

Monitoring of Xenophobia and Extremism in Ukraine September 2015

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Introduction

Annexed the Crimea, Russia continued anti-Ukrainian aggression on the territory of Donbas. Artificial Donetsk and Lugansk "People's Republic" became the centers of the Association of Russian mercenaries and professional fighters sabotage groups on the basis of people from the Caucasus and the local pro-Russian activists. Receiving from Russia funding and weapons, including heavy armor, Grad MLRS, terrorist regularly shelled not only the camps and checkpoints ATO forces, but also residential houses, resulting in widespread killing civilians. Reached in Minsk on the eve of the tripartite contact group agreement on the withdrawal of weapons caliber less than 100 mm in the first place will be realized in the Luhansk region. Withdrawal will be carried out at 15 km from the line of contact. There will be discharged tanks, guns caliber 100 mm and mortars of a caliber up to 120 mm. Challenge will take place in two stages. Russia is not ready to agree on a coherent reintegration of Donetsk and Luhansk in the Ukrainian state. At least until then, while in Kiev Donbass does not recognize the leadership of the republics, and will not negotiate with them the laws on the status of the LPR and the DPR. Most likely, low-intensity conflict will continue. In the Donbas, most likely, it will take the situation of "neither war nor peace" as long as one of the parties does not upset the delicate balance.

President Barack Obama has ordered the State Department to provide Ukraine \$ 20 million in military aid.

The Ukrainian delegation left the hall of the UN General Assembly during a speech by Russian President Vladimir Putin. So that representatives of the Ukrainian side expressed their disagreement and protest policies pursued by Moscow.

State Aviation Administration of Ukraine informed the Russian airlines on sanctions imposed against them. Russian Prime Minister Dmitry Medvedev instructed the Transport Ministry to consider retaliatory sanctions against Ukrainian airlines. Organization "Odessa underground" has claimed responsibility for the explosion at the building of the Odessa of the SBU.

Prognosis

Putin's deceptive pause: What are Russia's next steps in Ukraine, 02.09.2015

A deceptive late-summer pause has settled over the Ukraine crisis. At least, in the coverage of it. For many weeks now, the war in the Donbas has slipped off the front page. Although leaders such as Germany's Chancellor Angela Merkel and Ukraine's President Petro Poroshenko still search for an acceptable formula to end the war, it has continued in the southeast corner of Ukraine, with casualties mounting.

Who fired first is no longer a relevant question. The point is that the war stumbles along with no end in sight. The twin rebel "republics" of Donetsk and Luhansk have slowly frozen into a Russian stronghold, effectively detached from the rest of Ukraine. They are always available to be manipulated as a pro-Russian weapon in the East-West battle for Ukraine's future.

Poll in DPR: Less than third of residents support separatists, 12.09.2015

According to the survey, only 29% supports the DPR. Earlier, the figure was even lower - 22%. The vast minority of citizens agreed to consider themselves patriots of Russia. These are 11% in the town of Ilovaisk and 12% in the town of Debaltseve. In general, only 10% of citizens in the DPR consider themselves patriots of Russia. Most people consider themselves patriots of Donbas. From 34% to 48% gave a positive answer to this question in different towns of the DPR. The findings were published on the website of Donetsk news agency. Russia's Already Lost Its Own Information War, 15.09.2015

Despite the fact that Russian propaganda often finds support in European countries, it can hardly be called a success. The polls suggest that more people have adopted a critical attitude towards Russia. In Germany, over 70% are very critical of Russia's current policy, which was not the case some two-three years ago, Niehus noted. In other countries the situation is similar, she said. According to Niehus, more and more people become aware that Russia is guided solely by its own rhetoric designed to confuse people, preventing them from developing any kind of coherent position.

Respondents were asked, if Ukraine had a party which they could describe as the one reflecting their interests. Most Russians Oppose Sending Troops To Syria: Poll, 30.09.2015

More than two-thirds of Russians oppose sending troops to Syria to prop up President Bashar al-Assad's government, while a majority approve of Moscow's use of diplomatic and political channels to help its embattled ally in the Middle East, according to a respected independent pollster. At a time when the Kremlin has been ramping up its military presence in Syria, its largest deployment outside the former Soviet Union in decades, the poll by the Levada Center found that only 14 percent of Russians believe Russia should provide "direct military support" for the Syrian government by sending in troops. The poll results were published on Moscow-based Levada's website on September 28, the same day that President Vladimir Putin said in New York that sending ground troops into combat in Syria was "out of the question."

EU says Ukraine ready to pay high price for peace, 01.09.2015

Such remarks Tusk made after a meeting with President of Croatia Kolinda Grabar-Kitarović during his visit to the country. Tusk said they also discussed Russia and the crisis in Ukraine. "We are rapidly approaching the deadline for the complete implementation of the Minsk agreements. It is critical that everyone makes every effort to ensure that this deadline is respected," Tusk said. The President of the European Council also expressed his concern about recent violence in Kyiv. "In a sense this shows the strong determination of the Ukrainian government and parliament to honor their obligations and implement the Minsk agreements, also on very sensitive issues such as granting special status for parts of Ukraine. It shows Ukraine is ready to pay a high price for peace," Tusk said.

Washington has introduced new sanctions against five companies from Russia. All of them are a part of the military-industrial complex. The official US Federal Register reports. US extends sanctions on Russians over Ukraine civil war, 02.09.2015

The US added associates of a billionaire Russian gas trader, Crimean port operators and former Ukrainian officials to its list of those penalized. The fresh US sanctions come after the European Union and Canada recently stepped up pressure on Russia to ensure that the country fully implement peace accords reached in Minsk in February but regularly violated. "Today's action underscores our resolve to maintain pressure on Russia for violating international law and fueling the conflict in eastern Ukraine," John Smith, acting director of the US Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control, said in a statement released late Thursday. In all, Treasury announced sanctions on about two dozen individuals and entities, including 13 for supporting the evasion of existing measures, two companies operating in Russia's arms sector and five Crimean port operators. The sanctions also target four former Ukrainian officials, members of the ex-Soviet state's leader Viktor Yanukovych's regime, already on the EU sanctions list: Andriy Petrovych Klyuyev, Sergey Vitalievich Kurchenko, Eduard Anatoliyovych Stavytsky, and Oleksandr Viktorovych Yanukovych. In February 2014, Yanukovych fell after months of popular protests that he had tried in vain to suppress violently and fled to Russia with the help of Kremlin security agents.

Poroshenko Blames Russia For Police Deaths, 02.09.2015

Ukraine's president has laid the blame for the murder of three policemen during a right wing demonstration on Monday firmly at the doors of the Kremlin, accusing Russia of extending its "campaign of destabilisation". Three people died after grenades were thrown during clashes between nationalists and police outside Ukraine's parliament.

It followed a vote to give more powers to the regions, including separatist regions in the east. He said that Russia had become "unpredictable" but he did not feel vulnerable, even though "this is one of the most difficult presidencies in the whole world". His claim that Russia may have been behind the grenade attack on the police will gain credence among conspiracy theorists and some military theorists. Moscow has pioneered what is now known as "hybrid warfare" – the use of covert operators to foment instability.

The Ukraine war is scheduled to end Sept. 1 with a new truce set to coincide with Ukrainian students' return to school. On Aug. 26, the trilateral contact group—comprising representatives from Ukraine, Russia and the separatist territories, under OSCE oversight—hashed out this latest call to end the fighting. And during an Aug. 29 telephone call, Russian President Vladimir Putin, German Chancellor Angela Merkel and French President Francois Hollande called for a full cease-fire on Sept. 1. At midnight on Tuesday, guns fell silent along the eastern front, according to the Ukrainian military. "From midnight to 06:00 on Sept. 1, the Kremlin-backed mercenaries were not using weapons along the demarcation line," the Anti-Terrorist Operation press center wrote in a Tuesday morning statement.

Russia faces new sanctions if pro-Kremlin militants hold own local elections, 04.09.2015 If the so-called DPR and LPR do not reach compromise with Kyiv on the issue of the date of the local elections, the West will certainly accuse them of disrupting the Minsk accords and the put the blame on the Kremlin. One source noted: "The separatists claim that the Ukrainian authorities did not discuss with them the conditions of the local elections, but it is not so." According to the Western diplomat, the militants "have not shown willingness to compromise, calling the election dates different from the rest of Ukraine; they do not demonstrate willingness to organize elections in accordance with the Ukrainian legislation." Another source of the publication noted that if the militants hold elections in the occupied part of Donbas apart from the all-Ukrainian elections and they "do not comply with Ukrainian law and are not monitored by international observers, this will be a serious - and defiant - blow to the Minsk agreements. In fact, This will be the final 'nail in the coffin' of the peace agreements." The source stressed that "no one in Europe and the United States believes that Russia cannot influence the separatists to turn from this dangerous path." The third source in the western diplomatic circles assured that imposing sanctions "is not an end in itself for the U.S. and the EU." He did not speak about the concrete price, noting that it will be "slightly lower" than the price for Q3, which was offered to Ukraine. "But the problem is that Ukraine has not asked us for a discount," the minister said. Novak also denied information that Naftogaz Ukrainy asked Gazprom for an advance for the transit of Russian gas across Ukrainian territory.

Putin opposes changes to Ukraine's Constitution, urges for Ukraine's agreement with militants, 04.09.2015

Russian president Vladimir Putin believes the whole deal regarding amendments to the Constitution of Ukraine is used as a pretext for power games inside the country. "What we are witnessing today is further political confrontation in Ukraine, and constitutional changes are solely used as a pretext to fuel political struggle for power," he told reporters. Putin recalled that in accordance with the Minsk agreements, amendments to the Constitution of Ukraine should be discussed and agreed with the Donbas. "Nothing like that, unfortunately, today Kyiv is not taking any steps to negotiate the amendments. And that's the most important, the principal thing," Putin said.

Except that, according to Putin, the law on local elections should also be agreed with the territories. Moreover, the amnesty law should also be adopted and the law on special status of these territories should be put into force.

Russia's threats to impose an embargo on Ukrainian goods if no amendments are made to an annex to the Ukrainian-EU free trade agreement are based on far-fetched apprehensions and have no economic grounds, Ukrainian Foreign Minister Pavlo Klimkin said. "Russia's objections are purely theoretical. We have closely analyzed and calculated the situation together with the EU; at the present time, we have found absolutely no grounds for objections," Klimkin said in a presentation at a session of the Ukrainian Foreign Ministry's Council of Exporters and Investors on Friday. Nevertheless, Ukraine is continuing trilateral consultations with the EU and Russia and trying to persuade Russia that its concerns are unfounded, Klimkin said. "The next round at the political level will take place exactly on Monday, and a Ukrainian delegation will also take part in it," he said. "At the present time, Russia's position is purely political and is aimed at preventing us from implementing the agreement itself. Therefore, Russia is taking a number of measures, one of them the threat of a food embargo. No formal decision has yet been made on the matter," Klimkin said. Ukraine is consistently working with other CIS countries, Klimkin said. "We have received assurances from Kazakhstan that it will not" obstruct the enforcement of Ukraine's agreement with the EU, he said.

Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko is not content with the current voting mechanism in the United Nations Security Council (UN SC), whereby a resolution can be vetoed by Russia, which is one of its permanent members. "I think they (the Russian Federation) can remain in the SC but I think that Russia must be stripped of the veto right in those conflicts to which it is a party," the president said in an interview with the Voice of America news network. Russian troops are already in Syria to aid Assad against Islamic State, says Israel, 10.09.2015

The increased Russian activity in Syria reflects Moscow's deep concerns that its longtime ally is on the brink of collapse, as well as hopes by President Vladimir Putin that a common battle against Islamic State extremists can improve Russia's ties with the West, strained over Ukraine. But the strategy could be risky — and unless Russia sends large numbers of troops, halting the territorial gains made by Islamic militants could prove tough. Pentagon: Russians apparently setting up air base in Syria, 14.09.2015

A Pentagon spokesman, Navy Capt. Jeff Davis, said the U.S. is closely monitoring the buildup, but he declined to reveal specifics about the Russian military personnel and equipment being flown to the base in Syria's coastal province of Latakia.

"We have seen indications in recent days that Russia has moved people and things into the area around Latakia and the air base there that suggests that it intends to establish some sort of a forward air operating base," Davis said.

He declined to provide an estimate of the number of Russian troops there or say what kinds of military equipment have arrived. He said the U.S. has concerns about ensuring that any Russian military air operations not come into conflict with U.S. and coalition airstrikes that are being conducted in other parts of Syria against Islamic State targets.

"We have said before that we would welcome Russian contributions to the overall global effort against (the Islamic State group), but that things that continue to support the Assad regime — particularly military things — are unhelpful and risk adding greater instability to an already unstable situation," Davis said.

U.S. Envoy Tells Russia's Neighbors: Having Putin As Your Only Friend Not A Good Idea, 15.09.2015

The U.S. ambassador to the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE) says there is a very important lesson for former Soviet republics to have learned from the devastating conflict in eastern Ukraine: Don't be too reliant on Russia. "Having [Russian] President [Vladimir] Putin as your only friend is a terrible position to be in," Daniel Baer told in an interview in Prague. "I think Moscow has proved time and again that it likes to use and manipulate political forces to its own end and has very little regard for what people actually experience," Baer said. "It doesn't care about the way citizens experience their government -- it likes to manipulate governments to meet its own objectives." Baer suggested that Belarusian President Alyaksandr Lukashenka's release last month of opposition leader and former presidential candidate Mikalay Statkevich and five other activists was motivated by a desire to improve relations with the European Union and not have Moscow as its only, or best, friend.

Yatsenyuk wants new laws for launch of land market, 23.09.2015

Yatsenyuk stressed that in addition to forming a new legislation base, it is necessary to carry out an inventory of land, and hold negotiations with investors and the public to determine the most pressing and sensitive issues of land relations. "There should be the package of laws and the formation of a real basis for full-fledged land market relations – and only then we'll launch the market. There is no alternative," Yatsenyuk said. He also added he supported an experiment when state-owned land is sold through auctions. "Prior to lifting the moratorium [on the sale of land] we need to settle some issues. Firstly, it is the inventory of land. The second problem is limitations on land owned by one entity – be it directly or indirectly. There should be no new oligarchs on the land market. Thirdly, rights to own land at this stage – and this is my political position – should belong to the citizens of Ukraine. The fourth issue is how the land buyback procedure should work. The value of land should be determined, and the state, acting through a government agency, should be ready to buy the land back and sell it to another owner. Colonel-General Viktor Muzhenko tells Oliver Carroll about Russian mobilisation and manoeuvres in the separatist enclaves – and wonders how long it will be before shots are fired in anger once more. Like many of Ukraine's top military officers, commander-in-chief Colonel-General Viktor Muzhenko has a long association with Russia. He spent his formative years as a young cadet in Leningrad, the present-day St Petersburg; many friends and family remain on that side of the border. John Kerry: Russia's involvement in Syria could be 'opportunity' for U.S., 30.09.2015 Secretary of State John Kerry on Tuesday called Russian President Vladimir Putin's involvement in Syria a possible "opportunity" for the United States.

Kerry predicted, in an interview with CNN's Elise Labott, that Russia's presence in Syria means Moscow could find itself in a "complicated" situation that could affect its policy toward the war-torn country and its leader, President Bashar al-Assad. "If he's going to side with Assad and with Iran and Hezbollah, he's going to have a very serious problem with the Sunni countries in the region," Kerry said of Putin. "That means he ... could very well become a target for those Sunni jihadists." Kerry explained: "It's an opportunity for us to force this question of how you actually resolve the question of Syria. And the bottom line is, you cannot resolve it without including the Sunni(s) in a political solution, a political agreement ultimately, and that will mean that you're going to have to have some kind of transition, some kind of timing. Because as long as Assad is there, you simply can't make peace. Period."

"These people have been identified, we are investigating their activity. We are also establishing who have been involved in handing out explosives, blocks, stun grenades," Avakov said.

Explosion outside Rivne region prosecutor's office determined terrorist attack, - PGO, 04.09.2015

The explosive device planted by unknown individuals detonated near the building of the prosecutor's office of Rivne region today Sept. 4 at about 1:30 a.m. The Prosecutor Generals' Office has determined the incident as a terrorist attack. No one was hurt as a result of the crime. Facade elements and windows of the building of the prosecutor's office were damaged. Rivne police investigators have registered the incident in the Unified Register of pre-trial investigations under Part 1 of the Article 258 of the Criminal Code of Ukraine (terroristic act).

Court orders law enforcers to disclose investigation of tragic events in Odesa on May 2, 15.09.2015

The Odesa Administrative Court of Appeal upheld the first instance decision regarding a lawsuit filed by Leonid Shtekel and Serhiy Dibrov, enabling journalists to obtain copies of forensic experts' conclusions related to "Odesa 2 May trial," according to online local news portal Dumskaya. The panel of judges, headed by Andriy Bitov, did not support arguments of the Prosecutor General's Office and a regional bureau of forensic and medical expertise. The court admits that there is a significant public interest in experts' conclusions, which have been made in the framework of criminal proceedings. The police, prosecutors and the regional bureau of forensic and medical expertise were not able to justify a need to limit access to this information. Thus, a ruling of the District Administrative Court has entered into force. In accordance with the court ruling, the regional bureau of forensic and medical expertise is required to provide journalists, at their request, with copies of the relevant documents without specifying names and other identifying information of the victims and experts.

I am sure this issue needs to be urgently solved at the legislative level, and if not, then parliamentary immunity needs to be cancelled," he said.

Ukraine calls for UN to restrain Russian veto, 29.09.2015

In a grim speech to the UN General Assembly, Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko condemned what he called Russia's "aggressive war against my country," a more than yearlong conflict with Russian-backed rebels that has left 8,000 Ukrainians dead in eastern Ukraine, including 6,000 civilians. The speech, applauded by Poroshenko's western allies, also urged members to limit the veto power that has prevented Security Council action against Russia. He joined France in a call for reforms to rein in the use of vetoes by the council's five permanent members in cases of "mass atrocities." Russia has wielded its veto to quash a resolution to declare a referendum on Crimea's secession from Ukraine illegal, after Moscow seized the largely Russian-speaking peninsula. It also blocked a resolution to set up an international tribunal to investigate the downing of a Malaysian airliner over territory held by pro-Russian rebels, with a loss of 298 lives.

The same day, U.S. President Barack Obama and Russian President Vladimir Putin held a 90-minute meeting behind closed doors. It is reported that they were discussing the Syria and Ukraine crises.

GRU officers Yerofeyev and Aleksandrov remain in custody, while Specialized Higher Court to determine case jurisdiction, 29.09.2015

Holosiivskyi district court of Kyiv has extended the custody of captive Russian GRU officers Yevgeny Yerofeyev and Aleksandr Aleksandrov for 60 days (until Nov. 21). The corresponding decision was announced on Tuesday by preparatory meeting chairing judge Mykola Didyk. The court has also ruled to send the materials of the case against the officers of the Main Intelligence Directorate (GRU) of the General Staff of the Russian Federation Armed Forces Yevgeny Yerofeyev and Aleksandr Aleksandrov to the Court of Appeal of Kyiv which, in its turn, is to hand over the documents to the Specialized Higher Court of Ukraine for Civil and Criminal Cases for establishing the case jurisdiction.

"The fact objectively demonstrates the pointlessness of keeping the Ukrainian military units on the border with Crimea and the absence of order on the Ukrainian border, which increases the responsibility of the Russian state border authorities and other security agencies in charge of the border security in Russia's Crimean Federal District," the state border department of the Russian Federal Security Service (FSB) said. Russian border guards decided to hold the Ukrainian service members administratively liable for violating the regime of Russia's state border and to transfer the detainees to the Ukrainian side. The Ukrainian paratroopers have expressed the wish to return to Ukraine as soon as possible voicing concern that severe punishment awaits them there.

At the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) observation point at the "Donetsk People's Republic" ("DPR")-controlled Donetsk railway station (8km north-west of Donetsk city centre), during the whole reporting period, the SMM recorded no ceasefire violations[1]. In government-controlled Myrne (40km north-east of Mariupol), the SMM heard three undetermined explosions south of its position. In government-controlled Hranitne (47km north-east of Mariupol) the SMM also recorded three undetermined explosions. The SMM accompanied by a Russian Federation Armed Forces officer at the JCCC and escorted by an armed "DPR" member, visited "DPR"-controlled Lohvynove (56km north-east of Donetsk) located 6.5km north-west Debaltseve (56km north-east of Donetsk).* Outside of the village, the SMM heard one burst of heavy machine gun (HMG) fire at a location 2-3km from its position. Russia transfers \$37 mln for pensions in DPR every month: Bloomberg, 16.09.2015

Two people in the rebel administration told Bloomberg Russia transfers 2.5 billion rubles (\$37 million) for pensions every month. They declined to be identified, citing security concerns. "Coal and metals exports were the main earners before the violence flared last year. Now the region is mostly reliant on Russian financial aid and taxes the government tries to gather from local businessmen by requiring them to open accounts at the central bank to pay suppliers," reads the article. "Russian goods are imported by local entrepreneurs who now have 14,000 accounts in total at the central bank," said Irina Nikitina, chairwoman of a co-called Central Bank of the DPR. "They allow an importer to pay Russian suppliers through a Russia-based credit union or through a bank in South Ossetia, a pro-Russian region that broke away from Georgia after a conflict in 2008."

The SMM monitored the implementation of the "Package of measures for the implementation of the Minsk agreements". Its monitoring was restricted by the parties and security considerations*. The situation remained largely calm in Donbas with only one non-training ceasefire violation recorded by the SMM. "DPR" members at a checkpoint pointed weapons at and threatened to shoot SMM members. The situation remained relatively calm in the Donetsk region. The SMM – positioned 1km south-east of the destroyed "Donetsk People's Republic" ("DPR")-controlled airport (9km north-west of Donetsk) – observed one explosion. In government-controlled Krasnivka (35km north-west of Mariupol), the SMM heard approximately 20 explosions in the far distance to the east. In government-controlled Topolyne (19km north-west of Mariupol), it heard approximately ten explosions in the far distance to the west and south-west. The SMM assessed both instances to have been part of training exercises. In government-controlled Tonenke (19km north-west of Donetsk), residents told the SMM that the area had been calm since 1 September. According to them, some internally displaced persons – including children of school-age- had returned to the village. The children, they said travel by bus to the nearest school in government-controlled Orlivka, 3km to the north. "DPR" members at a checkpoint close to "DPR"-controlled Zaichenko (26km north-east of Mariupol) pointed weapons at and threatened to shoot SMM members*. As the SMM was leaving the scene, one of the "DPR" members fired shots into the air.

ODIHR and HCNM report identifies widespread human rights violations, discrimination and legal irregularities in Crimea, 17.09.2015

Since the occupation and annexation of Crimea by the Russian Federation in early 2014, the enjoyment of human rights and fundamental freedoms has deteriorated radically for a large number of residents and displaced persons – particularly for pro-Ukrainian activists, journalists and the Crimean Tatar community, the OSCE Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights (ODIHR) and the OSCE High Commissioner on National Minorities (HCNM) said in a report published today. The 100-page Report of the Human Rights Assessment Mission on Crimea provides a comprehensive examination of the current human rights situation in Crimea, in light of developments since the release of a previous joint report by ODIHR and the HCNM, issued in May 2014. "Fundamental freedoms of assembly, association, expression and movement have all been restricted by the de facto authorities in Crimea," said Michael Georg Link, Director of ODIHR. "This has occurred through the application of restrictive Russian Federation laws and through the sporadic targeting of individuals, media or communities seeking to peacefully present opposing views." Based on interviews with more than 100 civil society actors, representatives of the Ukrainian authorities. Between 8.000 and 10.000 gathered at the rally just outside of the center of the Russian capital, said Leonid Volkov, one of the organizers, by telephone on Sunday. Prior to the rally as many as 8,400 people had registered their interest on Facebook while Moscow authorities gave permission for up to 40,000 demonstrators to congregate. Moscow police press-service said that about 4,000 people turned up.

An Obama-Putin Meeting Makes Sense, 28.09.2015

However distasteful he may find it, President Obama has no choice but to try to work with President Vladimir Putin if there is to be an end to the Syria debacle, just as Mr. Obama had no choice but to work with the Russian on the Iran deal. Thus a meeting of the two presidents on the relatively neutral ground of the United Nations General Assembly is the right thing to do. It thus seemed puerile for the White House press secretary, Josh Earnest, to portray Mr. Putin as a beggar "desperate" for a meeting and to belittle his personal appearance. That is not the way to prepare for a critical meeting.

Still, it is easy to sympathize with Mr. Obama. Mr. Putin has openly defied international law and Western sanctions by his annexation of Ukraine and support of rebels in eastern Ukraine. His backing of Syria's President Bashar al-Assad is one reason the Syrian civil war has dragged on so long and has created so appalling a humanitarian crisis. He routinely blames the United States for his troubles.

For these and other reasons it is not easy for Mr. Obama to acknowledge that he needs Mr. Putin's cooperation. The hard truth, however, is that neither Mr. Obama nor Mr. Putin is on particularly solid ground. The American effort to train moderate Syrians who could roll back both the Islamic State and the Assad forces has been a dismal failure; indeed, it is becoming increasingly clear that ISIS cannot be confronted effectively without a political settlement in Syria between Mr. Assad's regime and the opposition, which may mean keeping Mr. Putin's client temporarily in power.

Tension clouds meeting between Barack Obama, Vladimir Putin, 29.09.2015

The two presidents huddled in a second floor conference room at United Nations headquarters for roughly 90 minutes, squaring off on the contentious issues of Ukraine and Syria and seeking to discern each others' strategies after a two-year freeze in face-to-face encounters. Ahead of the meeting, Obama's aides had modest expectations for results, saying they were looking for a candid conversation on Ukraine and greater clarity on why Russia is ramping up its military presence in Ukraine. Those goals, U.S. officials said, appeared to have been reached. "We have clarity on their objectives," one senior administration official said. "Their objectives are to go after ISIL and to support the government." It's Russia's support for Syria's government, run by President Bashar al-Assad, that divides Obama and Putin. Officials say while the two men agreed to maintain military-to-military communication to avoid conflicts in the region, they failed to agree on what a peaceful solution to Syria's civil war might look like.
