Introduction

November 2014 managed to bring neither desired peace nor economic stability to Ukraine. The month started with election in the so-called LNR and DNR, which have almost ruined all Minsk agreements and which were not recognized by the entire civilized world. Even Russian Federation used the term "respect" not "recognition" in respect to these elections. Donetsk airport which is under control of the Ukrainian military is severely shelled by millints every day. Due to their attacks civilians are murdered. Ukraine was losing its defenders almost every day. In addition to that according to the NSDC data 400 militaries are missing, another 399 are being held hostage; for the duration of the ATO, 4,079 military were injured. Russian humanitarian convoys continued to delivery support to anti-terrorist operation zone. Ukrposhta and state energy companies stop activity in anti-terrorist operation zone. From mid-April to 18 November, at least 4,317 people were killed and 9,921 wounded in the conflict-affected area of eastern Ukraine.

According to the UN report 957 people, including 838 men and 119 women, have been killed in eastern Ukraine during the ceasefire that began on September 6 as of November 18. The forex rate of the Ukrainian hryvnia on the interbank forex market on November 10 slid to 16.10 UAH per dollar, having hit new record lows. Prices on utilities significantly went up. Coalition Agreement has been signed. Representatives of the parties Petro Poroshenko Bloc, People's Front, Samopomich Union, the Radical Party of Liashko and Batkivschyna have signed a coalition agreement on the first anniversary of Maidan. The future coalition plans "to draw up and make amendments to Ukraine's laws on foundations of domestic and foreign policy

and foundations of national security, envisioning, inter alia, the cancellation of Ukraine's non-aligned status, the resumption of a political course toward integration into the Euro-Atlantic security space, and acquisition of North-Atlantic Treaty Organization membership". The agreement also envisages a public administration reform and the passage of legislation regulating the president's impeachment procedure. The agreement stipulates that parliamentarians who voted for the January 16 package of bills and members of the Opposition Bloc cannot join the coalition.

New Parliament started its work on November 27.

The first festive meeting was attended by Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko, as well as former Presidents Leonid Kravchuk, Leonid Kuchma and Viktor Yushchenko.

The newly elected MPs simultaneously took the oath of office. Verkhovna Rada Chairman Oleksandr Turchynov has resigned as parliament speaker. Volodymyr Hroisman took up his post. He announced the set up of "coalition in a Ukrainian European parliament by a constitutional majority of 302 MPs".

Incumbent Ukrainian Prime Minister Arseniy Yatseniuk has again been elected head of government. New government should be formed in the beginning of December. Newly elected Parliament was recognized by Russian Federation.

There are constant contacts between Russian and Ukrainian Presidents that gives hope that peace would come to Ukraine.

But the vote for prime minister here and in neighboring Luhansk region on Sunday was one more step towards creating a new reality on the ground and carving out a chunk of Ukraine that will no longer be controlled by Kyiv," reads the article.

NBU governor predicts annual inflation in Ukraine at 25%, 20.11.2014

KYIV, November 20 /Ukrinform/. Consumer prices in Ukraine this year will grow by 25%. National Bank of Ukraine (NBU) Governor Valeria Hontareva made such a forecast at the Fifth Ukrainian Investment Forum on Thursday, a Ukrinform correspondent reported. "Now inflation is 20%. By the end of the year it may speed up to 25%," she said.

Earlier, the National Bank of Ukraine forecast inflation in 2014 at 19%.

Presidential Administration flatly denies secret agreement on pseudo-elections, 01.11.2014

KYIV, November 1 /Ukrinform/. Deputy Head of the Presidential Administration Valeriy Chaly said there were no secret items in Minsk agreements that allow the elections for representatives of terrorist organizations "DPR" and "LPR."

He said on air of the program Shuster Live, Ukrainska Pravda writes.

"I consider the theme of secret agreements is a provocation against Ukraine. That something is going wrong. Today, it is all taken up on Russian channels," Chaly said.

He also showed copies of two documents with the signatures of members of the contact group, which was engaged in the settlement of the situation in Donbas.

"Show me, please, another document with the signatures, names ... All the rest - it's a game, provocation, pressure ... No other secret, unclassified, any arrangements of this sort, there are no documents of this sort. All that is in the process of work, all that is discussed - it is not a document," Chaly said.

Kyrylenko wants to create international coalition against Kremlin, 03.11.2014

KYIV, November 3 /Ukrinform/. People's Front Party member Viacheslav Kyrylenko has proposed creating an international coalition against the aggressive policy of the Kremlin, which would consist of the countries and institutions that do not recognize illegal elections held in Donbas on November 2.

Kyrylenko said live on the Inter television channel that it was necessary to discuss at a special conference the expediency of using diplomacy regarding the current Russian leadership, a Ukrinform correspondent reported.

"I do not think that now the Kremlin will conduct work on itself and will not recognize these so-called elections in these so-called 'DPR' and 'LPR.' I am fully confident that the Kremlin will recognize them. This means that we, together with the civilized world that has not recognized them, including the United Nations, to decide on the creation of a coalition, possibly a military coalition, against the aggressive Kremlin... So we need to convene a special conference and take a decision," Kyrylenko said.

Pseudo-elections in Donbas to have serious consequences for Russia - Lithuanian Foreign Ministry, 03.11.2014

KYIV, November 3 /Ukrinform/. The Lithuanian Foreign Ministry strongly condemns illegitimate "elections" held in some parts of Ukraine's Donetsk and Luhansk regions by illegal armed groups on November 2. This so-called "vote" will have serious consequences for Russia's future relations with the international community.

"The vote organized by the leaders of so-called 'Donetsk and Luhansk People's Republics' escalates the conflict in the east of Ukraine and will have severe repercussions for Russia's relations with the international community. Further invasion by the Russian army into Ukraine and continuous violation of the cease-fire by the illegal armed groups raise particular concern," reads the statement.

According to the statement, these acts, directly supported by Russia, represent a gross violation of Ukraine's territorial integrity, contradict international law, the laws of Ukraine and the September 5 Minsk agreement, and also do not allow for a free expression of political will by the citizens in Ukraine's Donetsk and Luhansk regions.

"The 'local authorities' formed on the basis of such farce 'elections' will have no democratic legitimacy," the Lithuanian Foreign Ministry said.

I should confirm that we have rather positive results. The only issue is that serial production of biometric passports is not arranged. NATO fears Ukrainian crisis will lead to frozen conflict, 04.11.2014

Russia's actions amid the crisis in eastern Ukraine could lead to the freezing of the conflict, which would in turn worsen Moscow's relations with NATO, the alliance's top general said. Supreme Commander of the European Combined Forces of the Alliance the General Philip Breedlove, speaking to journalists at a briefing, said that Moscow was shifting the border between Ukraine and Russia to the west, according to Russian news agency TASS. "We see that we're facing [border] demarcation and blurred Ukrainian-Russian boundaries," Breedlove said.

"One of the issues that I will submit for consideration by the NSDC is the cancelation of the law on the peculiarities of local government in certain districts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions. In due time, this law performed an extremely important role in stopping foreign invasion, mobilizing the world's support of the Minsk peace agreements, and the sincerity of Ukraine's intentions to de-escalate the situation in Donbas," Poroshenko said.

NATO: Hundreds of Russian troops training militants in occupied part of Ukraine, 04.11.2014

Hollande urges Putin not to recognize "elections" in Donbas, 04.11.2014

"I urge President Putin to remain within the frames of the Minsk agreement, which opened a way to the truce of September 5," Hollande stressed, speaking in the Canadian parliament. "According to him, sanctions against Russia are "necessary... but they cannot be the only response." "The aim consists in convincing Moscow and separatists to refuse from escalation and return to a dialogue," the President of France added.

OSCE: Ukrainian coal taken to Russia, 06.11.2014

Representatives of the Special Monitoring Mission of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (SMM OSCE) stationed on the Russian checkpoints of Gukovo and Donetsk in Rostov region report that the trucks are continuing to transport coal from Ukraine's Luhansk region to Russia.

The information was given in the weekly report of the OSCE mission stationed at the Russian checkpoints.

"The Mission witnessed a large number of trucks that are continuing to carry coal from Luhansk region to the Russian Federation," the report reads.

The reported noted that the OSCE observers saw Russian customs officials checking whether the trucks were empty when entering the territory of Ukraine.

EU: Russia must assume responsibility for disruption of Minsk agreements, 06.11.2014 KYIV, November 6 /Ukrinform/. EU High Representative for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy Federica Mogherini has condemned the pseudo-elections that were held in Donbas on November 2, reads a statement released on the European External Action Service website. "These so-called 'elections,' as well as any acknowledgement or recognition of them, are in breach of the letter and the spirit of the Minsk Protocol and we call on Russia to assume its responsibility in this regard," she said.

The European Union believes that only compliance with the Minsk memorandum may peacefully resolve the crisis in Donbas. Mogherini said that the EU was particularly worried about continuing violation of the ceasefire, the resulting losses of lives and increasing numbers of internally displaced persons.

Russia refuses to return to 'Geneva' peace talks on the Donbas, 06.11.2014

Russia refuses to take part in further negotiations with Ukraine over the conflict in the Donbas in the so-called "Geneva" format, Russia's Foreign Ministry said on Thursday.

"There will be no more negotiations in the Geneva format, ie, with the participation of Russia, the European Union, the United States and Ukraine," the ministry said in comments posted on its official Web site.

"Now it is evident that all these [Minsk] agreements were grossly violated by the Ukrainian side," the ministry wrote.

'Putin can't support Donbas,' says Nemtsov, 07.11.2014

Russia does not have enough money to support the four million residents of Ukraine's Donbas, according to Boris Nemtsov, a leader of the Russian opposition movement.

"[Russian President Vladimir] Putin's plan entitled 'Novorossyia' has gone wrong, because Russia does not have enough money to support the pensioners and public sector workers in the east of Ukraine," Nemtsov wrote on his page on Facebook.

"Putin defiantly refused to meet with the leaders of the DPR and LPR (Donetsk and Luhansk Peoples' Republics) not only because he is careful of the possibility of new sanctions, but also because they have nothing to discuss. There's no money to support four million people." Nemtsov also said Putin was continuing to send Russian troops to Donetsk, supplying weapons and arranging provocations. But Russia is not ready to financially support a vast region, Nemtsov said.

"What remains for [DPR leader Oleksandr] Zakharchenko and Co.? The mines are flooded, no work, no money. Just war," Nemtsov said.

Moscow says it 'respects' but does not 'recognize' Donbas elections, 07.11.2014

In a sign that Russia might be backing down slightly on the issue of its recognition of the elections held by insurgents in Ukraine's Donbas, the Kremlin on Friday said it "respected" but did not "recognize" last Sunday's poll.

"The official position of Russia is expressed in a short, but meaningful Foreign Ministry statement on the results of the election - it uses the word 'respect,'" Putin aide Yury Ushakov said of Moscow's official position.

Asked about whether it was possible to equate the terms "respect" and "recognize" with regard to the elections in the self-proclaimed republics, Ushakov said, "these are different words." "The word 'respect' was especially chosen."

Pentagon confirms presence of Russian units on border with Ukraine, 08.11.2014

"What we do see is a continued presence of significantly capable and ready Russian battalion tactical groups right across that border. And they are close. And they are very capable," Pentagon spokesman Rear Adm. John Kirby said.

Lavrov sees no Russian troops in Ukraine, 08.11.2014

KYIV, November 8 /Ukrinform/. Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov has once again stated that there are no Russian troops in Ukraine.

He told this to reporters at the beginning of a meeting with U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry at the APEC summit in Beijing, Interfax reported.

Lavrov said that U.S. Department of State spokesperson Jen Psaki had admitted earlier that Washington had no evidence indicating Russian military presence in Ukraine.

In addition, according to him, it turned out that Russia "is not directly involved in the implementation of the ceasefire agreements between the Ukrainian government forces and the militias" despite the Minsk agreements that it earlier signed.

"The ceasefire agreement was signed between the militias and the government, and it's they who should complete the demarcation of a separating line, which is being done right now," Lavrov said.

U.S. concerned about intensification of fighting in east Ukraine - statement, 10.11.2014 KYIV, November 10 /Ukrinform/. Washington has expressed serious concern over increasing

military activity in the militant-occupied eastern regions of Ukraine.

National Security Council Spokesperson Bernadette Meehan said this in a statement.

"We are very concerned by intensified fighting in eastern Ukraine, as well as numerous reports, including from the Special Monitoring Mission of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE), that Russian backed and supplied separatists are moving large convoys of heavy weapons and tanks to the front lines of the conflict," reads the document.

At the same time, it notes that the United States continues to call on all sides to strictly adhere to the cease-fire." Any attempt by separatist forces to seize additional territory in eastern Ukraine would be a blatant violation of the Minsk agreements," the statement says.

"We reiterate our call on the Russian Federation to honor all of the commitments it made in Minsk, including ending its military supply to the separatists and the withdrawal of all of its troops and weapons from Ukraine," the spokesperson said.

There will not be fixed hryvnia rate any more, get accustomed - NBU governor, 10.11.2014

KYIV, November 10 /Ukrinform/. "Our country will not live any more with the fixed rate. Unfortunately, it lived so for the whole its life," NBU Governor Valeria Hontareva said. "This does not lead our country either to economic growth or stability of the financial system. We spoke about this as far back as in April, when signed a program with the IMF. Our country said that we will have a flexible rate formation now."

She also said that the NBU looks for the "equilibrium level" as regards the hryvnia.

OSCE reports two military convoys near Donetsk, 10.11.2014

Observers from the Special Monitoring Mission of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE) say they sighted two military convoys of 17 trucks with heavy weapons near Donetsk, according to a report they made November 9, Russia's Lenta.ru has reported. The first convoy was spotted by the observers near the village of Sverdlovo on Sunday at about 1120.

"The OSCE Special Monitoring Mission reported about 17 unmarked ZIL trucks, five of them carrying Grad multiple rocket launcher systems, with ammunition in the other two trucks," the report reads.

The other military column was spotted at 1135 near the town of Zuhres, located 41 kilometers east of Donetsk. This convoy also consisted of 17 unmarked KamAZ trucks. According to observers, 12 of the vehicles were towing 122-millimeter howitzers.

According to the representatives of the mission, in both cases, the men in uniform in the trucks were not observed. Cars followed the convoys, heading west.

Over the last two days OSCE observers have seen several convoys of military equipment near Donetsk. On November 8 the mission observed a convoy of tanks, APCs, trucks and tank trucks 25 km away from Donetsk, in Makiyivka.

I understand that now I set him up, but I cannot help saying this. He said a phrase that 80% of all employees working in the OSCE mission in the sector "M" in Mariupol are Russians," Budyk said, quoted by ZN.UA.

Head of Naftogaz: Ukraine supplying Donbas militants gas for free, 11.11.2014

Ukraine is still supplying expensive imported Russian gas to the areas of the country that have been seized by militants, but gets no payment in return, the head of Naftogaz Ukrainy has said in an interview with German broadcaster Deutsche Welle.

A transcript of the interview with Naftogaz head Andriy Kobolev has been posted on the official Web site of Ukraine's national oil and gas company.

"These areas are now under control of, in the politically correct term, armed men. They do not pay us anything, although we continue supplying gas to these areas," Kobolev said.

He said Naftogaz and Ukraine are therefore suffering from a situation in which they have to buy gas from Russia at significantly higher than market prices and then supply it free of charge to those areas which are under the "protection" of the Russian Federation.

"This is very similar to the situation in Transnistria - gas is being consumed in the breakaway republic, with the payments carried out by the central government in Moldova. We believe that such situation is, at least, incorrect, and it requires some solution," Kobolev said.

OSCE says it can't work in Donbas, 12.11.2014

OSCE Secretary General Lamberto Zannier admitted on Wednesday that the escalation of the situation in the east of Ukraine and failure of the Minsk agreements was making it impossible for his organization's observer mission to fulfill its mandate in the Donbas.

"What we see is concerning, and there are a number of reasons for this concern," Zannier told journalists in Brussels, according to an UNIAN correspondent.

"First of all, given that our primary task was to help de-escalate the conflict, we are concerned because there really is an escalation. We've seen military equipment entering the region during a ceasefire."

Zannier said the observer mission records all violations, but is faced with restrictions on its work. "When we return to Donetsk and Luhansk, we have no freedom of movement. We would like to get to the border but de facto we do not have that freedom. We ask all parties to the Minsk Agreement to execute the agreements. We cannot help if they do not create the conditions for this. This is one of the problems."

Serheyev: Russia deployed 200 tanks and 190 aircraft on border with Ukraine, 13.11.2014

KYIV, November 13 /Ukrinform/. Russia has deployed 200 tanks, 1,600 vehicles, 640 artillery units, 191 aircraft and 121 combat helicopters on the border with Ukraine.

Ukraine's envoy to the UN Yuriy Serheyev said this at an urgent meeting of the UN Security Council, ukr.media reported.

Instead of complying with the Minsk agreements, militants, supported by Russian regular troops, continued to shell Ukrainian military and civilian targets. Since the beginning of the ceasefire (September 5) militants have violated the ceasefire over 2,700 times.

"As many as 131 Ukrainian servicemen were killed, over 500 were wounded, and 65 civilians were killed," Serheyev said.

He also pointed to Russia's attempt to create a land corridor to the occupied Crimea and concentrate Russian troops on Ukrainian territory.

"An illegal Russian convoy with heavy weapons is spotted almost every day. Russia's representative today said that his government does not provide any military support to separatists in Ukraine. This means that someone else, not the state, which has missiles, tanks and guns, supplies them to illegal formations in Ukraine. Someone else in Russia attacks planes and helicopters and violates our airspace," the diplomat said.

Stoltenberg said that "over the last year Moscow has tripled its military activity."

For a long period of time, Ukrainians preferred to keep the status of a non-aligned country. Yatseniuk says 7% GDP fall 'normal' for country at war, 26.11.2014

"The Association Agreement is a comprehensive and complex document, which covers the areas within the competence of both the European institutions and the EU Member States. A mode of provisional application may be distributed only to those areas of the Association Agreement, which relate to exclusive or mixed competence of the EU, as application of the Agreement in other areas will require ratification by the parliaments of the EU member states," the MFA noted.

The Bloc of Petro Poroshenko will have the greatest number of seats in parliament according to preliminary calculations of the results of voting in a multi-member district and single-member electoral districts.

Later, multi-thousand rallies spread throughout Ukraine and escalated into an armed confrontation between the government and citizens. More than a hundred people were killed in Kyiv's riots.

After a series of demands by protesters and the opposition to the government caused by bloody clashes on February 18-20, 2014, security forces began to slowly retreat. Many MPs started leaving the Party of Regions faction in the Verkhovna Rada. This resulted in the resumption of the work of the parliament, which unanimously approved a number of fateful decisions for the country that stopped the confrontation.

"It was a very difficult test for Ukraine... I, as president of Ukraine, have only to document it and sign a decree on the Day of Dignity and Freedom, which Ukrainians will now and forever mark on November 21... Russian President Vladimir Putin may be considering the start of open hostilities against Ukraine, military blogger Dmytro Tymchuk wrote on Facebook on Friday.

"The fact that the Russians are moving [equipment] to the border, including tactical missile systems, suggests that Putin is considering the option of open aggression against Ukraine, quite obviously, under the guise of 'protecting the local population' of the Donbas, who expressed their will in the elections in the Donetsk and Luhansk Peoples' Republics," he said. "However, this scenario is clearly not the primary one, and these preparation are more likely a 'safety net,' which also puts pressure on Kyiv in order to prevent it starting active offensive operations against the terrorists."

Tymchuk said an open attack by Russia could not be excluded, but that it would most likely happen only in the event of the insurgents attacking Ukrainian forces, but being beaten, and there then being successful offensives in response by Ukrainian forces.

Luhansk militant attacks leave more than 10 towns without gas, electricity and water, 18.11.2014

Continued fighting in Ukraine's Luhansk region has left more than ten towns in the region without gas, water and electricity supplies, the region's governor, Hennadiy Moskal, said on Tuesday.

Moskal said the Russian-backed militants who control part of Luhansk region had fired on government-held areas 32 times on Monday, using Grad rockets, artillery and mortars. He said the villages of Stanytsa Luhanska, Krymske, Shastye, Trekhizbenka and Troytske had been attacked by the militants.

"In Trekhizbenka an artillery shell fired by the militants exploded in a private courtyard and severly wounded a 43-year-old woman, severing her leg, while other injured people were hospitalized," Moskal said.

In a number of settlements supplies of water, gas and electricity have been cut off due to damage from the fighting. In Shastye, a barrage of Grad rockets fired by the militants broke a gas pipeline, leaving the village, and several others in militant-controlled territory, without gas. "Since the ceasefire began, from September 6 up to November 18, 957 fatalities were recorded - 838 men and 119 women, although some may have been killed prior to the ceasefire, with the data only recorded later," reads the report of the Office of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights, which was published on Thursday.

From mid-April to 18 November, at least 4,317 people were killed and 9,921 wounded in the conflict-affected area of eastern Ukraine.

Russian national Igor Strelkov, a former commander of pro-Moscow separatists in eastern Ukraine, has claimed personal responsibility for unleashing the conflict in which 4,300 people have been killed since April.

"I was the one who pulled the firing trigger of this war..." If our unit hadn't crossed the border, in the end everything would have fizzled out, like in Kharkiv, like in Odessa. There would have been several dozen killed, burned, detained. Girkin was quoted as saying: "Initially I assumed that the Crimea scenario would be repeated: Russia would enter... Nobody intended to fight for the Luhansk and Donetsk republics". At the start of this summer, 90% of rebel forces were made up of local residents, Strelkov said. However, by early August, Russian servicemen supposedly on "vacation" from the army had begun to arrive. The assault on the Black Sea town of Mariupol was conducted mostly by the Russian military "vacationers." Strelkov said that when he understood "that Russia was not going to take us in — I associated myself with the resistance — for us that decision was a shock." While Moscow has repeatedly denied supplying the rebels with weaponry and manpower, Strelkov said the assistance offered to rebels remained significant.

The SMM could not determine whether they were outgoing or impacting shells," reads the document.

It notes that on November 21 in Luhansk the SMM met the director of the department of the State Penitentiary Service of Luhansk region.

"The interlocutor stated that he will try to evacuate all prisoners (approximately 7,000) and correctional service staff (around 2,000 including 1,000 small arms) to government-controlled territory by December 1, 2014. The State Penitentiary Service representatives brought up that the main reasons for relocation are humanitarian: problems with electricity and heating, increasing difficulties of food supply as well as shelling in the vicinity of some correctional facilities," the report says.

Terrorists kill two civilians, 27.11.2014
