE Special Monitoring Mission to Ukraine, 07.05.2015

Fighting continued to rage in and around the destroyed "Donetsk People's Republic" ("DPR")-controlled Donetsk airport, with the SMM during the reporting period recording hundreds of explosions. At the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) observation post at "DPR"-controlled Donetsk Railway Station (8km north-west of Donetsk), the SMM, between 13:25 and 18:00hrs, observed a total of 573 explosions. Members of the JCCC at the observation post told the SMM that there had been two unsuccessful attempts to introduce local ceasefires at 9:00 and 9:30hrs. The SMM observed that the second attempt had lasted over an hour. The SMM also accessed "DPR"-controlled Spartak (8km north of Donetsk) and the airport, noting sporadic low-level incoming mortar rounds.

Furthermore, the movement of the SMM was impaired due to lack of mobile telephone coverage, reportedly caused by damage of the optical fibre cable, which resulted in the SMM vehicle tracking devices becoming non-operational. According to the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) in Donetsk, 120mm mortar outgoing shelling started early in the morning at 06:50hrs from Pisky village (12km north-west of Donetsk, government-controlled) to Zhabunki village (11km north-west of Donetsk, "Donetsk People's Republic" ("DPR")-controlled).

Two Ukrainian serviceman killed, 26 wounded in past 24 hours - Ukrainian military, 08.05.2015

Two Ukrainian servicemen were killed and 26 wounded in separatist eastern territories over the past 24 hours, Ukraine's military said on Friday, as attacks continued despite a ceasefire. In a speech to mark the 70th anniversary of the end of World War Two, Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko said he would stick to the Minsk peace agreements that the separatists accuse him of violating.

"Questions of war and peace are as relevant today as ever before ... No matter how much my peace plan is criticised, I will not swerve from this path," he told parliament.

Violence has fallen significantly since a peace accord was signed in Minsk, Belarus, in February, but both government troops and pro-Russian rebels accuse the other side of violations and casualties are reported almost daily.

"Banned weapons are used all along the frontline ... this is evidence of deliberate attempts by the enemy to sabotage the Minsk agreements," Ukrainian military spokesman Andriy Lysenko said in a televised briefing.

Militants escalating conflict with heavy weapons from hidden arms depots in city of Donetsk, 08.05.2015

"We're currently being shelled constantly in Pisky, [a village on the front line near the city of Donetsk]," Bereza said. "Previously it was only 82mm caliber mortars, but the militants have switched to more powerful weapons now. I'm not taking about what's going on with small arms – those little skirmishes are subsiding." Under the Minsk agreement of February 12, all weapons of a caliber larger than 100mm were to have been withdrawn by both sides far out of range of the front line. However, Ukraine has reported the use by the militants of 122mm mortars, 122mm D-30 howitzers, and 122mm Grad multiple rocket launchers many times since the supposed ceasefire was to have come into effect.

It should be recalled that yesterday three fighters of 13th infantry battalion and the first tank brigade were also release from captivity.

Ukraine President Says Almost 7,000 Civilians Killed in War, 08.05.2015

Speaking before parliament, Petro Poroshenko said that more than 1,000 people remained unaccounted for. The figures mark a sharp increase from the most recent United Nations tally of around 6,100 people killed.

Addressing an assembly packed with soldiers, Poroshenko said that 1,657 Ukrainian troops had also been killed in combat — which he described as aggression from Russia.

Moscow has always denied supplying separatist rebels with either equipment or manpower, but it has been open in its diplomatic support for the separatists.

Poroshenko said Russian involvement in the war had forced Ukraine to seek to align further with the West.

"In the past 24 hours, militants shelled Ukrainian troops from 120mm-caliber mortars 20 times, from 122mm-caliber artillery systems and tanks four times, and from a 152mm-caliber artillery system one time. All in all, they used tanks four times for attacks," presidential administration spokesman for the ATO Andriy Lysenko said at a briefing.

Though the Mariupol sector has seen a certain decrease in armed attacks by pro-Russian illegal units, the village of Shyrokyne has been shelled by militants from tanks and heavy-caliber weapons and mortars.

"The situation in the ATO zone remains tense. Pro-Russian militants don't stop their attacks even during the holidays, intensifying shelling from weapons banned under the Minsk agreements," he said. Fighting continues in combat zone hotspots, military spokesman says, 11.05.2015

Despite a ceasefire in Ukraine having been supposed to come into effect nearly three months ago, fierce fighting continues at the hotspots of Pisky near the battle-shattered Donetsk airport and the village of Shyrokyne near the Ukrainian-held port city of Mariupol.

Speaking at a briefing in Kyiv on Monday, the press secretary of the Presidential Administration of Ukraine on the Anti-Terrorist Operation, Colonel Oleksandr Motuzyanik, said that while fighting has decreased in some parts of the combat zone, it continues unabated in two main hotspots. "The hottest point was the town of Pisky – it saw 10 attacks [by Russian-backed militants] on Ukrainian army positions," Motuzyanik said.

Some experts expected an attack on May 9, celebrated as Victory Day in Russia and other former Soviet countries, but that day passed without much incident. However, the danger of possible active offensive operations is increasing, the ATO headquarters said.

Intelligence suggests that the militants have restocked their weapon and ammunition supplies, and they are targeting the positions of the Ukrainian armed forces in order to improve their skills for the active phase of hostilities.

The most threatening force of the enemy is its tank brigades, the headquarters said. The number of armored vehicles of the Russian-backed militants is already almost 700 units, it said. "On the territory of Luhansk region and Luhansk the militants have created three powerful rear maintenance bases, where they store their armored vehicles. ATO: Militants fire heavy weapons on Pisky, Shyrokyne and Stanytsia Luhanska, 13.05.2015

"The militants have no guidelines and formats of agreements. Starting from 1800 on Tuesday, they fired for a maximum of an hour on a territory where people do not want war. They fired banned artillery, mortars and rocket-propelled grenades, and other weapons available to them," the report says.

In addition, the militants fired large-caliber mortars near the village of Shyrokyne.

According to the report, in the direction of Artemivsk the militants fired 152mm artillery on the village of Druzhba. They also fired 120 mm mortars and tank weapons on the villages of Leninske and Kirove.

From midnight till morning, the militants continuously shelled the village of Stanytsia Luhanska. A sniper was working near the village of Shastya.

Latest from OSCE Special Monitoring Mission (SMM) to Ukraine, 17.05.2015

The SMM continued to observe ceasefire violations in and around Donetsk airport, albeit of reduced intensity.[1] Throughout the SMM's presence at two observation points near the village of Shyrokyne the situation was relatively calm. The SMM heard on 15 May three explosions whereas no ceasefire violations were registered on 16 and 17 May. However, the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) inDonetsk reported instances of mortar shelling in Hranitne (government-controlled, 57km south of Donetsk) and Chermalyk (government-controlled, 72km south of Donetsk). The senior representatives of the Ukrainian Armed Forces and the Russian Federation Armed Forces at the JCCC in Donetsk jointly reported 27 ceasefire violations in and around Donetsk airport and 25 violations in and around the area of Shyrokyne (20km east of Mariupol) involving mortar, tank and small arms and light weapons (SALW) fire for the period between 00:00 and 12:00hrs.

While on route south of Olenivka ("DPR"-controlled, 21km south-west of Donetsk) the SMM observed that the defensive positions in the areas around both "DPR" and government-controlled checkpoints were reinforced, and signs warning of mine danger were posted along the side of the road near the checkpoints, on both the "DPR" and Ukrainian Armed Forces side.

Two civil volunteers, two soldiers killed in landmine blast on Sunday, 17.05.2015

One of the servicemen was a colonel who worked as a deputy of a unit commander for logistics, representative of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine Vladyslav Selezniov said on the air on Channel 5 on Sunday.

"An UAZ Hunter SUV was going on a certain route this afternoon. There were two Ukrainian servicemen on board, one of them was in the rank of colonel, he was a deputy commander for logistics. There were three volunteers with them. We're now trying to find out which route and which mission that vehicle was running with. A landmine exploded when the SUV moved over it, going along an unpaved road near the town of Popasna. Two Ukrainian servicemen and two civil volunteers were killed in the blast. The third volunteer with severe burns (about 80% of total body surface area, according to doctors) is in hospital now. The doctors are fighting for his life," Selezniov said.

The situation remained the following day, when from its observation point (4.5km south-west of Shyrokyne. 16km east of government-controlled Mariupol) the SMM heard a noticeable increase in the number of explosions, mostly outgoing and some incoming mortar shells (82mm and 120mm). This marked a significant increase over the previous days with a total of more than 200 explosions over the course of the day.

Overwhelming new evidence of prisoners being tortured and killed amid conflict, 20.05.2015

The 36-page report - Breaking Bodies: Torture and summary killings in eastern Ukraine provides compelling evidence of frequent and widespread prisoner abuse by a broad range of captors on both sides of the conflict.

Former prisoners described being beaten until their bones broke, tortured with electric shocks, kicked, stabbed, hung from the ceiling, deprived of sleep for days, threatened with death, denied urgent medical care and subjected to mock executions.

John Dalhuisen, Europe and Central Asia Programme Director at Amnesty International, said: "In the shadow of eastern Ukraine's still smouldering conflict, our on-the-ground research shows that accounts of detainee torture are as commonplace as they are shocking. More than 30 former prisoners held by both sides gave us consistent and harrowing accounts of their captors' abuse.

Russian activists say find fresh graves of soldiers killed in Ukraine, 20.05.2015

Two activists who travelled around central Russia this week said they found fresh graves of soldiers from a special forces brigade of the army's Main Intelligence Directorate (GRU), which is based in Tambov, a city 400 kilometres (250 miles) south of Moscow.

Their investigation came as the Ukrainian authorities showed off two captured Russians they claim are serving GRU soldiers detained after being wounded in a firefight while on a scouting mission in war-torn east Ukraine.

One of the activists Vadim Korovin -- who posted pictures of the graves online -- told AFP that the burials helped show that the Russian military is carrying out "large-scale reconnaissance operations" in east Ukraine despite a tenuous truce.

One of the graves is near Tambov while the other is in the Tatarstan region on the Volga. Both show the date of death as May 5, 2015 and both have been adorned with identical wreaths from the Russian defence ministry, according to the pictures.

At the same time, commenting on the claims by the Russian authorities that no Russian soldiers are in Donbas, Aleksandrov said: "As you can see, [the Russian army] is there. It is just not good for the Kremlin to admit this."

The second captured Russian soldier, Yevgeniy Yerofeyev, has however denied that the Russian military is present in the Donbas.

During the last day three Ukrainian servicemen have been killed, another 12 injured in the area of the anti-terrorist operation in Donbas as a result of hostilities and military clashes.

Spokesman for the Presidential Administration on the anti-terrorist operation, Colonel Andriy Lysenko said this at a briefing in Kyiv on Friday, an Ukrinform correspondent reported.

"Over the past day, as a result of active hostilities three our soldiers were killed, another 12 were injured," he said. According to him, the greatest losses were in the direction of Donetsk.

Latest from OSCE Special Monitoring Mission (SMM) to Ukraine, 22.05.2015

The SMM observed a decrease in ceasefire violations as compared to previous days. Specifically, the SMM observed a small number of ceasefire violations in the area of "Donetsk People's Republic" ("DPR")-controlled Donetsk and Donetsk airport ("DPR"-controlled, 10km north-west of Donetsk). The violations were limited to light-weapons fire, including a limited number of bursts from anti-aircraft guns, automatic grenade launchers, and 82mm mortars. The SMM observed no ceasefire violations in the vicinity of Shyrokyne (20km east of Mariupol). The Ukrainian Armed Forces Major-General at the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) headquarters in Soledar (government-controlled, 77km north-north-east of Donetsk) told the SMM that the coke and chemical plant in Avdiivka (government-controlled, 17km north-north-west of Donetsk) had been shelled on 21 May. The Chief Engineer of the plant later corroborated the information, telling the SMM that thirty 120mm mortars had impacted in the plant, killing one worker and injuring two.

At Donetsk airport, the SMM observed the recovery of human remains at the "old terminal building" and the vicinity to the west of it. The remains were recovered by members of the "DPR". Representatives of the JCCC, the International Committee of the Red Cross, along with international and local media representatives were present.

Donbas militants continue using banned weapons, 24.05.2015

Russian-backed militants continue firing on the Ukrainian ATO forces, using the weapons banned under the Minsk peace agreement, Presidential Administration Speaker for ATO issues, Colonel Oleksandr Motuzianyk said at a briefing in Kyiv on Sunday.

According to him, the situation in the ATO zone remains difficult; however, the intensity of firing by militants has insignificantly declined in recent days.

"At the same time, the weapons banned by the Minsk agreements are actively used by militants against the ATO forces," he said.

Militants hit water main in Luhansk region, many houses in occupied territory to be cut off, 24.05.2015

The water main in the town of Zolote has been damaged as a result of shelling by militants, and a large occupied territory in Luhansk region – from the town of Pervomaisk to the town of Krasny Luch – has been cut off from the water supply, Moskal's press service said.

"The pipe near our farthest roadblock, which is regularly shelled from mortars, has been damaged. The hydraulic damper has been unsealed, and it is flooding civilian houses and our military fortification facilities. Simultaneously, various dirt gets into the damaged pipe, therefore the water supply will be cut off in the occupied territories in Luhansk region, namely the towns of Pervomaisk, Stakhanov, Brianka, Alchevsk, Antratsyt, Kirovsk and other towns and villages as farther as the town of Krasny Luch, in the coming hours, Moskal said.

According to him, this is a vast territory where there is no alternative source of the water supply. Considerable funds and labor force are needed to repair the water main.

Russian Consul to Ukraine Visits Suspected Russian Soldiers, 26.05.2015

The two Russians, Alexander Alexandrov and Yevgeny Yerofeyev, were detained on May 16 in eastern Ukraine, where pro-Russian insurgents and Ukrainian armed forces are still fighting in spite of a formal cease-fire. Ukrainian authorities and the men themselves say they are serving Russian soldiers who were on a military intelligence mission for Moscow. Russia insists both are former servicemen who had guit the army at the time of their capture.

Alexandrov and Yerofeyev were both "feeling alright," Oleg Grishin, a spokesman for the Russian embassy in Kiev, told TASS after consul Alexei Gruby visited them in a Kiev hospital. Russia's Foreign Ministry said in a statement earlier Tuesday that Russian representatives were being prevented from seeing the men, who earlier complained to reporters that their country had "forgotten and abandoned" them.

"Not only is the Ukrainian side denying access to the detained men, it is also politicizing this issue via the media," the statement said.

Six killed in Ukraine fighting, 27.05.2015

Four pro-Russian rebels, a Ukrainian soldier and one civilian were killed in clashes that broke out over the past 24 hours in violation of a February truce deal, officials said on Tuesday. The civilian died during an artillery fire attack on the Avdiivka Coke and Chemical Plant, which sits on the outskirts of the rebels' de facto capital Donetsk. A resulting fire at the plant caused a small ammonia leak, Ukraine military spokesman Andriy Lysenko told reporters, without providing further details.

Lysenko said 12 Ukrainian soldiers were also wounded in clashes across the war zone. The pro-Kiev governor of the separatist province of Lugansk said a soldier died when his military ambulance came under fire near the Russian border. It was not clear whether he was referring to the same serviceman as the one mentioned in Lysenko's daily update.

Rebel authorities said four of their fighters were killed and another three injured in the past day. Fighting was particularly heavy in Shyrokyne, near the strategic port city of Mariupol, military officials from both sides said.

Russian Soldier Captured in Ukraine Will Cooperate with Investigators, 28.05.2015

One of the two Russian fighters detained recently in Ukraine has agreed to cooperate with investigators, his lawyer told Ukrainian television.

"All that the investigation wants to get and is trying to drag out of my client, it will not be given to them," she was quoted as saying.

Kord machine gun was designed in the 90s to replace the NSV machine gun, the production of which partially ended up outside of Russia after the breakup of the Soviet Union. It was developed at Degtyarev plant in Kovrov city.

Russian-backed militants had been firing on Ukrainian positions for three hours. The firing stopped only at about one o'clock at night. After that there was a long pause in shelling. The Ukrainian troops deployed near the villages of Kamyanka, Opytne and Pisky [the latter is near the destroyed Donetsk airport] were also under enemy mortar fire.

The second hearing concerns the request of the investigation to prolong custody period," Polozov said.

According to RAPSI, attorney Ilya Novikov presented a PACE document at Moscow's Basmanny district court Wednesday stating it considered Savchenko, who was elected in absentia to the Ukrainian parliament in October and approved as a PACE delegate in January, had immunity from prosecution despite having become a parliamentarian after her alleged crime took place. Russia accuses Savchenko, Ukraine's first female military pilot, of having abetted the deaths of Russian journalists Igor Kornelyuk and Anton Voloshin, who were killed by mortar fire in eastern Ukraine in June. Savchenko, who claims she was captured by pro-Russian separatists and taken to Russia against her will last summer, has repeatedly denied any wrongdoing. The court rejected PACE's argument, claiming Savchenko's status as a delegate does not make her eligible for immunity.

Savchenko's lawyer Ilya Novikov announced this: "Apparently, the matter has come to the finish line, moving ahead to the court," he suggested. "We don't believe that the Russian court could justify Savchenko, but if the diplomats agree, then the Russian authorities will be able to save face by granting her amnesty after sentence has been passed," he said.

Savchenko to stay in custody till June 30 at least, 07.05.2015

Savchenko's lawyer Mark Feygin posted this information on Twitter.

"The judge reads out the decision. And it is upheld. To leave in custody," he posted. As reported, May 6, the Basmanny District Court of Moscow considered the request of the investigation to leave Savchenko in pretrial custody till June 30, 2015.

ATR world's only Crimean Tatar TV channel starts broadcasting on Internet, 07.05.2015

Another attack on journalists investigating Interior Ministry corruption, 25.05.2015

For the second time in the space of a few weeks, investigative journalists probing corruption within the Interior Ministry have come under attack. The film crew was from the same programme whose findings recently led to top Traffic Police official Oleksandr Yershov losing his job.

The film crew from the programme 'Schemy: Corruption in Detail' run by the First National TV Channel and Radio Svoboda was attacked in Kominternivske, near Odesa.

Journalist Maria Tymoshchuk and cameraman Maxim Lenko were on a work-related task near the office of Lemodo, a firm which recently won an Interior Ministry tender to provide vehicle number plates worth 70 million UAH. The company is registered in the Odesa oblast, and up till this successful tender had never been engaged in such activities.

According to Tymoshchuk, they arrived at what proved to be the extremely modest Lemodo office. The one room was closed, and they photographed the sign on the door, and spoke with people in other offices. Somebody ran up to them shouting that they mustn't film there, that they didn't have permission, and smashed their video camera.

Conscription to Russian army starts in Crimea, 01.04.2015

According to the report, more than 150,000 people aged from 18 to 27 years, subject to conscription, will be sent to the Russian Armed Forces by July 15. Ciygoz is a deputy chairman of the assembly, or Mejlis. He was arrested in late January by Russian authorities for his alleged role in clashes with pro-Russian demonstrators in February 2014, a month prior to Moscow's annexation of Crimea.

EU criticises 'unjustified' Russian travel blacklist, 31.05.2015

Russia has imposed an entry ban on 89 European politicians and military leaders, according to a list seen by Reuters, a move that has angered Europe and worsened its standoff with the West over Moscow's role in the Ukraine conflict.

A spokeswoman for EU foreign affairs said that in recent months Russia had denied entry to a number of EU politicians. "We consider this measure as totally arbitrary and unjustified, especially in the absence of any further clarification and transparency," she said.

A spokeswoman for Britain's Foreign Office said there was no justification for the travel ban. "If Russia's intention is to put pressure on the EU to ease sanctions then this is not the way to do it," she said. A Russian Foreign Ministry official confirmed to Russian media that lists of banned individuals had been sent to EU states but declined to comment on the individuals themselves.
