

Monitoring of Xenophobia and Extremism in Ukraine October 2015

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Introduction

Military conflict in the Donbas has entered a new phase. Withdrawal of small-caliber weapons from the boundary line before the next negotiations in the "Norman Quartet" in Paris marked the beginning of a long period in the diplomatic struggle for the restoration of the territorial integrity of Ukraine.

It is pretty clear that the Novorossiya project has failed. The attempt to grab about a third of Ukraine and shut it off from access to the sea has failed. It looks like the Ukrainian army has got its act together and the Russians together with a relatively small ragtag group of local separatists are not going to be able to push forward so that project has failed." The political analyst believes that "Putin's task is to reintegrate this separatist portion of eastern Ukraine into the rest of Ukraine as an internal poisoned pill." "Putin is pushing the idea that local elections must be held but what kind of local elections can take place under the rule of the gun of terrorists who have killed people and who are torturing people in basements. This is ridiculous." The world is changing rapidly. Humanity once again craves for another technological revolution, radically changing the way of life and the way of people's thinking. Local elections have shown that in many areas where the lead unit of Petro Poroshenko, the result will be formed regional councils controlled by the opposition. It is this majority will in many areas of central Ukraine. Elections to local councils brought quite unexpected results. Ukrainians have not only shown no spectacular appearance, but also proved to be tuned somewhat less radical than that expected policy. Overall turnout in the country has not held up to 50%.

Prognosis

Only 8% of Ukrainians favor closer ties with Russia - Poll, 13.10.2015

At the same time 14% of the population supports the idea Ukraine have no close relations either with Europe or with Russia. The survey shows that half of Ukrainians believe Ukraine will benefit from forging closer political and economic relations with Europe rather than with Russia. In addition, according to the study, 19% of the respondents say Ukraine should have close relations with both Europe and Russia, while another 14% of citizens would rather see Ukraine have no close relations with either Europe or Russia.

CVU exit poll returns: Incumbent mayor Klitschko leading with 40.4%, 25.10.2015

The poll was conducted by the Social Monitoring organization at the CVU's request. Livy Bereh portal published simultaneous counts of votes by Solidarnist, in keeping with which Klitschko received 41.1%, Bondarenko got 9.7%, and Serhiy Gusovsky, a member of Kyiv City Council, leader of the Samopomich faction at Kyiv City Council and a restaurateur, was third with 8.7%. At the same time, the results of the exit poll conducted by the Savik Shuster Studio show that Klitschko ranked first with 38.40%, Gusovsky was 2nd with 9.20%. The 3rd place was occupied by Borislav Bereza, the leader of the Rishuchi Hromadiany (Resolute Citizens) Party with 8.50%, while Bondarenko ranked only fourth with 8%.

Poll: 54% of Russians support airstrikes in Syria, while 59% not willing to accept refugees, 27.10.2015

The survey shows that Russians closely monitor the Syrian conflict. According to the results of October, only 11% know nothing about the situation Syria (last month it was a third of citizens). The number of those who are not interested in the policy of the Russian leadership in Syria has reduced from 33% to 18%. Almost 39% of respondents believe the main harm from Russia's military campaign is deaths of Russian servicemen during the operation or in terrorist attacks against them. Among other threats, the respondents identified a threat "to be involved in this conflict for a long time" and "an increase in the terrorist threat from the Islamic State (ISIS)." A total of 11% saw no harm.

23.8 percent of Ukrainians ready to resist occupation by force of arms, - survey, 28.10.2015

28.6 percent of respondents, who were asked what actions they would prefer under foreign military intervention in their town or village, had chosen the option of resistance by participating in acts of civil resistance (demonstrations, protests, boycotts, etc.), 23.8 percent would engage in armed resistance, 11 percent would prefer to go to a safer area, 3.2 percent would go abroad, and 13.1 percent would not take any action. 34.7 percent of interviewees considered nonviolent struggle to be the most efficient way to combat the armed invasion by the enemy's overwhelming power; 34.4 percent - the armed struggle and 28.5 percent undecided. 34.8 percent supported the nonviolent struggle under armed occupation while 34.2 percent were for armed resistance.

Besides, asked about the actions they would take part in against large-scale long-term foreign armed intervention, 25.9% of respondents indicated military action as part of the guerrilla forces or the army, while more than half (58.4%) of those, who consider Crimea to be occupied and the events in Donbas to be intervention, were not ready for such actions.

Russia air strikes 'probably' not in IS areas: US defense chief, 01.10.2015

Washington (AFP) - Russia's air strikes in Syria on Wednesday "probably" did not target Islamic State jihadists, US Defense Secretary Ashton Carter said, contradicting Russian claims. "It does appear (the strikes) were in areas where there were probably not ISIL forces," Carter said, using an alternative acronym for the IS group. The Russian defense ministry had said its strikes targeted IS militants. Russia's military involvement in Syria only risks inflaming the years-old conflict, Carter said. Moscow's "approach is tantamount... to pouring gasoline on the fire," he said at the Pentagon, hours after Russia launched air strikes in Syria. http://news.yahoo.com/russias-pouring-gasoline-fire-syria-us-defense-chief-182843432.html

EU: agreement on small-caliber weapons withdrawal in Donbas "positive step", 01.10.2015 "The agreement on the withdrawal of tanks, artillery under 100mm and mortars up to 120mm in eastern Ukraine reached yesterday (29 September) within the Trilateral Contact Group's working group on security is a positive step forward," reads the statement by the Spokesperson of High Representative of the European Union for Foreign Affairs Federica Mogherini. The EU official also noted that "the withdrawal would strengthen the ceasefire, which has been largely holding since 1 September 2015, and contribute to the complete implementation of the Minsk agreements in full respect of Ukraine's independence, sovereignty and territorial integrity." "To this end, it will be essential that the OSCE SMM is granted full, safe and unrestricted access to all areas and weapon storage points so as to carry out its mandate. Ahead of the Normandy Summit in Paris on October 2, it is now crucial to advance on the implementation of other provisions of the Minsk agreements, notably on local elections," the statement reads.

Lysenko: Agreement on withdrawal of weapons brings end to war in Donbas, 01.10.2015 "We want the war in Donbas to be ended soon, and make every effort for it to happen. We have made a lot of effort both at the state level and at the level of volunteers," he said. "The document signed in Minsk, which is a supplement to the package of measures to implement the Minsk agreements, is another important step that really brings us to the end of war. We are talking about the withdrawal of weapons of 100mm caliber and less, as well as of the armored vehicles," Lysenko said. "This means that they will be withdrawn at a distance of 15 km from the demarcation line. RUSSIA'S ACTIONS IN SYRIA NOT TO ENTAIL LIFTING OF SANCTIONS – GERMAN OFFICIAL, 02.10.2015

"A decisive factor for the lifting of sanctions is a point-by-point fulfillment of Minsk agreements to resolve the situation in Donbas," according to Thomas Oppermann, leader of Germany's Social Democratic Party (SDP) in Bundestag, who spoke ahead of a meeting of a Normandy Four in Paris on Friday, Deutsche Welle reports.

After the beginning of Russian air raids in Syria, Russia has become "an important factor in the military conflict." But this raises a new question, according to Oppermann: "If Putin stands on the side of Assad, to keep him in power at any cost, Syria will see no peace." According to the German politician, the majority of Syrian citizens are fleeing "Assad's brutal civil war." Turchynov: Active hostilities still possible in Donbas, 02.10.2015

"Ukraine fulfills all of its obligations under the Minsk agreements. And we can say that in fact there was no fighting or shelling within a month - there are some cases, which are still keep the situation on the front line tense, but it is a common trend. And this is stated by both international observers and those who are on the front line. But we can't be complacent, we can't say that the danger has passed, we can't say there is no threat that the hostilities resume," Turchynov said.

NATO's stance on Ukraine not changed by Russian operation in Syria, - Stoltenberg, 02.10.2015

"We will never accept that Ukraine is a subject to bargaining," Stoltenberg said. The Secretary General also noted that the stance of the Alliance regarding Ukraine's sovereignty and integrity has not changed. "We continue to support Ukraine, both politically and practically," he said, adding that cooperation with Kyiv might even be extended. "It is encouraging to see that the cease-fire is lasting for the first time: it has been respected since early September. Moreover, the parties have agreed within the trilateral working group of the heavy weapons withdrawal. This is another step forward. The situation is still fragile, the Russian troops remain in Ukraine, but it's encouraging," Stoltenberg commented.

Poroshenko: Putin will try to create 'Novosyria' after defeat in Donbass, 05.10.2015

"Putin has failed to build a coalition with the help of Syria to negotiate Syrian issues," Poroshenko said in an interview with TV journalists. "Putin's wish is very simple: having failed in a strategy for creating a 'Novorossiya' in the east of Ukraine, he cannot give up that logic and will try to create a 'Novosyria' to strengthen his positions." "But the world before Putin's aggression in Syria and the world after Putin's aggression in Syria differ," Poroshenko said. In his words, Putin will try to regain leverage in big-league politics. And "he will try to get there through the back-door entrance – from Syria," Poroshenko said. "Putin hasn't joined the international coalition" – he is on the side of terrorists, according to Poroshenko. "Russia continues to be a sponsor of terrorism, and the world is shocked," he added.

No Russia-NATO Council to be held soon – Stoltenberg, 06.10.2015

"There have been some meetings, I believe, after the crisis in Ukraine started, whether there's going to be a meeting in the foreseeable future, no decision has been taken so far...but we have other ways of communicating with the Russians on the political level, but also on the military level," said Stoltenberg, adding that this communication can also be used in a situation we saw in Turkey [intrusion into Turkish airspace of a Russian fighter jet]. NATO chief also stressed that he welcomes communication between the U.S., who lead the coalition against the

Islamic State, and Russia in order to set mechanisms of preventing incidents between military aircraft of different air forces which operate in the same area. Stoltenberg noted that NATO is not a part of this dialogue, but recognized the need to establish a system, to prevent incident and emergencies in the future.

Klimkin asks parliament to stop misusing "Donbas' special status" term, 07.10.2015

Ukrainian Foreign Minister Pavlo Klimkin insists that Ukrainian lawmakers stop speculating about terminology related to "special status of Donbas." "There is no special status. There is a law on the peculiarities of local self-government [in Donbas], which was adopted by the Verkhovna Rada. The law which respective amendments to the Constitution refer to is the only document that stipulates special aspects of local self-government. That's why, I urge [you] to stop speculating about this terminology," Klimkin said in parliament in Kyiv on Wednesday when asked whether the "Normandy Four" leaders agreed in Paris on October 2 that Donbas' special 'self-rule' status should be sealed in the Ukrainian Constitution.

Sanctions against Russia to remain until Ukraine gets Crimea back – Nuland, 07.10.2015 "The Crimean sanctions will remain until its [Crimean] occupation lasts," US Assistant Secretary of State for European and Eurasian Affairs Victoria Nuland said at a Marshall Fund meeting. At the same time, according to her, the US said that a report on Boeing crash in the east of Ukraine would confirm their position on what and who caused that tragedy. "We expect the Netherlands to publish the results of the investigation within a week or ten days. Russia will pay high price for its aggression - President, 09.10.2015

Putin: Russia obtains high-precision weapons, has will to use it, 11.10.2015

Russia is "forced" to upgrade its army with high-precision and high-tech weapons, since many models are outdated, as the weapons are getting more sophisticated worldwide: "It's not about a global [arms] race," said Russian President Vladimir Putin. "In principle, all of our partners are aware, at least at the expert level, that Russia has (high-precision) weapons in its disposal. One thing is to know at the expert level that Russia allegedly has such weapons, and another thing is to ascertain its existence, in the first place... and [to ascertain] its high quality. Third, that there are people who are well trained and prepared, who may use these weapons systemically. And the fourth, that Russia has the will to use it if it meets the national interests of the state and of the Russian people," said Putin.

NATO chief: Syria, Ukraine crises underline importance of NATO activity, 12.10.2015

"The crises in Syria and Ukraine underline the importance of what NATO is doing. Increasing our ability to protect our Allies, to reinforce and to deploy," he said at the NATO Parliamentary Assembly in Stavanger, Norway. "We are also concerned about Russia's current actions in Ukraine and most recently in the Middle East. About its unacceptable violation of Turkish and NATO airspace. And about Russia's substantial military build-up, its air strikes and its cruise missile attacks," he said. In his words, a political solution is needed more than ever. "We fully support and encourage all efforts by the UN and others to find a negotiated settlement to the conflict in Syria. We also need a peaceful and negotiated solution in Ukraine," he said.

"Why has Putin re-oriented his vector on Syria in a few months? Because they have already been losing in Ukraine. It was necessary to do something and act within the framework of the Minsk agreements, and it meant - to ceaze hostilities. The economic pressure on Ukraine didn't help - Russia restored gas supplies, and there is progress in other issues," former Deputy Chief of Staff Ihor Romanenko said. Almaz-Antey: Second experiment confirms flight MH17 was shot down from district controlled by Ukrainian army, 13.10.2015

The results of two full-scale experiments that simulated the July 17, 2014 shooting down of the Malaysia Airlines flight MH17 in Ukraine fully refuted the Dutch commission's conclusions regarding the type of the missile and the place of its launch, the general director of Russia's missile systems manufacturer Almaz-Antey, Yan Novikov, has said.

"Today we can say straightforward, and we will show this during the presentation, that if the Malaysia Airlines Boeing-777 was shot down by a Buk surface-to-air missile system, it was hit by a 9M38 missile fired from the direction of the locality of Zaroshchinske," he told a press conference on Oct. 13. US defense chief: we will deter Russia's 'malign and destabilizing influence', 14.10.2015 The US defense chief vowed to take "all necessary steps" against a resurgent Russia which is challenging a frustrated Washington in Eastern Europe and the Middle East. Ash Carter, the US defense secretary, said the Russian president, Vladimir Putin, had wrapped his country in a "shroud of isolation" which only a drastic change in policy could reverse. "We will take all necessary steps to deter Russia's malign and destabilizing influence, coercion and aggression," Carter said, attacking Russian military intervention in Ukraine and Syria. Carter said that as long as Russia pursued a "misguided strategy" in Syria to bolster its client Bashar al-Assad, "we have not, and will not, agree to cooperate with Russia".

Malcolm Turnbull vows Australia will seek justice for MH17 victims; Qantas CEO Alan Joyce says safety information should be shared, 14.10.2015

Mr Turnbull addressed the House of Representatives hours after Dutch authorities released their final report into the tragedy, which stated that the flight crashed as a result of the detonation of a BUK missile fired from eastern Ukraine. He said that the "murder" of the 298 people on board was a cowardly crime. "Those who committed this crime must answer for it," he said. "We deplore the conduct of Russia using its Security Council veto in July to block the establishment of a special international criminal tribunal." Meanwhile, Qantas chief executive Alan Joyce told the

National Press Club more could have been done to ensure MH17 was on a safe flightpath. Mr Joyce said Qantas had robust procedures in place to assess risks but security information needed to be accessible to all carriers. Merkel sees 'glimmer of hope' in Ukraine, but Russia sanctions remain, 15.10.2015
Speaking in the Bundestag lower house of parliament, German Chancellor Angela Merkel welcomed a decision by pro-Russian separatists in eastern Ukraine to delay disputed local elections there. She also welcomed the fact that a truce has been largely holding since the start of September, allowing the adversaries to extend a pull-back of weapons and raising hopes for the fragile peace process. "I'm speaking of a glimmer of hope, nothing more and nothing less," the conservative leader said. "But this offers us the opportunity now to finally make progress on the road to a political solution." But she added that the sanctions against Russia could be removed only when the peace plan, worked out in Minsk, Belarus, in February, had been fully complied with.

"The first condition – no one will hold elections under the muzzles of Russian machine guns. They have to withdraw from the territory of Ukraine and fulfill the Minsk agreements," said Yatsenyuk. Ousted president Yanukovych sues Ukraine in European court, 19.10.2015

A law firm representing former Ukrainian President Viktor Yanukovych says he is suing Ukraine for violating his human rights. Yanukovych fled to Russia in February 2014 following months of anti-government protests. He later insisted he was threatened and forced to leave the country. London-based Joseph Hage Aaronson said in a statement on Monday that Yanukovych has lodged a lawsuit against Ukraine's government with the European Court of Human Rights for "repeatedly" violating his human rights.

A district court in Kiev in August began trying Yanukovych in absentia for his alleged role in the massacre on Kiev's main square at the end of the protest. His lawyers said Yanukovych has suffered "discriminatory treatment due to his political status and opinions" and that he cannot return to Ukraine because of security risks.

Russia holding out of debt restructuring not to prevent Ukraine from entering foreign debt markets: expert, 20.10.2015

"The 'Russian' debt will not really prevent Ukraine from penetrating foreign markets in the future, even if the issue remains unresolved for a long time and will be decided in the courts. The upgrade of Ukraine's ratings by S&P suggests that the issue of the 'Russian' debt is considered separately. Regarding the Russian debt, S&P has already registered default, so any payment or non-payment in December will not change anything. The international lenders, to some extent, take the unresolved issue with Russia "out of the brackets," he said. According to the expert, there are two scenarios in respect of the Russian loan -- either Ukraine pays \$3 billion in December in case the IMF recognizes this debt as interstate, or litigation will ensue. "With the 100% probability, they will sue. It is their right, and a logical action. The bonds were issued under the British legislation, so Russia will file suit with the British court, respectively. And there are no grounds to reject this lawsuit. It's just that Ukraine will have also filed counterclaims by this time, related to the annexation of Crimea, and so on," he added.

"No Fighting" in Ukraine is Not "Peace", 20.10.2015

The main problem with the West's approach to Russian President Vladimir Putin is that it doesn't seem to know who it's dealing with. In an excellent article in Foreign Policy, Raymond Tanter states the bleatingly obvious—the Russian leader is nothing but a bully and should be treated as such. While the United States and Europe favor a "win-win" approach, Putin prefers the "I win, you lose" model. Any attempt to find common ground with someone who thinks this way is doomed to fail. They tend to view a desire to compromise as a sign of weakness. So now that we have that out of the way, the fact that heavy weapons have been silenced in the Donbas and the Russian propaganda machine is focusing its coverage on Syria (and a recent blast of lies on MH17) is unfortunately not good news for Ukraine. The recent summit in Paris in early October revealed that French President François Hollande and German Chancellor Angela Merkel simply want Ukraine to "go away."

Russia has not responded to the request of the Prosecutor General's Office of Ukraine (PGO) for the extradition of former president of Ukraine Viktor Yanukovych, chief of the PGO special investigations directorate Serhiy Horbatiuk has said. "There is no reply from Russian law enforcement agencies on the decision to arrest and extradite Yanukovych since a year despite our reminding them," he said. According to Horbatiuk, the Russian authorities have refused to confirm that Yanukovych is present in the country, despite the fact that lawyers representing Yanukovych had given the Ukrainian authorities the address of Yanukovych's residence in Russia, which was subsequently provided to Russian law enforcers. "We sent this information to Russian law enforcement agencies for them to confirm it and detain Yanukovych. Top U.S. Admiral Says NATO Should Rework Maritime Strategy, 22.10.2015

Russia's stepped up naval operations and other threats mean that the North Atlantic Treaty Organization should reexamine maritime strategy, the new head of the U.S. Navy said. Addressing the top naval officers in Europe at a meeting in Venice, Italy, U.S. Navy Adm. John Richardson, who recently became Chief of Naval Operations, said Russia has demonstrated growing prowess with its ships and demonstrated a willingness to use military coercion. Russian submarine patrols increased by more than 50% from 2013 to 2014, Adm. Richardson said, and its fleet has increased its range.

"Their operational tempo has risen to levels not seen in over a decade," he said in his speech in Venice. "Their proficiency is increasing." Russia unveiled a new naval doctrine in August, which western observers argue sets the stage for a more aggressive military posture by the Kremlin. But NATO has not updated its naval strategy since 2011. "Enough has changed with the Russia threat, with migration issues, with the rise of information systems that it may be time to take another look at the NATO maritime strategy to see if it adequately describes the problem set that we have got," Adm. Richardson said in an interview after his speech.

Ukraine Embassy: Veto on U.S. defense bill not obstacle to arming Kyiv, 23.10.2015

"U.S. President Barack Obama vetoed the defense policy bill for 2016 due to a number of reasons, which are not related to the volume of assistance to Ukraine, which is foreseen in this document," the embassy said. In particular, it notes that the U.S. president explained his veto by budget cuts, which remain in force, by the Congress's ignoring of a number of White House-proposed reforms to modernize the army, as well as that the provisions of this document make it impossible to close the Guantanamo Bay detention center, which has been Obama's main goal since his presidential campaign. According to the embassy, Obama didn't reject the military assistance to Ukraine in the amount of \$300 million for the next year. Now the document has been sent back to the Congress, where the votes of two-thirds of the Senate and the House of Representatives are necessary to overcome the presidential veto. Under congressional rules, the House will consider the veto before the Senate. A vote has been scheduled for November 5.

However, the U.S. Ambassador has expressed concern that the vote did not take place on October 25 in the city of Mariupol and in the town of Chervonoarmyisk in Donetsk region. In response, Okhendovsky noted that the CEC deemed fundamentally important, from the beginning of the election process, to organize elections in Mariupol, given that it is the largest government-controlled city in Donbas in terms of the number of voters, where the rule of law, established by the Constitution of Ukraine and the Ukrainian laws, is enforced.

"The election campaign in Dnipropetrovsk was accompanied by a series of scandals, conflicts and numerous violations of the electoral legislation," he said. According to Koshel, an ultra-high competition between the main candidates has been observed in Dnipropetrovsk, that's why the CVU expects that the whole range of illegal election technologies can be used in the second round. The second "hot spot," according to Koshel, is Uzhgorod. "The basis for this assessment is that the potential winners have actually swapped in the city. If we take the expert estimates, and if we take the results of sociological research, and if we look at the quality of the campaign, we can say that there is a complete mismatch of forecasts with the results of elections," he said. In addition, he said that the CVU received "hotline" information, which "was almost impossible to prove," regarding bribery of voters before or on election day." The third "hot spot," according to Koshel, will be Odesa. "During the election campaign, we recorded a number of violations of the law. Ukraine local elections generally respected democratic process, but additional efforts needed to enhance public confidence, international observers say, 26.10.2015

Ukraine's local elections were competitive and well organized overall, and the campaign generally showed respect for the democratic process, international observers concluded in a statement issued today. Nevertheless, the complexity of the legal framework, the dominance of powerful economic groups, threats and physical attacks against candidates, and the fact that virtually all campaign coverage in the media was paid for all underscore the need for further reform. Additional efforts are needed to further enhance the integrity of and public confidence in the electoral process, the observers said. The observers stressed that the elections took place in a challenging political, economic, humanitarian and security environment, characterized by the illegal annexation of the Crimean peninsula by the Russian Federation and the temporary control of parts of the territory of the Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts by illegal armed groups. This made it impossible for more than 5 million voters in these areas to vote. Despite resolute efforts by the Central Election Commission (CEC) to organize elections throughout the country, they could not be held in parts of the Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts or on the Crimean peninsula.

Annual volume of financing is calculated by multiplying two-hundredths of minimal wage as of January 1 of the year before the allocation of funds by the total number of voters in previous elections within the state multi-mandate constituency.

Funding shall only be provided to parties which gained over 3% of votes within the state constituency in previous elections.

Creating new Ukrainian Army, 16.10.2015

Over the past one and a half years not only have Ukraine's Armed Forces changed fundamentally, but also the country's entire security and defense sectors, experts say. However, they believe that, unfortunately, not all the problems were solved, to give birth to a brand new army. Ex-deputy chief of the General Staff, Lieutenant General Ihor Romanenko, says that one of the major problems yet to be solved is military funding. "If the government's priority is to fight for the interests of the people and the state in the war, how come financing the Armed Forces is not a top priority? I welcome the creation of a brand new patrol police, but if they earn UAH 8,000, while the mobilized soldiers and contractors on the contact line [in Donbas] get somewhere between UAH 5,000-6,000 thousand, and in ATO – just UAH 2,500-3,000. In my opinion, this approach is wrong," he said.

Ukrainian Parliament holds roundtable entitled "Openness of authorities through access to public information", 20.10.2015

The participants of the roundtable drew attention to the fact that the legislative background in this field was ensured by the Law of Ukraine "On access to public information," which was adopted on January 13 and further enacted on May 9, 2011.

"The law has reformed the relations between the citizens and state authorities," the participants of the roundtable noted. The legislative framework of the access to information administered by the state structures has revealed both positive and negative aspects during 4.5 years of its existence. The absolute advantage of the legal framework of Ukraine as against the ones in all other countries was called the term of fulfillment of the request within five working days. At the same time, this term is much longer in other countries (for instance, in Britain it takes 20 days). The participants paid attention that in some EU countries officials even ignored the law at the local level. Ukraine to raise issue of legitimacy of Russian sanctions against Ukrainian airlines in possible consultations, 20.10.2015

Fully reformed Ukrainian judicial system will lack 8,000 judges – presidential administration, 20.10.2015

Regardless of how the judicial system is reformed, either by the recertification or reappointment of judges, a significant number of the judiciary will consist of former staff, deputy head of the presidential administration Oleksiy Filatov has said. "I personally believe that there is no critical difference between the two proposals [on how to upgrade the judiciary]. The result will be the same," Filatov said at the forum "Respectable and Apolitical Themis through Constitutional Changes" in Kyiv. He said that if the judicial system is fully reformed there will be a shortage of almost 8,000 new judges. "If we pass certification or dismiss the existing [judges] and appoint new judges, we'll obtain the same result. The major part of the judiciary will consist of the same judges who work now," Filatov said.

Anti-terrorist center under Security Service of Ukraine reports, 21.10.2015

In the course of their personal search, UAH 1,880 million divided equally between them was found. According to the detainees, this money was intended to finance pro-Russian protests in Dnipropetrovsk. Presently, the investigators are establishing the recipients and origins of money as well as persons engaged in organizing of channel for illegal financing of unlawful actions. Seized money was recognized as material evidence within the mentioned criminal proceeding.

Flights Between Ukraine And Russia To Be Banned Despite Negotiations, 23.10.2015 Flights between Ukraine and Russia will be banned starting this weekend despite a last-ditch effort by senior Russian officials, according to Ukraine's infrastructure minister. "From October 25 there will not be air traffic with Russian cities," Minister Andrei Pivovarsky told reporters, according to Russian state news agency TASS. Russian and Ukrainian officials met on Friday in Brussels as part of a Russian-led effort to prevent the Ukrainian-initiated plans to ban flights between the countries. Russian Transportation Minister Maxim Sokolov told reporters that his country would continue to push for the bans to be removed. Ukraine announced late last month that it would ban flights from Russia starting on October 25. Russia quickly retaliated with a titfor-tat ban that would go into effect on the same day.

Human rights defenders submit communication on war crimes in Donbas to the ICC, 26.10.2015

An IPHR delegation present in The Hague handed over the communication together with a unique compilation of over 300 first-hand testimonies from victims and witnesses to representatives of the ICC's situation analysis section on Ukraine. The IPHR communication was submitted as part of a project aimed at fighting impunity for serious violations perpetrated during the ongoing armed conflict in southeast Ukraine. At the meeting with the ICC representatives, IPHR Project Coordinator and Advocacy Officer Simon Papuashvili explained that a total of 32 missions have been carried out as part of this project and over 300 victim and witness statements compiled. He said that for each case and episode reported, contextual information, details of the alleged crime and information on the possible perpetrators have been included. Oct 2 International monitors say they have spotted a new kind of Russian weapons system in rebel-held Ukraine this week, possible evidence of Moscow's continued interest in Ukraine even as it focuses on Syria. The Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe, which is monitoring a ceasefire in eastern Ukraine, reported that its monitors had seen a mobile TOS-1 'Buratino' weapons system for the first time. The Buratino is equipped with thermobaric warheads which spread a flammable liquid around a target and then ignite it. It can destroy several city blocks in one strike and cause indiscriminate damage. Only Russia produces the system and it was not exported to Ukraine before the conflict broke out, according to IHS Jane's Group and the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute, which track arms exports.

Tandyt also said that the bodies of 400 Ukrainian servicemen were still in the militant-controlled territory. "About 400 bodies are in the territory where laws do not work – these are unidentified bodies," he said. "As of today, 148 Ukrainians are being held captive by the combined Russian-separatist forces. The Kremlin is using them as political hostages," Tandyt added.

The Donetsk BCP continued to experience more traffic than the Gukovo BCP. Russia to consider Savchenko extradition if asked; defense responds, 01.10.2015

The question of Savchenko's possible extradition to Ukraine can be discussed if Ukraine recognizes the Russian court's verdict and guarantees she serves sentence in Ukraine, according to the ministry's press service. On September 30, 2015 it was reported that Savchenko would be able to apply for the extradition to Ukraine after the verdict in Russia. Her lawyers will be able to ask for this as soon as the verdict comes into force. Savchenko's defense immediately reacted. Mark Feygin, Nadia Savchenko's lawyer, commented on this proposal saying that it suggests his client's innocence is proved. "In connection with the statement the Ministry of Justice about the possibility of Savchenko's extradition to Ukraine after the conviction to serve her sentence... The Ministry of Justice announced its conditions: Ukraine (as well as Savchenko) must recognize the verdict of the Russian court and ensure the service of sentence," Feygin wrote on Twitter. "For clarity. The recognition of the Russian court's verdict by Ukraine may block the opportunity to appeal the decision in the ECHR," he tweeted. According to Feygin, the guarantee of Savchenko serving sentence in Ukraine is a "burden of country's external obligations."

PROSECUTOR: MH17 INVESTIGATION GOING WELL, 01.07.2015

The criminal investigation into the cause of the disaster with flight MH17 in eastern Ukraine is going well, according to chief prosecutor Fred Westerbeke.

The chief prosecutor of the Public Prosecutor's national office said on Tuesday that though the investigators haven't reached the point of "formally" identifying suspects, they have a group of potential suspects in view, NU reports. "We are getting closer to legal and convincing evidence." he said. According to the Public Prosecutor, the most likely scenario is that the Malaysian Airlines airplane was shot down by a BUK-missile. But that is not the only scenario that the Prosecutor is looking at. Experts are busy investigating alternative scenarios in order to substantiate or exclude them.

NY confrontation, assimetric Kremlin, and Paris talks, 03.10.2015 Although the United Nations is by no means a world government, the world leaders gather in New York each fall to discuss global issues. This time, besides sustainable development, the Syrian and Donbas crises were on top agenda. Not only have Barack Obama and Vladimir Putin exchanged harsh addresses at the UN, but they have also they have held a bilateral meeting, the first in two years. Fortunately, it had no special outcome for Ukraine, so Russia decided to raise the geopolitical stakes dramatically by launching its first air strikes in Syria. The manner of Russian warfare is strongly reminiscent of the tradition of undeclared wars. Besides, it would be much more difficult for the Kremlin to call for establishing an antiterrorist coalition. Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko also gave an address in New York. The president's busy schedule of his U.S. visit should be particularly noted, as he used every opportunity not to let the issue of Donbas crisis be left by the wayside. It seems that the Ukrainian leader succeeded. At least, his speech at the Sustainable Development Summit and at the general debate have left no one in doubting as to the nature of Russia's actions. Poroshenko mainly addressed the members of the General Assembly, many of whom are representatives of the third world countries, and therefore he was speaking English. He managed to weave the Ukrainian issues into the fabric of global agenda, which suggests that the situation in Donbas remains in spotlight.

Putin wants to topple Ukraine's government, not to engineer a 'frozen conflict', 07.10.2015 Is Russian President Vladimir Putin trying to engineer a frozen conflict in Eastern Ukraine? That's what some observers argue: that the main goal of sending troops there is to create permafrost, much like what Russia has going in Transdnistria, Moldova, and Abkhazia and South Ossetia in Georgia. Those conflicts have been described as "a string of nasty small wars [that] have been settled not through peace deals but simply by freezing each side's positions." Neither side can win a decisive victory. And so the nasty little war eventually freezes into long-term suspended animation: The dispute remains but fighting ceases. But that's not what Russia wants in Ukraine. A frozen conflict would harm, not help, its strategic interests there. It's far more likely that the conflict will keep burning, despite formal cease-fire agreements.

\$300,000,000 may be available to the Secretary of Defense, in coordination with the Secretary of State, to provide appropriate security assistance and intelligence support, including training, equipment, and logistics support, supplies and services, to military and other security forces of the Government of Ukraine, according to the website of the U.S. Congress. Appropriate security assistance and intelligence support includes real time or near real time actionable intelligence, lethal assistance such as anti-armor weapon systems, mortars, crew-served weapons and ammunition, grenade launchers and ammunition, small arms and ammunition.

Belarus President Alexander Lukashenko Wins Re-Election, 11.10.2015

Belarusian President Alexander Lukashenko, a pro-Russia autocrat, swept to victory on Sunday in an election that raises the prospects of a thaw in the country's relations with the European Union. Mr. Lukashenko, a former collective-farm boss who has ruled this former Soviet republic of some 10 million for more than two decades, won five more years in power with 83.5% of votes, according to preliminary results from the country's election commission. The 61-year-old Mr. Lukashenko has faced little opposition in Belarus, a country wedged between Russia and the EU where the state dominates the economy. He depends on Moscow for financial and political support, but has made recent overtures to the EU in an apparent attempt to foster ties. He released political prisoners in August, including the last one of several former presidential candidates jailed after the last election in 2010, and a small protest Sunday evening passed peacefully.

Ukraine halves electricity supply to occupied Crimea, - blockade coordinator Isliamov, 13.10.2015

At the moment, Ukraine supplies 505 MW of electricity to Crimea while the previous average supply amounted to 850-900 MW. The figures were announced by Crimea's blockade coordinator Lenur Isliamov. According to Isliamov, occupants were forced to put three power plants into operation in Crimea, which together can provide 250 MW of electricity. At the same time, a single Melitopol-Dzhankoi power line, which is now blocked by the activists, provided 330 MW.

Ukraine elected non-permanent member of UN Security Council, 15.10.2015

The results have been announced by President of the 70th session of the United Nations General Assembly, Mogens Lykketoft. A total of 192 countries took part in voting and one ballot was recognized invalid. The UN Security Council consists of 15 countries. The permanent members include the following five governments: China, France, Russia, the United Kingdom, and the United States. Each of the five permanent members of the Security Council has veto power over any matter voted upon by the Security Council. The remaining ten non-permanent members of the total membership of fifteen countries are chosen based on various regions of the world. The ten non-permanent members serve two year terms and half are replaced each year in annual elections. Each region votes for its own representatives and the United Nations General Assembly approves the selections.

Indications of an improving relationship between Kyiv and Moscow have given rise to speculation that a grand bargain may be taking shape to bring stability after a year of slow-burning conflict in eastern Ukraine. But despite the gains made in the past month, a broader settlement likely will not be reached before the end of the year for several reasons, according to Stratfor, U.S.-based geopolitical intelligence and consulting firm.

In crowded Mediterranean, NATO showcases military force, 18.10.2015

NATO and its allies will open their biggest military exercise in more than a decade on Monday in a show of strength in the central Mediterranean that takes place as Russia seeks to reassert itself across the water in the Levant. While the exercises were planned long before Russia's build-up in Syria and are independent of events, the escalation of conflicts across North Africa and the Middle East are challenging NATO to react to multiple threats on its borders. Committing 36,000 troops, 230 military units, 140 aircraft and more than 60 ships over five weeks, NATO and its allies want to show they can act in what British defence minister Michael Fallon has called "a darker and more dangerous world". Some of the North Atlantic alliance's most senior officials will descend on an air base in southern Italy for an aircraft and helicopter showcase on Monday, facing questions about how to react to a Russian threat no longer just on its eastern flank.

Another Russian "aid" convoy crosses Ukrainian border, 22.10.2015

Another convoy of trucks that Moscow says is carrying humanitarian aid to Ukrainians in Donbas has crossed the border of Ukraine, the National Center for Crisis Management of the Russian Emergency Situations Ministry reported on Thursday.

The convoy was divided into two parts en route: some trucks went to the Donetsk border crossing point, while the other part went to the Matveev Kurgan border crossing point. It is emphasized that the procedures at the checkpoints were carried out in the presence of the Ukrainian customs and border service officials, as well as OSCE observers.

"After the customs clearance of humanitarian cargo, over 100 vehicles with more than 1,000 tonnes of humanitarian aid were heading towards the unloading points in Donetsk and Luhansk regions." the report says.

Switzerland sends another aid convoy to conflict region, 26.10.2015

Two further Swiss Humanitarian Aid (HA) convoys have brought goods to supply suffering population on both sides of the contact line in eastern Ukraine. The aid consists mainly of chemicals and apparatus for the production of chlorine, essential for providing clean drinking water. In addition, two hospitals in Donetsk have been supplied with medicines. A total of 505 tonnes of aid worth around CHF 1 million has been delivered. One convoy of 20 trucks carrying 293 tonnes of goods reached the city of Donetsk on 26 October. Among the transported goods were aluminium sulphate and chlorine, destined for the Donbas waterworks, and reagents and cancer medicines for two hospitals. The convoy set out from Dnipropetrovsk on 24 October. On the first day it headed south to Mariupol on the Sea of Asov, and then continued north-east over the contact line at Volnovakha to Donetsk. Five further trucks joined the convoy as far as Mariupol, where 100 tonnes of chemical water treatment products were unloaded. Previously a convoy of six trucks carrying 112 tonnes of water treatment chemicals reached the city of Krasnoarmiisk on the government-controlled side of the contact line. Swiss Humanitarian Aid also delivered four WATA chlorine-production systems which will allow the local authorities to produce chlorine solution locally and sustainably to treat water for 20,000 people in four districts.

According to Semenenko's son, his father left with police officers and could not be reached since noon.

Russia intends to dissolve Moscow-based Library of Ukrainian Literature, 30.10.2015 Investigators stayed in the library premises until 21:00 and left the building through a back entrance. Natalya Sharina was taken with them, according to Krykunenko. He added he did not know anything about the court-imposed restraining measure, but said he was called in for questioning on Friday, along with an accountant and maintenance unit deputy director. At the same time, Echo of Moscow reported that Sharina had not yet been issued any documents about her detention. According to her lawyer Yevgeniy Smirnov, the library director has suffered two hypertensive crises after the arrest. It is reported that Moscow is set to dissolve the Library of Ukrainian Literature and transfer it into a branch of the Moscow House of Nationalities.
