Introduction

Upcoming holidays for politicians in both the Old World and the New prompt a search for new ways to resolve the Donbas conflict. The latest PACE session can be seen as quite successful for the Ukrainian delegation, and NATO continues to support Ukraine.

The situation in the Donbas continues to teeter between peace and war. The constant provocations by militants seem to cause no surprise any more, and nor does Russia's desire at any cost to "return" to Ukraine the now occupied territories - on Moscow's own terms. To do this, the Kremlin even let Viktor Yanukovich graze for a little while in the information field. The disgraced ex-president diligently duplicated in his interview with the BBC Russia's freshest messages on the prospects of settlement the Donbas crisis and the return of Crimea.

It is no wonder that a meeting of the Contact Group in Minsk, and the summit of the Foreign Ministers' Normandy Quartet in Paris ended with no results. The only interesting thing that happened in the capital of Belarus was the debut of a new OSCE representative from Austria, Martin Sajdik, who replaced his Swiss colleague Heidi Tagliavini. The foreign ministers agreed to negotiate. Reports that the European Union is putting pressure on Ukraine to ensure the unilateral implementation of the Minsk Agreement regarding the holding of elections in the occupied areas of Donbas were not confirmed. However, it should be understood that the EU is concerned about the current situation, while Ukraine is a member of the international community, and it is actually convenient to put pressure on it, especially now, when the state looks weak as never before. The best response for Kyiv would be to provide a sensible policy for the Donbas and implement reforms as soon as possible.

However, Russia still lacks consistency in its actions. Trying to portray itself as a civilized member of the international community, Putin's regime fails in important details. A good example

was the Kremlin's negative reaction toward the idea of establishing a special UN tribunal to investigate the MH17 case.

No less interesting is to see how the Russian media try to convince their viewers that the mass protests in Yerevan are due to Ukraine's influence. They seem to have forgotten that Armenia's foreign policy has always been and still remains Moscow-oriented. But any "Maidan" is regarded by the Kremlin as a threat.

The Russian delegation to the PACE will be deprived of voting powers until January 2016, so RF representatives do not personally visit Strasbourg but use their various agents of influence, among them Ukrainian Communists leader Petro Symonenko. However, this did not save Russia from the the first mentioning of the term "Russian aggression" in the official documents of the PACE. There is no need to exaggerate, but it really is a milestone on the path of changes in the European attitude toward the Donbas conflict.

Today, there is consistent political and financial support through trust funds from NATO, but Ukraine's Defense Minister Stepan Poltorak says the supply of lethal weapons is also possible in the event of an escalation in the Donbas. NATO Secretary General Jens Stoltenberg assured that NATO would never recognize the annexation of Crimea and will intensify its efforts to support Ukraine.

However, against the background of a dramatically altered security environment, the modernisation of the Ukrainian army and the finalisation of the unfinished defence reforms are urgent, not only in order to guarantee the country's security, but also within the framework of the consolidation of democracy in post-Maidan Ukraine.

Prognosis and polls

Expert assessment "President Poroshenko's First Year in Power", DIF, 05.06.2015

General score for the first year in Office was 5.3 points out of 10 possible. The most successful, in the view of experts, is – foreign policy achievements (7.3 points). Also, mostly positive assessment the President received for cooperation with the Parliament (6.4 points) and government (5.8 points). Furthermore, the experts gave Poroshenko (5.5 points) for his actions in defence policy, the functions guarantor of the Constitution and the rights and freedoms of citizens (5.4 points) and interaction with society (4.6 points). As for progress in reforms most experts assessed this are in negative term with only 4 points and this bring fulfilment of his election promises, in the eyes of the experts to only 3.7 points.

Analysing the achievements of the President, the experts pointed first of all to his role in the formation of an international coalition of countries and organizations that supported Ukraine in its conflict with Russia. He also was praised for signing the Association Agreement with the EU. As for domestic policy, Poroshenko's main achievements are: successful early parliamentary elections, freezing the acute phase of hostilities in the Donbas, preventing the spread of separatism in other regions of Ukraine, as well as enhancing the combat readiness of the Ukrainian armed forces. Some experts also mentioned Poroshenko efforts in preserving political stability in the country and some individual reform efforts. As for main failures during the first year, experts agreed on poor human resources policy (in particular in the context of the appointment of the Prosecutor General Vitaliy Yarema, Defense Minister Valery Gelety and head of the National Bank of Valerie Gontareva) and a very weak progress in implementing reforms expected by society. The inability of the President to perform one of the most high-profile campaign promises – to sell his business – has been the subject of criticism among the surveyed experts. In addition, some experts said Poroshenko failed to successfully complete the anti-terrorist operation despite his promises before the elections.

NATO Publics Blame Russia for Ukrainian Crisis, but Reluctant to Provide Military Aid, 10.06.2015

Publics of key member nations of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) blame Russia for the ongoing conflict in Ukraine. Many also see Russia as a military threat to other neighboring states. But few support sending arms to Ukraine. Moreover, at least half of Germans, French and Italians say their country should *not* use military force to defend a NATO ally if attacked by Russia. A median of 39% among NATO publics say Russia is the main culprit in the ongoing conflict in eastern Ukraine. The pro-Russian separatists in Luhans'k and Donets'k (18%) are a distant second. Half say Russia is a major military threat to other neighboring nations. In response to the crisis, 70% among allied countries say Western countries should send economic aid to Ukraine. A majority (57%) also supports Ukraine becoming a member of NATO. NATO nations are hesitant, however, to escalate their involvement in the conflict, especially militarily. Comparatively few support sending arms to Ukraine (median of 41%). And many allied countries are reluctant to uphold Article 5 of the North Atlantic Treaty, which requires NATO members to defend an ally with armed force if necessary. A median of 48% among these publics say their country should use military force if Russia gets into a serious military conflict with a neighboring nation that is a NATO ally, while 42% are opposed. Americans and Canadians are the only publics where more than half think their country should use military action if Russia attacks a fellow NATO member (56% and 53%, respectively). Germans (58%) are the most likely to say their country should *not*. All NATO member publics are more likely to think the United States *will* come to an ally's defense (median of 68%) than to be willing to do so themselves.

Yatseniuk-led People's Front doesn't make 5% barrier in hypothetical Rada elections – poll, 19.06.2015

Seven political forces that have the support of 5% or more voters could have a chance of making it to the Verkhovna Rada if parliamentary elections were held in Ukraine this coming Sunday, shows a poll conducted by the sociological group Rating on June 3-13.

A total of 16.4% of the respondents who said they would vote said they would vote for Petro Poroshenko's bloc Solidarnist, and Samopomich, Opposition Bloc and Batkivschyna would get 10.5%, 10.2% and 10.0%, respectively. A total of 6.3% of the respondents said they back the Radical Party, 5.7% said they would vote for Civil Position, 5.3% said they would vote for Right Sector, 3.8% said they would vote for Svoboda, 2.7% said they would vote for the People's Front, 2.5% said they would vote for the Ukrainian Communist Party, and 2.1% said they would vote for Strong Ukraine. The other parties received the support of less than 1% of the respondents each, and one out of every five respondents was undecided. Up to 60% of the respondents said they would come to vote if the elections were held this coming Sunday and 28% said they would definitely come to vote.

Putin's approval ratings hit 89 percent, the highest they've ever been, 24.06.2015

Think Russians are tiring of conflict with the West? Not according to President Vladimir Putin's approval ratings, which hit all-time highs of 89 percent Wednesday. Putin has been riding sky-high ever since the March 2014 annexation of Ukraine's Crimean Peninsula, which Russians embraced as a restoration of their place at the table of superpowers. Neither Western sanctions nor an economy in the doldrums nor NATO's bolstering its presence along the borders have been able to dislodge Putin's support ever since. Those who were planning for a collapse in Putin's support might want to pin their aspirations elsewhere. Putin's ratings jumped from 65 percent in January 2014 to 80 percent two months later, and they've stayed in the 80s ever since, according to measurements from the Moscow-based Levada Center, the only independent polling organization in Russia. They've kept going up: In Putin's 15 years in office, they've never been higher than June's 89 percent.

IMF sees signs of emerging economic stability in Ukraine, 01.06.2015

"The foreign exchange market has remained broadly stable. Gross international reserves, although still very low, have increased to US\$9.6 billion at end-April. Banks' deposits in domestic currency have been recovering. The budget outturn in the first months of 2015 was stronger than expected, partly due to temporary factors," IMF Chief for Ukraine Nikolay Gueorguiev said in the statement. "The authorities are also determined to complete the ongoing debt operation in line with program objectives. This will ensure that public debt is sustainable with high probability and the program remains fully financed, which are requirements for the completion of the review. More broadly, continued financial support for Ukraine's reform efforts from official and private creditors is vital for the success of the program," he said.

U.N. finds growing signs of Russian involvement in Ukraine war, 01.06.2015

A separatist conflict in eastern Ukraine is revealing increasing evidence, but not yet conclusive legal proof, of Russian state involvement, senior United Nations human rights officials said on Monday. "We are speaking about increasing inflow of (unofficial) fighters and increasing evidence that there are also some (Russian) servicemen involved in fighting," Assistant Secretary-General for Human Rights Ivan Simonovic told a news conference in Geneva.

Russia denies Western accusations that it is backing pro-Russian rebels with arms and troops.

On May 21, U.N. officials interviewed two Russians captured in eastern Ukraine. The two men believe they should be treated as captured servicemen, but Russia says they are former soldiers who had left the military.

The pair were charged with terrorism by Ukrainian authorities, putting them "between a rock and a hard place", Simonovic said.

"It is very difficult to prove whether they are servicemen or not. That is why mostly we are speaking about 'fighters' of the Russian federation," said Armen Harutyunyan, head of the U.N. Human Rights Monitoring Mission in Ukraine.

Lavrov: Russian retaliatory sanctions affected supporters of Ukraine state coup, 01.06.2015

Russia imposed its entry ban on those European politicians and military leaders who actively supported last February's state coup in Ukraine, Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov said on Monday. "We did not want to make the list public," Lavrov said. "We naturally could not break the main law of international relations - the principle of mutuality. And when the European Union introduced restrictions on 150 Russian citizens, we acted in a similar way but targeted a much smaller number of EU citizens. We did not want to follow the EU's bad example and turn the disclosure of these names into a loud campaign."

"We simply informed our EU partners that we also have a sanctions list, but we will not make it public and will not hand it to Brussels to avoid stirring up a scandal," he said. "But we asked the European Commission to notify those parliamentary, political and social functionaries from EU countries planning to visit Russia that they should enquire in Russian consulates in their country if they were allowed to travel with documents they had, whether it was a diplomatic passport or an open visa or their visa was closed."

European Parliament's relations with Russia, 03.06.2015

Following the publication of the blacklist of European politicians and officials, the President of the European Parliament, Martin Schulz, today informed the Russian Ambassador to the EU that insofar as the Russian authorities have failed to ensure transparency in their decisions, in line with international law and legal obligations, and allow the targeted individuals the right of defence and of appeal, he considers that it is now justified to take appropriate measures in response.

Consequently, pending the lifting of the blacklist, Parliament is:

- restricting free access to Parliament to the Ambassador and one other named diplomat;
- assessing requests for access by Members of the Duma and the Federation Council on a case-by-case basis;
- suspending Parliament's engagement with the EU-Russia Parliamentary Cooperation Committee.

"Terrorists won't get any food from our side until they release prisoners and stop shelling," – Lutsenko, 03.06.2015

Poroshenko Bloc faction leader Yuri Lutsenko says economic blockade of the gangs in the occupied territories of the Donbas is necessary.

"The terrorists won't get any food from our side until they release the prisoners and stop shelling. All our citizens who understand the situation shall leave for the free territory of Ukraine," Lutsenko said. According to him, not a single refugee family in the territory of the Luhansk region lives in the open - they live in difficult conditions, but have a roof over their heads. "Right now, the militants receive all the food from Ukraine - drinks, canned food, meat and so on. Of course the prices are higher. But the food is delivered by Ukrainian citizens who corrupt our checkpoints on the way, who in turn corrupt Kyiv officials, since for some reason the permission to pass is granted by Kyiv, not by local service," the MP said.

Berlin: G7 Format Cannot Last Long, Russia Can Renew Membership, 04.06.2015

The current G7 format of the world's leading economies cannot remain for long and Russia may renew its membership in the group, German Foreign Minister Frank-Walter Steinmeier said. Leaders of the G7, comprising the United Kingdom, the United States, Canada, France, Germany, Italy and Japan, agreed to hold a June 2014 summit in Brussels instead of the originally planned Russian city of Sochi. The 41st G7 summit is scheduled to take place in the Bavarian Elmau Castle, outside Munich, on June 7-8, 2015. Russia did not receive an invitation to participate in the meeting of the world's largest economies.

According to Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov, Russia cannot be excluded from the G8 because the group is an informal club bringing together world leaders to discuss issues of mutual interest. German Development Minister Gerd Mueller said Thursday that Russia's return to the G7 depended on the implementation of the Minsk peace deal on the Ukrainian crisis.

Over 9,000 Russian servicemen operate within 14 tactical groups in Ukraine – Poroshenko, 04.06.2015

"A colossal threat of the resumption of large-scale hostilities posed by Russian-terrorist groups is lingering on. Fourteen Russian battalion tactical groups consisting of over 9,000 servicemen remain in the territory of Ukraine. The concentration of Russian servicemen near the state border is 1.5 times larger than it was a year ago," the president said in his annual message delivered at the Verkhovna Rada on Thursday.

"The so-called 'Rosvoyentorg' is regularly delivering not only ammunition, food, clothing and fuel but also brand new weapons and military hardware," he said.

German Gov't Source Calls Fighting Near Donetsk Violation of Minsk Accord, 04.06.2015

"It is a violation of the Minsk agreements, a serious violation of the ceasefire regime," the source said, adding that the situation at the line of contact raised concerns.

The ceasefire was agreed upon by Kiev forces and Donbass militias in February in Minsk but both sides have since reported violations of the peace deal.

On Wednesday, the self-proclaimed Donetsk People's Republic said that the Ukrainian army had launched intense shelling along the line of contact, killing at least three independence fighters. The shelling also left dozens of civilians injured.

Kiev forces in their turn accused local militia of making advances in the direction of Ukrainian government forces in the country's east.

On Wednesday, Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov said Moscow was "deeply concerned" about alleged provocations by Kiev-led forces in eastern Ukraine.

Poroshenko Says Unable to Instate Martial Law in Ukraine Despite Pressure, 04.06.2015

Poroshenko said during his annual address to the country's parliament that majority of authorities pressured him personally calling for martial law.

"During the war we contained the country democratically. And this is besides the limitations on rights and freedoms that had a full, moral, and by the way legal right in law in line with martial law. But I could not [install martial law], regardless of political pressure from all sides and the majority of the authorities pressuring me personally."

Kiev will continue to increase expenses on military defense, the Ukrainian president said.

"Our priority task is to rearm our military since the Ukrainian Armed Forces already have the best fighting spirit and combat experience. A renewal of the command staff of the armed forces has begun and is continuing."

Ukrainian citizens in occupied Donbas have been taken prisoner by aggressors – Poroshenko, 04.06.2015

Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko has said that the Ukrainian citizens who live in the occupied territories of Donetsk and Luhansk regions are held as prisoners.

"Citizens of Ukraine, who now are in the temporarily occupied territories, I consider to be Ukrainian prisoners, who now are kept by invaders," he said in his annual address to the parliament on Thursday. Poroshenko said Ukraine and its international partners are prepared to help these areas of Donbas as an integral part of Ukraine.

"But they [Ukraine and its international partners] will finance the restoration of the infrastructure just when they will be sure that all [that is] rebuilt for today won't be destroyed by a full-scale Russian invasion tomorrow," Poroshenko added.

Portman Offers Amendments to Provide Military Assistance to Ukraine, 04.06.2015

Today, U.S. Senator Rob Portman (R-Ohio), co-chair of the Senate Ukraine Caucus, announced that he has filed two amendments to the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2016 to help Ukraine as they continue to face Russian aggression.

"Ukraine has reached a pivotal moment," Portman stated. "The Ukrainian people have made incredible sacrifices in the hopes of securing a democratic future for their country. However, sustained economic, political, and military support from the United States and NATO is absolutely crucial to ensuring that their vision comes to fruition.

"My first amendment will help to ensure that U.S. military assistance has a meaningful impact on the ground and gives Ukraine the tools they need to defend themselves. My second amendment will allow us to study the lessons learned from the conflict and their implications for the U.S. military. Some elements of this report, such as the report on armored warfare, will also highlight the importance of armored vehicles like the Abrams tanks and Strykers manufactured in Lima, Ohio. "I'm pleased to offer these amendments and will continue to push for steadfast support of the Ukrainian people during this critical time."

Klimkin: Russia's lies give the EU illusion of security. They have been using euphemisms in Europe for more than a year talking about events in Ukraine, 04.06.2015

Many people in Europe still do not want to see the truth about the events that are taking place in Ukraine and prefer to indulge themselves in illusions while our country needs their support, including by debunking the propaganda lies.

Minister of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine Pavlo Klimkin stated, speaking Wednesday evening in Berlin in front of the guests of the German ZDF broadcaster during the Burns Dinner - a traditional dinner meeting of leading journalists with prominent politicians, cultural and public figures.

"The truth is bitter and the lie is sweet. It gives Europe a false feeling, the illusion of stability and security ... Many people in Europe have been talking about the events in Ukraine using euphemisms for more than a year, without calling them what they are," Klimkin said.

"What we really need," the head of the Ukrainian diplomacy stressed, "is assistance of the society, the media, above all in persuading people, providing them with real information. This can be achieved through the social networks, but this is not enough. We need a good Russian-speaking social media, for example, TV, target audience of which could be Russian-speaking residents of Germany, because there are more than 300,000 of them only in Berlin, and a considerable part of them are victims of the Russian propaganda."

"This is also a feature of this war - the greatest experiment with the human minds. The minds of the Russian population are meant first of all, then the ones of the residents of the eastern Ukraine and Europe," Pavlo Klimkin said.

Ukraine is on high alert for a 'full-scale invasion by Russia', 05.06.2015

"The military must be ready as much for a renewal of an offensive by the enemy in the Donbass as they are for a full-scale invasion along the whole length of the border with Russia. We must be truly ready for this," President Petro Poroshenko said in an address to the Ukrainian parliament yesterday. "We must be really prepared for this."

Mr Poroshenko claimed there are already 9,000 Russian troops in separatist-held territory inside Ukraine, and said there was a "colossal threat" that Russian-backed forces would launch large-scale operations in the near future. Russia denies deploying troops to east Ukraine. Ukrainian generals said they would order heavy weapons back to the frontline to respond to what they described as a large-scale separatist offensive.

The withdrawal of high-calibre artillery and armour was a key part of the Minsk peace accords, and the move has raised fears that the ceasefire is close to total collapse.

Japan's Ambassador says G7 sanctions against Russia will remain until Donbas conflict over, 05.06.2015

The ambassador says that the G7's solidarity with Ukraine is the Group's very important position. "And this means that we reaffirm our position vis-à-vis Russia. And it also means that we will never recognize the illegal annexation of Crimea and destabilizing actions by Russia," the ambassador said at a briefing in Kyiv.

"We will continue the policy of sanctions against Russia," he added.

The ambassador also expressed hope that there would be a dialogue between the G7 and Russia for a peaceful resolution to the conflict in the east of Ukraine and problems existing in the country. According to him, the Minsk Agreement is one of the ways to peacefully settle the situation in the east of Ukraine. If the situation in Donbas hasn't been resolved until the next year, Japan will make every effort to settle it peacefully during its G7 presidency in 2016, he said.

The G7 suspended Russia from the grouping last year over its illegal annexation of the Crimean Peninsula and Moscow's involvement in the fighting in eastern Ukraine.

Harper's comments come ahead of the G7 summit in southern Germany on June 7-8.

He added that "Russia is more often than not trying deliberately to be a strategic rival, to deliberately counter the good things we're trying to achieve in the world than for no other reason than to just counter them."

Harper said Russian foreign policy was "to say black is white even though everyone knows the contrary" and that as long as they will "treat us like we are all stupid, there really is no point in having a dialogue with them."

Soros Flaring Flames of Ukraine War to Force Regime Change in Russia, 05.06.2015

The confidential document, allegedly part of communications between Soros and Ukrainian authorities, was published by hacktivists from CyberBerkut, known for releasing embarrassing revelations with regard to the US meddling in Ukraine.

"While it would be more desirable to have Russia as a partner than an enemy, that is impossible as long as Putin persists in his current policies," Zuesse quoted Soros as saying. In other words, Moscow should be a partner but Russian leader has to go, the historian said referring to Soros' stance.

"Soros wants Ukrainians to get rid of Vladimir Putin, and this requires heavily arming Ukraine," Zuesse commented. Billionaire's logic is simple: Ukraine should receive lethal weapons from the West as a preparation for an offensive on Crimea.

The Ukrainian invasion of the Russian peninsula will not take place, "however the threat of it happening is important to Soros," Zuesse underscored, adding that the European Union, especially Germany and France will never support the US initiative of arming Ukrainians.

Gas-Transit Deal Shows Cost to Russia of Bypassing Ukraine, 05.06.2015

Gazprom has a "ship-or-pay" transit contract with Eustream SA until 2028, Vahram Chuguryan, a spokesman for the Slovak gas pipeline operator, said in a telephone interview on Thursday. That obliges the Russian gas producer to pay transit fees for a minimum of 50 billion cubic meters a year whether the commodity is shipped or not, he said.

Slovakia, a nation of 5.4 million people that shares a border with Ukraine, is a major point of entry for Russian gas into the European Union and southeastern Europe. Its role as a transit country will be diminished if Russia builds a planned link to southeastern Europe through Turkey. "We have not received any official information from the Russian side that gas transit will be stopped after 2020," Chuguryan said. "The contract is clear. It's not something we would need to negotiate." Gazprom's press service declined to comment.

Russia, the EU's largest provider of natural gas, has been looking for ways to avoid the Ukrainian pipeline network because of disputes over prices and allegations of unpaid debt. The loss of transit revenue would be an enormous blow to the Ukrainian economy, kept afloat by a bailout from the International Monetary Fund.

Daryna Kalenyuk: Poroshenko attempts to control anti-corruption investigation and prosecution, 05.06.2015

Civil society organizations and international donors have had high hopes for the National Anti-Corruption Bureau, a law enforcement agency with a mandate to investigate the corrupt conduct of senior state officials. The bureau already has a director and his staff, a building for their operations, and the selection process for investigators has already begun. However, the bureau will be unable to start and develop any corruption investigations without the aid of anti-corruption prosecution, which has yet to be established. According to the Ukrainian Criminal Procedure Code, the prosecutor is obliged to provide procedural guidance and oversight of the work of the bureau's investigators. In other words, the prosecutor has the power to give obligatory instructions to the investigators, to change the actual participating investigators, and to approve the majority of court requests for obtaining evidence, like bank account information. The head of the anti-corruption prosecution must be selected through a competitive, independent selection procedure, conducted by an independent selection commission. The general prosecutor should be allowed to appoint only one candidate, approved by the selection commission. The selection procedure must be transparent and broadcast online. The head of the anti-corruption prosecution must have the right to appoint his own staff.

He said he regretted that the ceasefire in eastern Ukraine was violated, and hostilities happened occasionally. Shinzō Abe also stressed that all parties to the conflict – Russia and Ukraine – should consistently adhere to the Donbas peace agreements.

Russia backs Ukraine peace deal but Kiev is blocking progress, says Putin, 06.06.2015

"Russia is interested in and will strive to ensure the full and unconditional implementation of the Minsk Agreements," Russian president, Vladimir Putin, said in an interview in Italian newspaper Corriere della Sera on Saturday, calling the February deal "right, just and feasible".

His comments came a few days after the most serious outbreak of fighting in eastern Ukraine since February's ceasefire, which has cast doubt on the durability of the peace deal. Putin said large-scale hostilities in eastern Ukraine had on the whole ceased and a pull-back of heavy weapons had been implemented, despite occasional shooting and casualties.

"It is time to begin implementing the Minsk Agreements," he said.

"The problem is that the current Kiev authorities don't even want to sit down to talks with them. And there is nothing we can do about it," he said. "Only our European and American partners can influence this situation." Putin also said that Kiev's cutting off of economic ties with the rebel territories was causing a humanitarian disaster, and said the European Union should fulfill its obligations to restore the banking system in the region.

She charged that the Kremlin then tried to disguise its agenda through a torrent of media propaganda and disingenuous speeches at global venues such as the United Nations Security Council -- messages that helped President Vladimir Putin's domestic support touch record highs. "The focus on Ukraine in the Security Council is important because it gives me the chance – on behalf of the United States – to lay out the mounting evidence of Russia's aggression, its obfuscation, and its outright lies," said Power.

"When we hear such statements [by Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko], first of all we want to know whether the current authorities denounce their liabilities, of which we are most concerned about their financial liabilities," Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov told journalists, commenting on Poroshenko's pronouncements that the Russian three-billion-dollar loan to Ukraine was a "bribe" to former head of state Viktor Yanukovich for his abandoning association with the European Union. "Viktor Yanukovich, who was Ukraine's president at that time [in 2013] was toppled in an illegal and anti-constitutional state coup," Peskov noted. "So far, we have no answer to the question [about legal succession]. Frankly speaking, I find it difficult to say whether Poroshenko's words could be taken as an answer to that question."

'Russia and US far too powerful, cooperation has to be possible', 17.06.2015

Jeffery Sommers: Of course, there is some significant pressure that's emanating from both Poland and the Baltic States for the US to have an increasing commitment with NATO troops on their respective territories. In some measure, it is actually a quite measured response. In other words, I don't think we should be too alarmed by this. On one level, it's rather unfortunate that the US didn't honor its verbal commitment to not expand NATO beyond the original positioning of troops in Germany, as the German Democratic Republic was brought into NATO with the unification of Germany in 1990. Now that we do have these additional countries such as Poland and the Baltic States within NATO, I think that this is a fairly measured response.

The number of troops, roughly we're talking about 5,000 troops - is not enough to pose any threat to Russia, but instead it's kind of a reprise of the mutual assured destruction policies of the Cold War: if Russia was ever to intervene the Baltic States, something which I think is extremely unlikely, then of course that would trigger a greater US response given that it has troops there. So I can see some reason for concerns here, but at the same time we should remain calm.

US, EU Ready Tough Russia Sanctions, in Case They're Needed, 18.06.2015

Determined to prevent another Moscow-led rebel advance, the United States and European governments have prepared a new round of penalties targeting Russia's energy and financial sectors as part of a sanctions-in-waiting strategy that officials hope will help the West respond immediately if insurgents push deeper into Ukraine.

The penalties could start with banning more Russian government officials and businessmen from traveling and doing business in the West, U.S. and European officials said. But they can climb dramatically to include new measures to crimp the country's all-important fuel exports, cut Russian banks off from international financial transactions and severely limit the capacity of Russian businesses to engage in lucrative business deals overseas. The Americans and the Europeans are working off the same menu of contingency measures, the officials said, though there is no agreement yet on what level of response would be appropriate for each type of infraction. Secretary of State John Kerry told reporters this week that imposing additional sanctions on Russia "depends on what happens on the ground" and on President Vladimir Putin's support for fully implementing a February ceasefire in Ukraine. If violence stops and separatists can reach a political agreement with Ukraine's Western-backed government in Kiev, sanctions can be rolled back, he said. But, "if President Putin chooses to play a double game and continues to allow the separatists to press forward, then obviously we have a very big challenge ahead of us." The European Union will extend its current penalties on Russia next week, though officials said there is no consensus among its 28 members of new measures.

"According to our data, weapons are already being supplied [to Kiev]," the Russian leader said at a press conference following his meeting with Hungarian Prime Minister Viktor Orban. Up to 5,000 Ukrainian troops are thought to be surrounded in this key area deep inside rebel territory. "Our mission is to save the lives of those caught in the cauldron, and to make sure that the situation does not inflame relations between Kiev and the rebels further," Putin said.

We don't have an exact laydown of the separatist forces. But when I say combined separatists, obviously that connotes that there are some Russian force components to it. But it's hard to characterize exactly what that means and how many there are," Kirby said.

Amid Russian Threats, Dutch Foreign Minister Says NATO BALTOPS 2015 Exercise Is A Warning To Russia, 19.06.2015

The comments from Bert Koenders contradict a NATO statement earlier this month that the exercise was not aimed at any country in particular. It also comes after Russia announced plans to boost the nuclear arsenal in its Baltic exclave of Kaliningrad. "There are NATO member states in Eastern Europe that feel threatened by what is happening in eastern Ukraine. These drills are also a warning to President Putin," Koenders said. "This is not an aggressive approach. This is a combination of pressure and dialogue, rather than a lack of judgment when dealing with Putin." Russia, which under Putin's leadership annexed Crimea in March last year and has remained involved in the 15-month war in eastern Ukraine, also aims to increase the number of its intercontinental ballistic missiles, which can carry nuclear warheads. The U.S. has condemned Russia's move by saying it amounted to "nuclear saber-rattling." The BALTOPS exercise included 14 NATO members plus three countries not part of the alliance -- Sweden, Finland and Georgia -- which have all been the subject of speculation that they may join the U.S.-led alliance in the face of increasing Russian hostility. Georgia, which is by far the most keen to join, went to war with Russia in 2008 over the regions of South Ossetia and Abkhazia. Finland and Sweden have been partners in NATO drills.

NATO Secretary General Jens Stoltenberg tells about the alliance's concerns about the Kremlin's nuclear rhetoric, international military agreements that are violated by Russia, and about the allies' reaction to Moscow's "sabre-rattling." We have a strong and long-standing political and practical partnership with Ukraine. We have an intensive political dialogue through the NATO-Ukraine Commission. We strongly support Ukraine's sovereignty and territorial integrity. The NATO allies do not and will not recognise Russia's illegal and illegitimate "annexation" of Crimea. NATO is also providing practical support to Ukraine, as you pursue your reforms. We are making progress on the trust funds we set up to support your reforms and to help rehabilitate soldiers hurt in the fighting in the east. We have deployed additional personnel to the NATO liaison office in Kyiv and sent experts to the Ministry of Defence. NATO allies are also providing significant support bilaterally. All allies agree that Russia continues to support the separatists in eastern Ukraine with forces, equipment and training. This was last confirmed by all 28 allied foreign ministers in our joint statement when we met in Antalya in May. In recent months, Russia has transferred well over 1,000 pieces of heavy equipment to the separatists. This has included tanks, artillery and advanced air defence systems. We know this from our own intelligence. But there is also evidence published by the media, NGOs and from Russian soldiers themselves that Russia is supporting the separatists. Think tanks have also published reports, most recently the Atlantic Council, which gathered proof from various open sources, including satellite imagery. So the overall picture is clear. As you remember, Russia first claimed that its troops had not been involved in Crimea, then admitted that the annexation had long been planned and conducted by Russian troops, and President Putin even gave medals to the forces involved.

"NATO is a defensive alliance, and NATO nuclear doctrine is fully consistent with the Treaty on Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons," he said. "We have revised our nuclear policy, and decided at the summit in Chicago three years ago that it was appropriate."

US Participation in 'Normandy' Group May Destroy Format – Kremlin, 20.06.2015

Accession of new mediators to the so-called Normandy group on Ukraine reconciliation, in particular from the US, may destroy the format, Kremlin Chief of Staff Sergei Ivanov said. "Basically, we could do it by supplementing the Normandy Format with one more party, the United States. However, the Normandy Format is so fragile now that this step would be simply risky," Ivanov said.

"But the members of the security forces fulfilled their duties according to existing laws. They had the right to use weapons," he said.

NORMANDY FOUR FOREIGN MINISTERS VOICE 'DEEP CONCERN' OVER WORSENING VIOLENCE IN DONBAS, 24.06.2015

The "Normandy Four" foreign ministers of Ukraine, Russia, France and Germany have called for the withdrawal of tanks and weapons of calibers less than 100mm out of range of the front line in eastern Ukraine by June 26, according to a joint statement after they met on Tuesday.

According to the statement, the Normandy Four foreign ministers have reiterated their full commitment to the Minsk agreements. The countries also expressed "deep concern" over the deteriorating situation in the Donbas. In addition, the ministers emphasized the role of the Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights (ODIHR) of the OSCE in the preparation for and conducting of local elections. The Normandy Four foreign ministers also urged parties to the conflict to carry out a full withdrawal of heavy weapons and a further de-escalation in the village of Shyrokyne in Donetsk region. They also stressed the need for OSCE observers to be allowed unfettered access to all areas and the removal of barriers to the delivery of aid by the International Committee of the Red Cross. The ministers also called for a prisoner exchange on the "all for all" principle.

Britain to step up training of Ukrainian armed forces, 24.06.2015

Defence Secretary Michael Fallon said Britain would announce at a NATO meeting with Ukraine plans to double spending on the training to around 6 million pounds (\$9.4 million). "We are doubling up our training of Ukrainian forces. We've already trained around 650. By this autumn we will have trained nearly 1,000," he said.

"We've already been training in battlefield medicine, infantry skills, logistics, in tactical intelligence," he said. To those tasks will be added training in medical evacuation, operating in winter conditions and reconnaissance skills. Britain now has 75 trainers working at six sites in western Ukraine and that number will increase "a little" under the expanded programme, Fallon added. "This is not designed to be escalatory or provocative. This is helping to save lives," Fallon said.

NATO warns of risk of heavy fighting in Ukraine, 25.06.2015

NATO head Jens Stoltenberg warned there was still a risk of heavy fighting in Ukraine and urged Russia to halt its support for pro-Moscow rebels.

A February ceasefire brokered in Minsk by France and Germany has largely held but in recent weeks there has been an upsurge in fighting, threatening to undo the accord as the death toll tops 6,500. "Ceasefire violations persist. There is still a risk of a return to heavy fighting," Stoltenberg said. "Russia continues to support the separatists with training, weapons and soldiers; it has a large number of forces stationed on its border with Ukraine," he added.

"The best chance for peace is the full implementation of the Minsk agreements. I urge all parties to do so and Russia has a special responsibility in this regard."

Russia denies that it is directly involved in the 15-month conflict in Ukraine.

Stoltenberg was speaking at the opening of the NATO-Ukraine Council which the alliance set up to coordinate relations with non-member Kiev after the end of the Cold War.

He said NATO remained committed to Ukraine's territorial integrity and sovereignty, and would not recognise Russia's "illegal and illegitimate annexation of Crimea."

PACE maintains sanctions against Russian delegation, but leaves door open to dialogue, 24.06.2015

PACE – while keeping in place all sanctions against the Russian delegation decided in January in response to the situation in Ukraine – has decided not to go further and annul the delegation's credentials at this time, "as a signal of its commitment to an open and constructive dialogue".

Adopting a resolution based on a report by Stefan Schennach (Austria, SOC), the Assembly said there had been "a manifest lack of progress" as regards its January demands, but said it remained convinced that "an open dialogue, in good faith, between the Assembly and the Russian delegation" was important for finding a lasting solution to the conflict in eastern Ukraine and the illegal annexation of Crimea. The parliamentarians called on the Russian delegation – which has not taken part in the work of PACE since the sanctions were applied – to reverse its refusal to co-operate with the Assembly and to re-establish dialogue. The Assembly also repeated its call on the Russian authorities to – among other things – withdraw all its troops from Ukrainian territory, fully implement the Minsk agreements, reverse the illegal annexation of Crimea, and release Nadiia Savchenko and others.

Russia's gas discount for Ukraine to be cut to \$40/kcm, 29.06.2015

Russia will reduce the discount of the natural gas it sells to Ukrainian incumbent supplier Naftogaz to \$40/thousand cubic metre (kcm) for the third quarter of this year, prime minister Dmitry Medvedev said on Monday. That effectively leaves the purchasing price for Naftogaz unchanged, as the outright contract price has fallen considerably quarter on quarter. It could also curb Ukrainian demand for gas shipped from Europe. This is because the gas supply contract is indexed to the price of oil with a time-lag, and Brent crude prices plunged in the second half of 2014. For the coming three months Russian gas sold by incumbent Gazprom to Naftogaz will cost \$247.18/kcm, equivalent to €21.03/MWh.

The current discount of \$100/kcm expires at the end of Tuesday. But the outright price for Q2 was \$347.18/kcm.

The medium published harsh statements by the Ukrainian President regarding Russia, despite the fact that Corriere della Sera's editorial is usually more cautious about criticism towards Russian Federation. Poroshenko announced that the Parliament of Ukraine is discussing the procedure for conducting elections in the separatists-occupied territories of the Donbas. "Russia continues to send troops, weapons, and \$1 billion of financing to the Donbas terrorists. But we are ready for dialogue. Our parliament is discussing a special law to hold elections in these areas," Poroshenko said. Poroshenko also said in his interview that Ukraine is ready to spend money on the Donbas reconstruction.

"We are ready to reconstruct destroyed villages and cities, to renew the banking system. But until mercenaries with Kalashnikovs block our humanitarian convoys, steal money we deliver to local banks, and use them to finance attacks on Kharkiv, Odesa, and other cities, we cannot do that," Poroshenko said.

Brzezinski suggests using Finland role model to solve Ukrainian crisis, 30.06.2015

Russia and the United States have long been in a state of "cold war," but it is still unlikely that it will be a "hot conflict", Brzezinski said. A new "cold war" will not last long because events in the modern world are developing much faster than before, the American political scientist said. When asked whether the United States' intentions to deploy heavy military equipment in Eastern Europe and the Baltics are proper in response to a credible threat of Russia's invasion, Brzezinski said it was about "action and reaction." "I do not want war, but I'm not prepared to be intimidated by the assertion that we provoke a war with a symmetrical response. On the contrary, we do not react – this is the most likely way to bring about a war," the expert said.

If Russian soldiers enter the Baltic States, NATO will certainly counter this, Brzezinski noted.

"Vintorez", used by Russian special forces, Shmel portable rocket launchers, silent pistols, rifle SVD, about 20 automatic weapons, a lot of ammunition were confiscated," Butusov writes.

According to him, the most resonant terrorist attacks of the Russian special forces in the Kharkiv region, including tank explosions on railways, attack on the military Commissariat, night club explosion, volunteers' office attack, have been solved.

"I signed the law on the conditions of returning fixed deposits, which would promote the stabilization of the banking system," Poroshenko wrote on his Twitter page.

The draft law divides deposits into fixed deposits and fixed deposits with the option of early withdrawal, and retains the category of called deposits.

Amendments to the Civil Code have been made stating that under the banking deposit agreement, the bank is obliged to issue deposits and rates accrued when the term of deposits stipulated in the banking agreement expires.

The new conditions for deposits will apply to the period after the day when the law takes effect and will not apply to deposits that have been already opened.

Moskal sends prosecutors list of 65 crimes committed by Aidar Battalion, 08.06.2015

The list of crimes includes “a mass of incidents of kidnapping, extortion, torture, robbery and the illegal use of weapons” along the front line, Moskal wrote. His allegations come days after the battalion’s former commander, Sergei Melnichuk, was stripped of his parliamentary immunity by the Verkhovna Rada. Melnichuk, of the “People’s Will” faction, now faces charges for the illegal formation of armed groups, although the Verkhovna Rada stopped short of approving his arrest on June 3. “Once again, I would like to stress that part of Aidar is actually defending the territorial integrity of Ukraine on the front line, with weapons in their hands, while another part has decided to make money off of war. In the list, only 25 percent of the crimes are heinous and high profile -- including kidnapping civil servants and demanding ransom, resisting the work of law enforcement bodies and robbing entrepreneurs, etc.,” Moskal wrote on his official website on June 8. Moskal claims that many members of the volunteer battalion were not officially registered at the time the crimes were committed, though they were nonetheless given weapons and Aidar badges while Melnichuk was in charge. In total, the list includes 65 separate crimes, all of which took place throughout 2014. In the online statement, Moskal explained the list’s publication by saying the Verkhovna Rada had given consent to investigate crimes committed only in the Kyiv and Zhitomorsk regions, not Luhansk.

Rescuers evacuate two-kilometer zone around burning fuel depot near Kyiv, 09.06.2015

Ukrainian rescue teams on Tuesday began a temporary evacuation of residents within a two-kilometer zone around a burning fuel depot just outside Kyiv, Chairman of the State Emergency Service Mykolai Chechetkin said at the scene of the fire, the service's press service has reported. "The temporary resettlement of citizens within a two-kilometer zone from the danger zone has started," Chechetkin said. "The resettlement of people within a 10-kilometer zone may take place if needed. The fire is being brought under control. Rescuers from Zhytomyr, Cherkasy, Chernihiv regions have been involved in building up resources and carrying out monitoring of the situation. The main efforts are aimed at preventing the spread of fire in the direction of a military unit located 50 meters away from the fire’s edge."

Chechetkin said that the situation is totally under control, posing no obvious threat to the lives of people there. However, there is a likelihood of more explosions, he said.

The letter signed by Foreign Minister Pavlo Klimkin stresses that certain areas of the Luhansk and Donetsk regions have this status as well.

Minsk talks: Progress, but no breakthrough, say officials, 17.06.2015

"There has been progress, but no breakthrough. We still have to work," the representative of the OSCE in Ukraine Heidi Tagliavini said on Tuesday evening after the meeting of the Trilateral Contact Group. The representatives of the self-proclaimed Donetsk and Luhansk People's Republics, who are traditionally invited to the meeting, were more categorical.

"We expected more. There are positive steps, but they are not enough to fully resolve the conflict and to consolidate the ceasefire," the representative of the DPR militant organization Denis Pushylin told journalists. The latest round of negotiations on the implementation of the Minsk agreements was as usual closed to the press. A closing meeting of the Trilateral Contact Group was preceded by the work of subgroups that had been formed earlier with the participation of the representatives of the DPR and LPR militant organizations. But only three out of four subgroups worked this time on security, political and humanitarian issues in Minsk.

The work of a subgroup on economic issues was also disrupted last time, according to reports, because of the absence of the Russian representative. But it has not officially announced the reason for the recent failure. However, the parties have managed to make some decisions.

Sixth wave of military draft starts today, 18.06.2015

As reported, it will last for 60 days, as stipulated by the law 113-VIII "On partial mobilization." The General Staff of the Ukrainian army announced that there will be no differences from the previous wave. As of now, there is no information on how many people will be drafted. Military prosecutor Anatolii Matios said it would be 50,000 persons. Under the above mentioned law, military draft in 2015 is conducted in three waves of 210 days in total. Poroshenko sees law stripping Yanukovych of presidential rank as unconstitutional, 21.06.2015

Back in February this year Ukraine's parliament has passed a bill stripping the ousted former Ukrainian president Viktor Yanukovych of his title. Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko has sent a request to Ukraine's Constitutional Court, asking for designating as unconstitutional the law on depriving Viktor Yanukovych of the title of President of Ukraine because the law is not of "a regulatory character," the court's press service said. "Since the law whose constitutionality is being challenged is not of a regulatory character, the Verkhovna Rada passed it in contradiction to the provisions of the Constitution of Ukraine, which means that this contradicts Part 2 of Article 19 of the Constitution, which obliges the parliament to act within the powers and in the manner stipulated in the Constitution of Ukraine. In this connection, I request designating the law of Ukraine dated February 4, 2015, on depriving Viktor Yanukovych of the title of President of Ukraine as not complying with the Constitution of Ukraine and therefore unconstitutional," the president's request reads.

Poroshenko also stresses that in keeping with the Constitution of Ukraine, the Verkhovna Rada has no right to strip a person of the title of President of Ukraine, and therefore the Ukrainian parliament has exceeded its constitutional authority.

Kuleba: Foreign Ministry to make list of Russians involved in violations of human rights of Ukrainians, 22.06.2015

The aim of this initiative is to punish offenders for the illegal detention of political prisoners - such as Nadia Savchenko and Oleh Sentsov. However, the Foreign Ministry has not said when it will compile the list. "It is necessary to make a list of Russian officials involved in violations of human rights of our citizens in order to apply individual sanctions against them, [and] so that the names of these people became known to all - from an investigator or a security guard up to the political leadership responsible for the bullying that our citizens have been subjected to," Kuleba said. "As one of the prisoners who finally escaped from Russia said yesterday - they are afraid of publicity, the Russians want to keep everything in silence and 'under the carpet'. We will not allow them to do this," he said.

50 Russian mercenaries killed in attempted assault on Marinka, - ATO headquarters, 04.06.2015

This was stated by Chief Inspector of the Defense Ministry Valentyn Fedichev.

"We are now learning initial numbers of people and military equipment engaged by the enemy. In the morning there was information about 300, then 1,000, after clarification it's 500. That is a battalion task force, reinforced by artillery, multiple rocket launchers, and tanks. The numbers for losses among the militants are: more than 50 dead, destroyed equipment - two tanks. We'll find out about artillery systems late," he said.

At the same time you cannot say that the Minsk agreement was violated. Fedichev noted that this is what the Russian side had hoped for: "[They hoped] that in the preparation of deflecting these assault actions we will conduct a preemptive strike in violation of the Minsk agreements. That we would start hostilities, and in that case they would have shown losses among the civilian population in Donetsk ... And [would say] that the Minsk agreement was disrupted by the Ukrainian side." He noted that after receiving information about preparations for a provocation the Ukrainian military addressed the international community to receive authorization to use heavy weapons.

Eighty militants killed, over 100 wounded in Maryinka – Kyiv, 04.06.2015

"Yesterday, in disregard of the Minsk agreements, the militants tried to mount an offensive on the Ukrainian positions in the Donetsk sector. The fighting was severest in the Donetsk airport area, the northwestern outskirts of Maryinka, and Svitlodarsk. In addition to the broad use of large-caliber tube artillery, 120mm mortars and tanks, the illegal armed units conducted at least eleven attacks on our positions using Grad rocket launchers," ATO spokesman Andriy Lysenko said. Considering the threat to the life of Ukrainian servicemen and Maryinka civilians, the Ukrainian command decided to use the artillery weapons which had been earlier pulled out to comply with the Minsk accords, Lysenko said. "The move was coordinated with international partners and observed by the OSCE mission. Our servicemen defended their lines courageously and professionally, and the enemy had to retreat. As before, Maryinka is under full control of the Ukrainian authorities," he said. In his words, militants had suffered heavy losses.

"Yesterday, in the Maryinka battle, the illegal armed units lost up to ten armored vehicles, up to 80 militants were killed and over 100 were wounded. The bodies of dead militants are lying on the neutral ground," he said.

Luhansk governor Moskal orders to halt water supply to 'LPR' in return to latter's power supply discontinuation in Stanytsia, 05.06.2015

The blackout in Stanytsia Luhanska and eight villages around it began on Wednesday afternoon, the Moskal press service has reported. The local power line had been previously damaged by shells, and the area was receiving electricity via a reserve line across territories uncontrolled by Kyiv. The governor said that the militia was barring repairmen from entering their territory. "Repairmen have tried to reach the damaged sections [of the power line] many times but to no avail. The blackout has disrupted the water supply to Stanytsia [Luhanska] and a part of the district, and mobile phone service is unstable," Moskal said.

"They are waging a war on our public utilities, and I cannot help but bring to a complete halt the water supply to the occupied territory. The order took effect at 9 a.m. The water supply will be restored as soon as they resume the power supply to Stanytsia and guarantee its stability. We will act like Ostap Bender did: we get electricity in the evening and give them water in the morning," the head of the regional administration said.

OSCE SMM, JCCC personnel come under militant fire, 07.06.2015

The event occurred near the community of Schastia at 1115 Kyiv time on June 7, the Anti-Terrorist Procedure (ATO) press facility stated.

Fighting intensifies near Donetsk airport, 10.06.2015

"Apart from using actively guns and mortars, the enemy has brought armored vehicles - tanks and infantry fighting vehicles – up to the line of contact," The situation in the area of Horlivka was not calm either, according to Lysenko. The sound of firing was heard in its western, northern and eastern suburbs. There are also reports of tanks and 152-mm artillery shells being used by the militants to the east and west of Svetlodarsk water reservoir.

"It should be noted that the enemy is firing at our positions and settlements not only along the line of contact, but deep into Ukrainian territory at a distance of 5-10 km from the front, where shots can be fired only from artillery of 122 mm caliber or more," Lysenko said.

At the same time, according to Lysenko, the most intense confrontations in the Luhansk area were near Zolote and Popasna, where militants launched a large mortar barrage that damaged power lines. Intense attacks with infantry combat vehicle were launched by the militants in the village of Krymske.

During the last day two Ukrainian servicemen have been killed, another 13 injured in the area of the anti-terrorist operation in Donbas as a result of hostilities and military clashes.

The SMM monitored the implementation of the "Package of measures for the implementation of the Minsk agreements". Its monitoring was restricted by third parties and security considerations*. The SMM observed a high level of violence in and around Donetsk airport. The SMM resumed monitoring activities at observation points west of Shyrokyne.

The level of violence in and around Donetsk airport ("Donetsk People's Republic" ("DPR")-controlled, 12km north-west of Donetsk) remained high. From the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) observation point at the Donetsk central railway station ("DPR"-controlled, 8km north-west of Donetsk city centre), over a five hour period, the SMM heard over 250 bursts of small arms and light weapons fire, heavy machinegun, automatic grenade launchers and anti-aircraft guns as well as 134 explosions, both incoming and outgoing at one to eight kilometres north, north-west, north-east and west of its location.[1]At 15.35hrs, explosions only 500 meters from the SMM's position forced it to leave the observation point. The JCCC Ukrainian Armed Forces and Russian Federation Armed Forces representatives present at the observation point negotiated three ceasefires during the day, at 13:10, 14:00 and 15:15hrs, but neither held longer than ten minutes.

From the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) observation post at the Donetsk central railway station ("Donetsk People's Republic" ("DPR")-controlled, 8km north-west of Donetsk city centre), the SMM saw and heard 142 explosions from unspecified types of weapons and 34 anti-aircraft gun bursts at a distance between three to seven kilometres north-north-east, north, north-west and west-north-west of the SMM's location.[1]

From the observation post at the railway station, the SMM observed a large fire approximately 2.5km north of its position and on the other side of the destroyed new terminal at Donetsk airport ("DPR"-controlled, 12km north-north-west of Donetsk airport).

The SMM monitored the implementation of the "Package of measures for the implementation of the Minsk agreements". Its monitoring was restricted by third parties and security considerations*. Militants fire on Ukraine forces 65 times on Saturday, hit civilian facilities near Donetsk, 13.06.2015

In the past few days, Russian-backed militants have been most active over the last month, the ATO press center said. "The most complicated situation is still near Donetsk. Militants have been shelling the villages of Pisky, Vodiane, Opytne, and the towns of Maryinka and Krasnohorivka since the very morning," the source said. They have used almost all available weapons, including 120mm-caliber mortars and 122mm-caliber howitzers banned by the Minsk peace agreement. What is more, the enemy used tanks, guns of combat vehicles and 122mm-caliber artillery systems to fire on facilities in the village of Opytne five times. They also hit and destroyed residential areas in the village of Vodiane. "After a short break, the area around the Ukrainian-controlled city of Mariupol has again become a hot spot: ATO forces in the village of Shyrokyne were attacked eight times by militants, who used mortars and howitzers whose caliber is over 100 mm, as well as grenade launchers, heavy machine guns and small arms. The town of Schastia and the villages of Krymske and Bolotne in Luhansk region were under 120mm mortar fire. At the same time, the ATO press center said, the ATO forces have been beefing up their combat strength to be able to repel possible breakthrough battles and land grabs.

One soldier killed, 21 wounded in Donbas, 14.06.2015

Militants shelled both Ukrainian army positions and residential areas with Grad rockets and self-propelled artillery weapons. Tymchuk: 1,000 militants and artillery sent to Horlivka and Debaltseve, 15.06.2015

"In the area of the town of Horlivka, through the towns of Yasynuvata and Yenakieve, the militants have sent units of 450-500 people in several batches. At the same time, they are sending artillery: Six 2S1 Gvozdika 152-mm self-propelled artillery systems and five D-30 122mm howitzers have been redeployed in the last day," he said.

In addition, two TOR surface-to-air missile systems have been redeployed through the town of Shakhtarsk. "The Ukrainian army also recorded the movement of three 9K35 Strela-10 short-range surface-to-air missile systems between the village of Sadove and the town of Khartsyzk," Tymchuk said. Moreover, from the town of Alchevsk to Debaltseve, the militants have sent five-six trucks with local fighters, with at least 550 fighters now in the town.

According to Tymchuk, a column of four BTR-80 amphibious armored personnel carriers and four 2S1 Gvozdika 152-mm self-propelled artillery systems passed through the town of Alchevsk in the direction of the Isakovske water reservoir. In addition, to the south of Luhansk, the Ukrainian armed forces have recorded 20 trucks with a pontoon bridge system (all of them had obscured tactical numbers).

Militants attacked Ukrainian positions using all available means. Most attacks took place at Donetsk direction, - ATO press center, 15.06.2015

Today, June 15, illegal armed groups of the pro-Russian militants continued to actively provoke Ukrainian soldiers using practically all available weapons systems.

The report reads: "Out of the 33 shootings of the positions of our troops, 27 were carried out in the area of Donetsk. The Invaders manically fired 120-mm mortars at Berezove, Hranitne, Starohnativka, and twice at Marinka. Hranitne, Bohdanivka and Novohryhorivka were shelled by 122-mm howitzers. Ukrainian side informed OSCE about night attack on Marinka - militants do not stop attempts at revenge, 17.06.2015

Today, June 17, daily briefing for representatives of the OSCE SMM on the situation along the demarcation line took place at the Joint Center for Control and Coordination of the cease-fire. According to the report, Head of the Ukrainian side of the JCCC, Major General Andrii Taran told about attempts of the armed gangs to infiltrate the territory controlled by Ukraine in order to seize the positions. In particular, last night there were two clashes of the Ukrainian Armed Forces with militant groups of 30 and 150 people with small arms and mortars near Marinka. All attacks were repulsed. The cessation of the militants' activities in this case was encouraged by the intervention of the Ukrainian and Russian sides in the Joint Center. The OSCE representatives also received facts of the destruction of the infrastructure of towns by the militants, recorded on June 15. Thus, fire from the SPG-9 and armor-piercing incendiary bullets from heavy machine guns destroyed two buildings on the outskirts of Stanytsia Luhanska. The Ukrainian side also transferred recorded results of the shelling by 152-mm artillery and Grad of Toshkivka village and other violations of the Minsk agreements by the terrorists.

OSCE reports 120 explosions in LPR-controlled territory, 19.06.2015

Marinka of Donetsk Region Remains the Hottest Spot Of ATO Area, 19.06.2015

Yesterday pro-Russian militants conducted 90 ceasefire violations in ATO area. Along the entire clash line the militants attacked the positions of Ukrainian troops with MLRS "Grad", artillery, combat vehicles, small arms and grenade launchers. In the evening the militants intensified their activity. Overall during the night they shelled Ukrainian military positions and civilians 55 times. Shyroka Balka (near Artemivsk) and Shyrokyne were attacked with 152mm howitzers. Near Mariupol the militants shelled Chermalyk with 120mm mortars. In Donetsk direction Pisky, Opytne, Krasnohorivka and Marinka suffered attacks with small arms and 82mm mortars. After midnight, Russian-terrorist gangs shelled Zolote and Sokolnyky (Luhansk region). But the most active enemy attacks were observed in Marinka, where at least 10 attacks were recorded. The militants used 120mm mortars, infantry fighting vehicles, grenade launchers and small arms. Under the cover of dense fire the terrorists' subversive and intelligence groups twice tried to wrest ground from ATO forces, but suffered considerable losses, and had to retreat.

Latest from OSCE Special Monitoring Mission (SMM) to Ukraine, 19.06.2015

Donetsk airport and its environs were relatively calm for the fourth consecutive day. Both Ukrainian Armed Forces and Russian Federation Armed Forces personnel at the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) observation post at "Donetsk People's Republic" ("DPR")-controlled Donetsk railway station (8km north-west of Donetsk city) told the SMM that there were no significant incidents during the night of 18-19 June. The SMM observed incoming artillery hits (possibly 122mm or 152mm calibre), airbursts, mortars (outgoing and incoming), as well as small arms and light weapons (SALW) fire in the area of Shyrokyne (20km east of Mariupol). In government-controlled Volnovakha (35km south-west of Donetsk) the head of administration told the SMM that the 16 June decree adding amendments to the T-144 order on crossing between government and non-government-controlled areas is not yet in force (The amendments include, *inter alia*, electronic permits replacing the paper-based system). The SMM observed eight trucks marked "Humanitarian Aid of the Rinat Akhmetov Foundation" in a government-controlled area to the north of Horlivka (36km north-east of Donetsk) proceeding south towards "DPR"-controlled areas. The Luhansk region remains tense with shelling heard in several places.

Latest from OSCE Special Monitoring Mission (SMM) to Ukraine, 20.06.2015

Donetsk airport and its environs saw an uptick in violence from recent days. Both Ukrainian Armed Forces and Russian Federation Armed Forces personnel at the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) observation post at the “DPR”-controlled Donetsk railway station (8km north-west of Donetsk city) told the SMM that there had been no ceasefire violations during the night of 18-19 June and until 13:00hrs on 19 June. Starting at 13:00hrs, the SMM observed during a four-and-a-half-hour period 144 incoming and outgoing explosions, consistent with mortar and artillery fire, whilst at the Donetsk railway station. At the JCCC headquarters in Soledar (government-controlled, 75km north-east of Donetsk) the SMM was presented with two ceasefire violation logbooks for 18 June, compiled independently by the Ukrainian Armed Forces and the Russian Federation Armed Forces representatives at the JCCC. The Ukrainian Armed Forces logbook recorded 113 ceasefire violations, 23 of which were attributed to the Ukrainian Armed Forces and 90 to “DPR” and/or “Lugansk People’s Republic” (“LPR”). The Russian Federation Armed Forces logbook recorded 71 ceasefire violations, of which 15 were attributed to the Ukrainian Armed Forces and 56 to “DPR” and/or “LPR”. The security situation was tense in Shyrokyne (20km east of Mariupol). From observation points just west of the town, the SMM saw and heard various explosions, outgoing and incoming mortar fire, as well as small-arms fire in the Shyrokyne area.

This Is What the Ukraine War Looks Like: 8 Days on the Front Line, 20.06.2015

Ukraine—The notion that the Ukraine cease-fire is still largely holding, or even being followed at all, is fiction. In the eastern Ukrainian village of Pisky, only six kilometers from the separatist stronghold of Donetsk, and two kilometers from the ruined Donetsk airport, the Ukrainian army 93rd Mechanized Brigade is engaged in sustained combat with combined Russian-separatist forces. In Pisky, combined Russian-separatist forces violate the cease-fire every day with heavy artillery barrages, including 120-mm and 152-mm shells, tank attacks, and sniper and automatic grenade launcher fire. Separatist reconnaissance units also slip behind the lines after dark, and gun battles are a nightly routine. “I dance with death every day,” said Sergei Kozin, a red-bearded 43-year-old machine gunner from Dnipropetrovsk, who has been on the front lines in Pisky for more than two months. Facing these persistent, lethal attacks, the Ukrainian forces are forced to defend themselves by bringing up heavy weapons banned from the front lines under the Minsk II agreements, resulting in a complete collapse of the Feb. 12 cease-fire. “We have orders to fire only if we are directly under fire, only if they are trying to take our position,” Kozin said. “We can only fire if they shoot at us,” Volodymyr said. “But we usually won’t bother shooting back if it’s just small arms fire.”

The General added that Ukrainian army morale was extremely low with "all Generals and officers realizing the criminal nature of Kiev's actions and refusing to fight any longer." Meanwhile, the Ukrainian Defense Ministry confirmed General Kolomiyets' defection to the independence supporters in Donbass. Alexander Kolomiyets is not the first senior Ukrainian military officer to have sided with the pro-independence militia in Donetsk and Lugansk.

OSCE MONITORS CONFIRM MILITANTS IN DONBAS USE HEAVY WEAPONRY, 22.06.2015

The OSCE Special Monitoring Mission (SMM) to Ukraine reports that Russian-backed militants continue using heavy weapons, including the Grad multiple rocket launchers. The situation around the destroyed Donetsk airport and in the village of Shyrokyne near the Ukrainian-controlled city of Mariupol remains tense, according to an OSCE SMM update based on information as of 1930 Kyiv time on June 19 and published on June 20.

"In government-controlled Popasna (69km north-west of Luhansk), the SMM observed five fresh craters, which it assessed to have been caused by impacts from multiple-launch rocket system (MLRS) fire (122mm BM-21 Grad)," the update reads.

OSCE monitors observe approx. 700 explosions in Donbas over last weekend, 23.06.2015

"During the weekend, fighting intensified in Donetsk, where substantially increased shelling was observed. A high level of violence was observed in and around Donetsk airport," said the report released on Monday evening. "Over a period of two days, from its position at the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) observation point at Donetsk central railway station ("DPR"-controlled, 8km north-west of Donetsk city centre) and other observation posts in and near Donetsk city centre, the SMM observed more than 500 incoming and outgoing explosions consistent with artillery and mortar fire," it said. "The SMM heard 187 of these explosions from its observation post at the central railway station, at locations to the north, north-north-west, south-west, and north-east at distances 2 to 8km," the monitors reported.

An increase in ceasefire violations was also observed in areas near Mariupol over the weekend. In Luhansk the situation was calm over the weekend with sporadic shelling observed.

Between 09:00 and 17:00hrs, at the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) observation point at Donetsk central railway station ("Donetsk People's Republic" ("DPR")-controlled, 8km north-west of Donetsk city centre), the SMM observed a total of 362 explosions consistent with artillery and mortar fire as well as bursts consistent with automatic grenade launcher, heavy machine gun and small-arms and light-weapons fire. The SMM assessed that the explosions occurred at locations to the north, north-west, north-east and west and at distances ranging between 2 and 10km from its position. The SMM also observed 26 airbursts of anti-aircraft weapon at 2-3km west and north-west of its position. In the early evening hours of 21 June, the SMM unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) spotted burning houses in Shyrokyne. The situation around Shyrokyne (20km east of Mariupol) was quiet between 06:30 and 13:50hrs; during this period of time the SMM did not observe any ceasefire violations from its observation points located 1.5 and 3.5km west of Shyrokyne. In the Luhansk region the SMM observed several ceasefire violations, including 23 explosions consistent with incoming and outgoing heavy artillery fire in Toshkivka (government-controlled, 60km north-west of Luhansk) and 31 explosions consistent with incoming and outgoing artillery in Komyshevukha (government-controlled, 66km west of Luhansk). In "LPR"-controlled areas, the SMM heard several explosions in Donetsk and Kirovsk (50km north-west of Luhansk) and in Pervomaik and Molodizhne (57 and 62km west of Luhansk).

Small arms and grenade launchers were used against Opytne, Krasnohorivka and Shyrokyne.

Information Resistance: Russian-backed militants 'know about OSCE mission movements', 24.06.2015

The militants have been firing small arms and mortars from the "neutral zone" near the town of Prymorsk in an attempt to provoke the Ukrainian army to use heavy weapons as OSCE monitors arrive in the area, the group said in a statement released on Wednesday.

"Attacks are reported to have been launched on the positions of Ukrainian troops just before the arrival of the OSCE monitors to the front line, suggesting that the militants possess information about the movement of OSCE Special Monitoring Mission patrols," the group said in its statement. There have been numerous other reports of militants apparently timing their attacks to take place at times when there are no OSCE monitors present, particularly around the front-line town of Shyrokyne near Mariupol. The OSCE Special Monitoring Mission in Ukraine as of June 3 still included 24 Russian citizens, even though it is now almost beyond doubt that Russia is a party to the conflict in Ukraine: Several media have reported Russian regular troops and military equipment being present in Ukraine over the past few months.

Russian former leader of Ukraine rebels warns of "big war", 24.06.2015

A ceasefire is likely to collapse in east Ukraine and Russia could be drawn into a "big war" to cleanse the "sore on its borders", the former leader of the region's pro-Russian separatists said. Violence has eased but not halted in east Ukraine under what are known as the Minsk 2 agreements, reached in the Belarussian capital on Feb. 12 after an earlier ceasefire collapsed. Alexander Borodai, a Russian citizen and former journalist for nationalist newspapers who emerged last year as prime minister of the self-proclaimed Donetsk People's Republic (DNR), said he expects the Ukrainian army to launch a new offensive.

"To be honest, I expect that the Minsk 2 agreements will not be observed, in the same manner as the Minsk 1 agreements were not," Borodai said in an interview this week in a Moscow restaurant surrounded by former rebel commanders. "And at the end of the day the Ukrainian army will launch an offensive. This is a very probable development ... I am not sure that it will end without a big war, as Russia cannot tolerate this sore on its borders forever."

Pro-Russian militants in Ukraine train child soldiers, 24.06.2015

He is only 14 but already knows how to assemble a Kalashnikov rifle. Denis is a child soldier in the making - eager to join the pro-Russian militants fighting Ukrainian troops. "If I were an adult, I would fight," the skinny boy with a dishevelled crew-cut said in a war-scarred town deep in the heart of the rebel-run east of the ex-Soviet state. "I want to see war, to learn how to shoot, to see the tanks," he said with an air of excitement as two adult rebels stood nodding at his side. The UN children's agency said in January it had no proof of minors being used in one of Europe's bloodiest and most diplomatically-charged conflicts since the end of the Cold War. UNICEF believes that about 250,000 children are being exploited in wars fought across nearly two dozen countries - many of them in Africa. But the Western-backed leaders in Kiev accuse the rebels of training a small army of child soldiers in schools under their control. About 20 kids between the ages of 14 and 19 are still taking training lessons in the town of Khartsyzk - home to 60,000 people prior to the breakout of hostilities and a flood of migrants for safer regions that followed -- in the first weeks of their summer break. Some like Denis are learning basic drills. But his parents are understandably wary after being trapped in fighting that has killed 6,500 and shows few signs of abating 15 months on.

"They do not talk about the war with me. They hate it," Denis said. "They do not even watch the news." Others like 17-year-old Alina are taking first aid lessons provided by the rebel command.

"We are still children and not ready to go to the front," she conceded.

"But if something were to happen, I would be able to help out."

"We have almost 1,200 Ukrainians on this horrible 'missing persons' list," Heraschenko said on Tuesday. Heraschenko said International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) officials have offered expert assistance in the search for and identification of the missing people. She also said the Ukrainian authorities had also suggested in the negotiations in Minsk on Tuesday that the ICRC should monitor the situation with the detainees and their living conditions, including in Russia. "We again emphasized that our colleague Nadia Savchenko has been illegally held in a Russian prison for a year now," the Ukrainian official said.

Additionally, the Ukrainian officials raised in the meeting of the subgroup the issue of the Russian humanitarian convoys to Donbas, which Kyiv finds to be illegal.

At the same time, leaders of the self-proclaimed republics groundlessly and cynically accuse the Ukrainian side of committing this crime," the ATO press center said.

OSCE: All civilians have left Shyrokyne, over 80% of houses destroyed by militants, 30.06.2015

"The SMM visited Shyrokyne and confirmed media reports that all civilians have left the village. The SMM conducted a foot patrol on 27 June, focused on areas where a few remaining inhabitants had been known to live when the SMM last visited the village on 9 June. The SMM on this occasion found their homes abandoned and damaged or destroyed. Following this patrol, the SMM spoke to a "DPR" [the self-proclaimed Donetsk People's Republic] commander who said he knew by name those whom the SMM was seeking. According to him, the last civilian inhabitants left on 15 June. The SMM observed that the scale of damage in the village had increased since the last visit. It assessed that over 80% of the houses and buildings in the village are destroyed," the OSCE SMM said in its daily update on Monday after a visit to the village on Sunday. "At and around Donetsk airport, the SMM noted an increase in ceasefire violations as compared to recent days. During a one-hour period in the afternoon of 28 June, the SMM observed 139 explosions to the north, north-east and north-west. SMM could furthermore hear bursts of small arms and light weapons in combination with heavy machine-gun fire," the report reads.

Savchenko's lawyer says investigation dramatically accelerates, 05.06.2015

"It must be noted that investigators have recently started to whip themselves up. For example, when we told an investigator that we couldn't come, we were busy and had other things to do, the investigator could come to us on his own to bring papers for signing because he had to report on this on the same day," Novikov told Novaya Gazeta.

According to him, the investigation had accelerated dramatically even before two Russian special forces officers – Sergeant Alexander Alexandrov and Captain Yevgeny Yerofeyev – were detained by the Ukrainian military in Luhansk region. The lawyer explains this by "the command." "Apparently, the decision has already been made to hold a court as soon as possible and then conduct negotiations at the level of diplomacy after the court," Novikov said.

Moscow court extends Savchenko's arrest until September 30, 10.06.2015

Savchenko may face 13 years in prison - lawyer Novikov, 22.06.2015

Ukrainian pilot, MP of Ukraine Nadiya Savchenko, who is being illegally held in Moscow, faces a thirteen-year sentence in Russia. This was announced by one of Savchenko's lawyers, Ilya Novikov in the Podrobnosti Nedely weekly program on Inter TV Channel.

"This will be a guilty verdict with about 13 years [in prison], or even more. This doesn't bother us and this is not interesting. We are well aware that it's not the number [of years] her return home depends on," Novikov said. According to the lawyer, the defense of the Ukrainian pilot does not expect a fair verdict as justice in Russia has changed over the last 20 years.

"There will be no fair trial. Russian justice has become ridiculous in the past two decades. They won't free Savchenko just for a thank you. This would be a blow to [the reputation of] the country's leaders," Novikov said.

Pentagon Seeks Easing of Ban on Russian Rockets for U.S. Space Missions, 04.06.2015

Now, that simple act of punishment is proving difficult to keep in place.

Only five months after the ban became law, the Pentagon is pressing Congress to ease it.

Defying Obama, Many in Congress Press to Arm Ukraine, 11.06.2015

With the peace process stalled and violence escalating in Ukraine, a bipartisan coalition in Congress is defying President Obama and European allies by pressing the administration to provide weapons to the embattled nation.

Putin of Russia a pretext for further incursions.

U.S. Is Poised to Put Heavy Weaponry in Eastern Europe, 14.06.2015

In a significant move to deter possible Russian aggression in Europe, the Pentagon is poised to store battle tanks, infantry fighting vehicles and other heavy weapons for as many as 5,000 American troops in several Baltic and Eastern European countries, American and allied officials say. The proposal, if approved, would represent the first time since the end of the Cold War that the United States has stationed heavy military equipment in the newer NATO member nations in Eastern Europe that had once been part of the Soviet sphere of influence. Russia's annexation of Crimea and the war in eastern Ukraine have caused alarm and prompted new military planning in NATO capitals. It would be the most prominent of a series of moves the United States and NATO have taken to bolster forces in the region and send a clear message of resolve to allies and to Russia's president, Vladimir V. Putin, that the United States would defend the alliance's members closest to the Russian frontier.

EU extends sanctions against Russian occupied Crimea for another year, 19.06.2015

On June 19, 2015, the Council extended the EU restrictive measures in response to the illegal annexation of Crimea and Sevastopol until June 23, 2016. The sanctions include prohibitions on:

- imports of products originating in Crimea or Sevastopol into the EU;
- investment in Crimea or Sevastopol, meaning that no Europeans nor EU-based companies can buy real estate or entities in Crimea, finance Crimean companies or supply related services;
- tourism services in Crimea or Sevastopol, in particular, European cruise ships cannot call at ports in the Crimean peninsula, except in case of emergency;
- exports of certain goods and technologies to Crimean companies or for use in Crimea in the transport, telecommunications and energy sectors and related to the prospection, exploration and production of oil, gas and mineral resources. Technical assistance, brokering, construction or engineering services related to infrastructure in these sectors must not be provided either.

As stated by the European Council on March 19, 2015, the EU continues to condemn the illegal annexation of Crimea and Sevastopol by the Russian Federation and remain committed to fully implement its non-recognition policy.

The Fantasy Mr. Putin Is Selling, 22.06.2015

President Vladimir Putin of Russia is not veering from the mythology he created to explain away the crisis over Ukraine. It is one that wholly blames the West for provoking a new Cold War and insists that international sanctions have not grievously wounded his country's flagging economy. He told the story again on Friday at a business forum whose purpose was to give weight to that fantasy. It drew at least 24 chief executives of Western companies, some of whom attended even though their governments had urged them not to. Despite Mr. Putin's skill at using foreign executives as props, he is looking more desperate than confident that he will win the confrontation with the West. It will be a big setback for Mr. Putin if, as expected, European Union foreign ministers formally extend sanctions on Russia by six months when they meet this week in Luxembourg. Ever since Russia's 2014 annexation of Crimea forced NATO and the European Union to react, he has worked to split the trans-Atlantic alliance, and some believe its collapse is his real goal.

US analysts don't see Russia creating land corridor to Crimea, 24.06.2015

According to the U.S. experts, there is a threat of escalation of the situation in the east of Ukraine. "The escalation of the conflict in the Donbas has already taken place before, but the current escalation is characterized by its running along the whole demarcation line," the report says. "Previous active hostilities were localized and were rarely accompanied by a significant increase in the intensity of the fire. However, the militants are now sending heavy weapons, including howitzers and rocket launchers, to the front line. In addition, the number of attacks on the positions of the Ukrainian armed forces has increased significantly, the report reads.

"OSCE observers have recorded the disappearance of equipment from the storage sites where they were placed after the withdrawal from the demarcation line. This is a clear violation of the Minsk agreements," the document says. At the same time, according to Stratfor analysts, the concentration of forces and heavy weapons near the demarcation line does not indicate the preparation of a large-scale offensive with regular Russian troops to occupy Ukraine along the Dnipro River or creating a land "corridor" to Crimea.
