Introduction

October 2014 will be remembered due to constant ceasefire violations in eastern Ukraine, new victims among the military and civilians, humanitarian convoys of the Russian Federation and the early parliamentary elections, which took place on October 26th.

More than two thousand official observers from foreign states and international organizations supervised the election process.

The voter turnout was 52.9%.

According to the results of elections to the Verkhovna Rada were elected 7 political forces - the Bloc of Petro Poroshenko, the People's Front, Samopomich Union, the Opposition Bloc, Oleh Liashko's Radical Party, and Batkivshchyna All-Ukrainian Union.

The most radical political forces – "Svoboda" and "Right sector" - did not overcome the 5% electoral threshold.

'Novorossiya' to be a threat to Putin himself - Financial Times, 01.10.2014

KYIV, October 1 /Ukrinform/. A New Russia, or "Novorossiya," which was devised by the entourage of Russian President Vladimir Putin, will soon turn into a problem for Putin himself, as the Kremlin will sooner or later lose control over separatists, who it feeds with myths and unfulfilled promises, Britain's Financial Times newspaper has reported, according to a Ukrinform correspondent.

"He [Putin] thinks he can do what other Russian leaders have done before - subdue his subjects by putting Russia in a state of permanent confrontation with the outside world. But the propaganda that plays endlessly on Russian television channels will not mesmerize them for long. Russian society will only accept short and victorious war. It is not prepared for bloodshed," the newspaper wrote.

Capture of Donetsk airport or Mariupol to trigger new sanctions - Bloomberg, 02.10.2014

KYIV, October 2 /Ukrinform/. The European Union may impose additional sanctions on Russia if pro-Russian fighters capture the Donetsk airport or the city of Mariupol, Bloomberg has reported, citing its own sources.

"If the separatists took the Donetsk airport or the city of Mariupol in an effort to create a land corridor, the EU might impose additional sanctions... The outcome is impossible to predict and could go either way," reads the statement.

The report also states that the EU is far from considering an easing of the sanctions imposed on Russia for its encroachment on Ukraine.

Ukrainian economy to contract by 8% - World Bank, 02.10.2014

KYIV, October 2 /Ukrinform/. The Ukrainian economy will contract by 8% this year because of the war in Donbas, the World Bank said on Thursday, according to AFP.

Thus, an earlier forecast is downgraded and further shrinkage in 2015 is forecast. "Disruption in economic activity in the east has resulted in a sharper GDP decline than we expected," said Qimiao Fan, the bank's director for Ukraine, Belarus and Moldova who presented the latest report in Kyiv.

IMF forecasts reduction of Ukraine's GDP to minus 6.5%, 07.10.2014

KYIV, October 7 /Ukrinform/. The International Monetary Fund forecasts reduction of Ukraine's GDP to minus 6.5% in 2014.

This is said in the IMF World Economic Outlook, made public by the Fund on Tuesday, a special correspondent of Ukrinform reports.

According to forecasts for 2015, it is expected that Ukraine's GDP will demonstrate a positive dynamics at the level of 1%.

At the same time, the IMF experts forecast growth of consumer prices in the country by 11.4% in 2014 to 14% in 2015. The balance of payments index of Ukraine will remain at the level of minus 2.5% for this and next year.

In addition, the unemployment level in Ukraine in 2014 is expected at the level of 10%, however, in 2015 it will drop to 9.8%.

Washington Post: Putin may achieve major objectives in Ukraine, 07.10.2014

KYIV, October 7 /Ukrinform/. U.S. newspaper Washington Post reported on Tuesday that Russia should ensure the complete withdrawal of Russian troops and military equipment from Ukraine.

According to Deutsche Welle, the report says that only the withdrawal of troops could be a prerequisite for any weakening of European and U.S. sanctions against Russia. Washington Post also sees the need to seal the border between the countries, with monitoring by international observers.

Ukraine may default next year - Moody's, 10.10.2014

KYIV, October 10 /Ukrinform/. Ukraine is likely to default on its debts next year when it breaches the conditions of a controversial \$3 billion bond held by Russia, allowing Moscow to demand immediate repayment and possibly triggering a wider default on all the country's international debts, Moody's has warned, Voice of America has reported, citing Financial Times.

The rating agency notes that Ukraine's deep 7.5% economic contraction and wilting currency is likely to push its debt-to-GDP ratio up to 66% this year - above the maximum 60% ratio stipulated in the clauses of the Russian Eurobond that the last Kyiv government sold to Moscow before the revolution.

"When Ukraine's debt-to-GDP ratio official breaches that level - possibly as early as January 29, when it is slated to release provisional fourth-quarter economic data - Moscow can ask for an immediate payment acceleration," the report says.

Ukraine needs reforms to avoid default - The Economist, 13.10.2014

KYIV, October 13 /Ukrinform/. International experts believe that Ukraine, burdened by debt and lack of reform, may default in the near future, The Economist has reported.

According to the report, the Ukrainian government must pay external creditors \$9 billion by the end of next year, plus an additional \$5 billion in 2016 and \$8 billion in 2017. At the same time, the country's foreign-exchange reserves are drying up fast, having fallen from \$37 billion in 2011 to \$16 billion now.

According to the report, the good news is that Ukraine still has time to pull off an orderly restructuring. According to experts, with no oil to pump or other treasures to sell, it is hard to see how Ukraine's shrinking economy can service its current debts, let alone the new ones the IMF is providing. S&P upgrades Kyiv's ratings, 15.10.2014

KYIV, October 15 /Ukrinform/. Standard & Poor's rating agency has raised its long-term issuer credit rating on the Ukrainian capital city of Kyiv and its issue ratings on Kyiv's debt to 'CCC' from 'CC,' the agency's press service has reported.

"The city of Kyiv repaid its Ukrainian hryvnia (UAH) 1.125 billion domestic bond series B on October 8, 2014, instead of restructuring it as previously announced. We think Kyiv's course of action is coordinated with and supported by the central government of Ukraine.... For this reason, we are raising our rating on Kyiv to 'CCC' from 'CC' and removing it from CreditWatch negative," reads the report.

S&P believes that although Kyiv will face high debt service obligations in 2015-2016, including repayment of \$550 million in Eurobonds, it will similarly benefit from central government support. http://www.ukrinform.ua/eng/news/sandp_upgrades_kyivs_ratings_326621

Recognition of terrorist elections to strengthen sanctions against Russia - media, 30.10.2014

The European Union may tighten sanctions against Russia if Russian authorities recognize the results of elections in Donbas that were scheduled by the self-proclaimed Donetsk and Luhansk People's Republics (DPR and LPR) for November 2. Kommersant reported this, citing a well-informed source in the EU structures.

Kyiv, Brussels complete all formalities for launching Association Agreement from Nov 1 – Poroshenko, 01.10.2014

KYIV, October 1 /Ukrinform/. Ukraine has received a note from the European Union in which the EU announced the completion of its internal procedures for the application of the Association Agreement, Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko has reported on Facebook.

"Thus, Kyiv and Brussels have completed all formalities for launching the agreement from November 1. Consequently, it is now part of Ukrainian legislation. Russian troops still in Ukraine - NATO, 01.10.2014

"However, hundreds of Russian troops, including special forces, still remain inside Ukraine," Janzen said.

This is stated in Barroso's letter to Putin that was sent on Wednesday in response to Putin's letter of September 17, the European Commission told Ukrinform's correspondent in Brussels. Barroso urges Putin to resume gas supply to Ukraine, 02.10.2014

"We also expect that rapid and decisive progress can be achieved in the trilateral gas talks towards a mutually acceptable interim solution for the upcoming winter period, on the basis of the compromise elements set out by the European Commission. It is key that the resumption of energy deliveries to the citizens of Ukraine is ensured and that the fulfillment of all contractual obligations with customers in the EU is secured," Barroso said.

"I learned from operational sources that nationality to Ukraine's betrayers had been granted under a separate secret decree of Russian President Putin as a reward for their faithful service on the collapse of the national security, defense, law and order system and the economy," the Ukrainian interior minister's advisor, Anton Herashchenko wrote on Facebook.

Lukashenko ready to send his peacekeepers to Donbas, 03.10.2014

"If necessary. But for me this would be a very dangerous and terrible thing to put my own soldiers at risk: if the Russians mistrust the West, and the West Russia, if the United States and Russia mistrusted each other, and there is mistrust between the warring parties, I would have been putting my own armed forces in harm's way to separate the conflicting parties," Lukashenko said.

White House condemns killing of Red Cross employee, 04.10.2014

KYIV. October 4 /Ukrinform/. The United States has condemned the murder of an employee of the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), who was killed after a shell hit the ICRC office in Donetsk on October 2.

The White House said this in a statement issued on Friday, Ukrinform's correspondent reported. "The United States condemns the killing of Laurent DuPasquier, an International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) staff member, caused by shelling yesterday [on October 2] near the organization's premises in Donetsk, Ukraine. We extend our sympathies and condolences to Mr. DuPasquier's family, friends, and colleagues," reads the statement.

The White House urged all parties to the conflict to respect international humanitarian law and ensure that its protections are afforded to the ICRC and other humanitarian organizations, which are providing impartial and much-needed aid to civilians in Ukraine.

"We call on all parties to the conflict to protect the civilians in their midst and hold accountable those who engage in the indiscriminate use of force," the statement says.

Ukraine has evidence ICRC staff member killed by separatists - Serheyev, 04.10.2014

KYIV, October 4 /Ukrinform/. There is strong evidence that a shell that killed an employee of the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) in Donetsk was launched from the territory controlled by separatists, and Ukraine promises to conduct a full and open investigation. Ukraine's Permanent Representative to the United Nations Yuriy Serheyev said this at a briefing in New York on Friday, Ukrinform's correspondent reported.

OSCE observers admit to carrying armed militants in their car, 04.10.2014

The OSCE Special Monitoring Mission to Ukraine (SMMU) has officially acknowledged that OSCE mission employees in Donetsk region were transporting pro-Russian terrorists in their car and confirmed that this fact is a breach of the organization's internal security regulations, according to a statement posted on the OSCE website. Earlier media reports said that two militants had easily got into an OSCE car. This case was broadcasted by Russia's First Channel, TSN reported.

"The SMMU regrets the incident where two uniformed individuals boarded our vehicle. We have also undertaken all measures to prevent such a regrettable incident from occurring again," reads the statement.

In particular, from my talks in Moscow, it is not clear for me how the border will be controlled. NBU promises exchange rate of UAH 11.7/\$1, 07.10.2014

"Once we restore industrial potential, we can clearly think not about the rate of 12.95, but we'll again about the sale [rate] of 11.7," Hontareva said.

As reported, on Monday, hryvnia-dollar quotations on Ukraine's interbank currency market at the close of trading were set at UAH 12.9550/13.1500/\$1 against UAH 12.9633/13.1500/\$1 at 12.00.

80% of industry not working in Luhansk and Donetsk region - Economy Ministry, 07.10.2014

OSCE mission in eastern Ukraine expanded, 08.10.2014

Government trying to save Kyiv from default, 08.10.2014

KYIV, October 8 /Ukrinform/. "We have allocated UAH 1.8 billion in support of the capital. I am asking the finance minister to allocate [UAH] 835 million to ensure the repayment of Kyiv's debt for the consumption of natural gas," Ukrainian Prime Minister Arseniy Yatseniuk said at a cabinet meeting.

Yatseniuk said that UAH 1 billion of this amount was direct assistance to the city to complete debt repayment.

Government controlling situation with gas supplies - Yatseniuk, 08.10.2014

KYIV, October 8 /Ukrinform/. The situation in Ukraine's energy sector remains extremely difficult, but the government is controlling it. There are currently 16.7 billion cubic meters of natural gas in Ukraine's underground storage facilities.

Prime Minister Arseniy Yatseniuk said this at a government meeting on Wednesday, the government portal reported.

"Natural gas supplies began under a contract between Naftogaz of Ukraine and one of the world's largest energy operators, Norwegian company Statoil," he said, recalling that reverse supplies were launched from October 1.

US, Britain again urge Kremlin to withdraw troops from Ukraine, 09.10.2014

KYIV, October 9 /Ukrinform/. U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry and British Foreign Secretary Philip Hammond have again said that Russia should immediately withdraw its troops from Ukraine, end its "material support" for separatists, and meet its commitments under a ceasefire agreement reached in Minsk, Radio Liberty has reported.

"Together with our partners in the European Union, the United States and the United Kingdom are supporting Ukraine's sovereignty and territorial integrity, and the Ukrainian government's efforts to implement important democratic reforms," Kerry said after a meeting with Hammond at a press conference in Washington.

This would present no threat to Russia unless its forces launch further aggression against Ukraine. In other words, these weapons are lethal but not

provocative because they are defensive.

Russia says Ukraine should find money to pay for gas within a week, 22.10.2014 BY KATYA GOLUBKOVA

(Reuters) - Ukraine should be able to find ways of paying for Russian gas supplies within a week, Russian Energy Minister Alexander Novak said on Wednesday, suggesting a standoff would end once Moscow received financial guarantees from Kiev.

The latest round of gas talks between Moscow and Kiev ended late on Tuesday in Brussels with no agreement in a dispute that prompted Russia to cut off gas supplies to its neighbor in mid-June, potentially hurting flows west to the European Union.

On Tuesday, Russia increased the pressure on Ukraine, which is dependent on Western aid, demanding assurances on how Kiev, would find the money to pay Moscow. Earlier Ukraine asked the European Union for a further 2 billion euros in credit.

Novak told reporters at an energy conference in Moscow that the two sides had almost reached a deal but that the talks came unstuck "by another issue - where will Ukraine get the money to pay in advance for gas supplies in November and December".

"If the Ukrainians have the money, then the documents will be signed. If not, then we will wait." "If Europe gives them the money, then gas will flow," he said.

"The Stockholm arbitration court has accepted our additional lawsuit regarding an interim solution in the case between Naftogaz and Gazprom," Ukrainian Prime Minister Arseniy Yatseniuk said.

According to Yatseniuk, Ukraine has two options to resolve the problem with gas.

"The first option is to sign an interim agreement that we have drawn up together with our European partners.... The second option [initiated by the government several months ago] is a dispute settlement in court," Yatseniuk said.

"The court may set an interim price and, respectively, a procedure for payment and gas supply," he said.

"For the first time in 96 years, the Ukrainian parliament will be without communists. I congratulate you with this event. Ukrainians have struck a final blow to a political fifth column.

Justice has triumphed, and this also concerns the pro-Russian Party of Regions, which was unable to take part in the elections."

"Now we have reached a position where the price will be determined by the formula directly stipulated in the contract. This formula is influenced by the price of oil, which has fallen significantly. This means that in the last quarter of this year the price will be 378 [dollars per 1,000 cubic meters], while in the first quarter of next year the price will stand at 365 [dollars per 1,000 cubic meters]," Ukrainian Prime Minister Arseniy Yatseniuk said.

He recalled that earlier, Ukraine and the European Union had proposed that Russia amend the current contract, which would envisage the gas price for Ukraine in the summer season at \$325 per 1,000 cubic meters and in the winter season at \$385 per 1,000 cubic meters, when prices for energy resources grow.

"The price of gas for Ukraine has been agreed at \$378 per 1,000 cubic meters in the fourth quarter of 2014 and at \$365 per 1,000 cubic meters in the first quarter of 2015," the Russian company said on Twitter on Thursday.

United States officially deprives Russia of all trade benefits, 04.10.2014

KYIV, October 4 /Ukrinform/. The United States has officially deprived Russia of trade benefits under the U.S. Generalized System of Preferences (GSP).

A respective proclamation was issued by President Barack Obama, ITAR-TASS reported. "From now on, Russian goods, to which the GSP system earlier applied, will be subject to U.S. import duties on general grounds. The decision to deprive Russia of benefits was announced on May 8, but the White House decision officially came into force from October 3. The formal reason named by the United States is that the preferential approach is envisaged for countries less economically advanced than Russia and that the White House actions were not officially connected with the Ukrainian crisis," reads the statement.
