

Monitoring of Xenophobia and Extremism in Ukraine October 2016

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Introduction

Since the beginning of the antiterrorist operation in the Donbass in the fighting killed more than 2.5 thousand members of the Armed Forces of Ukraine. More than 280 thousand Ukrainians took part in the anti-terrorist operation during two and a half years.

Elimination in Donetsk Russian terrorist Arsen Pavlov, known as Motorola, can be a turning point in the war against Russia in Ukraine.

Experts point out that Motorola was the fifth "ranking" mercenary who was killed far from the line of fighting. Version that Pavlov was eliminated by Ukrainian special services does not withstands criticism, as the most likely scenario is the competition between gangs in the Donets Basin and the elimination of many militants who knows the secret services of Russia.

Another top theme began negotiations "Norman Quartet" in Berlin the fate of the occupied part of the Donbass.

In Ukraine is over the first stage of filing electronic tax returns of top officials of Ukraine for 2015. They were required to disclose their assets in accordance with the new law on combating corruption.

E-declaration is regarded as one of the priority reforms to Kiev could continue to enjoy the support of its Western partners.

More than 70,000 top government officials, including judges, politicians and civil servants, published their declaration.

Prognosis

30% of Ukrainians want to emigrate - poll, 24.10.2016

30% of Ukrainians would rather like to go abroad for permanent residence, nearly 65% rather wouldn't. This is evidenced by the research conducted by the sociological group "Rating" in September 2016. Increasingly show a desire to go abroad for permanent place of residence or work, residents of the Western and Central regions, men, people of younger age, with a high level of education and income. The main reasons – obtaining better conditions of life (53%), the desire to provide a better future for children (41%), lack of decent work in Ukraine (32%). In addition, for respondents with children under 16 years of age, the desire to provide a better future for children is the main motive (52%) travel abroad for permanent residence. Among other motives for departure abroad for permanent residence: 13% – to better fulfillment, 8% – from-for feeling in danger in Ukraine, 7% – with the aim of obtaining the best education or the best medical care, 5% for the best conditions for doing business abroad.

What Is Russia Up To, and Is It Time to Draw the Line?, 01.10.2016

The behavior of Russia in the last few weeks has echoes of some of the uglier moments of the Cold War, an era of proxy battles that ended in 1991 with the collapse of the Soviet Union. President Obama, fresh from a meeting with President Vladimir V. Putin this month, wondered aloud whether the Russian leader was content living with a "constant, low-grade conflict." His reference was to Ukraine, but he could have been addressing any of the arenas where Mr. Putin has reveled in his new role as the great disrupter of American plans around the globe. "It seems to me we have Mr. Putin's answer," said Richard Haass, the president of the Council on Foreign Relations and the author of a coming book, "A World in Disarray." "He's answered in the affirmative. Low-grade conflict is his thing. And the question is how directly or indirectly we introduce costs." None of these conflicts have, in fact, cost Mr. Putin very much. Cyber power in particular is tailor-made for a country in Russia's circumstances — a declining economy with the gross domestic product of Italy. Rada chairman Parubiy wants tougher sanctions, visas for Russia, 03.10.2016 Chairman of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine Andriy Parubiy proposes debates on the possibility of introducing a visa regime with Russia and expanding sanctions against that country. Addressing the coordination board of factions` and committees` chairmen on Monday, he recalled that in early 2016, he tabled a draft resolution in parliament, calling on the Cabinet of Ministers to terminate an agreement between the governments of Ukraine and Russia on visa-free travel. "Perhaps, today it makes sense to revisit the issue of the introduction of a visa regime with the Russian Federation," Parubiy said.

Ukrainian FM on Donbas: 'Security should be there and Russia should be out', 05.10.2016 "My fundamental point [is that] security should be there and Russia should be out, in order to get Donbas back into Ukraine," Klimkin told. He said Western sanctions on Moscow should remain in place until Russia is "literally out of Ukraine." Allowing Russia to attack an independent country would be like "opening Pandora's box." In an attempt to end the conflict in eastern Ukraine, both Kyiv and pro-Russian separatists from Donetsk and Luhansk signed the Minsk II settlement in February 2015. Today, key aspects of the agreement, such as the withdrawal of heavy weapons and the exchange of prisoners, have yet to be implemented. But Klimkin told DW's Tim Sebastian on Conflict Zone that these failures do not mean the agreement is dead, adding that "Minsk is simple and easy, if you want to implement it." "We have fundamental differences with Russia on how we understand Minsk," Klimkin said. "Russia wants to legalize [a] Russian protectorate in Donbas."

Future war with Russia or China would be 'extremely lethal and fast', US generals warn, 06.10.2016

Any future war with Russia or China would be "extremely lethal and fast" and produce violence on the scale not seen for 60 years, according to US generals. Artificial intelligence and automated weapons systems will accelerate any future conflict, Major General William Hix has warned. "A conventional conflict in the near future will be extremely lethal and fast," he told a future-of-the-Army panel on Tuesday, Defense One reports. "And we will not own the stopwatch." General Hix described his vision of accelerated future warfare: "The speed of events are likely to strain our human abilities.

EU to extend sanctions for six months over violation of Ukraine's sovereignty, 07.10.2016 "COREPER has confirmed the Council's intention to prolong by six months the application of the EU restrictive measures targeting action against Ukraine's territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence (until 15 March 2017)," the statement said. The statement added that the sanctions consist of an asset freeze and a travel ban against 146 persons and 37 entities. The Council of the European Union is due to formally adopt the relevant legal acts. "It is expected this will be done via written procedure," the statement said. No date has been set yet, but the legal act should to be adopted before September 15, the Council added.

Germany's Steinmeier Says East-West Tensions 'More Dangerous' Than Cold War, 08.10.2016

German Foreign Minister Frank-Walter Steinmeier has called the current escalation of tensions created by souring relations between the United States and Russia "more dangerous" than the Cold War. In the German tabloid Bild, Steinmeier cited differences over Ukraine -- where Russia-backed separatists controlling swaths of territory -- cyberwarfare, the recently announced end of some cooperation to dispose of weapons-grade plutonium, and Syria -- where the United States this week suggested Russia might be guilty of war crimes and over which competing votes will be put before the UN Security Council on October 9. "It's a fallacy to think that this is like the Cold War," Steinmeier said. "The current times are different and more dangerous."

Russia says U.S. actions threaten its national security, 09.10.2016

"We have witnessed a fundamental change of circumstances when it comes to the aggressive Russophobia that now lies at the heart of U.S. policy towards Russia," Lavrov told. "It's not just a rhetorical Russophobia, but aggressive steps that really hurt our national interests and pose a threat to our security." With relations between Moscow and Washington strained over issues from Syria to Ukraine, Lavrov reeled off a long list of Russian grievances against the US which he said helped contribute to an atmosphere of mistrust that was in some ways more dangerous and unpredictable than the Cold War. He complained that NATO had been steadily moving military infrastructure closer to Russia's borders and lashed out at Western sanctions imposed over Moscow's role in the Ukraine crisis. He also said he had heard that some policy makers in Washington were suggesting that President Barack Obama sanction the carpet bombing of the Syrian government's military air fields to ground its air force. "This is a very dangerous game given that Russia, being in Syria at the invitation of the legitimate government of this country and having two bases there, has got air defense systems there to protect its assets," said Lavrov. http://www.reuters.com/article/us-russia-usa-idUSKCN1290DP?il=0

"I've got ideas and scenarios of how to move further but I'm sure we're on the right track," Ukraine's Minister of Foreign Affairs Pavlo Klimkin said answering a question if there is a "plan B" if the Minsk implementation ends in deadlock. "We need to make Russia implement the Minsk [agreements]. Russia will anyway try to destabilize Ukraine. "No blitzkrieg": EU rejects idea of Russia's quick return to PACE – Ukraine envoy, 10.10.2016

The PACE Bureau has rejected the initiative for the early introduction of amendments to the regulations, guaranteeing Russia unimpeded restoration of their rights in the Assembly, Chair of the Ukrainian delegation to PACE, President of the Committee for Culture and Media Volodymyr Ariev wrote on Facebook during a meeting of the Bureau. "The Bureau abandoned the idea of promoting illegitimate and quick procedure to change the rules of the Assembly in favor of the Russian Federation. The protests of the Ukrainian delegation have triggered," he said. Ariev claims that still there will be an attempt to make these changes to the regulations, but according to a standard long procedure. Also, another way to make changes might be used by PACE. "It was decided to hold a debate in the political groups of PACE. Depending on the results, the issue will be submitted to PACE Bureau on Friday. In such circumstances, the blitzkrieg planned by pro-Russian lobbyists becomes almost impossible." Disengagement in Donbas doesn't mean armistice - Ukraine's envoy, 11.10.2016

Simultaneous disengagement doesn't mean that the process is over – it's just the beginning of the [peace] settlement. As roads need to be cleared of landmines so that OSCE patrols can drive. The OSCE mission's mandate says that personnel security is a number one priority. If there are no guarantees that a road is clear, it is considered to be inadmissible," Marchuk told. He says militants continue shelling the town of Popasna, which is close to the Zolote checkpoint. Under such conditions, it is difficult to speak about the disengagement, therefore no further steps could be taken, he said.

The situation along the contact line in Donbas is relatively stable, and these are the features of static warfare, he added.

Swedish Def.Minister: Russian missiles in Kaliningrad provocation, 11.10.2016

Minister of Defense of Sweden Peter Hultqvist commented on Russia's decision to move its nuclear-capable advanced Iskander missiles to Kaliningrad, considering this a provocative signal policy, according to Sydsvenskan. "This is something that we see as a provocative signal policy fundamentally, because it creates a sharper situation throughout the region. Especially considering possible nuclear carriers, which gives this an extra dimension," says Peter Hultqvist, Sydsvenskan reported citing TT news agency. The minister emphasized that Russia regards their move as a response against NATO's military presence in the Baltic states and Poland. "Then, one must remember that the military presence of NATO is based on the wishes of these countries," said Hultqvist. "And that, in turn, is a consequence of the annexation that took place in Crimea and the armed conflict taking place in Ukraine and the overall increase in training activities on the Russian side."

Ukraine MFA explains why diplomatic ties with Russia must be retained, 11.10.2016

Communication without intermediaries – this is the main reason why the Ukrainian diplomats do not break off relations with Russia, that's according to a Director-General for Policy and Communications at Ukraine's Ministry of Foreign Affairs Oleksii Makeiev. As an example, the official recalled that Georgia and the Russian Federation communicate only via Switzerland. If Kyiv breaks off diplomatic relations, it may lose the ability to protect and release its citizens from captivity. Makeiev has stressed that there are virtually no contacts with the aggressor state at the other levels. The exception is the communication in the Normandy format, aimed at the Donbas conflict settlement. Gerashchenko: "First elections, then borders" quintessence of EU position; Ukraine thinks different, 12.10.2016

"I can see how the words of the French president on Donbas stirred the web. In fact, he did not say a single new word. This is the position of France and Germany, representing the position of the European Union: "security - elections in line with the Ukrainian legislation and international standards (which is important, and which is what Hollande said yesterday) – [control over] the border," Gerashchenko wrote. The first vice speaker noted that the position that Ukraine defends at all levels is somewhat different and also realistic. She stressed that Ukraine stands for "security (not just a week-long ceasefire but full implementation of the security bloc of measures, including the withdrawal of foreign weapons and equipment) - a humanitarian bloc (the release of all illegally detained persons, without any indecent blackmail with amnesty, which in turn should only enter into force along with the political bloc) - border (OSCE SMM should already be on the border by now!) – a political bloc (elections under Ukrainian law and with international supervision). This is what we stand for. The elections with European observers," wrote Gerashchenko.

"Putin wants to pocket Crimea, nothing else": Hollande says new sanctions against Russia possible, 14.10.2016

New sanctions against Russia are possible in case of escalation in Donbas, while Ukraine can one day become a NATO member state, that's according to French President Francois Hollande who spoke with the authors of the book, published by Le Monde journalists, written based on conversations with the French president, 112 Ukraine TV channel reported referring to RFI. He also commented on the actions of the Russian President in respect of Ukraine. "I believe Putin's interest is to demonstrate sagacity, to calm the game down, pocket that what he has already taken [Crimea], and there's nothing else to do there [in Ukraine]," Hollande told the book's authors.

"If he does anything else there, more sanctions will come, arms will be supplied to Ukraine, and it will join NATO," said the French president.

Continuous isolation of Russia may be dangerous for Ukraine - ex-Foreign Minister, 16.10.2016

"If there is nothing more to lose one may want to escalate the conflict, regardless of the consequences, since the West will exhaust all of its levers of influence and deterrence," the former minister said. The probability of a full-scale conflict between the Russian Federation and the United States poses a threat not only to Ukraine but also to Europe and, potentially, for the whole world, Gryshchenko noted. "The aggravation of the conflict, especially considering Moscow's firm support for the Assad regime in Syria, the termination of bilateral and multilateral agreements on arms control, the undermining of efforts to resolve conflict in the east of Ukraine – all can lead to the establishment of a broad consensus in the U.S. and Europe to extend economic sanctions and strengthen political pressure on Russia. The next U.S. president may see it beneficial to demonstrate commitment to a greater consolidation of the West to repel the Russian Federation, although not all European countries will be enthusiastic about this. Gerashchenko explains why Putin avoids Normandy format meeting, 17.10.2016

First Deputy Chairperson of the Verkhovna Rada, Ukraine's representative in the humanitarian subgroup of the Trilateral contact group on Donbas settlement, Iryna Gerashchenko has told reporters why she believes Russian President Vladimir Putin avoids the meeting in the Normandy format. "As for the Kremlin's actions, it is clear that Putin is not set to leave Donbas, and neither is he willing to reach compromise. We see that he is hiding from the Normandy format because he is not ready to give answers to some very specific questions,""Putin is not ready to be held responsible for his crimes in Syria and for his crimes in Ukraine. In this context, the world needs to act appropriately, to call a spade a spade, to strengthen the sanctions, but not to debate on how to appease with a carrot someone who violates all international norms and is involved in the murders of thousands of Ukrainians and Syrians," she said.

Schultz: Sanctions against Russia to be maintained until full implementation of Minsk deal, 20.10.2016

"Sanctions will be maintained and they will continue to be applied until Minsk agreements are completely fulfilled," - said Schulz in his doorstep statement before the start of the EU summit, adding that the Minsk deal must be implemented by all parties to the conflict. The president of the European Parliament said that he had already held separate meetings with the President of Ukraine Petro Poroshenko and German Chancellor Angela Merkel, both of whom took part in the Normandy Four talks in Berlin: "Now I feel that there is no sufficient progress, but I've been told the atmosphere was more constructive than expected," Schulz said. At a briefing after the talks, Poroshenko said that the Normandy Four leaders had approved French and German proposals for the base of the "road map" for the implementation of Minsk agreements. Also, the Ukrainian president said that Russia supported the need for the deployment of an armed OSCE police mission in Donbas.

Klimkin: elections in Donbass a distant prospective, 21.10.2016

"We are a long way from being able to start organization of the elections, since before that we must make sure that all the necessary security precautions are in place. The fulfillment of these conditions will be assessed both by us and the OSCE, in particular the Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights," the minister stated. Klimkin confirmed that Ukraine has withdrawn from its earlier demand that the elections should be held only upon the return of control over the Russian-Ukrainian border. Ukraine has agreed that for the duration of preparation and holding of elections, the border will be monitored by the OSCE, he said. Ukraine must regain control over its border "on the second day after the elections." "First, there will be full monitoring [of the border] by the OSCE, the development of border control plans, and on the very next day after the elections - the transfer of the border under the control of Ukrainian border guards. Such logic was originally laid down in the Minsk agreements, and has never changed," said the minister.

Oleksandr Turchynov from the ATO zone: Over the past two weeks, the epicenter of Russian aggression has shifted towards Mariupol direction, 21.10.2016

Kremlin: Common language at Normandy Four talks is not often, 22.10.2016

"Common language is seen not that often as desired," he said. "At the same time, probably, as yet at this stage a lack of common language at least partially compensates for readiness of the Normandy Four leaders to continue working in that format. This is extremely important." Peskov told the audience about the talks, in the sense of command of foreign languages among the Normandy Four leaders. Russia's President Vladimir Putin, he said, "may be joking in German with Merkel, and then it becomes very complicated for his assistance who do not speak German." At the same time, Putin "can also speak English, he uses greatly the English language to talk 'briefly' with Hollande." The French president speaks English. Ukraine's President Pyotr Poroshenko "is trying to speak three languages." "Sometimes he begins speaking English, the parties are exchanging inquiring looks, but interpreters react masterly, translating both into Russian and Ukrainian. Some of phrases he says in Russian," Peskov said.

And Russia has a great responsibility because Russia continues to support the separatists in Donbas. U.S. intelligence names main goal of Putin's actions, 26.10.2016

U.S. National Intelligence Director James Clapper explained the motives of Russian President Vladimir Putin: "I think he is somewhat of a throwback not so much to the... Communist era or the Soviet Union but rather a throwback to the Czar era. I think he has this vision of a great Russia as a great power... It's extremely important to him that Russia be treated, respected as a global power on par with the United States," Clapper said during the meeting in the Council on Foreign Affairs in New York, answering the host's question on what is really driving Vladimir Putin. The head of the National Intelligence also said that Russia had tried to affect the outcome of the U.S. presidential election in the past. At the same time, Clapper pointed out that he considers this a minor impact, since the electoral process in the United States is decentralized and operates at the level of states and districts.

Also, the prosecutor noted that in the process of preparation and conduct of aggressive warfare, all tactical signs and insignia had been removed in advance from military equipment and uniform of the Russian soldiers who participated in the annexation of Crimea.

Ukraine Trolls Russia Hard With New Military Intelligence Logo, 31.10.2016

Russia's vice prime minister called the logo "idiotic" and said it reminded him of Nazi propaganda in the 1930's. The logo is doubly offensive to Russia, because the owl is a creature which hunts bats. The bat is the official logo of Russia's military intelligence unit, the GRU. "Russian media became very excited about the photo of Ukraine's President presenting a new chief of the Defense Intelligence. They saw there the emblem where an owl 'piercing Russia with a sword.' Let us tell them: an owl in the wild eats bats, and a bat is a symbol of the Russian military intelligence," Ukrainian journalist Dmytro Tymchuk said in a Facebook response to Russian criticism. Russia and Ukraine remain in a contentious proxy war in Eastern Ukraine. Russia continues to support Ukrainian separatist militias, often with non-uniformed Russian troops. Russia also illegally annexed Ukrainian Crimea in 2014, after a sham referendum supporting annexation passed.

Latest from OSCE Special Monitoring Mission (SMM) to Ukraine, 01.10.2016

The SMM noted an increase in the number of ceasefire violations recorded in Donetsk region on 1 October followed by a decrease on 2 October. In Luhansk region the number of ceasefire violations recorded dropped on 1 October but increased on 2 October. The Mission continued to monitor the disengagement process in Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske. The SMM was able to patrolon a road between Zolote and Pervomaisk through a section of the disengagement area. The SMM did not have full access in all disengagement areas and was restricted in its freedom of movement in the area of Stanytsia Luhanska and Petrivske. The SMM monitored three border areas not controlled by the Government. The SMM noted an increase in the number of ceasefire violations recorded in Donetsk region on 1 October, followed by a decrease on 2 October.[1] On 1 October the SMM recorded 473 explosions in Donetsk region compared with 255 the previous day. On 2 October the SMM recorded 280 explosions.

Ukrainian rebel leaders divided by bitter purge, 05.10.2016

After Russian-backed rebels proclaimed the creation of the Luhansk People's Republic in 2014, a paratrooper-turned-entrepreneur was swept to power as the prime minister of the breakaway state in eastern Ukraine. Gennady Tsypkalov, with a background in the oil pipeline industry and rumored links to organized crime, had gained a reputation as a discreet, well-connected man you could do business with — a pro-Russian pragmatist rather than an extreme separatist ideologue. He "was neither a hillbilly nor a gentleman," said a former colleague who spoke on the condition of anonymity out of concern for his own safety. "Sure, he had some romantic notions of the Red Army and the glories of the Soviet Empire. But first and foremost, he was a businessman."

Ousted a year ago, he was arrested in mid-September and accused of plotting a coup. Today he is dead.

Major escalation in Donbas: 68 militant attacks, artillery and armour used, 05.10.2016

Donbas sees a serious escalation of heavy shelling in the Luhansk sector, press centre of the Ukrainian Anti-Terrorist Operation HQ reports. Russian proxies attacked Ukrainian army positions in Donbas 68 during the day, hitting Luhansk region 36 times, Mariupol sector – 19 times, Donetsk sector – 13 times. The Luhansk sector, which was to be the scene of disengagement of the troops according to the latest agreement, turned into a major battlefield. Russian proxies used small arms, machine guns, grenade launchers, anti-aircraft guns, 120mm and 82mm mortars, 122mm artillery and infantry fighting vehicles to attack Ukrainian troops. In the Donetsk sector, Russia's hybrid military forces attacked with light arms and heavy 120mm mortars, the hottest point in the area was the town of Avdiyivka. In the Mariupol sector militants attacked with anti-tank rockets, and commenced firing on the villages of Talakivka and Lebedynske using 82mm mortars and infantry fighting vehicles. Ukrainian troopers also spotted one Russian UAV over Donbas.

The Mission continued to monitor the disengagement process in Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske; the SMM was restricted in its freedom of movement in all three areas. The SMM monitored the situation of civilians queuing at entry-exit checkpoints and observed a demonstration in Luhansk city against the deployment of an international armed mission. The SMM recorded more ceasefire violations in Donetsk region, including 329 explosions compared with 127 explosions on 9 October.

"The ceasefire in Stanytsia Luhanska did not last a week. Yesterday, the militants again fired on our positions from the opposite side of the Siverskiy Donets River," he told reporters. Bomb Kills Pro-Russian Rebel Commander in Eastern Ukraine, 18.10.2016

A prominent commander of the Russian-backed separatist forces in eastern Ukraine has been killed by a bomb, rebel leaders and Russian news reports said. Arsen Pavlov, the commander, who went by the nom de guerre Motorola after the brand of walkie-talkie he preferred, was blown up as he rode the elevator in his apartment building on Sunday in Donetsk, the larger of the rebels' two urban strongholds in eastern Ukraine, Russian news accounts said. Each side blames the other for the killing: Ukrainian officials said Russian special forces had been purging the charismatic but unpredictable early leaders of the rebel movement, while the separatists said Ukrainian assassins were operating behind their lines. Mr. Pavlov is the latest of about half a dozen commanders from the 2014 insurgency to be killed far from the front line.

U.S. Mission to OSCE: Russia continues sending troops, equipment into Ukraine, 28.10.2016

"Despite combined-separatist forces' restrictions, the SMM continues to document evidence that Russia is sending troops and equipment into Ukraine," the report says.

"On October 17, the SMM spotted a minivan with military license plates carrying personnel in camouflage as it crossed from Russia into separatist-held Ukraine. The minivan did not transit the border at an official crossing point, as would have been the case if it had been carrying a routine rotation of Russian officers to the Joint Center for Coordination and Control," writes the U.S. Mission to the OSCE. Also last week, monitors spotted a bus with at least 20 persons in camouflage crossing from separatist-held parts of Ukraine back into Russia. Taken together with the ramp up in access restrictions, this evidence is indicative of Russia's continued and active support of combined separatist forces in Ukraine.

Russian Supreme Court's Illegitimate Decision To Ban the Mejlis of the Crimean Tatar People, 01.10.2016

The United States does not recognize the legitimacy of the Russian Supreme Court's ruling to uphold the ban of Crimean Tatars' self-governing body, the Mejlis. We reject the characterization of the Mejlis as an 'extremist' organization and condemn the suspension of this democratic institution. This decision is particularly troubling given Russia's systematic and unjust mistreatment of Crimean Tatars. Russia continues to subject Crimean Tatars to arbitrary arrests, abductions, politically motivated prosecutions, restrictions on freedom of movement, and police raids on their homes and mosques. We call on Russia to cease these unacceptable practices immediately.

We do not recognize Russia's attempted annexation of Crimea, and we reiterate our call on Russia to return control of the peninsula to Ukraine. Our Crimea-related sanctions will remain in place until Moscow returns control over Crimea to Ukraine.

Ukrinform journalist left without food, water on first day of arrest in Moscow, 10.10.2016 "We have asked Roman if any physical pressure was applied to him. Sushchenko answered 'no.' But on the first day there was psychological pressure. And he was left without food and water on that first day. He received something to eat only in Lefortovo [a pre-trial detention center in Moscow] for the first time after his detention," Novaya Gazeta journalists wrote after they had visited Sushchenko in Levortovo. Sushchenko told them he had lost about six kilograms. In Lefortovo, Sushchenko got his personal belongings back, but he had to return the borrowed clothes, thus he has no second pair of clothes now, his Russian colleagues wrote. The Ukrainian journalist also told them he did not drink tap water and he was not provided by bottled water, therefore he drank tea served twice a day. Novaya Gazeta journalists say that Sushchenko is still kept in an isolation unit. "The room is absolute ascetic. The utensils include a metal plate, a spoon, a mug. PROSECUTOR: MH17 INVESTIGATION GOING WELL, 01.07.2015

The criminal investigation into the cause of the disaster with flight MH17 in eastern Ukraine is going well, according to chief prosecutor Fred Westerbeke.

The chief prosecutor of the Public Prosecutor's national office said that though the investigators haven't reached the point of "formally" identifying suspects, they have a group of potential suspects in view, NU reports. "We are getting closer to legal and convincing evidence." he said. According to him, the most likely scenario is that the Malaysian Airlines airplane was shot down by a BUK-missile. But that is not the only scenario that the Prosecutor is looking at. Experts are busy investigating alternative scenarios in order to substantiate or exclude them.

Criminal investigators from the Netherlands, Australia, Belgium, Malaysia, and Ukraine said they had "irrefutable evidence" that a Buk missile hit the plane and was fired from a part of eastern Ukraine then controlled by pro-Russian rebels. Russia is moving nuclear-capable missiles into Kaliningrad, a tiny Russian enclave sitting between Poland and Lithuania, a U.S. intelligence official said Friday, confirming Estonian news reports. Russia's reasons for shipping the 500-kilometer-range Iskander-M missiles to Kaliningrad "could be innocuous," said the official, who spoke on condition of anonymity. "They moved a similar missile system to Kaliningrad in 2014 for a military exercise. It could also be a political gesture - a show of strength - to express displeasure with NATO," said the official.

7 Ways Russia Is Telling People to Prepare for War, 16.10.2016

With tensions between Russia and the United States at their highest since the Cold War, there have been alarming signs coming out of Moscow that suggest the country is ready for war. Almost no one believes the Kremlin is actually preparing for a military conflict with the United States. Most analysts instead see it as a show, intended to boost support at home and to deter Western countries from intervening militarily in Syria. As the confrontation between the United and Russia has worsened over Syria, and amid speculation Washington might launch airstrikes against Syrian government forces, Russian state-controlled media has gone into high gear, asking Russians whether they are prepared for nuclear war. Putin's hope to ignite a Eurasia-style protest in the United States, 17.10.2016

In the fall of 2004 Vladimir Putin suffered a blow he has never forgotten. The fraudulent election of a pro-Kremlin Ukrainian president, which Putin had directly and brazenly engineered, was overturned by a massive popular uprising. What came to be known as the "Orange Revolution" created a model for resistance to rigged elections in autocracies across Eurasia — in Kyrgyzstan, Belarus, Azerbaijan and, in 2012, Russia itself. Most of the rebellions didn't succeed. But Putin developed an obsession with "color revolutions," which he is convinced are neither spontaneous nor locally organized, but orchestrated by the United States — and in the case of the Moscow protests four years ago, by Hillary Clinton herself.

Ukrainian citizen Klykh convicted in Russia gone mad due to torture – human rights activists, 22.10.2016

"As of today, Stanislav Klykh is in a very serious condition. He is a person involved in the so-called "case of Chechen militants" of Ukrainian origin... Stanislav Klykh is a person who has gone mad because of the torture, which was applied to him during the arrest and during the preliminary investigation. It is absolutely unclear how this person will be in prison, where he must be sent in the near future," she said. According to Svetova, it is necessary to conduct him a forensic psychiatric examination in the Serbsky State Scientific Center for Social and Forensic Psychiatry and to send him to Ukraine as soon as possible, putting him in a psychiatric hospital. "He's really a terrible victim of Russia's repressions against Ukrainian citizens. He was detained by accident when he arrived from Ukraine to the Russian city of Orel," she added. At the same time, according to Svetova, a forensic psychological examination of Klykh showed that he was mentally healthy and could participate in the trial.

International monitor quietly drops drone surveillance of Ukraine war, 31.10.2016

The European security organization tasked with monitoring deadly violence between government forces and Russian-separatists forces in eastern Ukraine has lost its most effective surveillance tool in the conflict: long-range unmanned aerial vehicles, or drones, according to the Foreign Policy (FP) website. "The long-range drone program was crucial for spotting armed

attacks, the stationing of prohibited weapons, and countless other cease-fire violations. But it was nixed two months ago, Foreign Policy has learned, after several of the aircraft were targeted by surface-to-air missiles and military-grade electronic jamming," senior reporter at Foreign Policy John Hudson wrote in the article titled "International Monitor Quietly Drops Drone Surveillance of Ukraine War,". "Long-range UAV operations were suspended in August following a series of hostile acts," said Natacha Rajakovic, a spokeswoman for the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE), the group authorized by world powers to observe the conflict.
